HUEY LEWIS - NO OVERNIGHT SENSATION


Chrysalis recording artist Huey Lewis and his back-up group, The News, are currently receiving tremendous chart action with their latest single, The Power Of Love. The single was taken from the MCA Soundtrack, Back To The Future, and after only 8 weeks of charting, topped the RPM 100 singles chart (Aug. 24). Lewis is one of those rare talents from the '70s to have hung in and successfully bridged the gap between CHR, AOR and A/C radio. His current direction in writing and producing would indicate his determination to maintain this status.

Contrary to what some might believe, Huey Lewis is not "an overnight" sensation. It was several years ago when he spent a great deal of time backpacking around Europe - with his only instrumental at that time - a mouth harp. When he returned home to Marin County in California he joined The Clovers, a country-rock group. He returned to England, with the group, in the late '70s and lucked out by backing Elvis Costello's first album, My Aim Is True. Unfortunately the band ran out of luck and Lewis returned to the U.S. and the San Francisco Bay area. It was here where he got together with the nucleus of The News: ex-Clover keyboardist, Sean Hopper; guitarist Chris Hayes, who now plays a major part in the writing for the group; and 3 members of Soundhole, another Bay area band, Johnny Colla (guitar & sax), Mario Cipollina (bass), and Bill Gibson (drums).

As Huey Lewis & The News, they released their self-titled debut LP in 1980. Described as "an assemblage of bluesy, good-time rock tunes", the album turned out to be a "critic's favourite". Although an abundance of chart action failed to follow, 2 tracks, Some Of My Lies Are True (Sooner Or Later) and Who Cares, received heavy airplay.

Picture This was the band's 2nd LP release, and with the experience, and a much smoother production, as it turned out this album surpassed the success of the first. The album netted 3 Top 40 singles: Do You

Believe In Love, Hope You Love Me Like You Say You Do, and Workin' For A Livin', which became an AOR sampler.



With the release of Sports, their 3rd LP, and with a powerful network of MCA promotion people behind the release, Huey Lewis & The News did, in fact, become "big news" across both Canada and the U.S. The album cracked the RPM 100 with a bullet on Dec. 10, 1983. The album netted 5 singles, 2 of them of which gained gold status: Heart Of Rock & Roll, and I Want A New Drug. The album remained on the RPM 100 for an incredible 77 weeks. "The Sports LP was the

New soundtracks shipped by MCA

MCA Canada, which has enjoyed much of its success this year on the strength of album soundtracks, has just issued 2 more: Secret Admirer on MCA, and Explorers on the Island label.

No Secrets, performed by Van Stephenson, has been taken as the first single from Secret Admirer. Other tracks on the LP include Kim Wilde's The Touch, She's Got A Part Of Me by Don Felder, and Nik Kershaw's You Might.

The Robert Palmer track, All Around The World, has been issued as a single from the Explorers soundtrack. A Red 7 track of Less Than Perfect is included on this set.

MCA recently issued the soundtrack from the motion picture Fletch, which stars Chevy Chase. The theme song, Bit By Bit, performed by Stephanie Mills, was culled as a single. Other tracks include Is It Over by Kim

Wilde, A Letter To Both Sides by The Fixx and Name Of The Game by Dan Hartman.

These soundtracks join the other MCA soundtracks, currently on the RPM 100 Albums chart, Beverly Hills Cop and Back To The Future.

Beverly Hills Cop, from which several singles were taken, has now been on the RPM chart for over 30 weeks. The LP is well over the double platinum mark in Canada.

Back To The Future, bulleting up the chart on the strength of the single. The Power Of Love from Huey Lewis & The News (which hit No.1 on the RPM 100 singles chart the week of Aug.24), is on its way to platinum in Canada.

OAC firms dates for Contact Ontario

The Ontario Arts Council (OAC) will once again host Contact Ontario, considered one of Canada's largest cultural trade fairs. The setting will be Toronto's Constellation Hotel from Oct.17 through 20. First presented in 1971, Contact is funded and orchestrated by the Ontario Officer: "Contact provides a showcase for touring artists of dance, music and theatre, as well as a marketplace for those artists to link up with potential buyers of touring performances." She continues "Contact was developed specifically as a marketing tool in response to community needs and growing professional talent in Ontario," concluding with "Through recent surveys, the Ontario office has determined that a majority of the more than 300 provincial sponsors who attend Contact select approximately 68 percent of their artists as a result of seeing them showcase."

This year, it expected there will be close to 700 performing artists and sponsors from over 300 communities across Ontario as well as from other provinces and foreign countries. These will include Valdy, who is doing extremely well with his Duke Street single, Sonny's Dream, John Allan Cameron, one of the leaders in contemporary folk music, as well as country songwriter/performers Garnet Rogers, Chris Rawlings and Nancy White, a pop recording artist who has had much success with her theatre and cabaret performances.

Dave Dargie killed in auto accident

Dave Dargie, Director, CBS Western Region, was killed in a traffic accident while enroute to his cottage. The accident happened just outside of Calgary at approximately 10:30, the morning of Aug. 21.

Police report that Mr. Dargie, who was on vacation, was returning from the grocery store when his car was in collision with a cattle truck.

The 32 year old Mr. Dargie has been with CBS since 1976, the last 3 years as Director of the Western Region. He is survived by his wife Barbara.

Funeral arrangements have yet to be announced.

Nod to CHUM Group for Stirling Stations

The CHUM Group adds 4 radio stations to its empire with the go-ahead by the CRTC to purchase the powerful AM/FM duo of Montreal's CKGM and CHOM-FM and Windsor's CKWW and CJOM-FM, which were part of Geoff Stirling's Maisseuneuve organization.

This purchase will make CHUM the most powerful broadcaster in the world. The CHUM Group already owns 13 radio stations and 6 TV stations, as well as the MuchMusic Network and the Atlantic Satellite Network plus radio systems in Alberta and Newfoundland.

With the purchase of the new stations comes conditions whereby CHUM must contribute to French-Language record production, with an initial contribution of \$50,000 this year, \$25,000 for next year and \$50,000 for each of the 3 years to follow.

Trebas expands to Hollywood

David Leonard, Executive Director and founder of the Trebas Institute of Recording Arts, has informed RPM that he "plans to set up a campus for Trebas, in Hollywood." The reason being that "there is not a single institution teaching a comprehensive program in the Recording Arts and Sciences in Los Angeles...at least not until now," says Leonard.

Since its inception in 1979 Trebas has opened campuses in Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal and Vancouver, attracting students from across Canada and the U.S. as well as Europe, providing professional training and education in the music business. According to Leonard, Trebas offers courses in: "Record Producing, Audio Engineering, Music Industry Management and even Music Video Production; none of the dozen or so colleges and universities in the U.S.A. that do offer Music Business and Recording Programs have these."

Trebas traditionally invites special speakers, among those planning to visit the new Hollywood campus are: Bones Howe, Bob Monaco and George Martin. They will be part of a seminar on the future of music in the industry.

The climb to No. 1 is a long, hard haul - Monaco

Topping charts throughout the world, Bryan Adams is without a doubt the most successful of today's breed of young performers - but that success wasn't instantaneous. There are obviously a lot of ingredients involved: people, time and money. What's the key, the motivation behind a success story like that of Bryan Adams? RPM spoke with Jim Monaco, Director of Publicity for A&M Records, Canada to see if there indeed was a key - one factor, something that perhaps others can emulate in order to achieve what Adams has.

"We've been working Bryan now for 7 years, successfully every step of the way,"

door-opener for Huey Lewis & The News," noted Stephen Tennant, Product Manager (Canada) for Chrysalis Records. "The popularity of the group just steam-rolled across the country, with exceptional support from both AOR and CHR programmers. We've now scored an almost unbelievable 8 times platinum (800,000 units sold) and the album continues to sell."

Tennant, of course, isn't the only one who feels good about the Sports LP. "We feel great about Sports," says Lewis. "It was the first record of ours where the minute I heard it, I knew we had it. This one's like our other's only better. It's like all our records - I hope - in the sense that it's honest and original. It's just us. We've always managed to have a self contained outfit. We produce our own records, do covers our way, help direct our own videos . . . and it seems to be working."

Lewis was asked how they settled on Sports as the title of their album. "I guess the best way to explain it," replies Lewis, "is our band is like a team - we're tight like that. Before we were a band we were all friends, and I think that's what's important in what sets us apart. Hopefully, Sports will get that across to the people." With 800,000 albums sold in Canada, obviously the message has been received.

Probably the biggest break for Huey Lewis & The News was their performing The Power Of Love for the movie soundtrack, Back To The Future. Taken as a single, The Power Of Love entered the RPM 100 singles chart at No.69 with a bullet (June 29/85) and only 9 weeks later (Aug.24/85) topped the chart. Back In Time, another Lewis track on the soundtrack is being released as a 12" single for radio only, at time of writing. The thinking might change however, if radio takes to this release which would force the release of a 7". In the meantime Back To The Future has soared past gold status and is now moving close to platinum.

Lewis & The News have just completed a mini-tour of North America and will be heading for the studios with an expected January release for their next album. So, there was more than a little good news for Huey Lewis & The News last year, which sets the scene for an even bigger year to follow. By the way - a little trivia - Huey Lewis was born Hugh Cregg III, 33 years ago in New York City.

says Monaco. "Bryan has matured as an artist and a songwriter, but the reason for his success? The quality of his product and the amount of dates that he has played over all these years. He's played an amazing number of live performances - he has committed himself to his career - and we have committed ourselves to his career. The climb to No. 1 has been a long, hard haul."

Monaco was asked that with Adams topping the U.S. charts would this create a renewed interest here at home (his Reckless LP is currently No. 7 on the RPM 100, but it did top the chart Feb. 23 last). "Naturally, if you sell records in America it's going to influence programmers here. However, I do believe with Bryan we've reached a certain point where there's an irreversible effect in motion here now." Monaco explains further. "Bryan has sold over 2 million albums in America - he's reached No. 1 and now you'll see sales continue to increase, naturally. Here, our sales are phenomenal - over 600,000 albums in under a year, which will, very shortly, be the largest selling domestic album by a solo artist ever. This surpasses Anne Murray's Greatest Hits album which now holds that record. But with Bryan Adams you're not looking at a phenomenon, you're looking at career results."

Monaco elaborated on success: "Success is a progression - a process - and there is no denying that Bryan is a prolific songwriter -all the elements are there; the hard work, faith and commitment." Monaco believes

that the devotion of the artist is equally, if not the most important aspect or ingredient to success. "Picture the success of this record in terms of the release date and where it stands now," explains Monaco. "We worked his first record the same way. We don't give up after 3 weeks or 3 months. I don't think Bryan's been overhyped. They've been very careful about the publicity they've been doing, but the key is the touring."

Here then, is the key, as Monaco says: "Bryan's opened up a lot of doors for us . . . he's gotten himself out there in front of people and let the people decide. In early '86 Bryan will blow everyone away with his new album. He's going to slay people. I think he's got it in him - he's definitely growing - he hasn't changed, but he is growing."

Monaco says he was relieved that critics hadn't termed Adams rise in stature as a "new Canadian invasion", because, in his words, "It's been in the grooves. Now, we have a different kind of star machinery. We have a different kind of star - the star really does have to shine on the whole world."

Adams is currently still on tour in the mid-Western U.S. and will be returning to Canada to play his hometown of Vancouver on Sept. 1, then possibly touring Eastern Canada late September, with dates already pencilled in for Ottawa, Montreal and Toronto.

We don't have to see all the acts, or write about all the movies that have soundtracks on our charts, but it's nice not to live in a void, and it gives the promo people a chance to express their appreciation for the mileage they often plead for. When they get ink, they like it. When they help us do our job . . . we like it. Thanks again to those two fine PR people.

Some retailers do . . . !!!

I quite often receive letters from disgruntled dealers complaining about the "dogs" they're supposed to sell which eventually becomes "dead stock". Some of these "dogs" have turned out to be big sales winners. Recently I have been taking a close look at retail stores in and around the Toronto area. The attitude of most of the clerks is pretty bad. Ask where a certain record might be - a finger or a nod of the head seems to be the only method

Cancon big in Europe . . . !!!

There was a time, not too long ago, when Cancon was unknown in Europe and much of this problem was because of the short-sighted attitude we had about this very big market. We preferred to channel all our energies south to the U.S. Well, times have changed . . . so much so, that many international hits are being broken in Canada before the U.S. can get a handle on them. The best news however, is that Cancon releases are breaking much easier in Europe now . . . and even before there's any interest from the U.S. Attic's Al Mair recently received 2 charts from 2 Munich radio stations. Of the 49 records on the charts, 7, which represents 14%, are Cancon. "Even more interesting," says Al, "is the fact that these aren't only Cancon records that broke in the U.S., but they include Canadian artists such as Belinda Metz, Eddie Schwartz and Paul Janz, who haven't yet had U.S. success."

Not too long ago . . . !!!

Five or six years ago, RPM invited John Hammond Sr. of CBS to address one of our Communication Meetings. At that time, many of our registrants had a chance to meet this great man. He is currently in the news as the one who discovered Bruce Springsteen. Those were the good old days and those meetings were very useful.

Rivoli is setting for ATV showcase

Having successfully introduced the Toronto band Wildlife to the music industry with the airing of the Holy Man video on MuchMusic ATV Michael McCarty informs RPM that "there is a market for the band, we're proving it - they're going to be nationally known before they have a record deal."

At MuchMusic, J.D. Roberts says, "Every once in a while we get a demo tape sent in from an independent that far surpasses the LP video masters we receive." The video is now playing on full rotation.

McCarty, who is the Creative Manager at ATV - which has been sold to the Michael Jackson group, explains the reaction to the group, "it's part of the psychedelic revival, people are reacting to attitude, commitment, conviction and energy not slickness." ATV is planning to showcase Wildlife, (Aug.29), at Toronto's Rivoli.

Artists can complain . . . !!!

For years, recording artists have complained about the stigma of legislated (forced) airplay. Now, they will have the opportunity to talk to the people who can do something about it. The Task Force on Broadcasting Policy is holding public meetings across Canada and here's one of the questions: "Is government regulation necessary to ensure Canadian programming in our broadcasting system?" Artists can now get rid of the 30% Canadian content legislation, once and for all. The Toronto meeting is scheduled for Monday Sept. 16 at 7 pm. The Beatles Live, also recorded at Ready Steady Go studios, includes their most classical material, as well as Chuck Berry's Roll Over Beethoven and the Isley Brothers Shout. The 20 min. reel contains comments from Paul McCartney and John Lennon.



I'm Falling, the first single of ComSat Angels' 7 Day Weekend LP is on your desk now. We're getting terrific response from alternative and campus radio, and most importantly, retail, on this track. A video will be available within the next 3 weeks.



CHAM power increase spreads country message

CHAM Radio in Hamilton, Ont. became the largest country station in Canada on Aug. 18 when it increased its power from 10,000 to 50,000 watts. The station also moved to 820 from 1280 on the dial. CHAM now reaches the largest populated area in Canada.

On the occasion of the expansion,



Hamilton's Mayor, Bob Morrow, and CHAM's Cliff Dumas, have just completed turning the giant radio dial from 1280 to 820 - during Gage Park blow-out.

CHAM hosted a country concert featuring many of the top names in Cancon country. These included The Stoker Brothers, Terry Sumsion, The Mercey Brothers and Kelita Haverland. The concert, sponsored jointly by CHAM and the city of Hamilton, took place in downtown Gage Park, drawing more than 10,000 country fans. At exactly 8:20 pm when the power increase went into effect, the dial on a giant radio was moved to 820 which signalled the release of 820 helium filled balloons and a fireworks display.

Country music has increased in popularity over the last few years as evidenced by the opening of country music bars throughout South Central Ontario. These included the Yellow Rose in Cambridge as well as the Yorktown Country Palace in the city of North York. CHAM's Joy Williams reports there are 50 bars featuring live country music in the county of Hamilton - Wentworth alone plus more than 20 country taverns in Toronto. Says Williams: "There are several factors contributing to the rise in popularity in country music including; the recent number of cross-over artists such as Tom Jones and Neil Young; this fall's fashions, which are designed with a distinctive country look; the popularity of 'upscale' consumer magazines

such as Harrowsmith; the sales of pine furniture; handmade quilts and folk art; and the interest in farm and dude ranch vacations."

CHAM has also been one of the leaders in major country stations giving top exposure and chart listings to Cancon product. Their most recent Weekly Country Survey gives chart berths to Marie Bottrell's Premeditated Love, Kelita Haverland's I'm So In Love, and Karen McCalls Rebel Getaway. Their adds for this week give a boost Carroll Baker's latest single release Can't Stand The Heat and Roni Sommers Yours Alone. CHAM also integrates Cancon product on their survey rather than relegating these additions to a separate list as do so many country stations - a factor that has been of major concern to some members of the CRTCC.


