D"Dare To Dream" is the title of the new **Yanni** album due out this month. This is his first album of new material in nearly three years. The one song you may find familiar is the

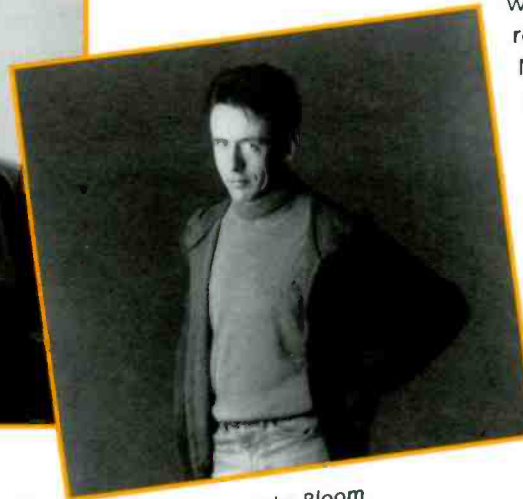

Suzanne Vega's hit **LUKA**. The last name Bloom, comes from a James Joyce character, "Leopold Bloom".

SPOTLIGHT

Although most of us would consider ourselves "city dwellers", many environmentally sensitive areas still exist in our own backyards. In this "Spotlight", Nancy Wilson points out one area where something as simple as a wall impacts local wildlife.

Have you noticed more and more walls going up lately? Walls block the natural flow of communication between human beings...they alienate, and ultimately divide us. The environmental impact of a wall can be just as tragic. Recently one was installed around the new Beverly Estates Development on Mulholland Drive, located east of Beverly Glen and west of Coldwater Canyon. It cuts off a big chunk of what was once a breathtaking and inspirational view of the Santa Monica Mountains, the ocean, and surrounding urban canyons. Unfortunately, that's not all the wall blocks off.



These luxury homes were built in the middle of an environmentally sensitive area; supporting herds of mule deer, fox, racoons and many other small animals. The wall, constructed for privacy, cuts off an important wildlife corridor, used by deer and coyotes to cross from the South Side of Mulholland to the Northern Canyon, and

must remain open if the existing animal populations east of the 405 Freeway are to survive. Studies have shown that maintaining more than one wildlife corridor is necessary to ensure maximum food and water resource availability, as well as safe movement between habitat patches. The L.A. Urban Wilderness Coalition is a local environmental group that's been working to preserve the unique and biologically rich canyons, nestled between the San Fernando Valley and the West Side. Removal of the Beverly Estates wall has become one of their biggest battles.

It's important to support the major environmental organizations such as Greenpeace and the Audubon Society, and it's imperative that we observe what's going on, ecologically, in our own neighborhoods. A good way to become informed is to get involved with the local environmental group looking out for your area. 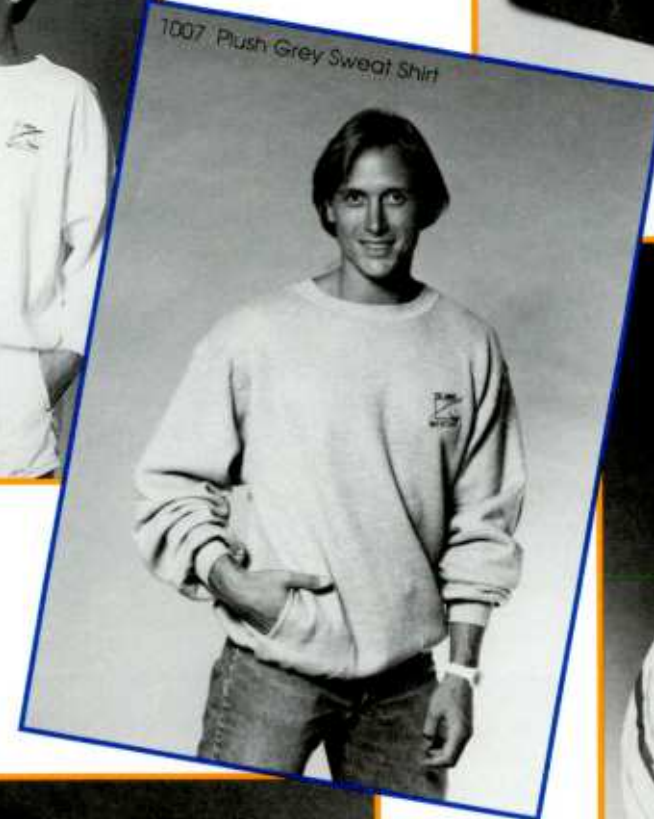
