# Names to Watch: Dr. Derrick DeSilva "Ask the Doctor"

"I'm a practicing physician. I'm an internist. It is something I do 8 or 10 hours every single day, even 12 hours some days. What I do in medicine is full time. I deal with real issues. I deal with real people every day, and I think that the advice I give is practical and user friendly.

I love people, I sincerely love helping people. I'll never forget this story, a woman called me on WCTC about a year and a half or two years ago and said, "I have abdominal pain and it's in my lower belly." I said to her please, you're 60 or 70 years of age. Please, go see your doctor. I was concerned because of what she was describing. She promised me that she would go to her doctor and she did. She ended up having early stage ovarian cancer. She called me back about 6 weeks later and said "Dr. DeSilva



my doctor told me that if I had not come in sooner, if I had waited another month or two, I would have had an ovarian cancer that would have spread." Do you know how good that made me feel? That I was able to impact somebody's life like that?

Numerous people have called me and said, "You know what you told me was absolutely correct and I feel so much better today." That's what makes me feel good.

To his listeners, Dr. DeSilva's is "the doctor in the family." DeSilva's honest, sincere love for health is evident when listening to "Ask the Doctor," heard weekday mornings on the Talk America Radio Network. Station by station, market by market, DeSilva's brand of health advice and conversation has spread from a handful of stations to more than 60 affiliates across the country.

Guide: For someone who hasn't heard your show, how would you describe it?

**DeSilva:** Real medicine — dealing with real people about real health issues. What I do is give them guidance. I try to guide them back to their physician. Most physicians today, because of the HMO's, because of managed care, don't have the time to sit and speak with their patients about the basics. So what I try to do is explain the basics.

I try to direct people back to taking care of themselves and back to their physicians. I always close by saying, check with your doctor because I am not able to diagnose or treat people on the radio. My purpose is to educate, to inform and to disseminate good, practical information that they will be able to use — in very understandable terms.

### Dr. Derrick DeSilva

**Guide:** Growing up, did you listen to the radio? Were you fascinated with it?

**DeSilva:** Nope, not at all. I remember that my father had been in media. My father was a reporter and writer, and was very interested in radio at one time. I remember him sitting in front of a reel to reel about 30 years ago recording his voice because he was practicing to do some radio, and I used to sit there and listen to him. That's probably how I became interested, but on a subconscious level. I never really brought it to a conscious level until this happened on the radio with me.

Guide: How did you get your break?

**DiSilva:** It was very coincidental. I was invited down to Florida to do a lecture on cardiovascular disease and was talking to an international reporter for one of the major television networks. I made the comment that I would love to do radio or television. She said, "Well, what you need to do is call your local radio station and tell them that you want to do a program."

As naive as I was many, many years ago, I called my local radio station on Monday morning and spoke to the General Manager of WCTC and WMGQ and said, "I'm Dr. Derrick DeSilva and I would like to do a program." He said to me "Well, we were just in a meeting and we were thinking of doing a medical show. You have a good voice on the phone, why don't you come in and do some programs and let's see how it goes." I've been on the air now for 7 or 8 years. That's how it started.

Guide: Why did you become a doctor?

**DeSilva:** I always saw doctors as good people. I remember even my grandmother going to the doctor whenever she wasn't feeling well; she had diabetes. I remember her coming out and saying "You know I feel better already," and I could never figure out how you could go to somebody, walk out of the office and say "I feel good." It was that type of the healing and the love of people that really made me do it. It's very gratifying to make somebody feel good.

**Guide:** What would you like to be doing in five years?

**DeSilva:** Five years from now I would like to be on hundreds of stations. I'd like to get through to people and be able to communicate the message of assuming responsibility for your own health. I see myself in five years being able to really get that word out have an impact on people's lives or health.





After many failed music formats, **KICS** switched to a news/talk format. Gene McCoy encourages other stations to stop simulcasting their FM and create an identity for their AM. After making the swich to talk, KICS revenue increased 30-40%.

# A Talk With Westwood One's Bruce Williams

"We do a show about life. That's what it comes down to. We're not going to settle any problems in Bosnia or any of that sort of thing, but we talk about getting along with the neighbor next door.

What do you do when your neighbor's dog is allowed to run free and it craps all over your yard and pees in your bushes and so forth? I got Mickey the Mutt hanging out here. I know dogs' habits and so did this guy. He calls in with a great solution. What he said was you get yourself an onion bag, the kind that are like a mesh bag, not a solid bag, you get 3 or 4 old fish and you kind of slit them so the guts are hanging out, then you get some old meat or chicken entrails, all kinds of fowl stuff, right. You leave that out in the sun about 2 days, then you put the bag out by the plant. Every dog in the world can't wait to roll in that, you see. Then they go home covered in this stuff and they go into the living room in the guy's house, and suddenly he's got a serious problem on his hands. The dog did it all. After a couple of excursions into your yard, when they find this, suddenly people figure out they better keep their dog out of that guy's yard. It also fertilizes your garden.



This is the kind of stuff we deal with."

That's the kind of stuff that has made Westwood One's Bruce Williams one of the most listened to hosts in talk radio. Often referred to as "Mr. Common Sense," Williams brings to the microphone his experience as a businessman, mayor, city councilman and entrepreneur. The Guide to Talk Radio Programming's Bob Long had the opportunity to speak with Bruce Williams, who is entering his 16th year as host of his nightly program. He has been the recipient of countless awards and, according to Westwood One, is heard on more than 350 stations.

#### **Bruce Williams**

**Guide:** Who did you listen to when you were growing up on the radio?

Williams: You have to realize that when I was growing up, 2 or 3 things are operative in that question. First thing is, you couldn't go out and buy a little transistor radio because the transistor had yet to be invented.

When I was in elementary school I used to build radios and in order to make them work, I had to have an antenna about 30 feet long. I used to stretch the antenna right down the aisle at school and I'd sit back there and listen to Peggy and Ned Fitzgerald on WOR when I was in 7th grade instead of listening to the teacher. Of course, she would go ballistic when she found the radio, she'd take it, and 2 days later I'd build another one and listen to whatever they were featuring on WOR.

There were a lot of things you could do in my father's house, but one of them wasn't turning on Barry Gray at 3:00 in the morning — not if you wanted to live 'til 3:30. I would sit in the garage listening to Long John Nebel, Barry Grey, Biggy Wilson at 3:00 or 4:00 in the morning.

Long John Nebel was the quintessential of all talkers -- the best in his day. He'd probably sound corny today. When I walk, I listen to a lot of old time radio: The Shadow, or Sherlock Holmes. I listened to a great Gildersleeve tape yesterday. A lot of that stuff is pretty corny though, but at the time, it was hot stuff.

**Guide:** Where was your first radio job?

Williams: One was with WCTC, which began May 14, 1975, but I was campaigning for a year before that with Tony Morana who was the general manager at that time. You've got

to realize, talk radio was nowhere near as ubiquitous then as it is today. As a matter of fact, we were the anomalies rather than the standard. I used to listen to a lot of talk and I just figured I could do it better than the average guy doing it.

**Guide:** I read when you jumped from New Jersey to New York City, you actually hired some women to call in?

Williams: I first attacked WMCA. I called them in excess of 3,000 times and I wrote them over 500 letters. Now, people will say "well you probably pissed them off," and that may be true, but what did I have to lose? They wouldn't hire me anyway.

There were only 2 stations at that time in New York City that were doing talk, MCA and WOR. WOR had Bernie Meltzer, so they weren't going to hire me. So, who's left? MCA, and the program director over there was Mark Mason. Mark is the guy that finally called me, and I told him I called out of almost desperation. He said every day he found 2 or 3 messages on his desk, Bruce Williams called.

Barry Farber was not doing so well on a Sunday afternoon, well, let's face it, Sunday afternoon is the toilet of radio and they said would you like to try it? And man, I would have tried anything to get into New York City. I went over and did the show and it went okay. After the show, we went into the other studio where they had the busy counter. That's how they used to measure you in those days. After your lines were tied up, you would get a click every time there was a busy on the meter. When she saw mine she said "Wow, you did real well. You got 225 busy's." I said "Would you look at that again?" "Oh, my God. You had 1,225!"

#### **Bruce Williams**

Williams: Well, the reason was I had a whole bunch of women making phone calls. There was no way in hell I was not going to get a high busy count because all through the show my people were making phone calls — just redialing and getting busy's.

**Guide:** So, your advice for young broadcasters is persistence? Keep after it?

Williams: Well yeah, let's face it, the program directors and general managers get more propositions than a hooker on 7th Avenue.

They're getting bombarded,

and you have to get their attention. The way to do that is to keep seeing them, and talking to them. There's no other way that I know of, unless you get really lucky.

**Guide:** Do you get upset when people label your show as being a financial show?

Williams: I don't get upset. I've grown to live with it. If you were to say that money is the Portland cement that glues us together, I'm not going to have a hard time with that.

**Guide:** What is the future of talk radio?

Williams: Talk is going to get bigger and bigger, not necessarily with me. I may get washed out, who knows? Every poll of radio stations shows that for a variety reasons, not the least of those certainly is a technical thing, that talk can compete very well on AM. Unless you have AM stereo, it's difficult for talk to compete with music, but it clearly can compete with sports and can compete with talk, and that's where it's going to be.

Furthermore, like a lot of things if one segment of an industry is successful, there's going to be 10 million wannabes out there.

Guide: What do you think makes for bad radio today?

Williams: Probably the biggest problem well,

not a problem but...Rush does what what he does very well, so you've got 10 Rush imitators out there. I like to think I do what I do reasonably well and you find 10 imitators of me out there.

Ted Lewis was a band leader in the 30s and somebody

came to Ted Lewis and said, "How do I get to be where you are?" He said, "Be yourself." In other words, you can't be an imitation of somebody else. You have to develop your own style and your own persona. You have to be you, not imitating somebody else. Imitations are just what they are — imitations.

**Guide:** What do you think about a Don Imus or a Howard Stern?

Williams: I don't know Imus, I know Stern. I've met him a few times and he knows enough of me to take a few shots of me on the air, I guess. Stern is probably the quintessential self promotor, he is the male Madonna. I mean, there are two people who have turned self-promotion into a fine art and it's become extraordinarily profitable. He's done very, very well. I couldn't appear on the front of a book in drag. I don't care how much money they gave me.

Imus, to a lesser degree certainly does what he does well. I don't necessarily agree with what

# Pete Rose: From the Dugout to the Microphone

"I don't think there are too many talk show hosts in this country who can sit down at breakfast or lunch with you and tell you exactly how it feels to be a world champion or how it feels to lose a world championship. You may think you know from covering the NBA, or the NFL, or the Stanley Cup or the World Series, but experiencing it and being around people who have experienced it are two different things. There's not too much in the world of sports that I haven't accomplished. I don't like to carry on conversations about things that I don't really know much about. I have a tendency to stick my foot in my mouth. I'd like to think that winning the World Series is just like winning the Super Bowl, or winning the NBA Championship, or the Stanley Cup Championship, no difference, just a different game."

Former Cincinatti Reds star Pete Rose made the transition from major league manager to radio talk show host in March of 1992 at WJNO in West Palm Beach, Florida.



Rose took his act to a national level, signing with the SportsFan Radio Network in 1994. According to Rose, The Pete Rose Show is fed live to almost 200 stations weeknights from 7 to 9 (Eastern) from his sports bar in Florida.

Although he will be forever known as one of the greatest baseball players of all time, Rose claims his show is a true sports show, covering hockey, basketball, and football. Sports celebrities make frequent appearances on the program. Recent guests have included Bobby Cox, Lou Duva, Willie Mays, Hank Aaron, Bob Costas, Terry Bradshaw, Brent Musberger, Bobby Knight and John Madden.

#### Pete Rose

Guide: Describe The Pete Rose Show.

Rose: It's a talk sports show and we want intelligent callers. If you want — be combative and argumentative, as long as you've got a good sense of what you want to argue about.

We try to be up-to-date as far as what's happening in the world of sports. I don't think there's any show in the country that has the array of guests that we have which is partly because of my friendship with so many athletes or athletes who are friends of the athletes of the athletes that I get.

**Guide:** Why do athletes feel so comfortable with you?

Rose: I'm not going to blind side them. They know that 1) I understand what athletes go through; and 2) I understand a little bit about controversy, and 3) I understand about being fair if you're in the media.

There are a lot of little things that I can do to help athletes.

I remember when Darrell Strawberry signed with the Yankees. There were people who said he'd like to do my show. He called me up, and the first thing he said was the only reason he was doing my show was because I didn't kick him in the face when he was down. I was very fair and he appreciated it; that was why he was doing my show and only my show. There are diplomatic ways of facing controversial issues without always blaming the athlete, the owner, or the fan.

**Guide:** Across the country, how have callers

and listeners responded to you on-the-air?

Rose: With respect, but I'm in the restaurant business and the customer's always right. The caller's always right, unless I can convince him he's wrong. You can call me up and you can argue with me or you can blast me if you want, but you'd better have your facts straight — just make sure you got your ducks in order.

**Guide:** Is your show more of a guest driven show or a caller driven show?

Rose: I think it's probably caller-driven. We

like to entertain them with guests, and we try to get the guests we think people like to hear.


**Guide:** Who do you admire in the broadcasting field?

Rose: I don't have any specific guys. If you work hard, and you're honest and dedicated and you're on time, that's the things I like.

Fox. I had Terry Bradshaw a couple weeks
ago and John Madden.

**Guide:** Your thoughts on other SportsFan programs?

Rose: Right now we've got Matt Goukas doing our In the Lane Show. We've got Phil Esposito doing our In the Crease, our hockey show. We have Bill Rafferty and Dick Fersais. We have all these notable guys doing pro

gramming on Sports Fan Radio Network, which will pay off eventually.

I'm with the top sports network around, and it's just amazing how many forward strides we've made in the last year.

I realize that I'm the main guy on the network. I'm not trying to sound arrogant; I understand the obligation I have to them and I work at it.

millions of dollars. I'm not here to say if he's right or wrong. I can only tell you when I was on Howard Stern, he was a perfect gentleman. People think he's not smart. He's a pretty clean cut guy, too, if you get to know him.

**Guide: What about Rush?** 

Rose: Rush is great, too. I watch Rush a lot of times during the day on his TV network.

**Guide:** It's clear that your work ethic is still there. It helped you in baseball and now it's helping your radio career.

Rose: I didn't set out to be the all time hit leader, but once I got within reach I focused in the right direction and concentrated in the right direction and went about my business. Now I'm doing it in radio.

**Guide:** Do you listen to other forms of talk radio, besides sports?

Rose: Yeah. I listen to other shows because when I'm in my car, which I am a lot, it's kind of like doing your homework. I can't get ESPN or CNN in my car, so if I'm not home watching the sports replays, I read the papers and listen to other shows.

**Guide:** You really love all forms of sports.

Rose: Yeah. I get tired of all the murders and the robberies and the wars going on in the world. I think sports are refreshing.

**Guide:** What do you think of somebody like Howard Stern?

Rose: He's got his own style and it's making

G. Gordon Liddy's pretty good. It's all what you have to talk about, and whether you make any sense when you talk.

**Guide:** How would you convince a program director to take your show?

**Rose:** I would help their station make money and if it's their business to make money, they would want my show.

I'm going to give them a product that's going to be sellable in their town if people like sports. You can like sports but you don't have to like me.

**Guide:** Well Pete, you're a lot different than I expected you would be talking to you.

Rose: Don't believe everything you read, and only believe half of what you see. •


## Tech Talk

with Engineer Carl Abrams

Sometimes when viewing elaborate switching systems in our high-tech society, we forget there are often simpler solutions.

The following is a way of using relays to accomplish a switching system that is adequate to run on. Keep in mind, this is a basic layout. It can be altered by simple wiring logic and more timers. Depending on the timer you may, or may not need, diodes and hold capacitors. The circuit uses a simple double pole double throw relay. The coil can be rated from 3 to 110 volts depending on timer output and voltages available. The contacts that move are the contact connections -- the point to which the contacts move between, are the input points to the air board.

On one side is program input, on the other the second source input. By using the timer to turn on the relay for a predetermined time, and off for a pedetermined time, one can add a little more versatility for their application -- be it on-air or production.



#### The Technical Side of Syndicating Your Own Talk Show

If you want to distribute a talk show to more than a handful of stations, satellite is probably going to be the least expensive and most effective way to deliver your program. There are plenty of satellite services available and many of them are listed here in *The Guide to Talk Radio*. These services range from full promotion and production packages, including call screening, to just the basic delivery.

However, since talk hosts are not likely to be broadcasting at the satellite uplink, the problem is how to get the program from the host's location back to the uplink site, while maintaining studio quality sound. Broadcasters often refer to the process of sending program from a remote location back to a satellite distribution point as "satellite backhauling" and there are two methods of satellite backhauling in widespread use.

The first method uses standard dial telephone lines and equipment called frequency extenders. For voice programming, a "two line" frequency extender is most often used. This equipment allows 5 kHz audio (decent voice quality) to be transmitted on two dial lines. A third phone line is required if callers are being fed back to the host from the satellite uplink or if an additional communications line is desired. Frequency extension is an encode/decode process, so an encoder is needed at the sending location and a decoder is required at the receiving site. Many satellite services are already equipped with two line frequency extender decoders.

The second method, which is gaining rapid popularity, uses digital dial telephone services called ISDN (or sometimes Switched 56.) The advantage of this approach is that even better quality audio (up to 15 kHz) can be sent *bidirectionally*, allowing both program transmission and caller return to be handled on a single line. The drawback to ISDN is that it is not available everywhere and the initial setup of the line can be somewhat frustrating, since this is a relatively new technology for the phone companies. This makes ISDN an excellent choice for fixed locations, but less desirable if a host wants to broadcast from random locations on the road.

ISDN stands for Integrated Services Digital Network and it is a dial-up service which provides an end-to-end high speed digital connection from your house or office to the location that you are calling. Switched 56 is a North American "precursor" to ISDN and is still the only digital service available in some areas. However, SW56 can dial up ISDN locations and vice versa. ISDN is also widely available in other parts of the world and provides an easy, inexpensive way to send audio programs internationally.

To send high quality audio on ISDN, digital audio codecs are required. Also needed are an ISDN modem, called a Terminal Adapter (TA), and an interconnect box called an NT1. Some digital audio codecs have both the TA and NT1 built in. There are two issues that are of primary importance for talk hosts as far as digital audio codecs are concerned. The first is compatibility - your codec will have to use the same "algorithm" as the codec at the satellite uplink. There are three main digital audio codec algorithms in use: G.722, ISO/MPEG Layers II & III. For talk radio, the most widely used algorithm is G.722, primarily because the coding delay in G.722 is minimal and does not interfere with host/caller interaction.

Here are some general budgeting guidelines: The two line frequency extender encoder costs about \$3500. Also, you will need the usual microphones, microphone amplifier (mixer), headphones and three phone lines. For the ISDN equipment, codecs with TA and NT1 range from \$2300 to over \$5000. 

In talk radio, if I get somebody on who's really interesting, I keep them on for an hour. Nobody in television is allowed that.


Guide: How long do you want to continue?
