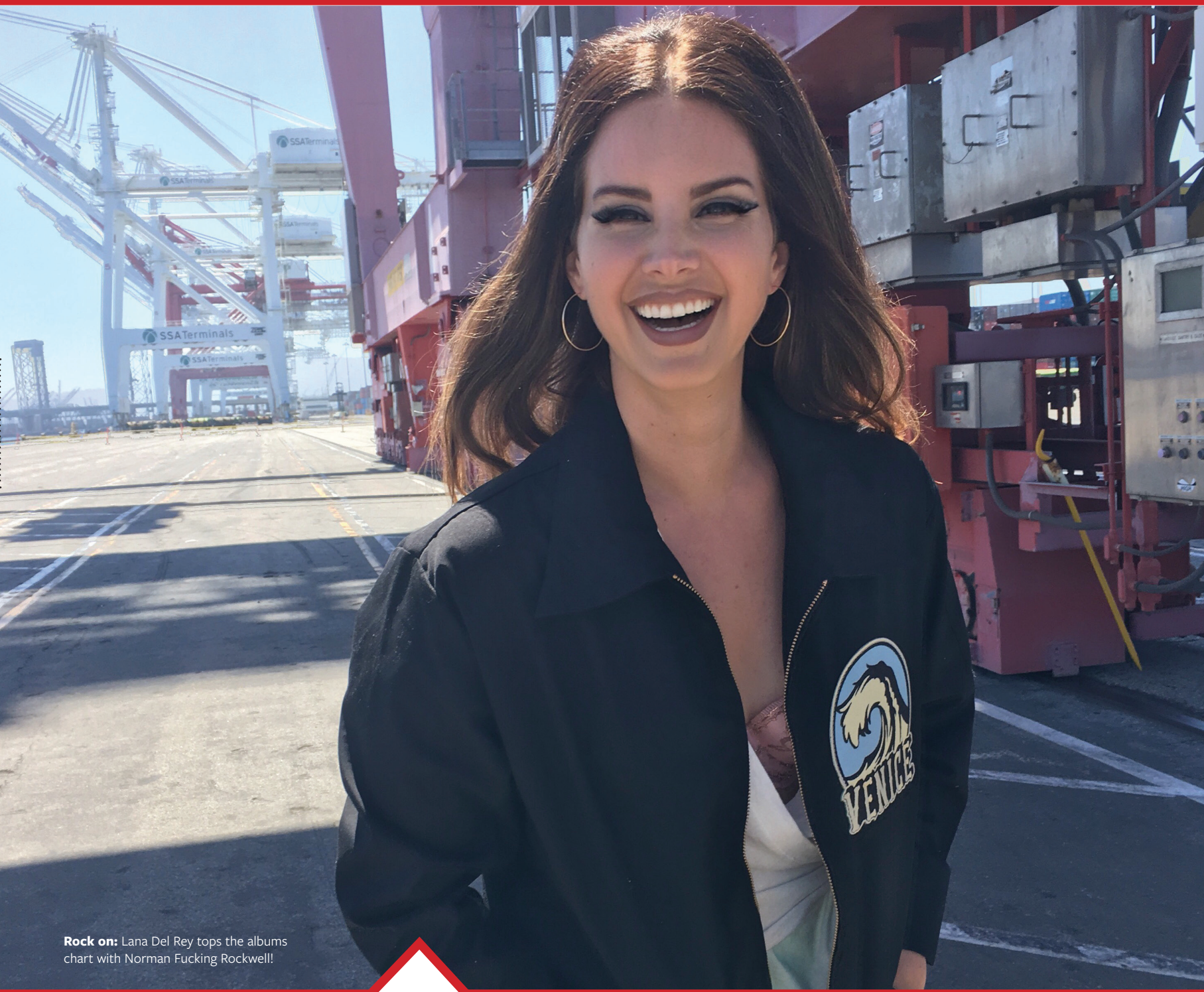

Take that: Ed Sheeran & Stormzy ease to a second week on top

After climbing for eight weeks in a row, Higher Love comes to a halt this week, remaining at No.2 for **Kygo** and the late **Whitney Houston**, with consumption of the track dipping for the first time, falling 8.22% week-on-week to 44,142 units. It is No.1 on paid-for sales (5,927) for the third straight week.

No.2 on paid-for sales but No.1 overall, Take Me Back To London (66,610 sales, including 60,965 from sales-equivalent streams) continues at the summit for a second week for **Ed Sheeran** feat. Stormzy. Despite the previously-noted heady mix of increasing radio and TV exposure, a 59p price tag at iTunes and the Sir Spyro mix all playing their part, its consumption is down slightly, falling 0.50% week-on-week, compared to an increase of 128.11% in the previous frame.

Three weeks after reaching its previous peak of No.4, Manchester rapper **Aitch**'s first Top 10 hit, Taste (Make It Shake) climbs 6-3 (42,097 sales). Aitch also scores his second Top 10 hit this week as featured guest on **Young T & Bugsey**'s Strike A Pose, which has taken 13 weeks to climb from debut position of No.30 to the Top 10. Its 12-10 climb this week (29,588 sales) mark its fifth advance in a row and brings Young T & Bugsey their first Top 10 hits.

There is also a new peak for Sorry (7-6, 36,461 sales), up for the seventh week in a row for first time hitmaker **Joel Corry**.

The rest of the Top 10: Ladbroke Grove (5-4, 41,244 sales) by **AJ Tracey**, 3 Nights (4-5, 40,480 sales) by **Dominic Fike**, Ran\$om (9-7, 35,081 sales) by **Lil Tecca**, How Do You Sleep? (8-8, 30,762 sales) by **Sam Smith** and So High (10-9, 29,679 sales) by **Mist** feat. Fredo. Ladbroke Grove and Ran\$om are both revisiting peaks.

It's a great week for **Post Malone** – the person and the song. The rapper of that name has the highest of this week's eight Top 75 debuts, with his 16th hit in less than three years, Circles, entering at No.11 (27,677 sales). It is the third hit from his third album, Hollywood's Bleeding, which dropped on Friday (6th). His recent No.5 hit, Goodbyes (feat. Young Thug) also continues its recovery, advancing 15-14 (24,361 sales).

Meanwhile, the song that bears his name, even though it refers to him in only an incidental manner, continues to grow, jumping 26-16 (23,220 sales) for **Sam Feldt** feat. Rani.

In the week that Norman Fucking Rockwell! becomes her fourth No.1 album, the title track (No.44, 10,627 sales) and Fuck It I Love You (78-59, 7,779 sales) become **Lana Del Rey**'s 16th and 17th Top 75 singles, while Doin' Time, which reached No.75 in June, is a re-entry at No.42 (10,854 sales).

Also new to the Top 75: Change (No.53, 8,633 sales), the sixth hit for drill MC **Deno** and the fifth for featured guest Digdat; Love Me Again (No.62, 7,036 sales), the ninth hit for **Raye**; Will

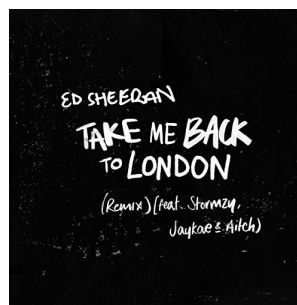

We Talk? (3-66, 6,620 sales), the second hit for **Sam Fender**; Jacques (No.67, 6,530 sales), the 10th hit for **Jax Jones** and the seventh for **Tove Lo**; and Pan-Fried (No.70, 6,405 sales), the ninth hit for **Kano**, and sixth hit for featured rapper **Kojo Funds**.

Registering growth of upwards of 40% for six weeks in a row, Ride It – the introductory hit for Kosovo DJ/producer **Regard** – makes a significant leap for the second week in a row. Up 69-45 last week, it now jumps to No.25, with consumption up 69.33% week-on-week at 18,225 units.

There are also new peaks for: Both (18-13, 25,186 sales) by **Headie One**, Harder (24-23, 19,340 sales) by **Jax Jones & Bebe Rexha**, Outnumbered (30-26, 18,132 sales) by **Dermot Kennedy**, Truth Hurts (31-30, 17,096 sales) by **Lizzo**, Dance Monkey (40-31, 16,952 sales) by **Tones And I**, Fuck I'm Lonely (33-32, 16,575 sales) by **Lauv & Anne-Marie** and Lalala (44-37, 12,059 sales) by **Y2K & Bbnos**. Plus: I Could Get Used To This (48-45, 10,606 sales) by **Becky Hill & Weiss**, XTC (53-48, 9,522 sales) by **Solardo & Eli Brown** and Good As Hell (63-55, 8,206 sales) by **Lizzo**.

With a maximum of three entries apiece as primary artists, there are multiple chart exclusions this week for Taylor Swift, Ed Sheeran and Lana Del Rey, with a total of 15 singles 'starred-out' of the Top 75.

Overall singles sales are down 1.77% week-on-week at 18,516,015, 21.99% above same week 2018 sales of 15,177,882. Paid-for sales are up 1.21% week-on-week at 637,386, and are 29.18% below same week 2018 sales of 900,054.

Stormin' Norman: Lana Del Rey tops week one sales for previous No.1

If statistics are to be believed, **Lana Del Rey** is the most significant female singer-songwriter to emerge in the 2010s. She furthers her claim to that title by securing her fourth No.1 album, with *Norman Fucking Rockwell!* - on which she co-wrote all but one of the songs - opening atop the chart.

Although **Taylor Swift** - whose *Lover* dips 1-3 (16,957 sales) to accommodate Del Rey's - shares top billing among female solo artists, with four No.1 albums apiece in the 2010s, she made her debut in the previous decade.

Opening at No.2 on vinyl (4,965 sales) and No.1 on cassettes (2,890 sales), *Norman Fucking Rockwell!* achieved total consumption of 31,539 units on debut (including 7,272 from sales-equivalent streams) - surpassing the 24,972 copies its immediate predecessor, *Lust For Life*, sold on its chart-topping arrival a little over two years ago.

Del Rey would be equal with Harry Styles (four with One Direction, one solo) and Robbie Williams (four solo, one with Take That) at the top of the list of acts with most No.1 LPs in the 2010s had her third album, 2015 release *Honeymoon*, not been up against David Gilmour's first solo album in 22 years, *Rattle That Lock*, which opened at No.1.

Twenty-six years since their debut album, and 13 years since their last release, California-based progressive rock legends **Tool** are finally back in harness, with fifth studio album *Fear Inoculum*. Becoming their second Top 10 album - after immediate predecessor *10,000 Days*, which sold 29,710 copies debuting and peaking at No.4 in 2006 - *Fear Inoculum* equals that peak and achieved consumption of 13,254 units on debut. Its physical availability has been restricted to an expensive (around £80) special edition which comes with a 4" HD rechargeable screen with exclusive video footage, a speaker and USB cable.

Five albums by Kasabian have reached No.1, most recently *For Crying Out Loud* in 2017. The band's guitarist and singer Serge Pizzorno's first solo project - both called and credited to **The SLP** - debuts at No.7 (7,162 sales).

London rapper **Kano** scores his second Top 10 album with sixth release, *Hoodies All Summer*, debuting at No.8 (6,672 sales), matching the debut position but not the first week sales of immediate predecessor, *Made In The Manor*, which sold 11,994 copies entering at No.8 in March 2016.

Threads, an album of collaborations that she suggests might be her last full-length studio set, earns **Sheryl Crow** her 11th Top 75 entry and 6th Top 10 entry.

Newly-released 25th Anniversary vinyl editions of **Oasis'** 1994 debut album *Definitely Maybe* propel it into the Top 10 for the first time in five years. Surging 56-6 (8,607 sales), it was last in the Top 10 in 2014, when it re-entered at No.5 following the release of 20th anniversary editions. Last week, 6,783 of its sales

were on 12", earning it a return to the top of the vinyl albums chart, and raising its career vinyl sales to 100,069.

The rest of the Top 10: No.6 Collaborations Project (2-2, 19,380 sales) by **Ed Sheeran**, *Divinely Uninspired To A Hellish Extent* (3-5, 11,175 sales) by **Lewis Capaldi** and *When We Fall Asleep, Where Do We Go?* (4-9, 5,649 sales) by **Billie Eilish**.

After 87 consecutive weeks in the Top 10, **The Greatest Showman** soundtrack dips 7-11 (4,829 sales).

Also new to the chart this week: *We Love You Tecca* (No.15, 4,023 sales), the introductory album by 17 year old New York rapper **Lil Tecca**; *Powers* (No.53, 1,643 sales), the sixth album for **The Futureheads**; and *Chronologic* (No.63, 1,518 sales), the second chart entry for French electronic act **Caravan Palace**.

No.11 on debut three weeks ago, **Bon Iver's** *I,I* rebounds 106-13 (4,328 sales) after release in physical formats, while the release of **Travis Scott's** Netflix documentary *Look Mom, I Can Fly* helped stimulate sales of his third album *Astroworld*, which reaches a 50-week high, surging 83-24 (2,890 sales).

Nineteen weeks after debuting at No.42, **Lizzo's** first chart album, *Cuz I Love You*, breaches the Top 40 for the first time, rising 48-40 (1,969 sales).

Now *That's What I Call Music! 103* is No.1 compilation for the seventh straight week (6,996 sales).

Overall album sales are up 0.35% week-on-week at 1,673,872, 0.22% above same week 2018 sales of 1,670,188. Sales-equivalent streams accounted for 1,163,559 sales, 69.51% of the total. Sales of paid-for albums are up 7.61% week-on-week at 510,313, 28.04% below same week 2018 sales of 709,153.

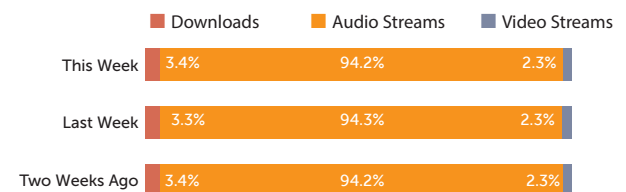

Purple Disco Machine powers to No.1 ANALYSIS

A year to the week after he landed his first Upfront club chart No.1, German DJ and producer Tino Piontek lands his third chart-topper as **Purple Disco Machine** with two tracks from his new EP, Emotion, namely the title track and Up & Down.

Piontek topped the chart for the first time last September with Dished (Male Stripper), and returned to pole position in April with Body Funk. Emotion and Up & Down are both storming disco/house tracks, and Emotion utilises a sample from The Emotions' 1970 classic I Don't Wanna Lose Your Love, which was famously used as the hook to Primal Scream's Loaded.

Belgian DJ Yves V had released a series of electronic and progressive house records over the last decade without setting the UK club charts on fire – but his latest release, We Got That Cool, is a smash that spent a fortnight at No.2 on the Upfront club chart last month and now gallops to the top of the Commercial Pop club chart. The track – a rousing



summer anthem – also features Dutch DJ Afrojack and Swedish duo Icona Pop. We Got The Cool is Yves V's first Commercial Pop No.1, Afrojack's fourth and Icona Pop's third, arriving nearly six years after their second, October 2013's All Night.

Mama Mia!: Manchester's **Geko** scores his fourth No.1 on the Urban club chart in 14 months with Hey Mama. His latest Arabic swing/afro wave/rap hybrid jumps 2-1 to defeat a charge from the similarly-titled Mama, up 10-2 for **Ella Eyre**. Hey Mama also features Anglo-Nigerian guest Maleek Berry and 27 year old Dutch singer Latifah. It is Berry's fourth No.1, and Latifah's first.
