## Warner-EMI to drive digital

LONDON — The 50-50 joint venture between Time Warner Inc. and EMI Group to create Warner EMI Music not only gives birth to the "world's premier music group" but also accelerates the integration of the music industry into the digital world.

The combined company, which will encompass more than 2,500 acts and two million song copyrights, with


operations in 70 countries, will be positioned at the forefront of the digital revolution through its connection with Time Warner's new owner, AOL.

"It's fully our intent to drive the digital download business," comments Time Warner president Richard Parsons, who will be co-chairman of the new entity alongside EMI Group chairman Eric Nicoli. "Our partners AOL are extremely excited

about this joint venture," adds Time Warner chairman Gerald Levin. "Of all our businesses, music is the one that will benefit the most from the Internet and the digital revolution."


However, before reaching that stage the new partners will have to clear the regulation hurdles on both sides of the ocean and create a new model for both companies. According to Nicoli, Warner EMI

## M2M make their name via Atlantic

OSLO — With support from the might of Atlantic Records, two 16-year-old Norwegian girls are on an international campaign trail. Their mission: to tap into the constituencies of pop mainstays from Britney to the Backstreet Boys.

M2M, comprising New York-based Marion Ravn and Marit Larsen and signed and A&R'd directly by Atlantic in the US, were in London last Thursday (27) to perform for the media at Tokyo Joe's. It was one in a series of showcases in the first of three scheduled European promo jaunts in the first quarter of the year, as the buzz about the duo and their *Don't Say You Love Me* single grows ever louder.

Already certified gold in the States, peaking at number 21 on the Hot 100 and number five on the Singles Sales chart, the song was the

## Sony reshuffles key execs

NEW YORK — Announcing a series of moves in the upper echelons of Sony Music Entertainment's management, chairman and CEO Thomas D. Mottola has formalised Mel Ilberman's position as his second-in-command, and has moved other key personnel up a rung.

Ilberman is named vice chairman, Sony Music Entertainment; his former position as chairman, Sony Music International (SMI) is filled by Robert Bowlin; and

Bowlin's previous title of president, SMI is taken by relative newcomer Rick Dobbis, who joined SMI as executive vice president in 1999.

In effect, Ilberman is freed from his former duties at International to work closely with Mottola, and the chain of command below him is maintained intact. "Mel's new role will enable him to work even more closely with me in developing the overall strategic direction of the company," said Mottola in a statement. "He will play a key role in helping transition the

# Upfront

The 1998 merger of Universal and PolyGram triggered the trend that, in the music business, size does matter after all. The union of Warner Music and EMI is another representation of this trend.

Well, after this week's events, the question is not "if" but "when" the next two major companies are going to merge, and which will they be? Some rumours on the Cannes Croisette this week had it that "Sony and BMG is a done deal." You can't stop the rumours, and in the light of the Warner/EMI agreement it would make sense. But we shouldn't rule out Universal setting up another partnership which would make it the indisputable leader.

However, before this happens, it's not too late to analyse the impact of the Warner/EMI deal. One first comment is that BMG now remains the only fully European major (but for how long?). The other point, which was raised by the UK minister of culture Chris Smith in Cannes, is that—in the wake of the AOL/Time Warner deal—an Internet provider is also a major owner of con-


tent and is "on the right side of the barricades," as Smith pointed out.

Then there are the benefits which both EMI and Warner can gain from joining forces. It is no secret that Warner has been underperforming since the management shake-ups in the mid-'90s, and that EMI, on its knees in the US after a series of difficulties, suffered a rather slow year in 1999.

Where Universal and PolyGram looked like a perfect fit (one was strong in the US, the other was an international giant), what we're seeing with EMI and Warner is almost a marriage of equals, with two companies of—at least in most European territories—similar strength (and in a way united in their weakness).

Will two bodies who are not in the best of shape make one good, healthy and efficient whole? And how long will it take to make these two entities work as one? This is the unknown quantity in the equation.

But as edel's CEO Michael Haentjes pointed out at Midem: "The more the majors are in turmoil, the better for us."

## New e-commerce initiatives at Universal

LONDON — Universal Music Group (UMG) has transformed and expanded its e-commerce operations to better reflect the evolution of the digital world.

UMG's existing Electronic Commerce and Advanced Technologies (eCAT) unit, which was handling the company's new media-related busi-



ness, will now be known as Universal eLabs. It will function as UMG's "centre for developing global strategies within the e-commerce realm and seek-

ing out investment opportunities." It will also "develop new businesses internally," according to a company statement. eCAT president Larry Kenswil will become president of Universal eLabs, based in Los Angeles. Universal eLabs reports to UMG president and COO Zach Horowitz.

In addition, UMG is creating a new stand-alone division, Global e, whose task is to build and manage new music businesses, including digital download, subscription, custom radio and pay-per-play businesses around the world, through all digital channels

of purchase such as kiosks, computers, TV set top boxes and portable devices. Heather Myers, who coordinated the Universal/PolyGram merger activities and has since been eCAT's senior vice president/operations, will serve as Global e's executive vice president/general manager. She reports to Bruce Hack, vice chairman, UMG.

On all e-commerce activities, both Horowitz and Hack report to both Edgar Bronfman, Jr., president and CEO of UMG's parent company Seagram, and Doug Morris, chairman and CEO of UMG. "This restructuring gives Mr. Bronfman, Jr. direct accountability for the company's global e-commerce development," says a statement.

## VARA still considering privatisation

HILVERSUM — Public broadcaster VARA is still "considering a potential departure" from the Dutch public broadcasting system to become a commercial operation.

Informal talks with commercial broadcaster SBS Holland (owner of TV channels SBS6 and Net 5) have been publicly confirmed by both parties, but as yet no deal has been closed. VARA claims that a debate in the Dutch parliament on January 20 about the so-called Concession Law for public broadcasters—which governs the issuing of licences and the programming of public channels—has had no influence on its "repositioning plans."

Although VARA's current strategy arises mainly from the new law's perceived detrimental effect on its TV programming, its radio arm "is involved in our future plans as well," VARA head of public relations Hans Elzendoorn tells Music & Media.



But VARA radio journalists, who work on news/talk-formatted Radio 1, are reportedly unhappy with the privatisation plans conceived by VARA managing director Vera Keur, and, off the record, VARA DJs and programmers on public CHR station Radio 3FM are also expressing doubts about Keur's plans.

Keur is currently in "strategic discussions" with SBS Holland managing director Fons van Westerloo, but so far no details have been revealed.

"It will be more difficult to achieve an independent VARA on radio than on TV," acknowledges Elzendoorn. Unlike TV, VARA radio programmes are currently spread over five distinctively different public stations. Despite the outcome of the political debate on the new law on January 20, during which MPs proposed doubling the duration of a broadcast licence for individual public broadcasters from five to 10 years, VARA will press on with its plans to privatise, according to Elzendoorn.

# French music sales sink to a low point

CANNES — Home piracy, fuelled by the use of CD burners, is to blame for a 15 year low in French record sales according to industry body SNEP, which says it may look at taking legal action to force the government to act in defence of the local industry.

Music sales in 1999 fell 2.5% in value to Ffr7.45 billion (euros 1.13 billion) and by 4.5% in units compared to 1998, according to figures unveiled by SNEP at MIDEM. The drop in sales affected mostly singles, which fell 9% in units and 6% in value, but album sales also dropped for the first time since the introduction of CDs in the mid-'80s—down 2.5% in value and 3% in units. In previous years, the market grew in value by 3% (1998/97) and 8% (1997/96).

SNEP president Pascal Negre says these are “the worst figures in 15 years” and puts the drop in sales firmly down to home piracy. “Since the introduction of CD burners, 75% of consumers have changed their consuming habits—some reduce the amount of purchases, others simply stop buying CDs,” he says. “If we don’t move fast, there will be a dramatic drop in sales in the next few years.”

In addition to its own awareness campaign aimed at young consumers, SNEP is asking the French government to act at several levels. Negre wants the government to lower the VAT rates on records, currently at 20.6%, a measure which needs approval from the EU, but which if approved would result in a lower retail price.

Negre warns that should the government choose not to act on VAT, SNEP will look at legal options to force it to do so. “If you buy a record through the Internet, you will rarely pay VAT,” he points out, “whereas when you buy a record in a shop you have to pay 20.6% VAT. This is a blatant case of unfair competition.”

The introduction of a levy on digital blank products would also help compensate the industry for its loss in revenues, Negre suggests—he proposes a euro 2 levy on blank CD-Rs.

With a 34.3% share, Universal was the largest record company in France in 1999, followed by Sony Music (30.4%), EMI/Virgin (17.6%), Warner Music (6.7%) and BMG (6.2%). Local repertoire now accounts for 54% of total sales, with international repertoire dropping 9% to 39%.

# NRJ Awards debut

CANNES — Mariah Carey, Whitney Houston, Will Smith and Texas were among the winners of the first ever NRJ Awards, organised by French CHR network NRJ in collaboration with TV channel TF1, and held during MIDEM.

Tina Turner was presented with an award by actor Alain Delon for her Outstanding Music Career, and U2 lead singer Bono was awarded a Special Prize for his involvement in the Jubilee 2000 campaign. Turner, Carey, Texas, Lou Bega and Bono were all pre-

sent in Cannes to receive their awards. The show, which was broadcast live on NRJ and TF1, also awarded prizes to French acts Mylene Farmer (best Francophone artist; album of the year), Zebda (French group; best song), and David Hallyday (male act). The show attracted a 28% TV audience share, increasing to 48% among viewers under 50. “We’re happy with the results; the show was watched by a young audience and that was our goal,” says NRJ president Jean Paul Baudecroux.

## ON THE MIDEM BEAT

### SWEDEN'S POPWIRE EXTENDS

Popwire.com, the Swedish Internet service for unsigned music acts, is set to open an office in New York in March. The company currently has offices in Stockholm, Tokyo and London. The opening of a New York office follows the launch of Cream ([www.popwire.com/cream](http://www.popwire.com/cream)) at MIDEM. This is a new password-protected service targeted at the A&R community and designed to feature the best of the new talents Popwire.com is distributing and promoting on its web site. Artists posted on the Cream section of the web site will also be signed to the company's publishing division, which currently includes a catalogue of Popwire acts jointly owned with Universal Music Group.

### FNAC MAKES RADIO MOVES

Leading French retailer FNAC is expected to launch a 25-channel radio service on its web site by the end of February. The radio channels will be part of Fnac.net, a sub-site within theFnac.com Web site. Visitors will be able to listen to any of 25 music genre-specific radio channels while surfing on other web sites at the same time. And, based on agreements with the record labels, on-line visitors can be hotlinked directly to an artist's web site or FNAC's online store to purchase a CD.

### MIDEMNET WINNERS REVEALED

The first MidemNet Awards winners, celebrating the most creative and innovative music-related web sites, were announced in Cannes on January 22. The awards were voted by the public in December, with over 57,000 votes cast, and presented to: Atlantic Records (best label/record company); Dave Matthews (best artist); MTV (best media); Amazon (best shopping/distribution); RIAA (best organisation); Woodstock (best festival/award/event); and Artist Direct (best services).

## Edel in Italian joint venture

CANNES — German indie label edel music has set up a joint venture with former PolyGram Italy chief executive Stefano Senardi, it was revealed on January 25 during MIDEM.

The two partners will create a new company called Nun Entertainment, based in Milan, which will be active in all areas of the music business, signing, promoting and marketing artists as well as setting up a music publishing unit. It will also incorporate a video production operation and a new technology lab. Senardi explains he wants a complete entertainment company in order to “take the opportunities offered by the changes in the market. It will not be simply a label; I want to take advantage of what technology has to offer.”

Nun Entertainment will utilise edel's sales and distribution network in Italy, and its repertoire will be exploited internationally by edel's

affiliates and partners. “Italy is a key creative territory with a history of breaking artists into Europe and even the US,” says edel CEO Michael Haentjes. “I want to capitalise on this trend and I am glad to have found, in Stefano, the right partner.”

Senardi was one of the major casualties of the PolyGram/Universal merger, which saw the Italian top job at the new company going to Universal Music's Piero La Falce. Senardi says he plans to sign new talent to Nun Entertainment as well as established acts.

Haentjes adds that this new venture is an example of the type of project he wants to develop in future. “I have been very busy in the distribution field recently,” he explains, “but I am now more geared towards content and music. There will certainly be more of these relationships with creative partners.”

# NRJ boycott 'punishes' BMG

STOCKHOLM — Reacting to the cancellation of UK boy band Westlife's scheduled appearance at the NRJ Radio Awards 2000 in Stockholm (M&M Hotline, January 29), NRJ Sweden is continuing to exclude songs by the band and other BMG-affiliated artists from its playlist.

NRJ's action followed a letter to the broadcaster from the management of Westlife dated January 10, which informed NRJ that the band had to give priority "to promotional appearances in Argentina and the US."

The only BMG-related songs remaining on the playlist are current singles by Robyn and Petter, who were among those attending the awards show along with other performing artists including Melanie C., Geri Halliwell, Blümchen, Bloodhound Gang, Enrique Iglesias and Lene Marlin.

On its own website, the station has

published extracts of the contract between NRJ and BMG, and the two letters which BMG and Westlife's management wrote to the station.

"It's unacceptable that NRJ is collectively punishing all of BMG's artists and publicly criticising Westlife [on the station's website]," says BMG Sweden managing director Hasse Breitholtz, adding that "We offered NRJ a whole day with Westlife at the beginning of February, but they were not satisfied. They maintain that BMG should be punished for this."



BMG Sweden has informed its affiliates in

other NRJ territories of the situation, also informed Whitney Houston's management that her single had been dropped from NRJ Sweden's playlist. Houston pulled out of NRJ's French awards show at Cannes on January 22, citing flu. NRJ Sweden executives were unavailable for comment.

# ON THE BEAT

## CAPITAL CHOOSES LIFE

LONDON — The Capital Radio group's new national AC station, which will broadcast on the UK's Digital One digital radio multiplex from January 31, is to be called Life. Adopting a research and lifestyle-led approach commonly used by consumer brands, Capital commissioned product development company New Solutions to help to select the station's name, visual identity and future brand positioning (M&M, December 11). "Life will be a stylish, upbeat, music-led radio station appealing to an intelligent, confident, quick-witted and individual listening public," promises Life programme controller Pete Simmons. "Musically, we aim to introduce some great songs and artists that don't currently receive airplay on UK radio, and we won't be frightened to stray from playing just the contemporary mainstream hits of the big artists." Meanwhile, the Digital One multiplex has also announced that its station dedicated to plays, books, comedy and reviews will be called Oneword. The service will be operated by Oneword Radio Ltd, a joint venture between The Guardian Media Group (30%), book publishers Chivers Communications (30%), independent production company Unique Broadcasting (30%) and audio book publishers Heavy Entertainment (10%).



## TEXAS OUT OF DANSK GRAMMYS

COPENHAGEN — Mercury act Texas have cancelled their scheduled appearance at the Dansk Grammy ceremony to be held on 5 February. Spice Girl Melanie C has been added to the list of domestic and international acts who will perform, and will headline a list of 13 artists including Juice, Marie Frank, Creamy, Poul Krebs, Clemens & Petter, Reme & Ms Mukupa, Thomas Helmig, Kashmir, Hampenberg, Funkstar De Luxe and Det Brune Punktum.

## CLIFF IS BOXMAN'S MOST UNWANTED

LONDON — On-line music retailer Boxman has revealed its top 10 list of unwanted CDs returned this New Year in its "CD Amnesty," in which 1,000 members of the public were given the chance to swap their unwanted CDs for ones they really coveted. Cliff Richard's *The Millennium Prayer* topped the list of rejects, followed by *Charlotte Church, The Vengaboys' Up & Down The Party* and S Club 7's *S Club*. Robbie Williams' *Millennium* topped the list of most wanted replacements, followed by Macy Gray's *On How Life Is*, *The Miseducation of Lauryn Hill* and *More Abba Gold*.

## VENUE 2000 BIGGEST EVER

COPENHAGEN — The annual Venue 2000 festival for promoting up-and-coming acts and the club scenes in Denmark, Norway and Sweden was scheduled to present more than 80 concerts at 28 clubs in 17 towns between 27-30 January. Public broadcasters in all three countries cooperated on delivering live broadcasts and recording shows. Performers include Lightning Seeds (UK), Sandy Dillon (US), Under Byen (Denmark), Respect is Burning (France), Emillana Torrini (Iceland), and Sahara Hotnights (Sweden). Venue began in 1993 under the auspices of brewers Carlsberg and the Roskilde festival.

## EDEL NAMES NEW PRESIDENT, BUYS INTO ARCADE

CANNES — Edel has announced the appointment of Edel Music Publishing CEO David Hockman as president of Edel Records Europe. He will retain his publishing job and continue to be based in London, reporting to Edel Music CEO Michael Haentjes. According to Haentjes, the job was created to allow himself to concentrate on more strategic issues. Concurrently, Edel Music has taken a 17% stake in Arcade Music Company, for an undisclosed sum, making it the second largest shareholder in the company. Arcade was recently acquired by WBG, also the parent company of Roadrunner.

## MOVING CHAIRS

LONDON — Hal Rood, senior research associate and director of international services at Princeton, New Jersey-based research and consulting firm Broadcast Architecture (BA), has been promoted to vice president, international services. Gabriela Isas has joined the BA International Division as director of international marketing. She was formerly with Westwood One International, where she was director of affiliate marketing. UK public CHR station BBC Radio 1 has promoted Alex Jones-Donnelly to the position of senior music manager, reporting to Radio 1 head of music policy Jeff Smith. Jones-Donnelly joined Radio 1 from London dance station Kiss 100 in 1997.

HILVERSUM — Frank Eijken has stepped down as managing director at Wegener Radio/TV (Radio 10 FM, Love Radio and TMF), formerly known as Arcade Media Group. Organisers choose what to offer, ranging from venue maps all the way to club membership services, and can monitor all related site activity. Unsigned and other artists with an interest in grass-roots marketing will see the potential of seeUthere immediately, especially now that it can be easily linked to downloadable music.

# Ö3 still leads Austrian pack

VIENNA — Nearly two years after the nationwide launch of commercial radio, privately owned stations have still come nowhere near dethroning Ö3 as the country's leading station, according to latest official ratings figures.

Across Austria, the state-owned CHR station continues to hold a commanding lead over the regional commercial broadcasters, with market shares up to 41% in

four of the nine provinces.

The commercial stations say a large part of the problem is that the nationwide broadcaster airs commercials, while also receiving financial support from the government.

Ö3 "has a fistful of money it can throw around. We're a station that has to listen to our shareholders," says Ian Walker, programme director of the AC-formatted Antenne Wien.

In the Vienna market, Ö3 took a 33% market share in the fourth quarter of 1999, compared to 34% the previous quarter. Its closest commercial competitor, the AC/gold station 88.6, holds steady with a 12% share, according to fourth-quarter ratings compiled by the market research institute Fessel GfK.

Radio Energy remains the second strongest commercial station in the Austrian capital, with a 6% market share—a slight slip from the previous quarter when the station, whose owners include France's NRJ, had a 6.5% share.

The other two main commercial stations in the Vienna market, Antenne Wien and the rock broadcaster 92.9 RTL, saw their market shares creep up, to 4% and 3% respectively.

"Ö3 can be beaten, but obviously it's not going to happen overnight," Walker says. "It's a hard slog."

# Dance grooves

## A BLANKET FO' YO' HOUSE

Following in the tradition of some of house music's original movers and shakers, Dortmund's Matthew Boone makes a sound that is the aural equivalent of a warm blanket. On *Throop Street Blues* (Montreux Recordings/Germany) Boone combines a soulful vocal, a phat, swooshy bass end and much liberal use of the low pass filters to create a sound that is phresh but at the same time deep and groovy. A splendid tune that, thanks to the "pop" voice, will brighten up any dancefloor. An edit is already on12".

## RIGHT TIME

Luciano's version of Junior Murvin's roots classic *Police + Thieves* (Palm Pictures/UK), to be included on the Third World Cup soundtrack, is, in the hands of garage maestro Dave Lambert, a full-on pop/dance screamer. Reggae fans may shudder at the thought of such a classic track being given the dancefloor treatment but in fact Lambert and Luciano are, in turn, innovative and respectful enough to have created a classic version of a monumental tune. Groovy, upful and chartable.

## UNDERGROUND MAESTRO

With its dry hi-hat sounds and ghostly bass line, *Calling The Freak's Noise Shaping* (Lightning Records/Belgium) starts out like a robotic version of Isaac Hayes' *Shaft*. The ersatz supafly vibe quickly morphs into something darker and harder, and then proceeds to head into heavy technoid trance territory. Echoes of *Hardfloor* in the austere instrumentation and a well thought out production should ensure that *Noise Shaping* finds its rightful place as a big-hearted minimalist classic.

## MIDI FUNK

Previously best known as a city that produces rap acts, Marseille has been looking more uptempo and funky of late. Local trio Superfunk—having already demonstrated with the single *Lucky Star* that they are every bit as bright, credible and poppy as last year's revelation, Kojak—have confirmed that initial impression with the release of their debut album *Hold Up* (Fiat Lux/France). Combining subtlety and an appropriate degree of musical dexterity with a love of all things disco, the group have produced an album that has it all: great production, irresistible, unorthodox beats, flashes of ragga, pure pop tunes and lots of humour. One of the best of the "post-filter" nouvelle vague.

## NO TIME LIKE THE PRESENT

After selling over 250,000 units of their last album *No Time Like The Future*, (Talkin Loud/UK) flagship funk act Incognito are back, with new versions of the aforementioned record. The Remix Album, featuring new mixes from Kenny "Dope" Gonzalez, Blaze, Jazzanova, MJ Cole and United Future Organisation, is, happily, a thoroughly worthwhile exercise, perhaps because the original tracks are still relatively fresh in the memory. Ski's Main Mix of *I Can See The Future* adds subtle references to electro while Jazzanova attack *Get Into My Groove* to provide a nervy, syncopated makeover. The splendid K-Dope Remix of *Wild & Peaceful* reveals a distinctly urban side to the original. But the absolute standout remake is UFO's sizzling, bossa nova-based version of the Crusaders-inspired *Port Louis*.

# Holland's City To City take The Road Ahead

City To City are a commercial hit in more ways than one. The haunting, REM-style ballad *The Road Ahead* (Parlophone/EMI), originally written for a Mitsubishi motor car ad, has put the pop duo of Maarten van Praag and Sandro van Breemen firmly on the map, with 20 weeks in the Dutch top 10, five of them at number one in the Mega Top 100. Now City To City are ready to shift into top gear and take their huge radio and sales hit from country to country.

*The Road Ahead*, the title track of the duo's self-described "millennium-proof '60s pop" album, has the ingredients of an instant classic, with a haunting melody enhanced by crystal-clear harmony vocals. It came about when Van Breemen, who works as an engineer in the studio owned by City To City producer Henk Temming, was asked to provide vocals by the composers Jan de Roos and Rens van der Meer, who were recording a demo for the TV commercial. Later, the song was re-recorded by City To City.

"Hopefully, that song will work as a catalyst for our own repertoire," says Van Breemen, who wrote eight of the album's 12 tracks. Indeed, the current follow-up single in Holland, *The Real World*, is a Van Breemen original. "That song I wrote eight years ago," he says.


Radio leapt wholeheartedly onto *The Road*

*Ahead*. "Numerous listeners kept on asking me about 'that song from the commercial,'" recalls Vranz van Maaren, programme director at national soft AC station Sky Radio. "I got a CD-R of it and I instantly felt that this was [the kind of] big record you only get once every three years."

Since first airing in June 1999, *The Road Ahead*, which is still the best-testing song among Sky's demographic, has been played about 1,000 times on the station. So far the single, which is still in the Dutch charts, has sold 130,000 copies; the album, released locally last November, shipped 15,000 copies, according to Danny Friedrichs, A&R/marketing manager at EMI Holland. "People bought the single because of the song. It's our task now to promote the band themselves as well," he notes. A special album campaign

has already run on Sky.

The German speaking territories are the key markets that independent marketing executive Bert de Ruiter is aiming for. "In Belgium the single has been top 10 already, and we're trying to get a radio promo tour sorted now," he says. Meanwhile, the wide appeal of *The Road Ahead* means that City To City are living up to their name. "Since we're on the Astra satellite and on the cable network in various countries," says Sky's Van Maaren, "we get lots of questions about that record, especially from Germany and Switzerland."

# Merz, musical adventurer

"It's so empty on my radio. It [should be] all about irony, fun and escapism." It might not make pretty reading for programmers, but that's the firm belief of Conrad Lambert, alias Merz.

Last year, this Brit produced a self-titled debut album on Epic UK revealing an organic mixture of dance, pop, rock and even world music. Not surprisingly, Merz's record collection is eclectic enough to include Bob Dylan, Underworld and new classical music.

Currently residing in Bath, the musician's passport shows that he has visited 48 countries so far. "I'm not a backpacker, I'm more like a musical adventurer," he says. "I'm just fascinated by the simplicity, purity and innocence of traditional music. I'm dedicated to hearing music in its natural environment. For example, rave music only makes sense in a club, doesn't it?"

Merz's album appeared in some critics' year-end lists and singles such as *Many Weathers Apart* gained good reviews, but such a product is hard to market in the ultra-poppy UK climate. "When you have such an artist with a certain depth—musical and visual as

well as perceptual—it deserves an intelligent approach," says Jon Fowler, international exploitation manager at Epic. "In the UK, we've had a reasonable start at radio, but Merz just didn't secure a big enough fan base to reach the top 40."

Fowler now aims to create a buzz in the French and Dutch press before servicing European radio. Thibault Dubouisne, product manager at Epic France adds: "We've had excellent reviews after his gig at [major indie festival] Inrockuptibles. Playing live is the best argument." Merz himself concurs. "Playing with other musicians, that's what this whole trip is about," he says. A French tour is planned for March, to follow the single *Lovely Daughter* which has just gone to French radio.

Dan Green, head of music at Liverpool's alternative rock/dance outlet 107.6 Crash FM, encourages his French colleagues to play it. "We really like Merz," he says, "because his music sounds so fresh and he was such a nice bloke when he visited our station. Our evening dance shows enjoyed the dance mix of *Many Weathers Apart*, and *Lovely Daughter* is a more commercial introduction." If more programmers agree, Merz might find it more interesting next time he switches on his radio.

## YOUSSEU N'DOUR JOKO - FROM VILLAGE TO TOWN

The Senegalese superstar seems finally to have found the desire, and the musical blend, to take on the world and not just the world music racks. It's taken him five years to produce a follow-up to the global million-seller *Wommat-The Guide* and its genre-busting single featuring Neneh Cherry, *7 Seconds*, but the wait has not been in vain. With an effective mix of traditional African instrumentation and vocal styles with western pop sensibilities, N'Dour has produced his most accessible album to date. *My Hope Is In You*, recently released as a single in France and written by N'Dour with Englishman Adam Gurwitz and Maribeth Derry, is exactly the kind of refreshing, uplifting pop song to brighten those long January evenings. An absolute must for radio is the superb *Don't Walk Away*, featuring Sting and produced by Johnny Dollar who worked on *7 Seconds*. Other airplay contenders are *How Come*, produced by and featuring the Fugees' Wyclef Jean, and *This Dream*, a wonderfully atmospheric track about the relationship between Africa and Anglo Saxon countries on which Youssou duets with Peter Gabriel. A superb album of surprising continuity considering the range of influences and styles, *Joko* is a firm reminder of what an essential artist Youssou N'Dour has become. CB

## THE WHO BBC SESSIONS

The BBC sits on a goldmine of classic live sessions from the '60s and '70s but it can take years of protracted wrangling to negotiate their release. After the success of the Beatles' *Live At The BBC*, three years ago Led Zeppelin's near-legendary Beeb tapes finally emerged and now comes the long-awaited release of The Who's early sessions. The group made nine BBC radio appearances between 1965 and 1970, all happily preserved save their debut on the Joe Loss Pop Show. Most were recorded for Saturday Club, presented by Brian Matthew, whose sober intros have been retained to enhance the period feel. As for the songs, there were no retakes, no studio trickery, just stand-and-deliver live versions captured by the BBC's engineers in glorious mono. Yet even in these primitive conditions the band deliver storming takes of *Can't Explain*, *Substitute* and *My Generation*. A second version of the latter, reworked as a Radio 1 jingle, amusingly transmutes the famous lyric into "talking 'bout my favourite station." By the time of the 1970 session recorded for the Dave Lee Travis show, the sound has filled out, echoing the excitement of the *Live At Leeds* album. As a relic of swinging Britain, both die-hard fans and the simply curious will find it irresistible. NW





## On the air

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

With a lot happening in the music industry at the moment, a closer look at this week's European Radio Top 50 reveals that the newly-combined EMI and Warner are, between them, behind 32% of the tracks. Sony is in second place with 22% of the records. However, our new number one has no connection with any of the majors—Britney Spears' *Born To Make You Happy* (Jive) knocks Celine Dion's *That's The Way It Is* (Epic/Columbia) off the top spot, down to five. Indeed, the entire top five this week is untouched by the new music giant, with All Saints' *Pure Shores* (London) providing EMI-Warner's highest position at six.


Pet Shop Boys' *You Only Tell Me You Love Me When You're Drunk* (Parlophone) takes a huge jump up from 43 to 17 this week. Artful Dodger's *Re-Rewind* (Public Demand/Relentless) has also gained a lot of interest since last week, as the track moves up from 48 to 33.

With prestigious newcomers such as Sting featuring Cheb Mami's *Desert Rose* (A&M) at 41, Aqua's *Cartoon Heroes* (Universal) at 43 and R.E.M.'s *The Great Beyond* (WEA) at 48, the highest new entry this week, Mariah Carey's *Thank God I Found You* (Columbia) at 27, certainly enjoys a warm welcome in Europe. Jan Brodde, head of music at Danish commercial stations Radio 2 (AC) and Radio Uptown (CHR), loves the track: "This is Mariah Carey at her best. We play the upbeat re-mix on Radio Uptown and the original on Radio 2. We also play *Heartbreaker*, but *Thank God I Found You* is our favourite—it's a great Mariah Carey ballad."

Radio Uptown is playing a great deal of Scandinavian music these days: "Danish trio Juice is releasing a new single shortly called *My Love* [EMI]. It's produced by Soulfish, who also produced Whitney Houston's *Heartbreak Hotel* [Arista]. The track suits both CHR and AC formats, and I think it will be a big hit. Swedish Christian Falk is another favourite at the moment; his *Make It Right* [WEA] is a top quality disco-funk tune. Otherwise, we are eagerly awaiting Aqua's new single *Around The World* [Universal] which will be released around the time of the Danish Grammys early in February. I heard their new album today and must say that it's a fabulous production, with ballads and upbeat tunes and even the appearance of the Stockholm Symphony Orchestra."

A likely contender for next week's chart is the Fun Lovin' Criminals' new single, *Couldn't Get It Right* (Chrysalis). The track is a cover of the Climax Blues Band's '70s hit, released on BTM. The song reached number 10 in the UK chart in 1976, and three in the US in 1977. Also a possibility for next week is Norwegian teenagers M2M's *Don't Love Me* (Atlantic), which keeps gaining airplay in Europe after a flying start in America.

lead-off for Atlantic's *Pokémon: The First Movie* soundtrack, a 2.3 million-seller in the US due for release across Europe in March. *Don't Say You Love Me*, already hot across Scandinavia, will get a UK release on March 20 on East West; the album *Shades Of Purple* is due in Europe in mid-February, and in the US on March 7, with British release still to be scheduled.

The Pokémon movie will open in Belgium, France and Switzerland on April 5 with the rest of Europe to follow, but the association of *Don't Say You Love Me* with such a hot property has only heightened pan-European interest in the single, which is number five this week on M&M's Major Market Airplay chart for Scandinavia, not to mention that it has already topped the sales chart in Thailand and gone top ten in Australia, New Zealand and Indonesia.

Norway's public CHR/alternative station NRK Petre A-listed the song on the day it went to radio in November and has been playing it ever since. "It's a very well-written, well-produced pop song, they're young and potentially the largest Norwegian pop success ever," enthuses Petre music director Marius Lillelien. "The song is best suited to an audience aged 10-16, but in my opinion it won't scare away older listeners."

M2M are the latest in a succession of Norwegian acts which Atlantic has floated internationally, including Sons Of Angels, Bel Canto and, of late, Babel Fish (M&M, September 19, 1998). But the teenagers are a different proposition, according to the label's Fran Lichtman, senior VP, international. "Atlantic never really had an act in this 'super pop' world," she says. "They are instrumental in writing their songs, they have no manufactured look or sound, and we're very proud of that. We feel they will have a long career with Atlantic."

company into the digital era."

Mottola said Bowlin's promotion was recognition of the "significant role he has played in the development and expansion of Sony Music International," pointing out that "Bob has contributed to the near doubling of International's sales, an increase of 30% in market share, and to the establishment of operations in Indonesia, India, the Philippines and a cooperative arrangement in China."

Rick Dobbis' step up comes just over a year after he joined the company from PolyGram, where he was president, Continental Europe and a member of PolyGram's International Management Board. Mottola commented on Dobbis' "depth of experience and understanding of the international marketplace."

## EMI-Warner to drive digital

Music is the "world's premier music group," but it will probably not be the leading record company. Warner Music chairman Roger Ames, who will be CEO of Warner EMI Music, estimates that EMI's and Warner's combined share is around 20%, second to Universal Music. In music publishing, the combination of Warner Chappell and EMI Music Publishing creates by far the biggest player in the sector.

The new company will have combined revenues of about euro 8 billion and employ some 23,000 people. EMI Recorded Music worldwide president/CEO Ken Berry, who will be COO of Warner EMI Music, said he expected job losses in the region of 3,000 over three years.

"There's a degree of overlap in terms of things we do," Berry says. "Some—like the finding of new artists—we don't want to touch. Other areas like manufacturing and distribution are easier to bring together, and there will be some staff reductions."

Plans include a pan-European distribution model. Both EMI and Warner were looking at this separately before merger talks, Berry says. "We'll do it together and bring big savings, and reflect the true nature of the European market going forward." Berry adds that IT and new media systems are areas where cuts could be made.

Ames says that the scenario is "to respect our many individual label's autonomy and culture." Both Berry and Ames emphasise

## EMI and Warner in Europe

The combination of Warner and EMI in Europe will create the continent's leading record group, according to cumulative chart shares based on Music & Media's Eurochart Hot 100 singles charts and the European Top 100 Album charts.

In albums, the joint company would have had a 29.7% chart share in 1999, 6.4% ahead of Universal and Sony. In singles, the gap is narrower with EMI and Warner at 21.2% and Universal at 19.5%.

Structurally, EMI and Warner operate in each of the main European territories with two separate entities. Warner has East West and WEA units in the UK, France, Germany, Italy and Spain, while EMI has in most instances Virgin structures distinct from EMI, except in the smaller territories.

This configuration will probably be redesigned in some countries where Warner's dual-company structure, originally designed to provide separate outlets for US-sourced repertoire, might not be relevant to the current situation.

At Warner, in the absence of a president for Europe, European regional chiefs Gerd Gebhardt (northern and central Europe), Gerolamo Caccia Dominiononi (southern Europe), Manfred Lappe (east-

ern Europe) and Nick Phillips (UK), report directly to WMI chairman/CEO Stephen Shrimpton. Europe is EMI's traditional stronghold, but the company is going through notable changes, including a switch of regional command from Rupert Perry to Charlie Dimont last September.

Heinz Canibol and Marc Lumbruso, new chief executives in the G/S/A and France/Benelux zones, respectively, are experiencing tough market conditions. Canibol is also overseeing the closure of Intercord, a notable German indie which EMI bought in 1994.

The flagship UK (and Ireland) operations of EMI and Virgin have enjoyed relative stability under seasoned executives Tony Wadsworth and Paul Conroy, respectively. They are used to combining resources: in 1997, Virgin/EMI TV was created with staff from previously separate units.

Meanwhile, Virgin companies in territories such as Germany and France—part of the network fostered by Ken Berry before EMI bought Richard Branson's record business—are expected to continue under their own steam, helmed by Udo Lange and Emmanuel de Buretel, respectively.

Sources say Berry has assured de Buretel that he has a place in the new world order. In addition to his French duties, he is president

of Virgin Continental Europe, reporting directly to Berry.

While in Cannes for Midem, UK culture minister Chris Smith declined to comment on the competition aspects of the deal, which he describes as "a major change in the music industry."

But Smith saw a positive aspect in that the new venture "could place a major Internet service provider on the right side of the barricades for the first time, as far as content is concerned."

Michael Haentjes, CEO of German company edel music, bluntly declares: "It's great for us. The more majors in turmoil, the better." However, Patrick Zelnik, founder of Naïve and president of French indies body UPFI, compares the deal to "an earthquake" and warns against the risk of excessive concentration of the market in a handful of players. "I don't know of any case of someone with a dominant position who has not abused it," he comments.

Pascal Nègre, president/CEO of Universal Music France and president of French music industry body SNEP, thinks differently. For Nègre, the music industry has entered a phase of concentration "like any other industry. I don't see why the music industry should be any different. We moved to four and by the end of the year, we'll be three," he forecasts. But he adds that "nature abhors a vacuum, and I am sure that new forces will emerge."

The Warner EMI Music COO expects significant cost savings in Europe. "We were looking at a pan-European distribution model, and we considered the possibility of a partner," Berry told analysts on January 24 at the announcement of the merger. "Warner was looking at the same initiative. Now we'll do it together, bring big savings, and reflect the true nature of the European market going forward."

This will also extend to the emerging territories in Eastern Europe, where EMI has invested more aggressively than Warner in acquisitions or partnerships.

London-based Warner Music International chairman Stephen Shrimpton could be tempted to delay the appointment of a European president following the announcement of the merger with EMI. The position has been vacant since Manfred Zunkeller left a year ago, and there appears to be no obvious internal successor. Shrimpton's would-be colleagues at EMI may have an alternative suggestion in the shape of their European CEO, Charlie Dimont.

At MIDEM last week, Hotline heard that several leading indie labels are getting together to create a new European indies network. Currently code-named Impala, its goal will be to represent the interests of independent companies in EU matters. The project is the brainchild of Michel Lambot, co-president of Belgian company Play It Again Sam.

RTL general manager of programmes Stéphane Duhamel has been appointed interim president of CLT-UFA's two music networks in France, Fun Radio and RTL2, following the departure of Axel Duroux. One of his first actions was to promote the stations' joint music programmer Christian Lefebvre to deputy general manager of both stations.

Proving that cross-media ventures don't always work, Dutch music TV channel The Music Factory has announced that it is shutting down its spin-off magazine, More! And staying in Holland, Oasis could have problems with the choice of name for their Big Brother label. Dutch TV production company Endemol Entertainment is understood to be investigating the legal situation, as it owns the copyright to the Big Brother name (which it uses for one of its TV shows) around Europe.

Central Scotland's new alternative rock and dance station Beat 106 is having trouble with Bowie...no, not the Thin White Duke but its breakfast presenter, George Bowie. Hired in a blaze of publicity from Glasgow CHR rivals Clyde 1 FM for Beat's launch on November 19 last year, Bowie walked out on his new station on January 17, subsequently announcing that he was returning to his former employers. However, Beat has obtained a court injunction to prevent him from doing so, as the contract Bowie signed with Beat runs until November 2000.

What exactly is Marc Marot's future within the Universal Music Group? The former MD of Universal Island UK, who left the label at the beginning of January following a contractual dispute, has relocated to Universal Music International's HQ in London, but there has still been no announcement about his new position, although it was rumoured he was being considered for an e-commerce post. "I wouldn't be surprised if Marot and Universal parted ways at some point," a Universal source tells Hotline.

Finally, M&M is saddened to report the death after a short illness of Scott Piering, founder of the UK's Appearing radio and TV promotions company. Born in the US, Piering first came to London in 1980 to set up Rough Trade's promotions and press department prior to launching his own company in 1984. Since then, Appearing has promoted some 121 UK Top 20 hits, as well as managing The Smiths for their first three albums.
