WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has formally announced its inquiry into development and implementation of new digital audio radio services, including digital audio broadcasting (DAB). In soliciting comments on DAB, the FCC is seeking "information that will assist...in developing technical standards and regulatory policies for the possible introduction of new digital radio services." Issues identified as important regulatory considerations include the impact DAB would have on existing audio services; how to accommodate digital audio service in the broadcast spectrum; what regulatory structure(s) should be adopted for the new service; and whether one set of governing policies should be used for new services regardless of frequencies, or whether policies unique to each proposed band and service should be adopted.

Thus far the FCC has received three filings seeking authorization for digital services: Satellite CD Radio, Inc., whose service would be provided in part by satellites and in part by terrestrial transmitters presently used for aeronautical telemetry operations; Radio Satellite Corp., which seeks to construct and operate an earth station to provide DAB programming along with other mobile services through the American Mobile Satellite Corp.; and Strother Communications, Inc., which wants experimental authority to construct and operate DAB systems in Boston and in Washington DC, providing DAB programs 14 UHF television channels using the European-developed Eureka-147 DAB system.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

The Commission has upheld a staff action cancelling KIQI San Francisco's 1980 CP for new nighttime operation and a change in city of license to Sunnyvale, CA. The FCC had acted unilaterally to cancel the CP in 1987 when a subsequent application noted that the CPs had not been constructed. KIQI has since added nighttime operation under a new construction permit.

On July 10, the FCC's Field Operation Bureau conducted a nationwide audit of 374 AM stations. The audit revealed a high level of compliance with new emission limitation requirements (the new NRSC standards) to reduce adjacent channel interference to AM stations. Of the 374 stations monitored, 325 (87 percent) complied with the equipment installed alternative. On July 12, technical measurements were conducted on the remaining 49 stations and all were found to be in compliance.

ELSEWHERE

Our friends at Radio & Records have added another piece to the Roy Henderson allocation puzzle around Houston TX. They've located the elusive (and tiny) Redland TX, where KRTX Galveston is to be reallocated under one of Henderson's counterproposals. It is just outside Lufkin TX, about 160 miles north of Galveston. Henderson's KRTX proposal is complicated by having not yet closed his purchase of the station from its current owner, Irvin Davis.

From Seattle comes word of a low cost overnight (10pm to 8am) programming alternative from MUZAK. YES, the people who bring you in store and office music. The music is delivered from CD's and RDATE tape via satellite in several formats. There are still a few bugs in the idea as the programming does not offer local cutaways and is only available only in mono. There is no commercial requirement and the service is expected to cost from \$200 to \$300, depending on the market. Formats available include CHR, AC, New AC, and light classical. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Congressional opposition is growing to a Bush administration proposal for a 4% tax on broadcasters as one mechanism for addressing the federal budget deficit. The proposal, which would levy a 4% tax on gross revenues as a "spectrum tax" for use of the radio spectrum, has already met public opposition from Senate Commerce Committee Chair Fritz Hollings (D-SC), House Commerce Committee Chair John Dingell (D-MI) and ranking GOP member Norman Lent (R-NY), and House Telecommunications Subcommittee member Matt Rinaldo (R-NJ), among others. The National Association of Broadcasters is urging all broadcasters to contact their local Congressional representatives to express their concerns. As the NAB and many other commentators have noted, a 4% surcharge on gross revenues exceeds the operating margins at many radio stations, and could cripple local radio service in the US.

The FCC has shifted administration of the Emergency Broadcast System from the Office of the Managing Director to the Field Operations Bureau (FOB). The change includes oversight responsibility for the EBS Advisory Committee.

ELSEWHERE

A CRTC decision to award a new FM license in Toronto to Rawlco Communications (which already operates several AM and FM stations in Canada) has provoked a rare public dissent among CRTC Commissioners. Three of the five CRTC Commissioners, including chair Keith Spicer, issued a statement objecting to the decision to back Rawlco's application for a new country-formatted FM in Canada's largest market. The dissent pointed out that country stations already exist in the market, and that competing applications - in particular a black applicant for an urban/dance/jazz format that would have been unprecedented in Canada - better serve the standard of providing diversity to the marketplace. Under Canada's current licensing system, a license can be awarded by the CRTC without the approval of a majority of its commissioners; and the licensee (in this case, Rawlco) must still research and win approval from the Dept. of Communications for technical facilities for the new station.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

WAMB-1160, Donalson (Nashville) TN, has been granted Special Temporary Authority by the FCC to operate a low-power FM relay station as compensation for Cuban interference to its AM signal at night. The relay will operate on 106.7 MHz with

a power of 75 watts, which is calculated to be equivalent to WAMB's normal interference-free 1 kw AM signal at night.

For many years, WAMB and other AM clear channel stations, particularly in the Southeast, have been sporadically plagued by severe interference problems from Cuban stations operating at frequencies and powers not authorized by international agreement. Since the advent of Radio Marti in 1986, interference has become more severe. In 1987 and 1988, brief high-power Cuban broadcasts on 1040 and 1160 KHz caused audible local interference to WHO, Des Moines IA, and KSL, Salt Lake City UT, and since then Cuba has used the threat of massive, high-power broadcast AM interference as leverage to try to stop Radio Marti broadcasts.

The FCC took pains to note that the Nashville FM would be allowed only as a temporary measure until a diplomatic solution can be reached with Cuba, and only as a last resort when preferred technical modifications to the AM facility itself cannot overcome Cuban interference. A number of AM stations in South Florida are operating with specially authorized high powers to counter co-channel Cuban stations; however, this is the first instance where the FCC has authorized operation of a simulcast FM station for the besieged AM.

The FCC this week officially terminated three 1988 Dockets intended to review AM technical standards. They included Docket 88-509, regarding nighttime operation for Class II-S and III-S AMs; Docket 88-511, regarding review of methods for calculating nighttime protection standards; and Docket 88-376, regarding the reduction of adjacent channel interference and eliminating restrictions on protected daytime signal contours. Also this week, the FCC denied reconsideration for the proposed allotment of FM channel 224C2 (92.7 MHz) to Cameron.

ELSEWHERE

King Broadcasting Co. of Seattle, operators of KING AM/FM Seattle, KGW/KINK Portland and KSFO/KYA San Francisco, has announced plans to sell the company and apply the assets to a new foundation dedicated to environmental issues. Priscilla Bullitt Collins and Harriet Stimson Bullitt, the sisters with controlling interest in King, decided to engineer a sale "at a time of our own choosing...[with] the maximum stability and continuity for King." In addition to the radio stations, King operates six television stations, thirteen cable systems and a large mobile television division; proceeds from the sale are expected to expand the Bullitt Foundation's funds from \$5 million to well over \$100 million.

SMN stepped outside the traditional role of a satellite format supplier last Sunday to broadcast the requests of families to soldiers in the Middle East. Dean Richards and Bob Leonard of SMN's AC format took calls and dedications from 224 stations across the USA. A tape of the program will be re-broadcast on Armed Forces Radio.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has upheld a Review Board decision granting license renewal for WHYI Fort Lauderdale FL. The station's license had been challenged on grounds of EEO violations and alleged violations of sponsorship identification rules.

The Commission also upheld a previous decision dismissing the application of WLVE, Miami Beach FL, to regain its previous Class C status. WLVE had appealed a finding that a prior owner's voluntary downgrading of the signal to Class C1 could not be reversed without a petition for rulemaking. Since WLVE was and is already short-spaced, the ruling makes it impossible for WLVE to achieve its upgrade.

For the second time this month, KIQI San Francisco has lost an appeal of an FCC decision. The AM was denied review of a decision fining the station \$8,000 for repeated FCC violations by failing to light the station's tower lights. KIQI previously lost an appeal to reinstate an expired 1982 construction permit.

The FCC has remanding the proceeding for a new AM station on 700 KHz in suburban Washington, DC. A 250 w daytime facility had been granted to Reston Community Broadcasting, Inc., in Reston, VA; their application and the 5000 w daytime application of Elijah Broadcasting Corp. for Walkersville, MD are now back in hearing status. Reston had been granted the station partly based on a greater need for first local broadcast service in its community; Elijah has challenged that grant on the grounds that, since either facility can be expected to serve the

greater Washington, DC area rather than simply its city of license, the application better able to cover the entire market should be granted.

Also this week: The FCC amended rules regarding the review of motions to disqualify presiding ALJ officers in hearings; no additional details were released. And, the FCC announced a second shutdown of a pirate radio station operating on 91.9 MHz in Floral Park, NY. "WPFA" was operated by Joseph Sapanaro, Jr., who was fined \$1,500, and had a previous pirate shut down by the FCC in 1981.

An application has been filed for a new international (shortwave) station, based in Miami. The application, filed by Radio Miami International, proposes service to the Caribbean basin with a heavy emphasis on regional news, culture and weather. RMI's owners also expect to broker some broadcast time initially until sales of commercial time develop. A potential barrier for the application is that it specifies 10,000 watts of power, whereas the FCC requires a minimum of 50,000 watts for a shortwave station; no U.S. station has ever been granted a waiver of the minimum power requirements before.

ELSEWHERE

Radio's most notorious manipulator of the FM table of allocations is striking again. Tom Gammon of Crown Broadcasting, which has drawn the ire of competing broadcast groups and industry leader for its move-in proposals for stations outside Atlanta and Sacramento, has purchased WKKJ in Chillicothe OH and proposed a move to the Columbus, OH suburb of Reynoldsburg. Crown's counterproposal would also allow a station upgrade in Lima and create two new Class A FM drop-ins. Another move to watch for: another subsidiary of Crown has recently purchased KFFN in Sierra Vista, AZ, about 75 miles southeast of Tucson.

Bob Arthur, co-host of KABC Los Angeles' "Ken and Bob Company" morning show, has announced his retirement from broadcasting Sept. 14. Arthur, 69, has for 17 years helped KABC's morning show dominate Los Angeles morning ratings. Replacing Arthur at KABC Oct. 1 will be well-known L.A. personality Roger Barkley.

The Milwaukee Journal reports that album rock station WLZR-102.9/1340 has been turned down by Satellite Music Network in its bid to broadcast SMN's heavy metal "Z-Rock" on its AM, now a 100% simulcast. In light of the recent ratings success of Z-Rock on KZZF (FM) in Fresno, SMN says it wants to refocus Z-Rock marketing on FM stations and will now consider only select AM stations for affiliation.

The Imagination Stations, one of four separate children's programming networks now now in development, has taken a major step to becoming the first in wide distribution. The format, based at WPRD-1440 in Orlando, is now on satellite, and will expand from its 6 AM-10 PM schedule to become a 24-hour service next month.

Technical details have not yet been released, but the Canadian DOC has granted a new network of publicly operated French FM stations in upper New Brunswick. CFAI, based in Edmundston, hopes to be the air by Nov. 15, 1990. The new outlet will broadcast from studios in Grand Falls, St.-Quentin and Edmundston.
