Branson unveils Virgin MDs plan

Jon Webster is to spearhead Virgin's international operations, with Paul Conroy taking over as UK managing director.

The new role of managing director Virgin International puts Webster in charge of all Virgin Records' operations outside the UK and US.

Webster has been acting head of international at Virgin Records UK since Chris Griffin left earlier this year.

When Virgin decided to reamp its international structure, Webster accepted the role. He will report to Virgin Music Group managing director Ken Berry.

Meanwhile, Paul Conroy is set to join Virgin as UK MD

—as soon as he can resolve his Chrysalis contract with parent company EMI.

Conroy, who joined Chrysalis as international president in 1989, still has six months left on the contract and is cur-

rently in discussion with EMI to decide when he can leave.

He began talking to Virgin about the move six months ago, well before Chris Wright sold the remaining 50% stake in Chrysalis Records to EMI.

"It's a much bigger company and I guess the time was right for the move," says Conroy, who is already drawing up his priorities for the new job.

"Virgin was one of the leading lights but now it needs to

Lauder quits Silvertone

Andrew Lauder has quit Silvertone after policy disagreements with parent company Zomba.

Lauder's departure, predicted in *MW* three weeks ago, comes three years after he set up the record company which went on to have hit albums with The Stone Roses and John Lee Hooker.

Lauder declines to comment on the reasons for his departure but is believed to be discussing future plans with major labels.

Zomba Group MD John Fruin says Lauder is leaving to pursue "other interests".

"The parting was amicable and caused by policy differences which (the two parties were) unable to resolve.

Double boost for retail sales

Strong product and a run of four strong shopping days leading up to Christmas helped maximise the seasonal surge in sales.

A weekend boosted by Sunday shopping followed by Christmas Day on a Wednesday created a "double weekend" effect at the busiest time of the year.

Gallup figures showed trade remaining high in the week before Christmas, with albums up 7% on the same week last year and singles up by 8%.

Music video was down by 1%. The week before Christmas, HMV reported a 50% increase

on the previous week, while Woolworth wholesaler Entertainment UK also reported a 35% week-on-week rise.

But HMV operations director Steve Knott says the increase was more of a sign of the weakness of previous weeks.

Indie retailer Bob Barnes, of Midlands chain Music Junction, says: "It was an excellent weekend, but it's all come extremely late."

The only disappointing reports came from indie retailers in secondary sites, and stores in Liverpool, Manchester and Leeds hit by bad weather.

Atlantic shuts London office

Atlantic Records is to close its London international office, ending a 20-year presence in the UK.

All five staff will lose their jobs when the office closes on January 31. UK promotion and distribution of the US company's product will continue to go through East West.

Atlantic vice president International Fran Lichtmar says the move will not diminish the global presence of the

company, explaining it simply as a "streamlining" exercise.

"The decision is a logical step in the restructuring of Warner Music International, and in particular the establishment of East West Records in the UK and Europe," she says.

The UK office was the base of European marketing and publicity manager Mary Houston who has been made redundant after 17 years.

Phillips on Mini-Disc mission

Sony has drafted in one of its top record marketing men in an effort to rally software support for the delayed launch of Mini-Disc.

Alan Phillips' appointment as vice president sound technology marketing Sony Software UK/Europe comes just six months after he took the job as international marketing director at Columbia.

His brief is to persuade the music industry of Mini-Disc's

merits, but he admits that he is starting from scratch.

"There are no concrete commitments yet," he says.

The format's rival, Philips' DCC, already has firm commitments to software development from all major companies, including Sony.

"People are not going to commit to anything until they have evaluated it," says Phillips. "My job is to show them that Mini-Disc is the future by

talking to everyone from record companies to retailers." The task begins at Midem this month.

Phillips hopes to see several hundred titles available in time for the launch — now planned for early 1993. It had originally been scheduled for late 1992.

"Obviously there are problems to be addressed," he says. "I have just started and it will take time."

But were there any truly great albums released? I can think of candidates (Massive Attack, for one), but few real definites. The reason is fairly clear, rock and guitar culture remain in the doldrums. And the dominant genre, dance, is clearly not singles.

There were undoubtedly some truly great ones.

ZTT star takes another Brits nomination

Seal has picked up a fourth Brit Award nomination — for best promo.

The ZTT artist's promo for Killer will go for final selection by viewers of BBC1's Going Live on February 8.

Around 20 BPI members turned up for the pre-selection meeting at a London preview theatre out of the 140 eligible to vote. They whittled down the original 20 nominees to 10.

The final list of nominations for the award is: Funny How Airhead, WEA; Sexuality, Billy Bragg, Go/Discs; Love To Hate You, Erasure, Mute; Last Train To Transcentral, KLF, KLF Comm.; Change, Lisa Stansfield, Arista; Cold Cold Heart, Midge Ure, Arista; Killer, Seal, ZTT; Goodbye Cruel World, Shakespear's Sister, London; Stars, Simply Red, East West; and Size Of A Cow, The Wonderstuff, Polydor.

Prince to pay Blenheim bill

Prince is footing the £450,000 bill to reimburse an estimated 20,000 fans who lost out when his concert at Blenheim Palace in August was cancelled.

Ticket-holders who haven't received any money back from their agents or promoter Diamond Promotions will have six weeks to exchange them for any of more than 50 dates in Europe this summer.

Details of 11 UK dates in June, promoted by Barry Clayton Concerts, will be announced this month.

Prince's assistant Jill Willis says: "There are only about 250 tickets we can't account for out of almost 20,000."

Cash refunds are not being offered but Clayman stresses Prince has no legal obligation to recompense fans. A £316,000 deposit paid by Diamond was used up preparing for the planned one-off spectacular.

Emap pips Virgin for control of Kiss

Emap Radio has won a battle for power with Virgin Broadcasting to take control of London incremental Kiss FM.

Emap has doubled its share in the dance station by buying into Virgin, to become the majority shareholder with a 59% stake.

The two companies had been the station's biggest shareholders with equal 29.5% stakes since its launch in September 1990.

The news follows weeks of

speculation that Virgin Broadcasting is to be disbanded, after it was absorbed within Virgin Communications in November.

The broadcasting arm's managing director Charles Levison resigned soon after the company failed to pass the ITC's quality threshold with any of its TV franchise bids.

Virgin Broadcasting will remain under the control of the communications arm's chairman, Robert Devereux.

Classical sales slip


The growth of the classical sector may have peaked with BPI figures set to show the first annual fall since surveys began nine years ago.

But the downturn was expected after 1990's exceptional sales.

BPI shipment figures for 1991's third quarter show a 18.7% fall in units compared with July to September 1990, and a 16.2% drop in value.

And trade deliveries for the year to September 1991 dip below the 1990 total, with unit sales of 15.96m compared with 16.69m in the previous year.

QUEEN'S CROWNING GLORY

Queen's double-sided chart-topper 'Bohemian Rhapsody/These Are The Days Of Our Lives' sold more copies in its first week in record shops than any other single in any other seven-day period since **Band Aid's** 'Do They Know It's Christmas?' in 1984. 'Bohemian Rhapsody/These Are The Days Of Our Lives' has continued to sell at a phenomenal rate, and is close to

becoming only the third single in Britain ever to sell 2 million copies.

The first to reach that figure was **Paul McCartney** and **Wings'** 'Mull Of Kintyre/Girls' School' in 1977, and the second was the aforementioned **Band Aid** hit 'Do They Know It's Christmas?'.

The success of the Queen single means that EMI have managed to hold onto the coveted number one spot on four of the last five Christmases, missing out only in 1989, when **Band Aid II** took the honours for **Polydor/PWL**.

Meanwhile, although 'I'll Be Home For Christmas' wasn't one of his more successful singles, it did check into the chart for a few weeks at the end of last year to maintain **Shakin' Stevens'** proud record of having had a hit every year since 1960.

Cliff Richard's seasonal song 'We Should Be Together' was rather more popular, earning him the distinction of becoming the first artist to accumulate 60 Top 10 hits.

Canny Cliff has been in the Christmas Top 10 in 16 different years now, beating the former record of 15 which was established by the late **Elvis Presley**.

● 'Black And White', the first single lifted from **Michael Jackson's** album 'Dangerous' must be judged a success. Thus far it has topped the chart in more than a dozen countries, and is still heading towards the summit in several others. It showed a particularly fine sense of timing in Australia, where it moved to the top of the chart on the nineteenth anniversary of Jackson's first number one hit with 'Ben'.



● Tina Turner's 'Simply The Best' compilation was one of the most outstanding successes of 1991. Although it has to be satisfied with a number two peak, it sold about 900,000 copies in the final three months of the year, and has yet to dip out of the Top 10 artist album chart. Yet in her native America, where compilations are looked on less

favourably, its chart life appears to be almost without it breaching the Top 100. Despite the inclusion of otherwise unavailable material, it peaked at number 113 Stateside. The fact is Tina is much hotter here than in America. Her last studio album 'Foreign Affair' only managed to reach number 31 there, but topped the chart here.

● A total of 43 singles entered the chart inside the Top 10 last year, a record which easily beats the previous highest tally of 30 in 1989. The total of six singles that debuted at number one and the 20 that debuted in the top five were also unprecedented. And yet — largely because **Bryan Adams** hogged the top spot for so long — the total of 17 singles that reached number one was the lowest since 1984. Conversely, 25 titles took a turn at the top of the album chart, equalling the record high set in 1989. In America, the singles turnover (27 number ones) far outstripped album activity (14).

● It was the year's biggest-selling single in Britain, America and in numerous other countries, but it's nice to know that **Bryan Adams'** ('Everything I Do) I Do It For You' didn't top the Belgians at least bucking the trend by making it only their number two hit of the year, behind **Enigma's** 'Sad(e)ness'. **Enigma** completed a notable double by topping the annual Belgian album listings via their 'MCMXC A.D.' offering. The top-ranked locally-produced single was **LA Style's** 'James Brown Is Dead', which finished the year in fourth place. In all, some 19 Belgian records were among the Top 50, a creditable performance.





Kenyatta

Self-taught musician and soulman Kenyatta is very much a part of LA-based Delicious Vinyl's new order. The label, best known for a hip-hop roster which includes Tone Loc, Young MC and Def Jef, has recently begun venturing into the territory of contemporary r&b, 'Love Again' being its latest soul release.

"I knew from a very early age that I was destined to write music and perform it on stage," recalls Kenyatta, born in Washington DC as Keith Poole. His migration from the North Carolina of his youth to Los Angeles was the turning point.



'Love Again' is released by Island on January 20.

After becoming a regular on the LA club scene, Kenyatta learnt how to play keyboards and drums and write music "in the tradition of my favourite influences: Funkadelic, Slave, Chic...".

Though the original 'Love Again' betrays those funky influences, the Joey Negro mix is the one which shines out. Like some late Seventies rollerskate soundtrack, the mix is pure disco — handclaps, racing hi-hat, synth tom-toms and all. Delicious stuff indeed.

Marathon

Marathon are based in Berlin and formed from the remains of the experimental group Palais Schaumborg. However, there is little evidence of these two facts on their new single, 'Movin', which has been remixed by Dave 'Joey Negro' Lee. With its remix strongly influenced by Steve 'Silk' Hurley's recent work and with its lyrics borrowed from Cuba Gooding/The Main Ingredient's 'Happiness Is Just Around The Bend', it sounds more American than 'The Star Spangled Banner' and is about as experimental as a Status Quo record.

Marathon's mainman, Moritz von Oswald says he finds the remixes "a little bit too soft", but they are certainly having the desired effect in the UK. Besides, in addition to Lee's four garage/house mixes, there are four much tougher versions on the flipside. These include Thomas Fehlman's acidic techno mix and Youth's popular guitar-driven rave mix.

Lee readily admits his house remix is heavily influenced by Hurley: "I did the piano track and it sounded like him, so I decided to go the whole hog," he confesses. "He gets \$20,000 a time, so I thought it would be funny if I could achieve the same sound. Hopefully people will see it as a bit of a joke."

Von Oswald says Marathon's aim is "to make music that can be played in a wide range of clubs," something which the eight mixes of 'Movin' should definitely achieve. **Andy Beever**s
