





## RADIO GUIDE

### 20 YEARS PATIENCE

It took the wonderful Tina Turner 20 years of patience to reach it... but this month she made it to nr. 1 in the Billboard Hot 100 with her What's Love Got To Do With It. She may be one of the oldest artists appearing in our charts but still is one of the hottest acts around. With lots of airplay reported by the major European stations and the single at nr. 9 (from 10) on the European Top 100, she is really back on top here.

Talking about Julio Iglesias, it took him quite a while to break big in the USA, but after his two duet hits with Diana Ross and Willie Nelson, he now scores heavily on his own with the 1100 Bel Air Place album. This is one of the best selling albums on the other side of the Atlantic and should also get our utmost attention, as it already holds nr. 5 on our European Top 100 Albums charts with high placings in England, Germany, Belgium, Holland, Switzerland, Denmark, Norway, Sweden and his home country Spain. The single The Air That I Breathe, a former hit for The Hollies, was written by Albert Hammond, who acted as associate producer for the whole album. This will be Julio's biggest success and a European tour is upcoming. Hard Rock still has (too) little attention on Euro Radio. General sales of this music are not only constantly in high volumes but are in fact on the rise again. If you look on the European Albumcharts you will find high positions for

headbangers like Iron Maiden, The Scorpions, Ronnie James Dio, Motorhead, while (almost) hard rock albums by Survivor, Van Halen and ZZ Top are doing extremely well with the last 2 already holding top placings for a very long time. The U.K., German and French charts are always containing plenty of these blasting albums and we are reviewing 3 important new releases this week on our Review page. European needletime holds no relation to the popularity of heavy metal, so who wants to take some initiative?? And a new upcoming Canadian group Honeymoon Suite is predicted to become a major force on the Rockscene. They are presently touring the USA with strong hitpositions for their debut album and the first single New Girl Now, which is just released in Europe. With some more very strong single candidates (Burning in Love) on the album this is a must for deejays looking for new Rock talent.

### 4 IN A ROW

The last few years record labels have been able to get no less than 4 hit singles on one album. This has helped to bring already well selling acts to superstar status. Prime example is Lionel Richie with All Night Long, Running With The Night, Hello and Stuck On You all from the LP Can't Slow Down (with a 5th hit

Penny Lover upcoming?!); Boston based band The Cars have their most successful album Heartbeat City with the hits You Might Think, Why Can't I Have You, Hello Again and it looks like the new one Magic will make it four in a row. MCA's Nik Kershaw makes a great debut with Human Racing album containing the hits Wouldn't It Be Good, I Won't Let The Sun Go Down On Me, Dancing Girls and the new single Human Racing. (3 of his singles were in the German charts simultaneously).

### EURO-CROSSOVER

Records by Continental European artists are doing well on the European Charts. The great (sales)race for Euro hitsingle of 1984 is between German band Alphaville and Holland's Art Company. It looked like Alphaville was the real winner with Big In Japan finally breaking in the UK, but Art Company's Susanne is creeping up in many countries with possibly 1 million sales in France alone! This song originally was a hit in Holland in the Dutch language and the band then had an impossible Dutch name V.O.F. de Kunst. In any case Art Company still has to prove themselves not to be a one-off successband, while Alphaville already had 2 Eurohits with the third to come out now. Their strong debut album is released this week.



IRON MAIDEN started their worldtour with gigs already played in several countries amongst them Poland, Austria, Portugal & Spain etc, then onwards to the UK and back again to Europe. 28th of October, I'll go and get my ears blasted in Zwolle, Holland. ANDY SCOTT released his 2nd solo single for Statik records, entitled Let Her Dance, a rock/pop song with a Big Sound, also available on 7" & 12".
