



# RADIO PICTURES

*A New Field for the Experimenter*

By JOHN C. COATSWORTH

For the man who liked to build things with his hands and whose job did not contain that pleasure for him, radio in the early days was heaven-sent. He was too old to get out his boy's construction blocks and toy railroad tracks and thus provide an outlet for that instinct to build things. But with radio he could build and rebuild and still not be laughed at. And so the early days of radio saw hundreds of thousands of serious men and women tinkering with condensers, coils and wires and having the time of their lives. But soon the manufacturers began to turn out sets so much more efficient and perfect than could be built by the ordinary amateur that set-building came to be largely a thing of the past although many still prefer to build their own sets from manufactured kits.

Then came the experiments in short waves for which no sets were available and again great numbers began the fascinating work of experimenting to bring in those frequencies too high for the ordinary set. The thrill of the short waves is distance for programs carry on these waves literally around the world. In fact one of the defects of the short wave set is that it is apt to receive the sound twice—once a slight fraction of a second after the other—caused by the vibrations entering the set *after passing both ways around the world*.

And now comes an even more interesting and fascinating pastime, that of actually picking pictures out of the air. Do you remember that wonderful thrill that came back in the early twenties when you had first assembled a miscellaneous lot of wire and thingamajigs and suddenly you heard "this is Chica-

go" or "this is Denver"? Well that thrill is exceeded by watching the etching upon a slowly turning cylinder of a picture coming to you from New York or Milwaukee or St. Louis. Or the removing from the cylinder of a still blank piece of paper and immersing it in a developing fluid and watching suddenly spring therefrom a picture or sketch or what-not.

Several broadcasting stations throughout the United States are already maintaining regular schedules for broadcasting still picture impulses in addition to their ordinary programs, and others are taking up this feature every week.

Stations WMCA and WOKO, New York and Peekskill, are broadcasting this feature four times a week, station WTMJ, Milwaukee, nightly; while station KMOX is furnishing St. Louis with regular programs, and station WFI will be broadcasting for Philadelphia fans by the time you are reading this.

Several manufacturers are working on various still picture and television recorders to be merchandised in the form of kits and assembled by the fan. Soon everyone can "roll his own" pictures out of the air.

The picture-receiving mechanism will consist of three units. First there is the regular tuning unit for which the present receiving set can be utilized. The wires that now go to the loud-speaker will be disconnected and attached instead to the second unit, which is the picture-reproducing device. The third unit is the cylinder-turning device and for this any old phonograph may be used. Ultimately parts for all

# MOVIES BY RADIO

*Another Story in A. B. C.*

By HOMER CALDWELL

At first the sending of voice and other sounds through the air was a marvel we could scarcely comprehend but already that is common-place. Now it is difficult to realize that vision is actually traveling the ether from one far point to another. Yet fundamentally the two feats are the same for actually, of course, neither sound nor vision is carried through the air. As RADEX has already explained in a previous article, a microphone which vibrates by sound, alternately makes and breaks an electrical circuit. This circuit sending out these vibrations into the air is caught up by a radio set tuned to their frequency and carried through a loud speaker which is practically another microphone and this is vibrated by the electrical current in sympathy with the sending instrument. These latter vibrations are caught by the human ear and we apparently hear the original voice or instrument but we are of course only hearing a reproduction of it as we do from a phonograph record.

We found in the microphone and in the radio tube a means of vibrating the ether-carried current by sound. Scientists thereupon began to search for a means of vibrating that same current by means of light. The first result was the sending of "still" pictures or sketches by means of radio. This has already been described in a previous issue of RADEX. Pictures are now being regularly broadcast as shown in another article in this issue and this is quite a simple operation. The sending of moving pictures, however, is quite another tale and is fraught with the greatest difficulties. It is true that moving pictures are merely a series of

still pictures but in order to make them seem to move, they must pass before the eye with great rapidity—eighteen to the second. As they are thrown on the screen, each picture remains the fraction of a second when it flashes out and the next takes its place. The human eye possesses a "carry-over" faculty; that is it continues to see a thing for an infinitesimal period of time after it ceases. This covers the space between the two pictures and makes the picture seem to be a single unit actually in motion.

Now it is of course an impossibility to send even one picture as a whole in one instant either over the radio or over wires. Each picture must be split into tiny fragments of black and white and gray and these fragments must be reassembled again just as they are in the sending of still pictures, each of which takes several minutes to transmit. To send these pictures at a rate of eighteen complete photographs to the second, made television a seemingly impossible thing. One of the greatest difficulties was that there was no light that would vibrate with such speed but the discovery of the photo-electric cell has changed all this and already tennis-games have been broadcast in which the flight of the ball has been discerned by radio audiences at a distance.

We will try to explain in the simplest possible language just how this is done and in doing this must sacrifice something of scientific exactness. Everyone is familiar with the pocket kodak which contains a roll of film with a preparation sensitive to light. The subject is posed where the light falls upon

# THE BROADCASTING SITUATION

By EVERETT J. DALTON

As this is written a committee of the Radio Commission is working on a re-allocation plan and it is universally hoped that through its labors there may be evolved some plan that will be at once effective, fair and just. None can deny that at present broadcasting is in a muddle. The Commission ought to adopt as its first and most fundamental principle "The rights of the radio listener are paramount." Everything possible ought to be done to protect the financial investment of the broadcaster and a station should be eliminated only when it conflicts with the primary principle enunciated above. But of what use to radio will it be to protect the investments of the broadcasters if the air is so cluttered up that listeners become disgusted and lose their interest?

But listeners, while demanding preferential treatment, ought to be willing to make reasonable concessions. Some people take violent objection to the line of introduction of sponsored programs, giving the name of the sponsor, a description of his product and an offer of literature regarding it. Unless this line is badly overdone there should be no reasonable objection to it. Programs must be paid for. In some countries the listeners are taxed for the means with which to provide the programs. Such a plan is undesirable in America. Far better the present plan of providing programs through the willingness of some advertiser to furnish them for the advertising and goodwill value. If a firm is willing to spend several hundred dollars in providing an hour's entertainment for you and me, surely it is entitled to the courtesy of some mention of itself and its product.

Some radio fans are writing to the

newspapers strenuously objecting to chain programs because six or eight cities in their range are broadcasting the same program. Many neighborhood houses show the same moving picture film and we either go to see it or we don't. The fan who likes to tune in one program and then almost immediately tune in another, cannot expect a broadcasting situation suited to his whims. He doesn't want to hear programs; all he wants are announcements. What would we think of a person who started out in the evening to see moving pictures and visited one theatre after another, stopping but a minute or two in each? And how could the movie houses provide programs suited to his peculiar ambulations? Such a use of radio is a pure fad and robs this great medium of its power to perform a real service.

It seems to us that radio will best serve its ends when every owner of a fairly good set can bring in with suitable volume and minimum static or disturbance, one or two local stations, six or eight large-city stations in his section of the country and one or two of the large national stations such as WEAF and WJZ. There is ample room at the upper and lower ends of the dials for hundreds of local stations of small power sharing time where necessary so that every listener may have access to his local stations. This would leave the great central band for stations of greater power located in the larger cities. In our opinion, power ought to be in direct proportion to the population of the city in which the studio (not the antenna) is located. This may seem an odd basis for power allotment. Our reasons are these: the

## HOW TO USE RADEX

If properly used RADEX will add immeasurably to the pleasure and success in tuning. In the "Index by Frequencies" note that the stations are arranged in groups according to their frequency or "beat." Each station in any of these groups must come in at exactly the same places on the dials as the others in that group. If it does not it is temporarily off its legal frequency and should not be logged. Read the following instructions carefully.

Tune in any station and enter the dial readings in the spaces opposite the frequency or wave-length of that station as shown in the reproduction on this page. Now tune in another station and again enter the dial numbers as before. Continue doing this for as many stations as you can receive. You will notice that your dial numbers have either an ascending or



a descending scale depending upon whether your dials read right to left or left to right. You will now find that you can tell at a glance where to set your dials for those stations you have not received by noting the dial readings for the group before and the group after.

For instance if you desire to tune in WHAS which has a frequency of 650 kcys. you will note in the illustration that it comes between 71-70 or 69-68 on the dials of the set used. Therefore if the dials of this set had been placed at 70-69 it would have been tuned to 650 kcys. and if WHAS were on the air and in range of the set it would have been tuned in.

To identify stations received without waiting for the call letters, compare the dial reading with the dial readings already entered and this with the power of the station shown in the second column will enable you to name the station you are hearing.





it. This light is reflected into the camera and upon the film through the lens just as it is into the human eye. The spots of the subject that are white falling upon the film discolor it and change it to black. Black spots in the subject reflecting no light, leave their spot on the film white while those parts which are neither black nor white, leave the film gray. This film is then "developed" and becomes a negative from which endless reproductions of the original picture may be made.

In radio-movies a photo-electric cell or tube which is so quickly affected by light that its response is in the millionths of a second, is placed in the electric current where the microphone is in the ordinary broadcast. As light is permitted to fall upon this cell through a lens and shutter, white spots in the picture falling upon the cell cause it to glow fully and release a full amount of flow of the electric current passing through the circuit. As black spots fall upon the cell, the light is unaffected thus stopping the flow of current. Grays similarly only partly affect the cell and permit but a portion of the current to flow, the amount being determined by the amount of white in the gray.

To permit the whole picture to impress itself upon the cell as it does on the film in a camera would mean nothing at all therefore the picture must be broken up just as it is in a half-tone engraving. If you will take any half-tone picture in a magazine and examine it through a microscope it will be seen that the picture is composed of a multitude of small dots, some black and some white and some the gray between. In order to break up the picture into small particles therefore a "scanning" device is used. The usual form of this

scanning device is composed of two disks which whirl rapidly between the lens and the photo-electric cell. One of these disks has a circular slot in it which begins near the other edge and gradually comes closer to the center. The other disk has a slot in it which runs like a spoke in a wheel. If you were to peek through these whirling disks you would see a spot of light which traveled up and down and back and forth until it had covered the entire vision of the lens.

In operation the subject is seated facing the device with the light full upon it. The scanning device is started and instead of a single picture being taken at once as in a camera, hundreds of small pictures are taken instead each one being a "dot" of the whole picture just as in the half-tone. So rapidly is this done however that your eye would seem to see the whole picture just as when you look at anyone through the spokes of a rapidly moving wheel. As each of these dot pictures is taken, the amount of light reflected by that particular dot is thrown upon the photo-electric cell which vibrates accordingly and the broadcast current is thereby vibrated just as it is by the microphone actuated by sound.

At the receiving end we have an identical apparatus with the disks synchronized with the sending instrument. That is, they must whirl at *exactly* the same rate of speed. Here another photo-electric cell, connected with the broadcast circuit, vibrates white, black and gray in complete sympathy with the sending cell. If we then look at this second cell through the scanning device a picture is painted for us, dot by dot, so rapidly that we seem to see the whole at once. As eighteen complete pictures must be sent each second in order to conform to the speed of the eye and as each picture is made up of hundreds of tiny pictures, some idea

of the incomprehensible speed of the device may be secured. The larger the picture that is sent, the greater must be the speed of the device to scan it completely eighteen times a second. Therefore in the machines now in use the picture that is reproduced is very small, about the size of that of a pocket kodak. Without doubt means will be found to magnify these pictures and perhaps throw them upon a screen so that they will be life-size as in the movies. Television is still in its swaddling-clothes and no station is as yet broadcasting moving pictures regularly although WGY of Schenectady is doing so occasionally only for local use that its experts may both send and receive them in their efforts to make them practical and the devices marketable. The day is not far distant however when we radio-listeners will both "see" and "hear" the great events of the day.

larger the city, the greater the supply of worth-while artists. No small town can possibly hope to put on programs seven nights a week that will have any sort of attraction to listeners at a distance. Their clientele must be found in their own locality where necessary crudities of local talent will be overlooked because the hearer knows the person broadcasting. To put hall-town programs out over a chain of stations would be folly. But when an advertiser in New York is willing to employ Whiteman's Band, for instance, there can be no possible objection to the broadcasting of such a program over dozens of stations simultaneously. Far better to be limited to hearing one good event than to have the power to tune in a dozen poor ones.

these may be bought so that a single instrument capable of reproducing both sound and pictures, will be available to those who would build their own.

There are still several differing methods of reproduction of pictures in use and the set one builds must be adapted to the requirements of the sending station he will receive. The speed of his cylinder must be identical with that of the sending station otherwise grotesque pictures will appear that may resemble either hash or a futuristic picture of intoxicated design.

RADEX will from time to time publish the latest information for the benefit of those who are interested in this new development in the field of radio.

The Radiovision Corporation announces that stations KSTP, St. Paul, Minn. and WJBI of Scranton, Pa., have joined the list of stations broadcasting pictures through the Cooley Rayfoto process on their radio schedules. WMCA, New York City, broadcasts a picture playlet every Wednesday night and pictures three mornings each week. WDEL Wilmington, Del., WWJ, Detroit, CKNC, Toronto and CJRN, Winnipeg are also included in the Radiovision chain.

# RADIO GRAND OPERA

*The Coming Season Will Hold Treats*

The most elaborate schedule of grand operas ever attempted by radio is disclosed in the National Broadcasting Company's announcement of musical dramas to be produced by the National Grand Opera Company beginning September 17.

The 1928-29 radio opera season officially opens on Monday night, September 17, with an interpretive arrangement of Verdi's "Aida" never before heard over the air, and specially made for the National Grand Opera Company. All the operas of the new season will be heard in more inclusive form, requiring an hour and a half for production. They will be broadcast through the NBC System each Monday night from 10:30 o'clock to midnight, Eastern Daylight Saving Time.

A greater variety of artists will sing the leading dramatic roles under the direction of Cesare Sodero, maestro of several successful seasons. Overtures and orchestral support gain new importance as played by a symphonic group of more than forty pieces. Sodero will conduct except when operatic composers themselves lead a special performance of their own work.

Again the new season's operas have been drawn from the masterworks of every land, but this year American composers will receive greater recognition than ever before.

This is done by presenting an American opera on the last Monday of every month, starting with Victor Herbert's "Natoma" on October 29. In doing this, NBC officials believe they are enabling those who bring the world's best music right into the homes of the

American public to encourage a native school of American opera.

In addition to Victor Herbert's "Natoma," American works on the first half of the NBC schedule include Cadman's "Shanewis" and Harling's "The Light from St. Agnes." Franke Harling himself will conduct the performance of the latter, which scored such a triumph for both opera and composer when presented by the Chicago Civic Opera Company.
