

INTRODUCTION

Velcome to the first volume of Radiomania's vintage radio reference guides. In compiling this reference, it quickly became evident that, in order to do the subject justice, focus should be placed on specific areas of interest. Radio collectors seem to naturally find their niche in one particular area of collecting or another. Whether it be cathedrals, bakelites, catalins, tombstones, consoles, early battery sets, 1950s kitsch, machine age design, etc.

A common ground for many collectors is the tabletop radios of the high style era beginning in the early 1930s and continuing through the 1950s. It was during this period that industrial designers saw their heyday and radios became more than functional pieces of electronic equipment. They were icons of a new age in communication, designed to be consumed. Where radios are known to be attributed to major industrial designers we have so noted the designer in the description.

Since a picture is worth a thousand words, not much in the way of a written description is necessary. However, we have noted the materials used in constructing the radio, year of manufacture, coloration and average market value. Additionally, given the plethora of references available, it was decided to focus on the most desireable radios and those that are not pictured in other reference books. It is hoped that this will be a well received supplement to the collector's library.

PRICING

In compiling this book the question as to whether to include prices at all was one of major concern to both the author and contributors. As most collectors are aware, even the best price guide, if not initially flawed, is soon obsolete. The range of prices paid for most items is wide. One can pay anywhere from a few dollars to a few hundred for a given item, dependent on where it was purchased and from whom. Thus the task of establishing a 'market value' is difficult if not impossible. This problem given, it was still generally felt that the value of including prices, at least as a general market gauge, would outweigh the disadvantages of omitting them completely.

In establishing values a number of sources were utilized including auction results, classified ads, meet pricing, collector valuations and the author's personal experience having been both a collector and dealer for over ten years. Prices in this book represent items in average condition. Average meaning that the radio is intact but 'as found'. No repairs would have been made, either electrically or otherwise. If wood, the finish would be original. It might show some wear, but would be presentable in a collection once cleaned up. If plastic, the cabinet would be free from cracks and chips. Plaskon radios in average condition might evidence some minor stress lines but nothing which would detract from their aesthetics. Values followed by a '+' symbol represent rarer items, only a few of which have traded hands. In such cases the value listed represents an estimate of what a collector might expect to pay for an average example. The '+' symbol is also used to indicate baseline values for catalin radios, the price of which will vary widely based on color, condition, marbelization, and variations. This reference does not attempt to address the intricacies of valuing catalin radios, but merely to provide the reader with a baseline gauge.

A word about dealers and dealer prices: expect to pay a premium when purchasing from a dealer. The dealer offers one the luxury of eliminating the time consuming hunt through yard and estate sales, flea markets, antique shows and the like. It is he who goes through the trouble of rooting out those hard to find items. Ones which you might not happen upon except after years of hunting yourself. Dealers inventories represent long hours and related expenses and must reflect those additional costs.

FINE TUNING VALUES

To assist the collector in fine tuning the value of a given radio, some general rules of thumb are offered. Please remember that, as with all rules, there are exceptions to these. If you are unsure about a specific item you will always do best to ask another collector whom you trust.

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

Chassis Corrosion: In buying any radio it is important to visually inspect the chassis, particularly if you plan to restore the set to working order. Minor surface corrosion is typical and acceptable to all but the most finicky of collectors and should not deter from the value. Extreme corrosion can be an indication that the radio was submerged at one time or at least has seen a lot of humidity. If so, the bulk of the internal components may need to be replaced. Even if you plan only to display the radio, if it is so damaged its value will be decreased by the fact that it would be less desirable to most other collectors.

RODENT WEAR: Most of us have, at some time, come across a radio with leaves stuffed into the nooks and crannies of its chassis and acorns which have mysteriously gotten underneath, or a set which has had every wire, both exposed and internal, chewed through. Such phenomena are caused by common vermin such as squirrels, rats and mice. At one time the radio was probably stored outside in a barn or garage and it happened to become someones home. The damage caused by such occupancy can be severe. If you come across such a set and are tempted to buy it, inspect it carefully. The easily observed superficial problems may be but a sign of more extreme damage internally. Yank the chassis if you plan to restore it to working order. You may chose not to after you see the innards.

Transformers: A common problem, and one that may be costly to remedy, is that of the 'smoked' transformer. Caused by a short circuit or overload, damage to the transformer almost always necessitates its replacement. Fortunately, such problems are often easy to spot. Look for smoke damage to the chassis and on the inside of the cabinet. Also look for gooey stuff (which may have hardened over time) oozing from the transformer itself. Most collectors stay far away from sets with blown transformers if at all possible. Short of finding a junker radio of the same variety but with a good transformer, you'll need to buy a replacement with the same specs. This can cost anywhere from twenty to ninety dollars assuming you are lucky enough to even find a match.

Tubes: Missing tubes are generally easy to replace, particularly amongst radios from this era. The resources are numerous. Your local club will probably be your least expensive resource (usually one to three dollars per tube). After that there are local repair shops, mail order companies and specialty houses. It is a good idea to know your resources when considering the purchase of a radio sans tubes. Also be aware that there are critters known as ballast tubes which look like filament tubes superficially but which are really resistors. Count on about one out of every two ballast tubes needing replacement. Unlike filament tubes, few ballasts have survived. Replacing a bad ballast will require much perseverance or some clever electronic rigging to bypass the device.

BACKS: Most radios pictured in this book had backs when they were originally sold. Most don't now. The backs were typically flimsy cardboard which became worn and fell off never to be seen again. Often times the antenna was attached to the missing back and is now also missing. To most collectors the absence of a cardboard back will not detract from the value of a radio. Conversely, the presence of a back, particularly if it is in good condition, will add value. One exception to this rule are those radios made during the mid to late 1930s with moulded plastic backs (like the Fada 260 series or the Emerson 199). With these radios the back is considered to be a critical element of the radio design and, as such, its absence can devalue a set by as much as 25%.

KNOBS: If one or more knobs are missing from a radio its value will be diminished. The purchaser of such a radio must resolve himself to either completing the set or substituting another complete set that looks right. If you chose to complete the set with correct knobs, the most cost effective, but also the most time consuming, method is to bring a correct knob with you to a local collector meet in hopes of finding a match in a box of odd knobs for sale. Cost for such knobs is typically in the one to five dollar range. Be prepared to wait a long time and look through a lot of boxes though. Another way to complete the set is to purchase a reproduction from one of several vendors throughout the country. Check ads in trade periodicals and club newsletters for such resources. There are dozens of types being reproduced and stocked today. The price for such reproduction knobs will range from two to seven dollars. Specialty knobs with chrome rings or those that duplicate catalin can run upwards of twenty-five dollars each. If you've got an odd bird which is not being reproduced, your final alternative is a specialty vendor who will make a casting of your knob with reproductions upon order. Cost for such knobs typically begins at ten dollars. Regardless of how you decide to deal with the missing knob(s), the value of the radio will be reduced by an amount which correlates directly with the time, cost and aggravation of completing the set.

DIAL LENSES: Covering the dial area on most radios pictured in this book is a plastic or glass dial lense. A damaged or missing plastic dial lense can be reproduced to order by a number of vendors. The going rate is about fifteen dollars per lense. If you don't have the original you can still make a tracing of the dial opening and send it to with your order. Again, look in periodicals and club bulletins for resources.

Glass dial lenses are typically made from convex round pieces of glass secured either inside the dial bezel or attached to the dial scale on the radio itself. Clockmakers usually will have matches for such pieces in the form of clock crystals. Just measure the outside diameter of the glass and make a few calls to area clockmakers or contact a supply house. You might, as an alternative, decide to replace the glass with plastic and contact a lense reproducer.

Both glass and plastic dial lenses were sometimes reverse painted with dial scales and ornamentation. If such a dial is broken, cracked, warped or otherwise damaged you've got a significant problem facing you. Except for a limited number of high value radios, no one makes reproduction dial scales. It will be next to impossible to find a suitable replacement. Your best hope will be to find another of the same radio and use its glass. You'd probbly do just as well to wait for that next radio instead. The only reasons to buy a radio with such a problem are either that the price is extremely reasonable (enough to make the problem tolerable) or that you do not expect to have another opportunity to own such a radio in the forseeable future.

PLASTICS

For the novice collector the number of different plastics used in the manufacture of radio cabinets can be confusing. Furthermore, the names we use today have been established more from convention than anything else. That is, most all of the descriptive names currently used were at one time a brand or product name for the material. Typically, many manufacturers produced the same or a similar material. For one reason or another a single brand name has, over time, become synonymous with the material itself. The most common types of plastics and their conventions are as follows:

BAKELITE: The 'first' plastic, Bakelite was made from a powder and molded under tremendous pressure and heat. It is typically brown or black and somewhat pourous. Brown bakelite can be heavily 'mottled' with various shades of coloration.

BEETLE: Formed, like bakelite, under heat and pressure, this early plastic can be striking in appearance. Used to mold cabinets from the late 1930s through the early 1940s, beetle is typically opaque ivory in color with marbled streaks of orange, rust, geen, blue, red and brown. Some examples may be subtle with just a hint of rust marbelizing while others evidence themselves in a wide array of deep color tones.

CATALIN: An early resin, catalin was poured into molds and then cured in low heat ovens over a period of days. Once removed from the mold, if not broken in the process, the catalin radio cabinet was machined to remove debris and to add detail to the design. The labor intensity of this material was not at issue in the late 1930s when it was first introduced in radio cabinetry, but after World War II, with the shortage of manpower that resulted, its use quickly became cost prohibitive.

Catalin is known to be the most valuable of plastics used in radios with colorations ranging from opaque solid colors to semi-transluscent marbles resembling polished agate. Catalin is more fragile than other plastics of the period and is prone to chips, cracks, burns (from tube heat), discoloration (those butterscotch radios were originally white) and shrinking. All of these hazards have had a significant impact on the number of catalin sets which have survived, thus driving up their price.

PLASKON: Also manufactured using a process similar to bakelite, plaskon was molded in ivory and opaque colors. Typically, radio manufacturers offered the consumer the option of an ivory color at a higher price. Sometimes this was simply a painted brown or black bakelite cabinet. Other times it was molded in ivory plaskon. Occaisionally, radios were offered in colors other than ivory. Plaskon cabinets were available in colors such as pistaschio green, chinese red and lavender. Although plaskon wears about as well as bakelite, it is subject to stress lines. These are superficial cracks which, unfortunately, fill with dirt and grime over the years. Some can be cleaned or bleached out, others can be sanded down, but most must be lived with.

PLASTIC: Refers to contemporary injection molded plastics, most frequently polystyrene. First widely used in the late 1940s and available in a variety of colors.

TENITE: Occaisionally used for cabinets, tenite was most often used for the manufacture of radio grilles, knobs, handles and ornamental parts. The most significant problem with this material was its vulnerability to warpage due to proximity to heat. Tenite was not a particularly wise choice for use in construction of heated filament tube-type radios. Almost all tenite warps to one degree or another. The best one can hope for is minimal warpage.

VALUING PLASTIC RADIOS

CHIPS AND CRACKS: As a rule of thunb, a major flaw in any plastic radio, such as a significant visible chip, crack or warp, will cut the value of that radio in half so long as it remains displayable. Among plaskon radios hairline stress cracks are fairly common. In many models they are the rule and not the exception. As stated previously, so long as the stress lines are not too numerous and do not detract materially from the general aesthetics of the radio, the depreciation should be minimal. On the other hand, the stress free example of a set which is commonly found with stress lines is worth considerably more than average.

FRACILITY: Dependent on the thickness of the casting, materials used in construction and the extremity of design, some radios are inherently more delicate than others. The most fragile (such as the Kadette 'Classic') are rarely found in near perfect condition. This 'universe' from which each radio is drawn must be considered in determining its value. In our example, a Kadette 'Classic' in what would appear to the casual observer as marginal condition, might, in fact, be an excellent example of that model, given the condition of other surviving sets.

REPAIRS: Although there have been some relatively successful attempts at bakelite repair, no repair can go undetected. A well repaired flaw can increase the value of a radio but will never raise its value to that of an unflawed one.

PAINT CHIPS: While many of these early plastic radios were available in different colors (typically walnut, black and ivory), oftentimes the ivory colored sets were brown or black bakelite which had been painted at the factory. This factory painting process was similar to that used in the automobile industry. After several layers of paint were applied, the cabinet was baked for several hours. As a result, the paint became 'hard' and much more susceptible to chipping over time. In addition to the problem of chipping, the baking process made the paint that much more difficult to remove. Stripping old baked on paint is extremely difficult and time intensive at best. Be prepared to use caustic chemicals and spend a lot of time. You may then find yourself with a black or brown radio and cast ivory plaskon knobs. This may look fine to you, but it is not 'original' and will be less valuable to other collectors. The net result is that the value of a factory painted radio with paint chips will be reduced by anywhere from ten to fifty percent dependent on the extent and placement of chipping.

VALUING WOOD RADIOS

Although typically not as popular with collectors in the past, wood cabinet radios are gaining in value and popularity as the hobby expands. It is interesting to note that, when radios were sold in the 1930s and 1940s, it was the wood cabinet which sold for a premium. Plastics were considered then to be a cheap man-made alternative.

The following are some basics to keep in mind when considering the purchase of a wood cabinet radio:

FINISH: Most wood radios produced during the 1930s through the 1950s were finished with either clear or toned lacquer. The more expensive sets were hand rubbed resulting in the 'piano' finish many today find so desireable. Over the years many things can and usually do happen to a lacquer finish. The finish will dry and chip, peel or separate ('alligator'). Rarely does one come across an original lacquer finish without some evidence of the passage of time. Unless the surviving finish is horrendous, it is worthwhile trying to salvage. There are various products available which will allow you to easily clean the surface and replenish the moisture in the lacquer. Additionally, you may want to amalgamize the finish to cover bare spots. This involves dissolving the original finish with denatured alcohol or other substance and respreading it.

As opposed to clear lacquer, toned lacquers present more of a problem. Many manufacturers, instead of using different wood veneers for contrast, used a single veneer type and sprayed toned lacquers for variations in color and shade. Originally, the difference was difficult to discern. Today it is evident. When toned lacquers age they reveal the original color of the wood underneath, usually in deep contrast. The darker the toner, the more significant the problem. The purchaser of such a radio must resign himself to live with the radio as is or refinish it. Both are a compromise.

VENEERS: Most all early radio cabinets were made with wood veneers as opposed to solid exotic or hardwoods. Over time the glue which bonds the veneer to the wood of the cabinet can deteriorate. The result ranges from small veneer chips to full pieces of veneer falling off. The best case is where the veneer is separating, but still present. This is easy to remedy with glue and clamps. If pieces of veneer are actually missing, they must obviously be

replaced. This means removing the remainder of the damaged section of veneer and replacing it with another full piece. You may be able to find such a piece with an original finish on a junker radio. Otherwise, you will need to apply a finish to the new veneer. If the piece is very small and in a relatively concealed area you may chose to fill the hole with a matching wood puttly, shellac stick or toner pencil.

Additionally, veneer tends to lose its flexibility over time. Veneer which has been bent at angles of ninety degrees or more on a radio may break at those turns. If this occurs, again, be prepared to live with it or replace that entire section of veneer.

PAPER VENEER: A concept similar to the toned lacquer, paper veneer involved application of exotic veneer decals to the radio cabinet. This technique was used for both whole radio cabinets and small details. Upon close inspection of the veneer, one can usually discriminate between paper and real veneers. A damaged decal will make the difference apparent. If a radio is ornamented with damaged paper finish, any attempt to repair or refinish the radio will likely remove the decal or damage it further. This should be kept in mind when evaluating such a set for purchase.

REFINISHING: All but the absolute purists will agree that some radios just need to be refinished in order to be displayable. Many collectors have not seen a well refinished radio and so cannot appreciate the art to it. The process is long and involved, and extremely time intensive, but the result of a 'professional' refinish is astonishing. Of course there is refinishing and there is refinishing. Many collectors will use a caustic solvent to remove the original finish, then stain the cabinet and apply a coat of polyurethane or tung oil. The result is something that looks like it came out of a craft shop, not a vintage radio. If you are considering the purchase of a radio which is so refinished it should be valued as if it had no finish at all (about half the value of such a set in average condition).

Oftentimes one encounters a radio with the original finish intact. It is just underneath a coat of slopped on varnish or shellac. Various solvents can be used to remove the top coat and leave the original finish. There is an art to this process in both identifying the right solvent and its application. Read up on refinishing and talk to other collectors about their experiences before attempting this on a valuable acquisition. The net result on the value of radios so 'refinished' is a reduction by about twenty-five percent. A note of caution: be certain that the slopped on coat is not polyurethane. If it is, you're back to square one and must remove all finishes.

RESOURCES

As the hobby of vintage radio collecting has evolved over time, so have the resources for collectors. There are regional, national and international clubs. Cottage industries have sprung up offering a wide range of products and services. There are club newsletters, bulletins, references books and a monthly periodical on the subject. The following pages serve to provide the novice with some basic resources. This is, by far, not a comprehensive listing of all resources available. Any ommissions are not purposeful and do not reflect in any way on the individuals or organizations omitted.

VINTAGE RADIO CLUBS:

By far the best part of the hobby is meeting and spending time with other collectors. Club meets provide a forum for exchange of information, purchase of material and new radio acquisitions among other things.
