JACOR TO BE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT'S "GUINEA" PIG . . . The legal department at Jacor Broadcasting is putting in a lot of overtime as the Justice Department is investigating its pending purchase of both Citicasters and Noble Broadcasting. The separate investigations could sidetrack the nearly \$1 billion deals. The Justice Department is looking at potential anti-trust violations resulting from owning up to eight stations in a single market. The investigation marks the first test of the new ownership rules.

"GO WEST, YOUNG GROUP!" Jack McSorley's BayCom Partners is cashing out in San Jose and Portland, OR for \$103 million. It will sell rocker KSJO, San Jose and classic rock KUFX, Gilroy, CA and country KUPL-FM and jazz KKJZ, Lake Oswego, OR in the Portland market to none other than West Coast-crazed American Radio Systems. ARS has plans in the works to buy new rock KBBT, rocker KUFO, and contemporary Christian KDBX in the Portland market.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Two AM stations lost their licenses this week. The two silent AM's were up for renewal but were cancelled. They are WYSE, Bainbridge, GA and WNMT, Garden City, GA. An educational FM is also gone in Baltimore. WBYQ-FM, Baltimore's license was cancelled and its call letters were deleted. WBYQ-FM was on 94.3 MHz and has been silent since early 1994.

The Commission has two more AM's up for termination for remaining silent without authorization. KEZJ, Twin Falls, ID and KRBG, Canadian, TX both must show cause why they shouldn't be revoked. The FCC may revoke the licenses of a combo in Sidney, MT. KGCX, Inc.'s KGCX (AM) and KGCH-FM are in jeopardy after being silent for years.

The Commission's Post Office Boxes associated with filing fees and renewal fees have been changed. All AM, FM, and translator renewal filings should now go to FCC, Mass Media Services, P.O. Box 358190, Pittsburgh, PA 15251-5190.

ELSEWHERE

Evergreen Media will have three FM's in San Francisco with the \$44 million acquisition of dance KYLD, San Francisco from Crescent Communications. Evergreen already owns hot AC KIOI and urban KMEL, both San Francisco. The LMA began May 1. Star Media's Peter Handy brokered the deal. Crescent holds on to urban AC KSOL and KYLZ.

Ragan Henry's US Radio is picking up two more stations in the Memphis market with the purchase of black gospel KWAM and urban KJMS for \$12.5 million. US Radio already owns urban AC WDIA and urban WHRK in that market. US Radio recently announced its group will be sold to Clear Channel Communications.

OmniAmerica is selling off its remaining property in Cleveland. Sports-talk WHK will spin to Salem Communications for \$6.5 million. OmniAmerica announced the sale of WHK's sisters, WMMS and WMJI to Nationwide Communications last week.

Pathfinder Communications is picking up a fifth station in the Fort Wayne market from Regional Radio. Rocker WBYR, Van Wert, OH will be added to Federated's collection of country WQHK-FM, Decatur, IN; and gold-based AC WOWO, CHR WMEE, and standards WHWD, all Ft. Wayne. No terms were disclosed.

Joe Amatore is buying into the Santa Rosa market in a big way. He'll pick up three stations from Fuller-Jeffrey Broadcasting and another from Pacific Radio. Terms have not been disclosed. The three from Fuller-Jeffrey are rocker KXFX and news-talk KSRO, both Santa Rosa, and classic rocker KLCQ, Healdsburg. Pacific Radio is selling oldies KMGG, Monte Rio.

Nassau Broadcasting is adding to its New Jersey collection with the purchase of AC combo WJLK (AM) and WJLK-FM, both Asbury Park, and WQNJ, Ocean Acres. Seller New Wave Communications will get \$16.75 million for the stations. The LMA began May 1. Nassau now has ten New Jersey properties.

Four former industry execs. have formed a partnership to buy a combo in the Hudson Valley/Poughkeepsie, NY market. Hudson Valley Radio Partners is buying 70's oldies WBWZ, New Paltz and country WRWD-FM, Highland from William Walker III for an undisclosed price. The partnership is made up of former ABC Radio President Aaron Daniels, former Wilks/Schwartz exec. Michael Schwartz, former Amatore Group President Monte Lang, and former WSRZ, Sarasota, FL sales manager Bill Burns. The LMA begins immediately. Walker will keep WRWD (AM), which currently simulcasts the FM.

In Canada, Shaw Communications is beefing up its Alberta presence by picking up Redmond Broadcasting's country CKRY, St. Catharines in the Calgary market for an undisclosed amount. Shaw owns soft AC CHQT and country CISM, in the Edmonton market and country CKGY and rocker CIZZ, Red Deer.

The Michigan Association of Broadcasters Legislative and Legal Monitor reports the Michigan Senate passed the "business lottery" law, making it legal for a business to hold and advertise promotional lotteries in the state. The bill is expected to be signed into law soon.

The Arbitron Company announced that Savannah, GA has qualified for the company's radio sample target increase plan effective with the Fall 1996 survey. The sample target will increase by 40% from its current level of 640 Persons 12+ to 900 Persons 12+. Since the sample increase plan was introduced in 1993, 148 markets have qualified for a sample target increase. Of the continuously measured markets, 68 have qualified for a 70% total sample target increase. Of the Spring/Fall markets, 80 have qualified for the 40% increase. All increases are based on the Fall 1993 Metro sample targets. To qualify for the sample increase plan, each subscribing station in a market must agree to pay a basic license fee surcharge of 4% in a continuously measured market, or 2% in Spring or Spring/Fall markets.

Principals from more than 55 agencies specializing in the Hispanic market will meet in Dallas May 14-15 to discuss a proposal to draft a mission statement and plan for the creation of a Hispanic Advertising Agency Association. Eduardo Caballero, Chief Executive Officer of Caballero Spanish Media will spearhead the effort. For more info, call 212-916-0524.

The National Association of Radio Talk Show Hosts (NARTSH) will give the Freedom of Speech Award for 1996 to multiple recipients - Alan Dershowitz, Michael Eisner and Bob Grant - for their role in exercising and defining the principles of free speech as guaranteed by the First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States. Interep Research released its annual radio format report, "The 1996 Radio Format Study." The report includes individual profiles on each of the 20 primary format classifications used in the 1995 nationwide Simmons Study, as well as Fall '94 to Fall '95 format share trends and format delivery of key target demos. The study also includes a discussion on the different audience measurement estimates which can be used to evaluate radio formats, including index and qualitative cume, and the marketing implications of using one or the other. Some of the highlights include the formats with the greatest 12+ share growth are Urban, up from 9.2 to 10.3, Spanish going from 4.4 to 5.4, and New Rock moving up from a 3.1 to a 4.1 share. Grant debuted on Buckley Broadcasting-owned WOR on April 29 with his own talk program running M-F 4-7 pm on WOR and 3-6 pm on the WOR Network. On May 5, the station will also start broadcasting the weekly program of Alan Dershowitz, who also lost his job at WABC for calling Grant a racist, a bigot and "a despicable talk-show host."

TEXAS TWO STEP . . . It was a banner week for brokers as station sales and swaps continue at a brisk pace. As promised, CBS' Dan Mason is making things happen at Black Rock with the swap of CBS-owned classic rocker KKRW, Houston for SFX Broadcasting's KRLD, Dallas and the Texas State Network. The deal is a tax-free, even exchange valued at around \$70 million and will give CBS a strong AM player in the Dallas-Ft. Worth market to combo with rocker KTXQ, Ft. Worth and classic rocker KRRW, Dallas. SFX will hold three FM's and an AM in the Houston market after all its pending deals are completed. It will own news/talk KNUZ, soft AC KODA, and standards KQUE in addition to KKRW. Paul Leonard and William Steding of Star Media Group handled the transaction. In addition, SFX will complete its withdrawal from the Dallas market with the spin-off of sports KTCK, Dallas for \$14 million to Susquehanna Radio Corp. The company also owns talk/sports KLIF, Dallas and country KPLX, Ft. Worth. Paul Leonard of Star Media Group handled the KTCK deal.

TEN MORE STATIONS IN FLORIDA FOR PAXSON? It's true. The Miami-based broadcaster is buying the Southern Broadcasting group which owns properties in Tallahassee, Pensacola, and Panama City as well as Shamrock Broadcasting's rocker WDIJ, Orlando. Southern Broadcasting owns five stations in Tallahassee---oldies WSNI, Thomasville; country WTNT, Tallahassee; hot AC WTPS, Midway; rocker WXSX, Quincy; and talker WNLS, Tallahassee. In Pensacola, new rock WOWW and rocker WTKX-FM. In Panama City, it has rocker WPAP-FM and oldies WPBH, Port St. Joe. Paxson is buying Southern Broadcasting for \$21 million while it will pay \$22.5 million to Shamrock.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission is taking comments on revisions of the Broadcast Blanketing Interference Rules. The Commission has found that when a broadcast licensee receives a complaint of blanket interference, there is a difference of opinion between the complainant and the licensee as to what the licensee is responsible for. To give licensees detailed guidance from the FCC in resolving these problems, the Commission is proposing the licensee's responsibility will be determined by whether or not the complaint was filed within the first year of operation, whether the complainant is located inside the blanketing contour, and whether the device experiencing interference is covered under the blanketing rule. Comments are being sought on, among other things, whether the rule should be modified for new services and technologies that come into a neighborhood after the one year period, as well as if transient residences, such as hotels and dorms, should be subject to the rule. Further, the Commission is trying to determine the extent of the broadcaster's responsibility to resolve interference complaints. Comments are due June 25, replies July 25, 1996.

The Kravis Company's KGTO and KRAV, Tulsa, OK was hit with a \$12,500 fine, reporting conditions, and short term renewal for EEO violations. The terms were the result of a settlement agreement between the licensee and the NAACP.

Great American Broadcasting's silent KWHK, Hutchinson, KS has been ordered to show cause why its license should not be revoked. The station's assets were liquidated under Chapter 7 bankruptcy proceedings in 1993.

Janice Wise has been named confidential assistant to FCC Commissioner Susan Ness. She joins the Commission after serving as Manager of Community Relations and Special Projects for the law firm of Arnold & Porter. She was there eight years.

ELSEWHERE

SFX is dumping out of the Washington, D.C. market as quickly as it got in. It's selling 70's oldies WXTR, Waldorf, MD (Washington) and simulcast WXVR, Braddock Heights, MD (Frederick) and country WQSI, Frederick, which will go to Bonneville International Corp. for \$25 million. Robert F.X. Sillerman commented that the stations were not contributing to cash flow, which were recently purchased from Liberty Broadcasting. The deal marks Bonneville's first foray into the D.C./Frederick markets.

Colfax Communications is buying up all of the Phoenix-based Sundance Broadcasting group. The \$95 million deal gives Colfax five stations in Phoenix, as well as new combos in Milwaukee and Boise. When all is done, Colfax will own urban AC KISO, standards KOY, jazz KYOT-FM, and new rock KZON in addition to KOOL and KOOL-FM in the Phoenix market. In Milwaukee, country WMIL, Waukesha and standards WOKY, Milwaukee. In Boise, classic rocker KARO, Caldwell; and oldies KLTB and news-talker KIDO, both Boise. The deal should close in August, 1996.

Sheridan Broadcasting is picking up classic rocker WSSZ, Greensburg, PA from WHJB Corp. for \$2.4 million. Sheridan will simulcast urban WAMO-FM, Beaver Falls, PA on the station, which will give the entity better coverage of southeastern Pittsburgh. WHJB Corp. will retain its AM, AC/talker WHJB. Sheridan also owns WAMO (AM) in the market, which simulcasts WAMO-FM, as well.

Those who thought you can't sell what you don't own, think again. American Radio Systems has decided it will swap the two stations it plans to buy from Marlin Broadcasting, classical WQRS, Detroit and WFLN, Philadelphia for the previously announced purchase of Secret Communications' sports KMJI, Sacramento and dance KSFM, Woodland, CA (Sacramento). ARS will also receive \$20 million cash. ARS currently manages the Sacramento properties under an LMA. Secret will begin an LMA with the Marlin properties as soon as the sale to ARS closes, which is planned for June 1.

Country WDL, Dallas, PA (Scranton/Wilkes Barre) is going through a two-step sale/swap. For \$950,000, Mountain Broadcasting will sell to Winston Radio, then Winston will swap the station for oldies WALY, Bellwood, PA. WALY is owned by Swanson Holdings, which has standards WCDL and oldies WSGD, Carbondale there.

Community Pacific Broadcasting is picking up a fourth station in the Modesto/Stockton market. It will buy Joseph Gamble Stations' KJAX, Stockton for an undisclosed amount. CPB owns news-talker KFIV and AC KJSN, Modesto and classic rock KVFX, Manteca there. The LMA begins immediately and KJAX has begun simulcasting KFIV.

Don Curtis is paring down his debt to George Beasley on the \$15 million purchase of Beasley's country WKIX-FM, Raleigh. Radio Business Report says for \$4.2 million Curtis will spin talker WEWO and oldies WAZZ, Laurinburg, NC, which will give Beasley six stations in the Fayetteville market. Curtis will retain its standards outlet, WFLB, Fayetteville.

Barry Mayo's Mayo Radio will merge with the Wicks Broadcast Group to form a six station duopoly in the Charleston, SC market. Terms weren't disclosed. Mayo will bring urban WWWZ, Summerville and urban AC WMGL, Ravenel into the fold that includes talker WTMA, Charleston; news WTMZ, Dorchester; and soft AC WSUY and CHR WSSX-FM, both Charleston. Wicks currently manages classic rocker WRFQ, Mount Pleasant under an LMA, as well.

Jim Wesley's Patterson Broadcasting is buying a duopoly in the Springfield, IL market. For \$7 million, it will get Neuhoff Broadcasting's sports WFMB, and country WFMB-FM (both Springfield) and 70's oldies WCVS-FM, Virden, IL.

Mike Shott's Adventure Communications is selling its western North Carolina properties to Benchmark Communications. Talker WSIC and country WFMX, both Statesville will go for \$9.6 million. WFMX serves the Greensboro/Winston-Salem market.

Point Communications is picking up a Savannah combo with the purchase of its LMA partner, Radio Southeast, which owns news/talker WBMQ and rocker WIXV. Terms weren't disclosed.

John Borders' Sunburst Broadcasting is buying three stations in the McAllen/Brownsville market. In two separate transactions, it will buy Tippie Communications' gold-based AC KVLV, Edinburg, TX and Rio Grande Partners' rocker KFRQ, Harlingen and Tejano KKPS, Brownsville. No terms were announced.

Magic Broadcasting is beefing up its Macon, GA presence to five stations with the purchase of Piedmont Communications' three stations, AC WPEZ, Macon; CHR WMGB, Jeffersonville; and black gospel WDDO, Macon. Magic already owns country combo WDEN and WDEN-FM. Terms weren't disclosed.

Once again, Arbitron has flagged several stations during the Winter release for statements broadcast directing diarykeepers to report listening to their station which could result in possible bias or ratings distortion. KLVO-FM in Albuquerque was cited for an announcement which declared "It is time for a Spanish bilingual radio station to be number one in Albuquerque." The announcement then requests if anyone asks you, or a member of your family what station you listen to, please say 'Radio Lobo' all day. The last phrase is repeated in Spanish. KLBN-FM also broadcast their desire to be the number one station. "Not only in Spanish, but above all the ones in English." Other stations marked for ratings bias are WCMO-FM and WAMR-FM in Miami who also refer to what to say if someone asks you what radio station you listen to.

According to the RAB, the radio industry enjoyed its 43rd consecutive month of revenue gains in March 1996, posting a four percent increase in combined local and national spot advertising revenue vs. the same month in 1995. Local revenue led the growth with a 5% increase, while national spot revenue rose 1%. Year-to-date combined revenues gained 6% through March 1996; national year-to-date revenues were up 1% while local dollars were up 7%. These figures are based on the RAB's Radio revenue index of more than 100 markets.

The corporate name of Capital Cities/ABC Inc., now a subsidiary of Walt Disney Co., will cease to exist early next year. In a company newsletter, Cap Cities President Robert Iger said the name will be shortened to "ABC" by the beginning of next year.

Interep has released a new study called "Country Radio & Retail Shopping" comparing the profile of country radio listeners and department, discount, clothing and children's store shoppers. The study confirms that country radio is #1 for reaching America's shoppers.

FEEDING FRENZY . . . It was yet another "big deal" week for radio. George Sosson's Radio Equity Partners decided to sell to Clear Channel Communications. Then, Cox Broadcasting announced it is buying Dick Ferguson's NewCity Communications for \$250 million. Not to be outdone, Chancellor Communications decided to buy OmniAmerica's eight stations in Florida for \$178 million.

For Clear Channel, the \$235 million purchase from Radio Equity will give it another 19 stations, bringing its total to over 80 in the U.S. (if the previously announced purchase of Ragan Henry's U.S. Radio goes through.) The deal gives Clear Channel new combos in Providence, Springfield MA, Columbia SC, and Fort Myers. It will also get a three station duop in Greensboro/Winston-Salem. It will add to its complement in Memphis and Oklahoma City, giving it five stations in Memphis and six in OK. The details of the Cox/New City and Chancellor/OmniAmerica deals are on page eight.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission is looking into the silent status of Southwestern Broadcasting Corp.'s KLZK, Brownfield, TX and Clarence Jones' WMNY, Elloree, SC. KLZK, according to the FCC, has been silent for seven years, WMNY for two. Their licenses have been designated for hearing.

The FCC has a new form for New AM Broadcast Stations out. Form 302-AM must be used after June 1, 1996. The form eliminates the need to file FCC Form 159 (Fee Remittance Advice). For copies of the form, call (800) 418-FORM.

ELSEWHERE

Cox Broadcasting adds 18 stations to its group with the \$250 million purchase of New City Communications. The deal gives Cox yet another station in Atlanta, jazz WJZF. Commission approval may be dicey on this one because Cox already owns news/talk WSB and AC WSB-FM, two Atlanta newspapers, a television station, cable systems, LMA's sports WCNN, North Atlanta, GA, and is in an SMA with urban AC simulcast WALR, Atlanta and WALR-FM, Athens. It also picks up four stations in Orlando, three each in San Antonio, Birmingham, Tulsa, and Syracuse, and one in Bridgeport, CT. Cox will own 37 stations after the deal closes.

Chancellor's purchase of the remaining OmniAmerica stations, which are all in Florida. The deal will give Chancellor three more stations in Orlando to combo with oldies WOCL, De Land. It will add three stations in the West Palm Beach market and two in Jacksonville. In Orlando, it adds urban WJHM, Daytona Beach; hot AC WOMX-FM, Orlando; and CHR WXXL, Tavares. In West Palm, news WEAT and soft AC WEAT-FM, West Palm Beach; and oldies WOLL, Riviera Beach. In Jacksonville, CHR WAPE-FM, Jacksonville and rocker WFYV-FM, Atlantic Beach. The deal will give Chancellor 43 stations. Paul Leonard brokered the deal for Star Media Group.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

In Louisville, SFX Broadcasting is selling its three stations there in separate transactions. Clear Channel Communications will buy talker WWKY and rock WTFX for \$6.9 million. Regent Communications will buy soft AC WVEZ for \$12.6 million. The deal will give Clear Channel four stations and an SMA partner in that market. (It owns country WAMZ, talk/oldies WHAS, and is in an SMA with country WKJK). Regent will own five plus one SMA (CHR WDJX, religion WFIA, and country combo WHKW (AM), Louisville and WHKW-FM, Corydon, IN, and an SMA with 70's oldies WQLL).

Crescent Communications is dumping two of its three stations in San Francisco and San Jose with the sale of urban AC combo KSOL, San Francisco and KYLZ, Santa Cruz to Tichenor Media System for \$40 million. The combo are the first two on the West Coast for Tichenor. Peter Handy of Star Media Group was the broker.

Down the coast, Jefferson-Pilot is spending \$30 million for a third FM in San Diego. It will buy Anaheim Broadcasting's oldies KBZT, which has been in an LMA with Jefferson-Pilot's country combo KSON-AM & FM, both San Diego. It's also planning to buy jazz outlet KIFM in that market.

Multi-Market Radio is adding a third station in the Myrtle Beach, SC market with the purchase of classic hits WMYB, Socastee from Puritan Radiocasting Co. for \$1.1 million. Multi-Market owns country WYAK-FM, Surfside Beach and has an LMA with WVCO, Loris, which simulcasts WYAK-FM. An LMA with WMYB begins immediately.

Saga Communications is keeping the momentum going in the Springfield, IL market with the purchase of Central States Network's talk/country WPRC and country WWTE, Lincoln, IL and news-talk WTAX, and CHR WDBR, Springfield, IL. Price tag is \$6 million. The deal gives Saga 32 radio stations.

Bob Brooks' K-Country, Inc. is doubling up in its home market of Albany, GA with the purchase of classic rocker WJAD, Leesburg, GA and oldies WEGC, Sasser, GA from Rowland Albany Radio. No terms were disclosed. K-Country owns news-talk WALG and country WKAK. The LMA begins immediately.

In Pittsburgh, long-time Philadelphia broadcaster W. Cody Anderson is picking up urban WCXJ, Braddock, PA for \$150,000 from Homewood-Brushton Revitalization and Development Corp. Anderson owns talker WHAT, Philadelphia. Ray Rosenblum was the broker.

Arbitron announced they will delete five diaries which were sent to a single household in Escambia county from the in-tab sample of the Fall 1995 Pensacola Radio Market Report. Arbitron learned the diaries were completed by individuals who were affiliated with a radio station. A revised Fall 1995 Pensacola report, MaximiSer estimates and client tapes have been mailed to stations.

Interep announced the creation of "Allied Radio Partners," an alliance between Major Market Radio Sales, Torbet Radio Group and Concert Music Broadcast Sales. The new company is designed to address the challenges raised by the Telecom Bill, specifically, representation of multiple radio stations in the same city and the need for immediate responsiveness to client stations' needs. Each client station will have its own team of sellers selected in collaboration with its Managing Partner.

Children's Broadcasting Corporation announced that it has signed a licensing representation agreement with Meridian Worldwide, Inc. Meridian will exclusively represent CBC in connection with its licensing of Radio AAHS(R) trademarks, servicemarks, logos, names, characters and images for the specific purpose of merchandising Radio AAHS(R) products and services. The agreement covers licensing efforts in the U.S., Canada, Mexico and their territories for a one year period.

As of May 1, 1996, Peoples Network, Inc. has become United Broadcasting Network, Inc. United Broadcasting is best known for Chuck Harder's program, "For the People." Telephone numbers and address will remain the same.

SWING YOUR PARTNER, SELL AND SWITCH! . . . On the heels of last week's sale of SFX Broadcasting's stations in Louisville, Clear Channel Communications is picking up country simulcast WHKW (AM) from Regent Communications and appears it is buying its SMA partner, Snowden Broadcasting's country WKJK, Salem IN. It's also buying the call letters and format of Regent's WHKW-FM, Corydon, IN, but not the station itself. Clear Channel will move WKJK's country format to WHKW (AM) and will move WHKW-FM's country format to WKJK's dial position at 98.9 MHz. WHKW-FM will change to classic hits and get new calls soon. Classic hits WQLL will switch to smooth jazz with a call letter change, as well. With its recently announced purchase of talker WWKY and rock WTFX from SFX, Clear Channel will own six stations.

HERE TODAY, GONE TOMORROW. . . Joseph I. Kendrick's WDBS, Bolingbroke, GA has been ordered off the air by the Commission. Even though the station has been on the air since late last year serving the Macon, GA market, the Commission couldn't let go of the fact that Kendrick let his CP expire in September of 1994 without giving the FCC a good reason why. The Commission says Kendrick referred to a "vague" process in a letter to the Commission just after the CP expired, but that his efforts to construct the station during the previous 12 months "did not evidence the diligence expected of a permittee." The Commission reasoned that even though a station will be taken out of service, the market is still served by 20 broadcast signals and that rewarding "Kendrick's failure to timely construct" the station would be more damaging to the "public interest."

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Broadcasters may have more good news soon as the Supreme Court ruled this week that commercial speech is protected under the First Amendment and cannot be banned. Inside Radio reports the decision resulted from a Rhode Island case involving a liquor store which challenged state law banning prices in print ads. It may take some time for things to loosen up, however, as state and federal agencies study the ruling. Also, broadcast media are subject to different rules than print. The ruling's impact will have to be analyzed in both areas before bans are lifted. Although cases are pending before the Supreme Court regarding liquor and cigarettes, the ruling could open up advertising for casinos and state lotteries.

The NAB has filed comments with the Commission supporting consistent eight-year renewal terms for all radio and television stations, and agrees with tying terms of translators and boosters renewals to the stations they rebroadcast. The Commission asked for comments on renewal terms as mandated by the 1996 Telecom Act.

The Commission has granted a one-to-a-market waiver for Fisher Broadcasting in the Portland, OR market. Fisher recently purchased KWJJ-AM & FM from Park Broadcasting. Fisher also owns ABC affiliate KATU (TV), Portland.

Two AM's and an FM have been designated for hearing after being silent longer than one year. Jotocon Communications' WBEM (AM), Windber, PA has been off the air since October, 1989. The University of Kansas' AM, KFKU, has been off since December, 1987. The FM is WKZF-FM, licensed to Bayboro, NC. WKZF-FM, Inc.'s station has been silent since July of 1993.

James R. Coltharp has been appointed to serve as Special Counsel to Commissioner James Quello. Coltharp will be responsible for cable television and mass media issues, as well as economic policy aspects of wireless and common carrier issues.

ELSEWHERE

A three-way deal announced this week will give Entercom, Secret Communications, and Nationwide Communications new properties. Entercom is buying rocker KISW, Seattle from Nationwide while trading its Pittsburgh stations, country combo WDSY-AM & FM and new rock WNRQ to Secret Communications. Secret will swap new rock KTBZ, Lake Jackson, TX (Houston) to Nationwide to complete the transaction. When all is said and done Entercom will own five stations in Seattle: adult alternative KMTT, Tacoma; new rock KNDD, Seattle; oldies simulcast KBSG, Auburn and KBSG-FM, Tacoma; and rock KISW. Secret will have WDSY-AM & FM, smooth jazz WNRQ and new rock WXDX, and album rocker WDVE in the Pittsburgh market. Nationwide gets an FM duopoly in Houston with AC KHMX, Houston and new rock KTBZ.

Infinity Broadcasting will be up to four FM's in Chicago. It will swap its Orlando stations and \$20 million for Cox Broadcasting's Chicago holdings. The result will be an AM and four FM's in Chicago for Infinity. It will pick up classic rocker WCKG, Elmwood Park IL and 70's oldies WYSY, Aurora IL. It already owns country WUSN, oldies WJMK, and talker WJJD, all Chicago. Cox will enter the Orlando market with classic rock WHTQ, alternative WMMO, and standards WHOO.

Paxson Communications opens up its checkbook again to pick up four more stations in Florida. The company will buy WIOD, Miami from Cox Broadcasting for \$13 million giving Paxson five Miami stations including rocker WZTA, Miami Beach; talk WFTL, Ft. Lauderdale; jazz WLVE, Miami Beach; and news-talk-sports WINZ, Miami. Paxson also has an SMA with Spanish news-talker WACC, Hialeah.

In a separate transaction, Paxson will also buy up three stations from the Boss Radio Group in the Panama City market: AC WFSY and jazz WGNE, Panama City and standards WEBZ, Mexico Beach. Boss Radio will retain classic rocker WMTO, Port St. Joe. Paxson recently announced the purchase of country WPAP, Panama City and oldies WPBH, Parker from Southern Communications in that market.

Benchmark Communications, which has lately been on a spending spree, decided to sell something this week. It's getting out of the Norfolk market, selling news/talk WTAR, Norfolk and new rock WKOC, Elizabeth City, NC to Sinclair Communications for \$8.1 million and oldies WLTY, Norfolk to Susquehanna Radio Corp. for \$14.6 million. Sinclair already owns news-talk WNIS, Norfolk and new rock WROX-FM, Cape Charles, VA while Susquehanna owns sports WGH (AM) and country WGH-FM, both Newport News, VA in that market. LMA's for both groups begin immediately. WKOC plans to change its format this week.

Boston's Charles River Broadcasting is picking up a station on the Cape with the purchase of Dolphin Productions' classical WFCC-FM, Chatham, MA. Charles River owns classical WCRB, Waltham, which serves Boston. No terms were disclosed.

Citadel Broadcasting will spin off Albuquerque's sports KRZY (AM) and country oldies KRZY-FM, Santa Fe to EXCL Communications. Citadel recently bought the stations along with country KRST, Albuquerque from Crescent Communications. Citadel already owns talker KKOB, AC KKOB-FM, news-talk KHTL, and AC KMGA. It also is in an SMA with Ramar Communications' country outlet KASY.

Jacor Broadcasting is picking up two more stations in the Toledo market. For \$13 million, it will acquire standards/talk WCWA and rocker WIOT from Enterprise Media of Toledo. The deal will give Jacor five stations in the market as it owns soft AC WRVF, and CHR WVKS and news-talk WSPD, which it recently purchased from Noble Broadcasting.

Guaranty Broadcasting is buying deeper into the Baton Rouge market with the purchase of new rock WTGE-FM from Vetter Communications for an undisclosed amount. Guaranty owns classic rock WGGZ, Baton Rouge and news-talk WFPR and country WHMD, Hammond, LA all serving Baton Rouge.

Redwood Broadcasting is selling its combo in the Chico market to its LMA partner, Portland-based McCoy Broadcasting. News-talk KNSN, Chico and country KHSL, Paradise CA will sell to McCoy for \$1.836 million to combo with news-talk KPAY and AC KMXI, both Chico.

In a story we ran two weeks ago, Don Curtis' Curtis Media Group was selling talker WEWO and oldies WAZZ, Laurinburg, NC to George Beasley after purchasing country WKIX-FM, Raleigh. The price paid for WKIX-FM should have been \$16 million. Curtis purchased the station from Alchemy Communications, not Beasley. In addition Beasley will buy Curtis' adult standards WFLB, Fayetteville for \$200,000.

Tribune Broadcasting has sold the Interstate Radio Network, a syndicated radio program targeted to cross-country truckers, to Keymarket Radio, a division of River City Broadcasting. Financial terms of the transaction were not disclosed. Keymarket will continue its own truckers show, "The Road Gang," which is broadcast nationally over six clear-channel AM frequencies. IRN broadcasts five hours of programming, seven nights a week and includes weather information, road conditions and other information for truckers, as well as country music, talk and special features to more than 30 stations nationwide.

Arbitron plans to add a Fall Survey to 33 markets in the fourth quarter of 1996. Those markets include: Bangor, ME; Bryan-College Station, TX; Cedar Rapids, IA; Columbia, MO; Columbus, GA; Dubuque, IA; Duluth-Superior, MN-WI; Eau-Claire, WI; Elmira-Corning, NY; Fargo-Moorhead, ND-MN; Florence, SC; Green Bay, WI; Joplin, MO; Killeen-Temple, TX; LaCrosse, WI; Marion-Carbondale, IL; Monroe, LA; Myrtle Beach, SC; New London, CT; NW Michigan; Sioux Falls, SD; Springfield, IL; Springfield, MO; St. Cloud, MN; Terre Haute, IN; Topeka, KS; Tri-Cities, WA; Tupelo, MS; Tyler-Longview, TX; Waco, TX; Waterloo-Cedar Falls, IA; Wausau-Stevens Point, WI; and Yakima, WA. Stations in these markets have until December 1, 1996 to sign up for the additional survey at introductory rates.

White Springs, FL-based People's Radio Network has a new name and new investors. The talk network, known for its populist talk show host Chuck Harder, is now the United Broadcasting Network after an investment of "several million" dollars from the United Auto Workers. According to the Wall Street Journal, the UAW has purchased a less-than 10% share of the network. The capital will be used to buy new equipment and purchase stations where coverage is weak or non-existent.

Commodore Media has filed a registration statement with the Security and Exchange Commission for a proposed initial public offering of 4.3 million shares of Class A Common Stock. 2.9 million shares are for the company, while the balance will go to the estate of the late Carter Burden, who founded the company.

Deregulation fever has swept "across the pond." Reuter's reports British officials will relax regulatory restrictions on radio-newspaper cross-ownership. The rules will be amended to allow newspapers which have a 50 percent market share own a radio station, as well. The old rules limit newspapers to a 20 percent stake in a radio station in the same market area.

SportsFan Radio Network announced that WinStar Communications has exercised its option to assume a controlling interest in the company and will become a division of WinStar New Media, which is WinStar's information services and entertainment arm. SportsFan also announced a joint venture with FOX Sports and Major League Baseball which will offer sports fans nationwide the chance test their baseball trivia knowledge with "SportsFan Radio/FOX Sports Saturday Baseball."

Interep Research released a new study on the demographic and qualitative characteristics of the heavy users of the various major users of radio, television, cable, magazines and newspapers. Radio shows the youngest age composition and heavy radio listeners show the highest percentage of professionals, managers, college graduates and those living in \$75,000 plus households. Interep also released a new Quantitative Radio Research Primer, a comprehensive guide to research terminology, applications and the services available to radio sellers.

Bonneville's KHTC and KIDR has acquired the radio rights to broadcast the NFL Phoenix Cardinal football games. KIDR programs children's. KHTC is 70's oldies. Mac America's AC KESZ previously held the rights to the broadcasts.

Inside Radio reports Infinity Broadcasting has picked up the broadcast rights to the Raiders, its tenth NFL franchise. KYCY, San Francisco won the rights from Chancellor's KSAN-FM. The deal is estimated to be worth \$2 million.

Computer Concepts has released a new version of their hard disk audio system called Maestro. Maestro will allow you to drag and drop control all the carts you are about to play, allows access to 400 carts with several mouse clicks, gives you easy access to your live copy, lets you audition the end of the song you are playing on the air at the same time, and gives you countdown clocks for all of your song intros and endings on one screen. 00010010111101101. . . . Four Digital Audio Broadcasting systems have agreed to field tests which will start next month. The Electronic Industries Association's Consumer Electronic Manufacturers Association has signed agreements to test AT&T/Lucent Technologies in-band/adjacent channel (IBAC) system, AT&T/Lucent Technologies/Amati Communications in-band/on-channel (IBOC) system, the Eureka 147 DAB L-band system, and the VOA/JPL satellite S-Band system. USA Digital Radio's in-band/on-channel system is markedly absent from the field tests after the company could not reach an agreement with the EIA on testing claiming cross-comparisons between IBOC and non-IBOC systems would be a problem. A vehicle is being equipped by NASA and shipped to San Francisco for testing that will begin in June. The FCC has issued two experimental radio station licenses, one on the FM band for the IBAC test and one on the L-band. The S-band system will be uplinked to NASA's facility from White Sands, NM. The IBOC tests are on hold until a host station is found.

FCC SERIOUS ABOUT STAYING ON AIR. . . . Three more stations have had their licenses designated for hearing after being silent for more than one year. One of them is back on the air, however. Communication Enterprises, Inc's WRAH, Easley, SC went silent on December 10, 1993. WRAH is back on the air with a children's format. WPVG, Inc.'s WPVG, Funkstown, MD (Hagerstown market) has been off since October 30, 1994. Hometown Media's WAYB, Waynesboro, VA left the air more recently, March 17, 1995.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Jacor Communications has decided to do a three-step reorganization of its holdings. Transfers filed at the Commission this week reflect a company reorganization with its Zell/Chilmark Fund backers, as well as a reorganization from an Ohio Corp. to a Delaware Corp. The company is also transferring control of the Citicasters stations it recently announced it will purchase back to Citicasters. The applications affect Denver, Tampa/Sarasota, Atlanta, St. Louis, Cincinnati, San Diego, Toledo, and Jacksonville.

The Commission has denied PDB Corporation's application for review of a staff action dismissing PDB's application for reinstatement of its expired construction permit for WUMI, State College, MS.

ELSEWHERE

ARS is picking up a third FM in Sacramento with the purchase of jazz outlet KSSJ, Shingle Springs, CA from Doug Kahle's Olympic Broadcasters for \$14 million cash. \$13.5 million will be paid at closing with another \$500,000 due when some technical upgrades are completed. ARS has recently announced the purchase of soft AC KYMX and standards KCTC as well as sports KMJI and dance CHR KSFM, Woodland. Paul Leonard of Star Media brokered the transaction.

Gold Coast Broadcasting is buying two more stations in the Oxnard-Ventura market. Greater Pacific Radio Exchange will sell its Regional Mexican KTRO, Port Hueneme and dance CHR KCRQ, Oxnard for \$3.65 million. Gold Coast already owns standards KKZZ, Santa Paula and classic rock KOCP, Camarillo in that market.

Newly-formed Meridian Broadcasting is buying a duopoly in the Fort Myers market. It will pick up classic hits WARO, standards WNOG, and talk WNOG-FM, all Naples, from Palmer Communications for an undisclosed amount. The new company is headed by former WINK-AM & TV President Joseph Schwartzel.

The Radio Advertising Bureau's accounting of ad revenues shows more good news this month. Combined local and national spot advertising was up six percent marking the industry's 44th consecutive month of growth. Year-to-date combined revenues gained six percent through April, 1996; national year-to-date figures are up seven percent. Local spot rose in every region of the country while national spot rose in all regions except the Midwest.

Metro Traffic will have a new competitor in the Boston market as Mel Karmazin's now Infinity-owned Shadow Traffic enters the market to help round out its top ten market coverage. Inside Radio reports a sales office will be opened soon to be headed by Joe DiDonato.

SW Networks, working in conjunction with Don Cornelius' "Soul Train," will air a two-hour special celebrating 25 years of Soul Train Award winners and legends of black music. It can be aired anytime between June 27-30, 1996. For more info, call (212) 833-5400.
