WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Although we took last week off here at M Street, rest assured this issue takes into account all of the FCC Applications, Actions, and Notices since our last issue.

A whole slough of year-end fines were handed out by the Commission this past week, mostly for lottery violations. A slot machine tournament commercial cost KWAZ Needles/KABS Bullhead City CA \$12,500. KMZQ-FM Henderson NV was also pegged \$12,500 for gambling spots. Bell Broadcasting's WJZZ Detroit MI paid \$6,250 for not conducting a "count-the-song" contest as it had aired. WQBB Knoxville TN ran a spot for the Kentucky lottery in a state where playing the lottery is illegal. It cost them \$6,250.

The eight year battle over WNWK 105.9 in Newark NJ (New York) may finally be over. The Commission upheld the approval of a joint settlement agreement which resulted in granting the application of Multicultural Broadcasting to operate the deleted WHB1 facilities. The current interim operator, Global Broadcasting Group, was expressly prohibited from applying for permanent authority to operate the station so that no applicant for permanent licensing would have an advantage.

Rarely does it happen, but the commission has denied the application of Normandy Broadcasting Corp. to renew its license of WYLR in Glens Falls NY. Normandy Broadcasting was charged with misrepresenting several aspects of its operation to the commission by a competing applicant in a neighboring town. The Commission found the allegations had merit, and granted the license to Lawrence N. Brandt for the station, which is at 95.9 MHz.

The Commission has denied Joelmart, Inc.'s petition for reconsideration of the Review Board's reversal of the ALJ's Initial Decision which granted the application of Joelmart. The Board granted the application of Delta Broadcasting for the new FM in Santa Barbara.

CANADA THIS WEEK

Canada's broadcast regulator, the CRTC, has told the CHUM group that it has only six months to sell its second Vancouver FM, CHQM. The CRTC gave CHUM until May 12 of this year to sell the station, six months less than it had asked for.

ELSEWHERE

The Radio Advertising Bureau reports that combined national and local spot ad revenue is up 3% for November, 1992. This means that 1992 to date is up 2% over the year before. Local revenue for all markets was up 4%. National revenue for all markets, something which had been threatening to actually stabilize, was off 4%. The best region for local revenue was the southwest which was up 9% for this November vs. November 1991.

After six years as a monitored airplay trade of some sort, Monday Morning Replay finally ceased publication over the holidays. MMR was born in 1986 as Mediastat, then came back in 1987 as MMR. For the last nine months, it had been publishing the magazine on computer disc only. MMR used one day logger tapes of stations for its monitors. Its demise leaves Billboard as the only major monitored airplay trade for now; Billboard will launch a separate CHR monitor publication this month.

New duopolies: WMXP Pittsburgh to EZ Communications' WBZZ (see formats); Atlantic Radio's WRMM-AM-FM Rochester, N.Y., from a would-have-been duopoly with WPXY-AM-FM to WCMF Rochester instead; KHFI Austin from Rusk to Clear Channel, creating a duopoly with KPEZ.

Hartford-based Murray/Walsh Radio Programming has launched "American Dance Classics," a two hour weekly disco oldies show similar to those heard on WQHT New York and WKSS Hartford. WQHT's Al Bandiero will host. Call 800-729-6499.

Just when you thought radio was getting out of the affinity group credit card business, Business Radio Network and People's Bank of Connecticut are now offering a BRN Mastercard through BRN's main network as well as its American Forum Radio and Sports Radio Network webs. For more info, call 719-528-7040. Also, Joe Namath will host an SRN show--"Talk Sports With Joe Namath"--beginning January 18.

The IRTS seminar on talk radio/TV had been rescheduled for January 19. For more info, call 212-867-6650.

You still have a few days to get your country station's composite to the Country Radio Seminar for inclusion in its annual station highlights tape. Send your material to Barry Mardit at WWWW, 2930 E. Jefferson Ave., Detroit, Mich., 48207 by Jan 11. Remember, early registration for CRS is Jan. 15. And while you're there, be sure to buy the Grand Ole Opry a beer. That show has been inducted into the National Assn. of Broadcasters' broadcasting hall of fame. The induction will take place at the NAB's annual convention in Las Vegas on April 18-22.

Unistar has announced two new specials. The three hour "A Country Valentine" love songs program for the Feb. 12-14 weekend and the San Francisco-themed "The Best Of The Bay" for Feb. 19-21. The latter will be hosted by WMMR Philadelphia's Earle Bailey. No word yet on which KRQR or KFOG personality will be hosting the upcoming "Best of Philly. International" special. In other network news, ABC has announced the addition of Summit's WRKS New York, KJMZ Dallas, WVEE Atlanta, and WXYV Baltimore, as well as WVVAZ Chicago as ABC Radio Networks affiliates.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Just in case you thought it had been awhile since the FCC went back to its roots, leveling indecency fines against those off-color songs that somehow end up on college stations, the commission has leveled a \$23,750 fine against noncommercial WSUC Cortland, N.Y., for the oral-sex themed rap song, "Yodel In The Valley." Unless you count "The Candy Rapper," it's the first time that an actual rap has been the target of an FCC action.

The Commission also upheld the short-term renewal and \$15,000 forfeiture against WGUL AM & FM, New Port Richey, FL for EEO problems, and the KMEL San Francisco indecency fine of \$25,000. Malrite's WHK/WMMS Cleveland OH escaped EEO violation charges, over the objection of the NAACP, and had its licenses renewed. The station's were asked to keep better EEO recruitment records, however.

Non-commercial WBHL Florence AL was slapped with a \$5,000 for commercial announcements that didn't quite fit the non-comm rules. WMGA Moultrie GA received an NAL for \$10,000 for transferring control of the station without approval and not filing an annual ownership report.

Joelmart, Inc. , an original applicant for the new 107.7 MHz in Santa Barbara lost its petition for reconsideration of the grant to Delta Broadcasting.

Apple Computer chairman/CEO John Sculley will be the keynoter at this year's National Assn. of Broadcasters' convention to be held April 18-22 in Las Vegas. For more info, call 202-429-5350.

You've probably heard a little about John Abel, NAB's Exec. VP/operations, since the DAB debate helped bring him to center stage a few years ago. He'll anchor a session called "The Impact Of New Technologies on Broadcasting" at the forthcoming Radio Advertising Bureau Managing Sales Conference to be held in Dallas Feb. 4-7. Registrations for this year's MSC are 20% ahead of last year's largest-to-date convention. For more info, call 212-387-2100.

ELSEWHERE

Jones Satellite Network is on the verge of rolling out two new services in the coming months. JSN's new hot country format, "CD Country" will debut in February and is described as current-intensive and high personality. Look for JSN to debut an all-sports network shortly thereafter. Terms for the country network will be a combination of barter and cash, unlike the preexisting cash-only Jones formats.

In this industry, it seems that each year is more tumultuous than its predecessor. But there is something to be said for "the more it changes, the more it stays the same." Some interesting facts we pulled out of the database at year end: there were 577 call letter changes in 1992 vs. 534 in 1991. There were fewer format changes this year than '91--991 vs. 1018. There were 69 frequency changes this past year, 3 fewer than 1991. 13 stations changed their city of license--the same as last year. The statistic that has changed the most? New stations. In 1991, 425 new facilities were licensed vs. only 273 this past year.

On the RBDS Front: During the 1993 Winter Consumer Electronics Show (CES), the Electronics Industries Association (EIA) and the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) announced the long-awaited RBDS standard. RBDS is a data transmission standard utilizing the 57 kHz FM subcarrier. This technology will allow call sign identification, format tuning, traffic alerting, messaging, paging, data transfer, use in navigation systems, and is being considered by the Commission as a key element in revamping the emergency broadcast system (EBS). It will cost the average FM station a minimum of \$2,500 to purchase the encoding equipment to make use of the technology. RBDS is only operational with FM stations and is currently broadcast by 42 stations (ten of which are in Las Vegas--and the equipment was installed complements of the EIA). For stations that choose not to participate in RBDS, or for any AM, ID Logic (see next story) will allow for format scanning and call sign identification.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Sony, Sanyo and Clarion have joined with Matsushita (Panasonic), Alpine, and JVC as licensees of the ID Logic technology that allows radio listeners to search for their favorite stations by format. According to the announcement by PRS Corp, the developer of the format-scanning technology, Alpine and Matsushita (under the Panasonic brand) already have several radios on the market that feature the technology. PRS President Pierre Schwob hopes to establish ID Logic as a standard feature in all radios, as his ID Logic "B" technology was incorporated in the new RBDS standard adopted last Fall. ID Logic permits the immediate identification of any station in either band. ID Logic "A" operates independently from any radio signals, while ID Logic "B" updates the radio automatically through digital subcarrier transmissions from selected FM stations.

The latest niche network will be introduced in late February via satellite as "Job Radio," syndicated by Western Star. The network plans to comp affiliates depending on the number of hours carried. Spokesman Bob Picaly says the net will train station staffs, supply marketing materials, and help with marketing plans. Job Radio will feature three separate channels, each having different levels of station interaction. For more information, call Bob at 708-527-9000.

Equipment manufacturer Wegener Communications announced a \$1 Million deal with Fox Broadcasting for software and satellite equipment. Wegener is also introducing a new line of SCPC receivers and transmitters that use half the bandwidth of an analog transmission. For more info, call Ken Leffingwell at (404) 623-0096.

Radio America talk host Morton Downey, Jr., moves the base of operations for his syndicated show from WWRC Washington to KGBS Dallas. Downey's net is now being billed on-air as the "American Blue Collar Radio Network." Elsewhere on the talk-host front, R&R reports that former Nixon aide John Dean has filed a personal attack against his former co-conspirator G. Gordon Liddy for remarks on Liddy's WJFK-FM Washington show where Dean was featured in Liddy's weekly "Pop Goes The Weasel" segment.

More news on WJFK: The station has been slapped with a page 5-B note by Arbitron for a "frequent listener" promotion by p.m. drivers Don & Mike. Arbitron took umbrage at WJFK's "20 Hour Club" for people who listened to the entire show all week long.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

This one sound familiar? Inside Radio reports that the FCC is again going to try to make good on its Congressional mandate to tighten the "safe harbor" rule in February, thus limiting indecency--something currently still allowed from 8 p.m. on. The new rule will probably be challenged in court, just as the FCC's previous 24-hour indecency ban was. R&R, meanwhile, reports that the NAB joint board "will keep a low profile" on the issue by complaining about the "vague" indecency standards, but also restating its support for a 1990 voluntary programming code. The NAB board also decided to again ask for a relaxing of the prior notification rules on taping of phone calls.

The Commission has approved a settlement agreement between Bakcor Broadcasting, Inc. and Southwest Educational Media Foundation of Texas, Inc. and granted the renewal for KKIK Lubbock to Bakcor.

Another EEO fine this week. Pasco Pinellas Broadcasting's WLVU Dunnedin FL was hit for \$18,000.

The DAB face-off between the Electronics Industries Association (EIA) and the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) continues as USA Digital's Project Acorn, the broadcaster-backed, in-band system, will not be submitted for testing to the EIA's Digital Audio Radio Subcommittee. According to Radio World, in a letter delivered by Gannett Radio VP/Engineering Paul Donahue, the testing process does not have adequate support from the broadcasting industry. Gary Shapiro, VP of the EIA's Consumer Electronics Group, said the decision could potentially exclude Acorn from the EIA testing process.

The NAB's Winter Board Meeting in Naples, FL yielded several press releases reaffirming its positions on today's hottest issues. The board opposes the new FCC forfeiture schedule, arguing that a public comment period should be required. The board also reaffirmed its voluntary programming principles aimed at establishing guidelines regarding indecent programming in the wake of Howard Stern.

ELSEWHERE

The Radio Advertising Bureau's Radio Creative Fund has announced a new prize structure for its upcoming Mercury Awards for radio spot advertising. While the \$100,000 grand prize will again go to the best overall commercial, a \$20,000 "gold" prize and a \$5,000 "silver" prize will be awarded in the following categories: humor; non-humor; station produced; and music/sound design, meaning that a minimum of \$25,000 will go to local stations. Entries will be accepted until February 24th.

As part of the ongoing "LMA them in the crib" trend, Susquehanna's WFMS Indianapolis has announced an LMA for forthcoming Greenwood, Indiana CP WGGR. WFMS is already worried about whether WGGR will get into the right nursery school and is teaching it to speak French in the womb. WGGR (106.7) is expected on in spring.

Attention, sports fans: Former Sports Entertainment Network staffer Jack Hayes has announced the cancellation of the Interstar All Sports Network which was to have debuted next month. Hayes cites "the rumored entry into the sports-talk net arena of Jones, Infinity, and Paxson Broadcasting." Jones' arrival, actually, was announced here last week. Hayes will continue to consult sports-talk outlets at 619-229-8307. Meanwhile, Business Radio Network's American Sports Network is up and running; for more info, call Joe Speck at 800-800-9963. ASN's initial offerings will include the NHL All Star Game and Stanley Cup Finals. And SFN adds two new hosts, night host Bill "Maddog" Matlock and ESPN staffer/SEN weekender Al Bernstein.

Bud Paxson announced his intent this week to pick up the 68-affiliate Florida State Network, and its lucrative sports networks, putting another notch in his Florida radio belt. According to Inside Radio, Paxson is close to closing the deal with Pat Robertson, which helps to round out his collection of Florida properties.

Gary Owens and Wink Martindale are the latest addition's to Southern California's new AM simulcast standards format. Owens will do afternoon drive. Martindale will cover mid-days.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Even though Monday was a holiday, the Commission decided to take Wednesday off, too. This issue is a little light because of that.

The Commission has blasted T. Kent Atkins, who controls six stations in Texas and Louisiana, with a \$250,000 fine and has designated for hearing the license renewal of KRGN Amarillo, KLMN Amarillo, and KENT Odessa, all Texas; and the license applications for KAMY Lubbock, KENT-FM Odessa, and KOJO Lake Charles LA.

The Commission said an investigation revealed that he arbitrarily constructed KLMN, KAMY, and KENT-FM. He also allegedly misrepresented facts and knowingly submitted fraudulent documents. The Commission further designated for hearing the assignment of a CP for KBTB Bridgeport TX, and the CP for a new FM in Stanton TX. Atkins controls several of these station under the Caprock Educational Media Foundation.

The Commission designated for hearing four mutually exclusive applications, three for a new FM at Beaumont CA and one for the modification of facilities of KATY-FM Idyllwild CA. Two applications for a new FM at Eldon IA were also slated for a hearing.

The Commission has denied a petition by Ramapo Indian Hills Regional High School District seeking reconsideration of the Commission's earlier decision upholding the dismissal of Ramapo's application to upgrade the facilities of WRRH Franklin Lakes, NY from class D to class A. Ramapo's proposal would have created overlap problems with WFDU-FM Teaneck NJ and WBGO-FM Newark NJ.

Montachusett Broadcasting, Inc. unsuccessfully tried to get the Commission to reconsider a \$4,000 fine levied for broadcasting a telephone conversation without permission on WXLO Fitchburg MA. Montachusett tried to argue that the Commission issued the fine in accordance with a policy statement that was not yet in effect. H. Drew Wilder, licensee of WBAW Barnwell SC was hit for \$5,000 for a similar violation.

ELSEWHERE

The verdict is in on radio revenue for 1992. We're up two percent overall. According to the RAB, local advertising, which accounts for three-quarters of radio revenue, closed the year up five percent, which more than covered national's six percent drop. Network was down 13.5 percent. Both national and network were up in December. As for 1993: "Modest but healthy growth within the radio industry" predicts President Gary Fries.

In the "look before you leap" department...KLSX Los Angeles, and morning host Howard Stern, made a big stink about Spanish KLAX's ascension to number one 12+ in the most recent book. KLSX claimed that many of the diaries improperly credited KLAX with listening that should have been for KLSX. Arbitron and KLAX had maintained the book was clean. After a diary audit, KLSX admitted as much stating that KLAX "is definitely a strong station" according to Daily Variety. KLAX jumped from 21st to 1st in just four months after a format change last summer.

Motorola announced this week it will produce an AMAX chip set to provide a low-cost design for manufacturers producing AM Stereo radios, according to the NAB. Both chips, the tuner I.C. and the AM Stereo decoder, include the noise-blanking circuitry that is now available in several Delco radios and one Denon tuner. Engineering samples of the chipset will be available this fall.

Since President's Day is just around the corner, what better way to celebrate than to become one (again). . . The former presidents of VNU Operations and Birch Scarborough are back together to form a new research venture. Bill Engel and Bill Livek have created Symmetrical Resources, Inc. to do qualitative programming and advertiser research concentrating on mid-sized and smaller markets. They can be found at (305) 427-4104. Rhody Bosley, former Arbitron VP, has joined forces with Breakthrough Marketing VP's Julie Heath and Marc Greenspan to create Research Director, Inc. to produce sales research materials and conduct audience analysis.
