Canadian Broadcasting Hit New Peak in Operation During 1957

NINETEEN-FIFTY-SEVEN was a boom year for Canada. More babies were born—475,000 of them—than in any previous year in our history. More immigrants arrived—282,164 of them—than in any post-war year. There were more marriages—136,000—than in any year since 1946, when thousands of postponed weddings took place between second world war veterans and their brides.

Not only was Canada's population up, so was our gross national product; our consumer spending; consumer price index; wage index and real income. And the Canadian broadcasting business expanded along with population and production.

Canada's 177 non-government radio stations now provide service for all but a handful of the Dominion's 17,000,000 people, and about 90 per cent of the population is also served by one of the 49 TV stations, 41 of which are non-government. What makes the Canadian television industry different from the U.S. industry, however, is that there are only two networks, one English-language network and one serving the 30 per cent of Canada's population who are French speaking.



But while both networks are owned and operated by the government-owned Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, most of the network shows reach their audience through private stations. Only eight TV stations in six Canadian cities are owned by the CBC. The rest of the stations (41) in the network are privately-owned stations who are required to make a minimum of 10-1/2 hours per week available for CBC programming.

Another unique feature of the Canadian industry is that one out of two Canadian TV areas are captive markets, serviced by only one station. U.S. residents can visualize the Canadian picture if they imagine Dallas or Kansas City or San Diego serviced by only one TV station. Moreover, perhaps because Canadians are a home-staying race or because they were prepared for TV by the U.S. experience, set saturation has been reached remarkably quickly. Canadian TV stations range in age from four years to

six months but many areas (London, Ontario, for example or Regina, Saskatchewan) have already achieved set saturation of over 80 per cent, and set saturation in other areas, e.g. Quebec City and Sydney, N.S. is over 90 per cent.

The radio picture is also a bright one. While TV has been backing up into daytime (a process especially encouraged by the fact that "network option time" falls in the Class "A," 8 to 11 p.m., time slot), nighttime radio has been firming up. Whereas advertisers last year were prime time happy with 7:00 to 9:00 a.m.; 12:00 to 1:30 (a good many Canadians still go home for lunch) and 4:30 to 7:00 p.m., virtually sold out on every station.

Now advertisers—national and local—are going into nighttime, sometimes reluctantly—because there isn't enough daytime to buy and sometimes with the feeling that nighttime can deliver a good general audience—at less than daytime rates.



On the political front, the Canadian radio news of 1957 was the report of the Fowler Commission.

The two major policy recommendations of the Commission—the creation of a new broadcast governing body, and licensing of competitive television stations—were welcomed by Canada's private broadcasters since both had been major points in the CARTB brief to the Commission. Due to the unsettled political situation in Canada, however, (Canadian voters go to the polls at the end of March, 1958, for the second time within nine months to elect a new federal parliament) no action has been taken on the Fowler Commission Report.

All Canadian radio and television conventions—regional and national—had their best attendance records in their history last year.

CBC Extending Its Network TV Links To Span Across The Entire Dominion

THE Canadian Broadcasting Corporation expects to be operating the world's longest television microwave network by the end of this year.

It will stretch some 4,200 miles from St. John's, Newfoundland, in the east to Victoria, B.C., in the west. The microwave system, since the completion on February 2nd this year of the length between Quebec City and the Maritimes, now reaches from Sydney, Nova Scotia, in the east to Calgary, in Alberta, in the west.

Forty-eight television stations are now in operation across the country. Eight are owned and operated by the CBC, six English-language network stations at Halifax, Montreal, Ottawa, Toronto, Winnipeg and Vancouver, and two French-language network stations at Montreal and Ottawa. In addition, two stations licensed to and managed by the CBC are located at Goose Bay, Labrador, and Harmon Field, Newfoundland. These outlets, using U.S. facilities, serve Canadian and American military personnel and civilians in the two areas.

The country's forty privately-owned television stations include thirty-four English-language outlets and six French-language. Five satellite stations are also operated by private interests.

The growth of Canadian television, which started little more than five and one-half years ago, has been at the fastest rate of any country in the world. Television service is now available to about 87 per cent of the population.

Canadians, during the past five and a half years, have spent more than \$1.2 billion on the purchase and maintenance of TV receivers, or more per capita than anybody else in the world. An estimated 2.9 million sets are now in use.

Possibly the most distinctive achievement of Canadian television has been the development of two separate program services, each complete in itself, one in French and one in English. The CBC's French-language production constitutes the world's major French television service. In hours per day, the combined program output in English and French of all CBC production centres, is greater than that of any other television organization in the world.

Last year more than 11,000 television

programs were seen in Canadian homes.

In terms of live television production Canada ranks next to the United States and Britain, while the CBC production centers at Montreal and Toronto rank next to New York and Hollywood as North America's leading TV centers.

All Canadian television stations, public and private, are part of the national system. The privately-owned stations serve as outlets for a good share of the national network programs produced by or provided through the CBC. When television first began in Canada, the CBC agreed to provide not less than ten and a half hours of network programming a week to the private stations—actually, in the past year, the affiliated stations have been carrying on the average about forty hours a week of such network programming, or some fifty-five per cent of their schedule.

The privately-owned and CBC stations, working together within the national broadcasting system as established by act of Parliament, co-operate to mutual benefit and to a degree greater than is generally thought. The CBC provides the national program service free to the private stations and they, in turn, give it free distribution, while at the same time earning revenue for themselves in the case of sponsored programs on the national service.

We look forward with unbounded confidence and optimism in the future of Canadian television. Specific steps, however, on such things as color TV, extension of TV broadcast hours, and broadening of coverage to areas not now served must await Parliamentary action on the recommendations of the Fowler Royal Commission, which, after an exhaustive public investigation of national broadcasting, submitted its report last spring. One of the main conclusions of the report was that the present system—the uniquely Canadian system of private and public co-operation—be continued.

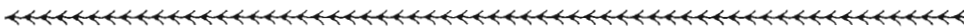
