

## spotlight on

In our Spotlight we'll feature important radio or television personalities and their stations. One by one this will become a book of the top media people in Europe.

### STUDIO 105 - MILAN - ALEX PERONI (with Miguel Bosi)



Alex Peroni, an ex Economy student in Milan, started off his pioneer radio station STUDIO 105 back in February 1976. He and 6 other people built the station up with their own hands and only 3 years later they were No. 1 in Milan and growing fast. Now the station has moved onto network and the 7 people that started it have become 50 and ... "incredible but true, everyone brings home his money at the end of the day".

Alex is one of those people who continue to be enthusiastic on his work, his records and the people surrounding it. Months ago when we told him about our plans, of setting up a paper especially for the European media people, he was immediately into the idea. "Oh yes! You can call me every wednesday after 4 o' clock and I will tell you my favourite records". And that's what we did and what we still do every wednesday 16.15 pm.

Talking to Alex does not mean a strict telephone call about new entries, additions to the playlist and so on. No, it means chatting about records, the industry, holidays and hang-overs. One only has to take a look at some of the previous Eurotipsheets and you know exactly what we mean.

The way Studio 105 started is perhaps symbolic for Alex's personality. Listen to what this dynamic personality says:

"...The place where Studio 105 put his first cautious steps into the air was a tiny dusty garage in the suburbs of Milan where the sewer was giving back the rain when it was too much. In other words, every time it rained we had to pull on fishing boots, which is not really a hot dee-jay look, you know. Two days before we moved to our second site, it was the sixth day of a very intense rainy springtime week and the water was rising to my knees, the storm broke loose: it seemed that every piece of lightning wanted to have its way with the tiny garage. At last a particularly nasty one decided to finish its trip on our so-very-tired mixer and burned it just one second after I took my hands off it.


When we moved to our second site we found out that the owner of the place was a madman. The mysterious hand which was keeping on cutting the aerial every night was his; the reason being our supposed overdue rent!!"

Well, after all they managed to get on and are now regarded as one of the major stations in Italy. Although the record business in Italy is not too good compared to a few years ago, Alex is definitely not pessimistic about the future. "There is an Italian wave going on at the moment with artists like Gianna Nannini, Matia Bazar and Novecento. Our relation ship with the record companies is very positive. We collaborate with them if they want us to wait with a certain record or work more on it. But if we believe in something we will keep on playing it, we make the choice of our music and in that sense they have no influence. We get every support from them and if we want to have an artist in our show they are of great help in getting the artist to our studios. In this way we have had Duran Duran and Rod Stewart recently. And thanks to them we were very proud to have had the European premiere of the new Bruce Springsteen and Rod Stewart singles at the beginning of May this year."

Needless to say Alex and his colleagues are more than willing to tip their own made record 'Rio', sung in what they call a 'gramelop language', a language containing meaningless words ('Rio' is the only word that makes sense). They found out they were good singers and three weeks ago the record was released and according to Paolo Grandolini, producer of Studio 105, 'Rio' moves faster than any other record on the 105 charts. How peculiar...

**Violent Femmes - Hallowed Ground- Slash/ London**

Apparently as a reaction on the explosion of synth bands the last few years, there is a breeding ground for country (billy)/folk acts like The Alarm, R.E.M. and recently The Dream Syndicate, Rank & File and The Violent Femmes. "A brilliant solution to the problems of overkill", as one of the ads says. Indeed.



**The Gun Club - The Las Vegas Story - Animal/ Chrysalis**

Gun Club's frontman Jeffrey Lee Pierce first gained notoriety as president of the Debbie Harry fanclub. In 1980 he formed the band in L.A. together with Kic Congo who soon after went to the psychobilly band The Crammps. He's back on this one again and gee.. what a distinctive guitar sound this man has! Produced by Jeff Eyrich the band moves from their earlier voodoo-swamp to the more accessible essentials of rock 'n' roll. From a wonderful rendition of the George Gershwin's composition *My Man's Gone*, to the obsessed *Bad America*, resulting in the devilish *Moonlight Hotel*. I'm in for this gamble!



**Sheila E. - In The Glamorous Life- Warner**

Apart from doing session work for artists like Prince, George Duke, Herbie Hancock and Diana Ross, percussion player Sheila E. is further known through the two latin-rock albums she cut with her father Santana's Pete Escovedo. Now she's part of the Prince clan (the Starr Company, producing artists as The Time and Apollonia 6) and looking at the cover this will surprise nobody. Swinging and lean arrangements, punchy percussion and Prince like keyboards (*Oliver's House*, *The Bell Of St. Mark*) coupled with two almost classical orchestral themes evoking a fairy-tale like atmosphere (*Next Time Wipe The Lipstick Off Your Collar*, *Noon Rendezvous*).







## COCKTAILS AFTER MIDNIGHT



### Everything But The Girl - Eden- Blanco Y Negro

No style is sacred these days. Now this. Everything But The Girl return to soft cocktail jazz, as (each and) everyone was probably aware of after their debut single *Each And Everyone*, one of the most refreshing singles since long. But unfortunately a whole album is a bit too much as the material tends to complete anonymity in the long run. Oddly enough, a lot of the arrangements remind me of the early America and I am not quite sure if they like that comparison. It's hard to keep awake amongst such a collection of sleepy after midnight songs but I did find some lovely tunes in *Another Bridge* and *I Must Confess*.



### David Sylvian - Brilliant Trees- Virgin

After a long period of silence, David Sylvian, former frontman of Japan, launches his 1st solo album. Backed with all the ex-Japan members (except for Mick Karn), David presents us an excellent album with the emphasis on sober melancholic songs such as *Nostalgia*, *Weathered Wall* and *Brilliant Trees*. Highlight on the album is *Pulling Punches*, a funky song with strong bass lines and the characteristic drumstyle of Steve Jansen. Although the album may for some people be too introvert it definitely deserves wider public acceptance.



### Special AKA - In The Studio- Chrysalis

This album follows their much respected tribute to Nelson Mandela, the leader of the banned South African Liberation movement, who has been imprisoned in South Africa since 1962. A lot of the material on side 1 is in line with the material of the later (More) *Specials* and on the whole not that interesting (apart from perhaps *What I Like Most about You Is Your Girlfriend* - a favourite of Costello). On side 2 though Jerry Dammers seems to have grip on the material again. *Racist Friend*, *War Crimes* and *Alcohol* (Ray Davies?) are original pop songs and contending for a single release.

## NEXT NEWS CORNER

THE GUN CLUB (with their fingers firmly on the trigger!) released their first studio album since 1982 on July 29th, entitled *The Las Vegas Story*, with special guest appearance of MUSTANG DAVE ALVIN from the BLASTERS. The album was produced by JEFF EYRICH, who has previously worked with T-BONE-BURNETT, THE BLASTERS & RANK 'N' FILE among others ★ 22nd of June saw the release of a new single by MESSENGERS, entitled *Great Institutions*. It was released on MIDGE URE's Musicfest label Through Chrysalis Records and was also produced by Midge Ure. The Messengers are the first signing to his label and this is their second single. Their new single *Get It Out Of Your Head*, is heading for the same! ★ The Dutch band BRAAK released a mini album, entitled *Ik Weet Wat Je Lust (I Know What Your Taste Is)*. Their new single called *Lachen Met De Meiden (Laughing With The Girls)* was produced by WILLEM ENNES (known from his work for SOLUTION). Tourdates are soon to be announced in Holland - Belgium - Germany. Italy will probably release their new single too. (It will be sung in Italian, which makes things easier to understand. Occasionally the band is singing in English but they mainly handle the Dutch Language!) ★

RED HOT CHILLI PEPPERS released their selftitled album. Their power rapping vocals have made the band (following a quote from Julie: "A must to see among Hollywood Hipsters!") ★ NIGHTRANGER released their second album entitled *Midnight Madness*. Until now two singles have been drawn of from this album. First, *Sister Christian* & their current single *When You Close Your Eyes*, which enjoys a huge airplay in The States (well deserved by the way!). Brad, their very talented guitarist, helped out OZZY OSBORNE on his tour last year. Ozzy tried to recruit him for his band, but Brad wanted to stay on with NIGHTRANGER, as he believed strongly in their success; now proven that he made the right decision. Their first album *Dawn Patrol* was simply stunning (guitarwork like firework!). This new album should break them! *When You Close Your Eyes* has only been released

Amongst the guests who enjoyed champagne plus spectacular fireworks were Duran Duran, Frankie Goes To Hollywood, Spandau Ballet, Howard Jones, Andy Summer of the Police, Meatloaf, Marilyn, Imagination, Blancmange and many others. THOMPSON TWINS' new single *Sister Of Mercy* is currently high in all charts. In August and September an extensive US tour is about to start ★ Talking about parties, MUSIC BOX had a few great parties going on last week to celebrate their independence. First the launch of a movie channel 'Premiere', next day lunch at the Kensington Roof Gardens to demonstrate to the journalists from all over the world the new independent Music Box and evenings at London's Stringfellows, a direct on the air launch; button was pushed by Midge Ure of ULTRAVOX. A very successful party, well organized and pleasantly arranged. Good luck to all of MUSIC BOX!! ★

They finished their album ready for release in September. After his hit last summer **I Can Hear Your Heartbeat**, **CHRIS REA** has constantly been touring. This month he headlined the **Montreux Jazz Festival**. During August Chris will be writing on his new album - to be released early next year. Prior to that, he will go on a well earned holiday with his wife & 10 months old daughter **Joanne** (Chris' pride and joy). Chris has several TV's lined up in Ireland as he is very popular overthere. His next UK tour takes place in September. Tickets to the **SPRINGSTEEN** tour featuring **NILS LOFGREN**, went on sale at Meadowland area. Gigs will be played August 5th - 20th. 400.000 tickets were sold in only 28 hours in New York - It's amazing! But was to be expected, seeing **Springsteen & Lofgren** is an event not to miss anyway! Following their successful UK club dates, **SHRIEKBACK** are playing **Paradiso Amsterdam**, 10th of August, and 4 dates in The States, including **The Danceteria** in New York August 2nd, and 2 festivals in Belgium. **AL JARREAU** has his new album scheduled for release early August. **FRANK SINATRA** has his new album (produced by **QUINCY JONES**) scheduled for release August 13th, with the single **LA Is My Lady**, released end of July.
