WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has once again reversed itself long after granting a new FM construction permit. In this case, it has reinstated the application of David T. Murray for a new FM station in University, MS, ruling that the prior dismissal of the Murray application was insupportable. Since the facility granted (WUMS-92.1) has been on since April 89, the FCC rescinded the CP but issued a special temporary authority (STA) to let WUMS to operate for 90 days while its owner, the Univ. of MS Student Media Center, and Murray work out a joint interim operating agreement. Once again, the question must be asked: when, exactly, is an FCC decision final?

Buck Owens Production Co., Inc., licensee of KCWR-550/KUZZ-FM-107.9 Bakersfield, has been granted a waiver of one-to-a-market rules to allow purchase of KDOB-TV-48 Bakersfield. KDOB is now in bankruptcy and qualified as a "failed station"; it had been operated separately by Buck Owens' sister. In a similar case, George S. Flinn, owner of Flinn Bcstg Co. and WHBQ-560 Memphis TN, was granted permission to buy the construction permit for an unbuilt TV station on Ch. 50 in Memphis. Flinn claimed economies of scale would allow both the struggling WHBQ and the new CP to operate successfully. Flinn has already avoided multiple ownership rules once by selling WGSF-1210, Arlington TN (Memphis), to his brother-in-law, Fred Flinn, in order to buy WHBQ. Finally, the FCC dismissed American Legal Foundation's request for reconsideration of multiple ownership rules for AM, FM and TV stations.

The FCC has revoked the license of WRPZ-1440, Paris KY, which has been silent for over a year. As part of this action, the FCC noted that all stations off for twelve to eighteen months are subject to license revocation. With record totals of stations now silent, particularly stand-alone AMs, enforcement of licensing requirements might trigger de-licensing of dozens of facilities in the next year.

FCC employees are among hundreds of thousands of federal workers who have received notice of possible unpaid 22 day furloughs if Congress does not approve a fiscal 1991 federal budget by October 1. The furloughs would take effect on Oct. 1 unless emergency funding legislation is approved before that date.

BFM CALENDAR NOTES

Stations in Samoa, Guam, Alabama, Hawaii, Oregon and Washington must file renewal applications (FCC Form 303-S and Form 396) by October 1. Iowa and South Dakota FM translators must file renewal applications on FCC Form 348; and Samoa, Guam, Florida, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, Iowa, Missouri, Alabama, Hawaii, Oregon and Washington stations must file Annual Ownership Reports (Form 323) by Oct. 1.

The Society of Broadcast Engineers (SBE) meets in St. Louis Oct. 4-7; Kansas' state broadcasters meet Oct. 10-12 and Massachusetts broadcasters meet Oct. 19-21.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Timed to coincide with the opening of campaigns for the upcoming November 1990 elections, the FCC this week released an extensive report on broadcast station electoral advertising practices, based on its surprise audit of 30 TV and radio stations in July. The report concluded that a majority of stations surveyed were not in compliance with laws requiring that candidates be charged the lowest available rates available at a station.

Of the 20 television and 10 radio stations audited, the FCC found that candidates were being overcharged by 20 stations. In some cases, candidates were being charged more than any of the station's other clients in a given time period. The higher rates were generally charged due to candidates' insistence on purchasing time at fixed, non-preemptible rates.

The FCC report makes no conclusions with respect to specific violations by any of the 30 stations audited. Instead, the report focuses on practices the FCC believe to be in violation of "the intent of Congress." It also reminds broadcasters of the need to "maintain a political file which is current, complete, and self-explanatory"; and that "broadcasters may not establish restrictions or limitations in advance when selling or furnishing time to federal candidates."

The FCC's July raid on broadcasters, and this week's report, are in large part a response to political pressure brought on the Commission by Congress. A number of proposals have been suggested by members of Congress to either minimize or eliminate advertising charges for political candidates. This week brought relatively few FCC actions due to the Labor Day holiday.

David E. Horowitz has been appointed Chief of the Legal Branch, Policy & Rules Division, Mass Media Bureau of the FCC. Horowitz joined the Commission as a staff attorney in 1988, and was previously a Washington, DC communications lawyer.

ELSEWHERE

Willhight Radio Research has announced nearly a dozen radio markets, including its first outside the Pacific Northwest, that Willhight will measure for the first time in 1990/91. The new markets, all of which will be measured once yearly, are: Crescent City CA; Yreka CA; Aspen CO; Durango CO; Maui HI; Bozeman MT; Newport OR; St. George UT; Casper WY; Cheyenne WY; and Vancouver, B.C., Canada. Willhight also announced that measurements of its Idaho Falls/Pocatello market will increase to twice yearly.

Unistar Radio Networks has repositioned its "Niche 29" oldies-based CHR format and is renaming it "Adult Rock 'n' Roll." ARR is described as targeting "21-36 year old, 60/40 male/female listeners." In addition to US affiliates, SMN also provides specialized formats in the Caribbean and the People's Republic of China.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

In FCC decisions this week:

Design Media, Inc., licensee of WNSL Laurel MS, has been admonished for discriminating between opposing legally qualified candidates and for failing to broadcast required sponsorship identification.

The appeal of John Spencer Robinson to have his application for a new FM at Edgewater FL reinstated has been granted.

The denial of Chester County Broadcasting Company's request to modify the FM table at Chester and Wedgefield SC has been upheld.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission has affirmed the Review Board's decision to grant the application of Posey County Broadcasting Corp. for a new FM at Mount Vernon IN. The FCC agreed with the ALJ that Posey was the better applicant on the basis of "substantial quantitative integration preference".

James R. Burtle has been appointed Chief of the AM Branch of the audio services Division, Mass Media Bureau.

ELSEWHERE

Birch/Scarborough has announced new station activities guidelines. The new policy addresses such activities as ratings distortion, ratings bias and any other special activity that is not considered generally accepted industry standards. Copies of the guidelines can be obtained by calling 1-800-62-BIRCH.

The NAB and the Broadcast Financial Management Association have published the 1990 Radio Financial Report. The report contains more than 100 tables based on revenue categories, station type, market population, and formats. Each report shows the average revenue sources, departmental expenses, selected revenue and expense items, and profits for specific groupings of stations.

Highlights from the NAB/BCFM report include: 76.9% of 1989 radio time sales came from local advertising, 21.5% from national/regional and 1.6% from network compensation. On the expense side, program and production accounted for 20.8%, engineering 4.3%, news 4.5%, sales 19.4%, advertising and promotion 9.9%, general and administrative costs 41.1%. Copies of the report are available from the NAB.

The air line-up includes, Robin Sanders 5-10am (MDT), Craig Jackson 10-3pm, Dean Taylor 3-8pm, Jim O'Brian 8-12m, and Bill Lyall 12-5am.
