ABOUT THE CHARTS....
THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):
In many European countries one chart is recognised by the
music industry as the "OFFICIAL," hitparade and is therefore
used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP100. However
times are other countries where various charts are in existence
and often equally important. For these countries we have
compiled a number of these charts into one representing the
sales in that market sales in that market.

Each charr position for every country then receives, relevant to that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied by a factor determined through the latest known sales

that postion, an equal points rating which is in torn multiplied by a factor determined through the latest known sales percentage of total singles for album) sales which that country holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such as IFPI-BPI-Gallup-Deutsiche Phonoverband etc. A European Chart-Committee, with experts from a number of these industry-organisations will overlook the calculation system and will decide on improvements, changes and updates. For the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16 countries. Since the sales percentages of a few countries are too small to get their hits into the EUROPEAN TOP 100 Committee and to small to get their hits into the EUROPEAN TOP 100 Committee are not charted in any other territory, we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE list each week.

The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 60 is compiled through all our correspondents tips received this week.(*)Records of the week receive extra points. THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It includes video-t-u programs and other tu-shows partly using video's from 14 European countries.

EUROPEAN POP FESTIVALS

Now that summer hangs in the air and dj's are starting to program Summer In The City and all those other ideal summer hits, the European pop festivals are about to start. In Holland the Pinkpop Festival will take place on June 11th, Belgium will have its yearly Torhout/ Werchter, two festivals one day after another and in Denmark the Roskilde festival will begin the 29th of

What has been known much longer in the folk and jazz music world, was only in the mid sixtles discovered by the pop field. Folk had its Newport Festival (where Dylan in '65 shocked the pure folkies by appearing with an electric band, remember?), while jazz has always had many regular festivals. The so called 'love ins' were in fact the real precursors to the later massive gatherings of people living for 3 days like nomads in the meadows. Love ins like those of the Gathering Of The Trips Festival (january '67), the Human Be-In (San Francisco, '67) and the Magic Mountain Music Festival (California, '67) were set up to let people listen to the messages of the love & peace movement combined with appearances of pop musicians. But the first pop festival of more than 1 day was The Monterey in California, taking place the 16, 17 and 18th of June. Not only is the Monterey festival legendary for being the first big festival with 50.000 attending, but also it has a bizarre name in the history of pop festivals, because many of the appearing artists like Janis Joplin, Brian Jones (he wasn't actually appearing, but was one of the visiting guests), Jimi Hendrix, Mama Cass, Otis Redding and Al Wilson (Canned Heat), died soon after.

STARDUST

In the following years a lot of festivals were organized in Miami, Denver, New Orleans Atlanta, Seattle etc. but the one that attracted the largest gathering of people was of course the Woodstock festival. This festival with 400.000 people became the symbol of a new generation, 'the Woodstock generation'. Three days of peace, love and music with Crosby, Stills & Nash ("we are golden we are stardust"), Jimi Hendrix, Jefferson Airplane, The Who, Sly And The Family Stone, Santana, Joe Cocker etc. An impressive line up which many rock fans for years to come were able to re experience trough the triple and double live albums that were released shortly after (where are the legendary festival soundtracks these days??). Not too much longer and the festival as the symbol of peace is rudely disturbed by the festival at Altamont, California, when the guard of the Hell's Angels during the Stones Concert stab down the black man Meredith Hunter. The whole world witness this awful and disenchanting incident in the movie 'Gimme Shelter' and the Seventies start with yet another ideal shattered.
Compared to the US, Europe was rather late with organized pop festivals. The Isle of Wight Festival attracted every year masses of people and the one from '69 is famous because of its legendary line up of Bob Dylan, The Doors, Hendrix and the Band. In Holland the first big three days festival was organized similar to Woodstock. The happening in the woods of Rotterdam (Kralingen) is a nationwide event covered by all newspapers and ty's. From the same festival comes the story of the 16 year old boy who told his parents that was he staying with a friend for 3

by his parents. Also starting the same year is the Pinkpop Festival in the southern part of Holland (Geleen) which draws the first year 10.000 trailerly which draws the first year 10.000 visitors but has now grown to be, together with the English Reading Festival, Europe's biggest and most popular one day festival (from 10.000 the first year, to 50.000 successively in 1979, 1980 and 1981) only beaten in popularity by the Torhout/Verchter festival (2 test festival is Policium atterdation 10.77, in day festival) in Belgium, started in 1977. In Denmark the Roskilde festival is celebrating its 12th year of existence, drawing people not only from Scandinavia but also from Germany and Holland. A new phenomenon the last few years is the use of big Football stadiums to draw as many people as possible on one day for acts like The Rolling Stones, Rod Stewart, Supertramp and David Bowie.

TORHOUT/WERCHTER

Despite the fact that there's a new generation who has no ties with the subculture that created the popfestivals, people still have the

urge to attend festivals. The double festival Torhout/Werchter (organized by Herman Schueremans) presented on June the 7th in Torhout (near Ostende) and June 8th in Werchter (near Brussel) has always a quality music billing, with acts this year as Lou Reed, Joe Jackson, The Alarm, Nona Hendrix, Chris Rea. David Johansen, The Simple Minds and Paul Young The festival uses an enormous stage which was used by acts like Genesis, Supertramp, Barclay James Harvest, and now Dylan and Santana, Rod Stewart and the Police on some of their European dates. As always the festival will be covered by Dutch radio KRO and most probably by Dutch T.V. (Harry de Winter) as

Although the Dutch Pinkpop Festival decreased in popularity the last two years (due to the competition with Torhout/Werchter and the Stones concert two years ago), it is still very popular among people from the Benelux, Germany and even France. As always it takes place June 11th with acts this year like Wang Chung, Marillion, John Hiatt, The Pretenders, Dio, Big Country and Jimmy Cliff. The promotor Jan Smeets is a full time professional, who has an experience of more than 15 years in the festival organization. Of the Scandinavian countries, Denmark seems to be the country of the festivals where every town has one of its own. The most important one of course is the Roskilde Festival which has a history of 12 years of good programming, with Lou Reed, Johnny Winter, Paul Young, New Order, James Blood Ulmer, The Alarm, Ina Deter Band and Telephone appearing this year. The festival is a three days festival, happening on the 29, 30th of June and July 1st. Apart from the Roskilde festival there are also the festivals in Skagen (every 4 years with the emphasis on folk but with some pop acts as well), Mittfyns, Vise. Gilleje and the one on the Isle of Fyn to name but a few. The 25th of August, there will be the Monsters of Rockfestival in Sweden, which gives a whole day of Heavy Metal acts and around the same period Norway will have its Isle Of Calfs festival and Finland the Turku festival

France has had it Reims Festival on May 31th and June 1nd with acts like TC Matic, Shriekback, Peter Hammill and Peter Blegvad And of course we should not forget Germany which has, especially the last few years, a couple of very interesting festivals lined up. This year there was the festival in Schuettdorf (Simple Minds, China Crisis and Marillion), the 25th of August the Lorelei festival will be again organized and at the moment the Germans-are treated on a package tour with Bob Dylan, Carlos Santana en John Baez (will Dylan sind Positively 4th Street again?), travelling around the major German cities. Some smaller festivals still worth to be mentioned are the ones organized in Switzerland like the St. Galen festival from the lst till the 3rd of July and the Festival in Nyon the 16th and 17th of June

CHART CHATTING ON THE EUROPEAN TOP 100

Not so many changes in the top 10 this week, Relax again to 1, Phil Collins back to nr. 2. Duran Duran moved up 6 places from 9 and Lionel Richie (and the blind young lady) feel their way back to nr. 7. Only Whon You Leave. No doubt many countries will be added the coming few weeks. Nick Heyward made quiet) a successful career after his departure from Haircut 100, his single Love All Day comes in this week at 75. Alphaville's follow-up to Big In Japan, Sounds Like A Melody made an entry at 86 this week, only due to Germany. Looking at all the tips from our correspondents, there is no doubt this record will make some big jumps in a few weeks time. There is some significant chart movement for the two guys from Blancmange with their synthy hit Don't Tell Me. They move up from 36 to 23 this week. Cyndi Lauper, the ex-babydoil from Blue Angel (who had a modest hit with I'm Gonna Be Strong a few years ago) moves up no less than 40 places this week with her follow-up Time After Time. A third single is on its way (Money Changes Everything) (..indeed), Due to England new band Bronski Beat move up from 72 to nr. 14 for the 3rd week.

The battle between RAF (or RAFF as they are called in Germany, problably due to the touchy association with the terrorlst organization Roten Armee Fraktion) and Laura Branigan doesn't seem to be over yet. Both versions are top 3 in Germany but due to the top 5 position in Italy RAF is still taking the highest rank in the European Top 100 singles. And than, from France, comes Axel Bauer who went up to 48 this week from 58 with the lovely Cargo. Unbelievable that until now nobody has made a cover of the song yet. The Naughty boys from Madness move up with their 'umpteenth' single to 49 (from 62). Though England is already enjoying the third single from the critically acclaimed album Human Racing from Nik Kershaw (I Won't Let The Sun Go Down On Me) his first single Wouldn't It Be Good moves up to 51 mainly due to Italy, Austria and Switzerland. The success of Bruce Springsteen Dancing In The Dark is a bit disappointing. It moves back to 44. Perhaps when his new album Born In The USA will be released, the single will go up as well. Rod The Mod moves up to 62, for the 3rd week due to UK and Ireland, but will soon be followed by the Benelux and Germany. His latest release Infatuation is according to sorne people Stewart at his best but according to yet other people a very poor composition.

Limahl had a nice hit with Too Much Trouble, while Kajagoogoo move up to 77 with their Turn Your Back On Me wich was last week the most popular video in Eurotiosheet.

Dutch acts are doing very well lately. First of all the Star Sisters who are now breaking with their Hooray For Hollywood not only in Holland but also in France (and they had a smash in France with Stars On 45 last year). Secondly the Art Company (in Holland called VOF De Kunst) not only nr. 1 in Greece, but now breaking in the UK and France as well. As mentioned earlier in our chart chat it was quiet surprising that the French picked up on the Shorts, the Dutch group consisting of boys not older than 15 and 16 years of age. Not only was Comment Ca Va a million seller, but their second one Je Suis Tu Es (I Am, You Are) is on its way to acquire the same status.

Back to the albums. The huge and impressive marketing campaign from recordcompany Island on Bob Marley and The Wailers really payed off. The album Legend is now already up to 10 (from 21 for the 4st week). Much chartmovement for Ultravox this week, they move up to 19 from 42 most probably due to the single Dancing With Tears In My Eyes (have you seen their doomed and fatal video clip?). Biggest movement on the European charts this week for the boys of Kajagoogoo. Their album Islands is only out for 3 weeks and is already up to 27. They moved up no less than 66 places!

Although it seems a bit boring, Chicago is already up to their 17th album. Despite the boring figures, their great single Stay The Night was most probably responsible for the big move-up of their album to 28. On 37 we find a title which is for most of the Europeans impossible to understand (it means something like 'between salted pie and beer' if we understand the Cologne dialect in which they are singing correctly). Their album is out for two weeks and made a new entry right at nr. 2 in Germany this week! BAP is a group that is extremely popular the last few years in Germany. They toured in almost every major city (in Germany and Holland). Their music is a mixture between the directness of Bob Dylan and the spirit of good time rock 'n roll. Flying Pickets who started their career with the cover of the Yazoo song Only You, come in at nr 60 this week with their new album Love Boys, wich is until now not tipped outside of the UK by any of our correspondents. Probably due to the tour that Udo Lindenberg and his Paning Orchester made the last few days with Bob Dylan, Carlos Santana and John Baez his album Goeterhammerung moved up to 68 this week, thanks to Germany.
