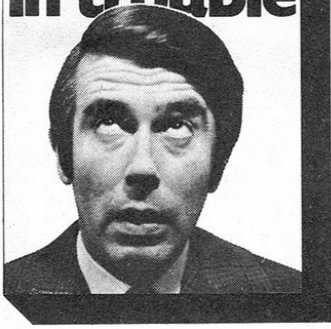

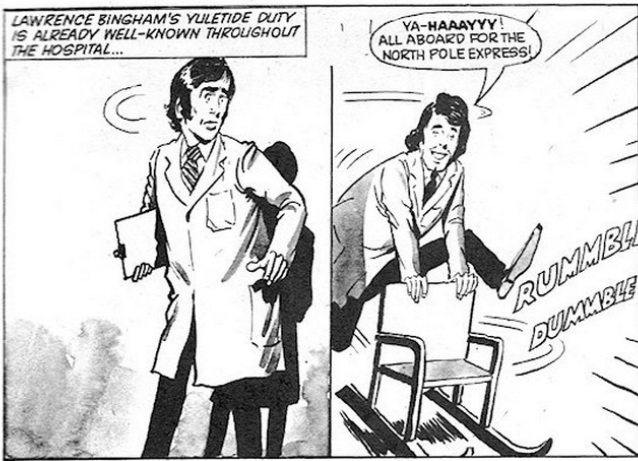

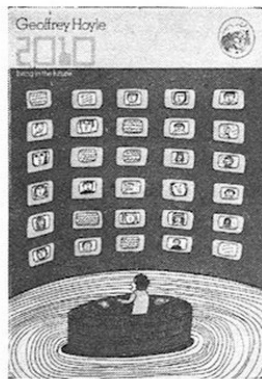

BOOKSHELF



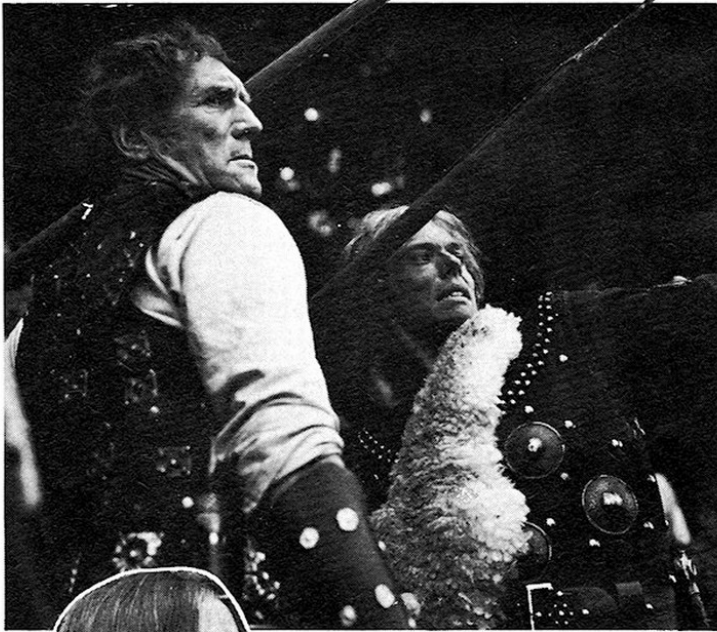
Have you ever wondered what it'll be like to live in the future?

There's a lovely little book on sale now called '2010' by Geoffrey Hoyle. Together with some funny drawings, he writes about what he thinks life will be like in that year. Some of his ideas could be right, too.

Actually, '2010' is just one book in a new series called Heinemann's 'Green Grass' Books which you should ask to see next time you're in the bookshop.

As the story opens, we see the Celtic chiefs struggling, one by one, to move a great boulder. Beneath it lies a sword, and great honour awaits the first man to lift that sword above his head. But all the chiefs fail—and then the young warrior called Arthur steps forward. He shows them how to move the boulder by pushing together—but as the surprised men recover from their effort, they realize that Arthur has snatched up the sword and now holds it aloft.

Arthur has established his right to become war-leader of the Celts. At the same time, he has taught his men two important lessons. First, that unity is strength. And second, that victory goes to the man who thinks and plans rather than to the strongest.

Dream of a united Britain

But although Arthur becomes the leader of Celtic resistance to the Saxon invaders of Britain, he needs all his wisdom and bravery to keep his place. His men are only too ready to fight among themselves. And of his two lieutenants, only the veteran warrior Llud is completely reliable. The other, Kai, is part-Saxon, a violent and head-strong young man who sometimes sees Arthur's careful planning as a sign of weakness. But with these men, Arthur strives to bring about his dream of a united Britain.

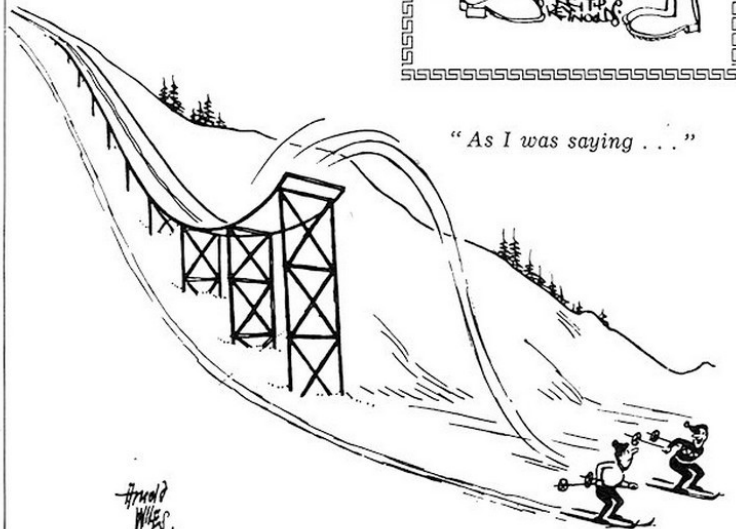
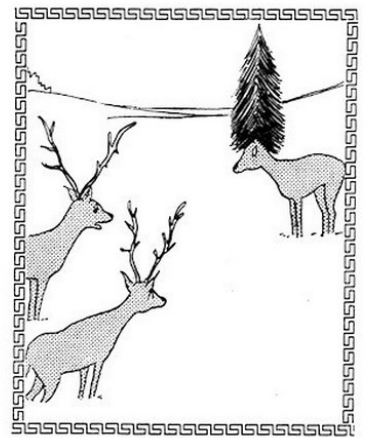
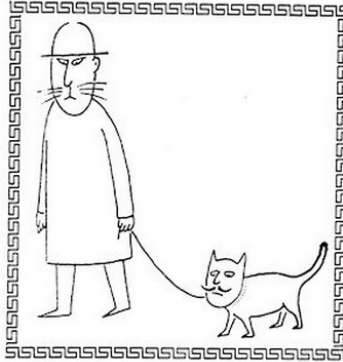
"Arthur of the Britons" is based on what historians, rather than imaginative writers, can tell us about Arthur. In fact, we know very little. But what we do know is that a man called Arthur once existed, and that his deeds were so great that he was to be remembered for centuries as a mighty leader. From about A.D. 1200 onward, when the stories of Arthur were first written down, the legends of 'King Arthur' took on the colourful form in which we read them today.

It is these legends, no more true than fairy-tales, that HTV's "Arthur of the Britons" strips away—to show us the real man who lies behind them.

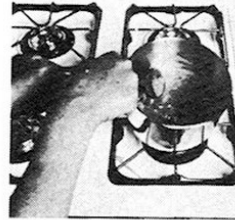


Hello, Kathie Webber, Cookery Editor of TVTimes here. Sauces play an important part in cooking. They serve to bring out the full flavour of food. Here is a basic recipe for Brown Sauce with some hints on how you can add ingredients to vary the taste.

BROWN SAUCE



1oz. dripping
1 oz. plain flour
1/2 pint brown stock made up from 1 beef stock cube and 1/2 pint boiling water
Salt and pepper.



1. Melt the dripping in a saucepan then stir in the flour using a wooden spoon. Turn down the gas to the very lowest heat and let the flour and dripping mixture cook for 15-20 minutes or until it is a rich brown colour. Don't let it burn.

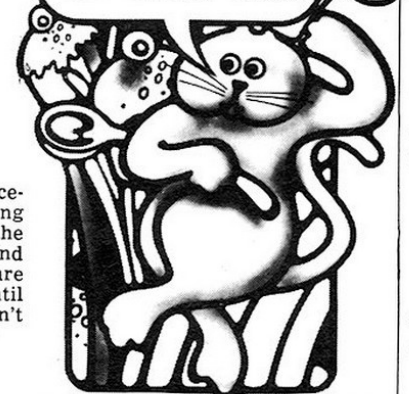


2. Remove the pan from the heat and gradually add the brown stock, stirring all the time. Return the pan to the heat and bring the mixture to the boil, stirring all the time. Turn down the heat and simmer for two minutes. Season with salt and pepper.



3. The finished sauce garnished with a few lightly fried mushroom slices. You can vary this sauce by adding 2 level tablespoons lightly cooked sliced mushrooms or the same amount of chopped, cooked onions to the stock.

Blending To blend also means to mix but this term is used mainly about mixing cornflour with milk or water to make a sauce or to be used as a thickening.
Creaming Butter and sugar are creamed for making a cake. This means to beat the butter and sugar well together with a wooden spoon until they have mixed to form a pale coloured creamy substance.

Tip of the week

It is a common failing, when heading the ball, for a player to let the ball hit his head rather than for his head to hit the ball. Because of this, the ball will frequently fly off the head in a totally unwanted direction.

To be certain of hitting the ball fairly and squarely with the centre of the forehead (and that's the only part of the head which should come into contact with the ball if you want power and direction), try to "throw" your eyes at the ball at the moment of contact.

It has up to six on either side of the front of its head, Lesley. They look like bits of rather dull glass.

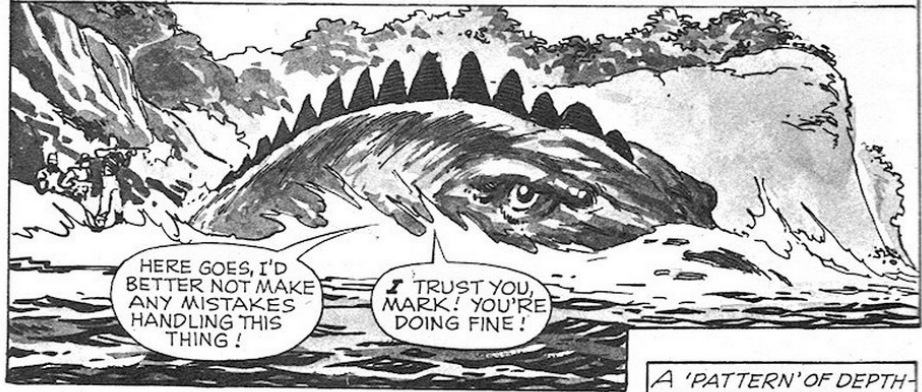

An Armour-Plated God

Maybe you've been to the magnificent 'Tutankhamun' Exhibition at the British Museum, London. Even if you haven't, you've almost certainly seen pictures of the gold mask of the young Pharaoh and other treasures found in his tomb. Have you noticed that many of these treasures bear pictures of a very ordinary-looking beetle?

The scarab beetle, of which the ancient Egyptians thought so highly, is

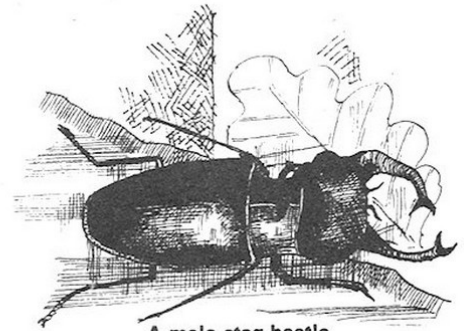
one of some 20,000 species of the family *Scarabaeidae*, distributed throughout the world. *Scarabaeus sacer*, the sacred scarab, was thought by the Egyptians to be a symbol of eternal life, for they believed that all scarabs were male. So the scarab became a sort of insect god, carved on tombs and on jewels worn as amulets, or 'good-luck charms'.

Among over 300,000 different species of beetles so far known to science are 3,000 or so species of British beetles. Of these, the largest is the stag beetle. Like other beetles the stag beetle is heavily 'armoured'. Most insects have four wings, but in the beetles the front pair of wings are hard and thick, folding down over the insect's back to form a protective cover for the delicate hind-wings, which can only be seen when the beetle is in flight. This feature gives beetles their scientific name of *Coleoptera*, or "sheath-winged".

Although the stag beetle may grow to a length of around three inches, with huge lobster-like "antlers", or claws, about one-third the length of its body, it is quite harmless. In fact its claws are mainly used to impress the female

during courtship. The stag beetle lays its eggs in the vegetable compost at the foot of trees or plants, and the developing beetle spends about *five years* in the larval stage and another year in its chrysalis.

Stag beetles are very rare and the species needs conservation, so under no circumstances destroy or harm one.

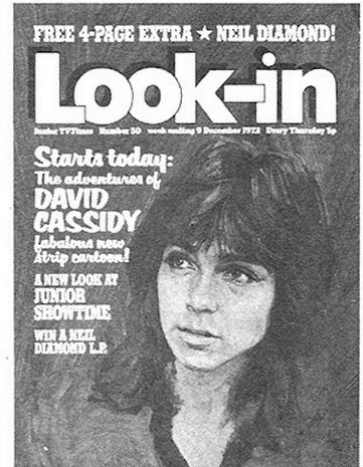
Among the worst of the beetles found in Britain are the Colorado beetle, which does immense damage to potato crops, and the 'oil beetle'. The latter is a really worthless character: in the larval stage it climbs into a plant and waits for a bee to come along. While the bee collects nectar and pollen, the larva climbs on to its back and is carried back to the hive. There it grows to maturity among unlimited food supplies, making a general nuisance of itself to the hard-working bees. No beekeeper is ever likely to make a 'good-luck charm' out of the 'oil beetle'.
