Based at the University of California Irvine, KUCI broadcasts 24 hours a day 7 days a week. The 110 volunteer staff members of KUCI dedicate themselves to exposing the un-exposed, digging deeper into issues to see what is really going on, spending a vast amount of money on records/cd's, and actively working themselves into the various subcultures that make up Orange County. This dedication is what makes people like you look to us to see what is next.

We at KUCI believe that our transmitting power should be used to give light to music and ideas that really have no home on any other part of the radio spectrum. You will not hear music that is played on KROQ or Power FM. You will not hear Howard Stern or Rush Limbaugh on KUCI. What you will hear is what is up-and-coming in the next year, 5 years or even 50 years. Our mission at KUCI is to deliver informativite programming that educates our audience about the ideas and music the rest of the profit-driven radio market choose to avoid. No other station plays gospel music on the same day as hard-core punk or even noise. KUCI represents over 20 genres of music, and over 25 different talk show topics. We are the only station in all of Southern California that boasts this diversity.

KUCI is a listener-supported radio station that is completely non-profit. We do not pay our staff or our DJs. Each DJ dedicates about 10 hours of their time a week to be part of KUCI.



We rely on you to keep us on the air and we make the promise to continue delivering the most diverse programming in Southern California. Thank you.

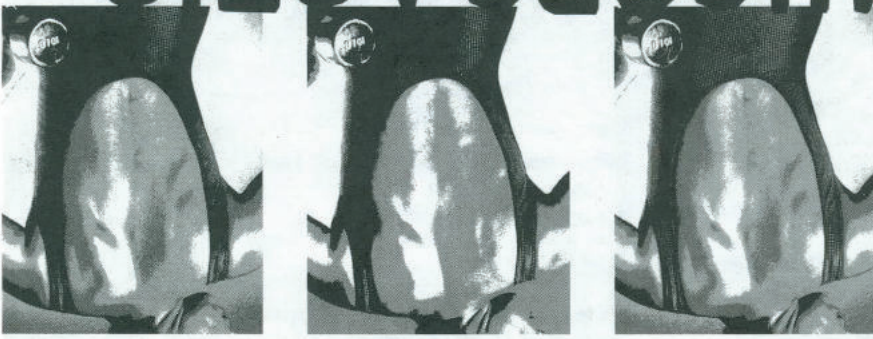
