



THE American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers, the leading performing right society in the United States, is an unincorporated, non-profit, voluntary association. The Society, which is the oldest American performing right society, has a total membership of 1,629 writers and 218 publishers; during the past year more than 39 writers and 15 publishers have become active members.

ASCAP has continued to cooperate with the war effort to the fullest extent of its ability. The ASCAP scripts, which have been so successfully used by more than 600 of the 929 licensed radio stations, have been definitely slanted to emphasize civilian participation in war activities.

Our script department was utilized during the United States Treasury Department's Sixth War Bond drive, when we prepared eight 15-minute broadcasts. These programs were transcribed, and featured not only some of the music from the Society's tremendous repertoire, but also some at-the-front interviews with our service men on Guam, Saipan, and many other theatres of operation. The transcriptions were used by radio stations throughout the entire country.

With the launching of the Liberty Ship Ethelbert Nevin, sponsored by Local 802 of the American Federation of Musicians, the ASCAP board of directors voted to purchase a complete library for the use of the ship's crew.

It is significant that the majority of leading ASCAP songwriters have been tremendously active not only within the organization, but on their own in bringing entertainment to wounded service men in various military hospitals. Through the cooperation of its membership, the Society has furnished entire units for service men's shows at the National Press Club at Washington, D. C.

Last March, ASCAP, in collaboration with the American Theatre Wing Music War Committee, sponsored a concert in tribute to its member, the late Larry Hart. The proceeds from this concert, as well as the proceeds from the concert given last January in conjunction with the Los Angeles Times, were donated to the Armed Forces Master Records, Inc. Some of the money from the Larry Hart concert has been used to establish a "contemporary music" room in the New York Public Library System.

In the field of industrial music ASCAP, in close cooperation with production officials of the war effort, has issued licenses for its entire repertoire in industrial plants for the nominal fee of \$1 per year for the duration.



F OUNDING OF AMP: Associated Music Publishers, Inc., was founded as a private corporation in the State of New York on December 22, 1926. Radio licenses have been issued since August, 1928. The corporation conducts a music publishing business and is exclusive agent for numerous foreign music publishers.

Scope: The AMP repertoire, representing 45 U. S. and European catalogs, has now been increased to include 500,500 titles, of which approximately 18,500 are copyrights. Copyright registration in Washington is in the name of AMP as owner. Ranging from symphonic works to dance music, including concert works for ensemble, solo instruments and voice, its repertoire constitutes a flexible and rich source of distinctive music for radio

program builders.

AMP licenses: Licenses cover performing rights, "small" (i.e., strictly musical) and "grand" (i.e., musical-dramatic.) AMP's radio license is unique in that it covers "small" and "grand" rights under a single fee. The radio license stipulates that: (1) the monthly fee shall be equal to a station's highest quarter-hour rate card; (2) that AMP will sell the licensee any music (covered by the license) which is for sale, and rent such music as is not for sale; (3) that AMP will indemnify the licensee against claims arising from the use of music covered by the license.

AMP licensees: The national networks, the principal regional networks and most of the important independent radio stations are holders of AMP

licenses.

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE is the twenty-fifth anniversary of radio. BMI wholeheartedly celebrates this great event in the history of the industry which created it, and celebrates at the same time its own fifth anniversary. The broadcasting industry can well be proud of its great record of public service during the past twenty-five years, for radio now occupies an invaluable place in the life of the nation.

More than 600,000 titles are listed as available for use in the latest BMI catalogue. These titles range all the way from arrangements of the classics

to the hottest swing.

Bulletins are sent out periodically listing vital changes in the catalogue, so that the Index is always kept up to date. In addition, the Research Department which does this work is always at the service of BMI licensees.

The BMI FIELDMEN are specially trained to be of use to stations. They call on broadcasters with helpful suggestions for better programming, and are continually gathering opinions and suggestions from station men with an eye to making improvements in BMI's service.

The STANDARD DEPARTMENT continues to add music which never

falls out of public favor to station libraries.

According to a station's needs, it receives regular shipments of con-

cert, popular, hillbilly and other music.

The NEWSLETTER carries a weekly message on music to program

directors and musical directors.

The BMI MUSIC MEMO is issued weekly to keep the record programs up to the minute on the latest releases, and provide background material on the artists who appear on the discs.
