




TURNTABLE TIPS



Joan Jett & The Blackhearts - Glorious Results Of A Misspent Youth- Epic
Joan has a tradition of recording original interpretations of classic songs like Woolly Bully (Sam the Sham), Shout (The Isley Brothers), Crimson & Clover (Tommy James) and this one contains a striking over as well: the Gary Glitter stomper *I Love You Love Me Love* supported by a funny and Disney-like video clip. The rest of the material on the album ranges from commercial powerpop to mainstream rock 'n roll, full with energy and unbridled optimism. Best tracks: *Cherry Bomb*, *New Orleans*.



Madonna - Like A Virgin- Sire
Preceded by a 7 and a superb 12 inch, here is, after some delay, the Nile Rogers produced 2nd album of New York's hot star Madonna. This album will move her undoubtedly from the borderline of stardom into real acclaim. And although there is no other track on the album so irresistible and commercial as *Like A Virgin* (with the exception perhaps of *Material Girl*), the overall production sound is more than magnificent and her vocal performance is distinctive and fresh. Best tracks include *Stay*, *Get Dressed* and *Angel*.



Lloyd Cole & The Commotions - Rattlesnakes- Polydor
Wonderful debut album of a Glaswegian band recently popping into the English charts with singles as *Perfect Skin* and *Forest Fire*. It's about time they do make some impact in other charts as well. Well crafted songs, measured arrangements and a vocal diction reminiscent of Lou Reed. And although the compositions do betray a predilection for people like Dylan and Reed, the material is that strong that comparisons are in fact senseless. Highly recommended album with no weak tracks.

WASP - W.A.S.P. Capitol
Looking at the album sleeve and knowing the single title one's tempted to be a bit negative. But listening to it makes you change your mind instantly. It's perfectly clear that we're dealing with a very good band who know how to play. Despite their image of blood & horror they even come to terms with emotions. They hit your ears with *Tormentor* & *On Your Knees!* Listen to *I Wanna Be Somebody* and you can bet your life they'll be somebody soon! Produced by Mike Varney and Blackie Lawless. Metal YES, Horror NO but mindblitzing!!



Armoured Saint - March Of The Saint- Chrysalis
This is their debut album, which when listening to leaves a different impression. A strong opening in the anthemic title track. While pounding through the songs, a classic approach of guitars in battle has been used. *Take A Turn*, a slower track, has exciting build-up solos. These axemen love their instruments and make full use of its power, their guitar sound is excellent. Produced by Michael James Jackson.



Queensryche - The Warning- EMI America
Queensryche adds a new dimension to the HM scene with their first album, different in more ways than one. The lyrics to their songs are as well written and thoroughly prepared as their arrangements. The sound produced is superb - along with the voice of Geoff Tate - strong & clear. Listen to *Take Hold Of The Flame* and you'll see all the pieces fall in place. Very untraditional use of instruments for HM, but listening to their tracks proves how Queensryche is on the way to becoming one of the better bands.





RADIO GUIDE

Biggest surprise this week on the European Airplay front is Nik Kershaw's victory on Stevie Wonder, who's single charted 13 consecutive weeks on the top of the European Airplay Top 50, though it must be stated that the difference between the two is only marginal in points. Other new additions on the European Airplay Top 50 this week for **Kool & The Gang** (no. 21), as expected **Alison Moyet** comes in high (at 27), the new **UB40** single Riddle Me at 28 and Italian duo **Albano & Romina Power** at 38 this week. Only one week after its release **Foreigner's** beautiful ballad I Wanna Know What Love Is (from their forthcoming album Agent Provocateur) enters the European Airplay Top 50 at no. 40. While the new **Jacksons** single Body cautiously comes in the lower regions of the English charts, their first single from the Victory album Torture is now breaking in France and therefore makes a (re)entry at 49 in the European Airplay List. Highest entries on the Singles Top 100 chart this week for **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** (30), **Claude Barzotti** (82) and **Big Country's** second single Where The Rose Is Sown at 89. Biggest moves in The European Top 100 Singles for **Madonna** (no less than 43 places) and **Frederic Francois'** big selling single moves further up to no. 27 this week (from 89). Some more movements for **Nik Kershaw** (43 to 21) and **The Eurythmics** (up to 14).

HUMAN VOICES

On the album front exciting things are happening. Highest entry (at 25) for **Jean-Michel Jarre** with his superb album Zoolook. Featured names on the album are **Adrian Belew**, **Laurie Anderson** and **Marcus Miller**. For this album Jean-Michel recorded a lot of human voices in languages ranging from Afghan to Eskimo, Gabonese to Sioux, edited and transformed by using different electronic devices.

Nik Kershaw comes in just after Jarre at 26, making him the artist with the most striking changes on all fronts: No. 1 in the Airplay beating **Stevie Wonder**, a fast moving single and the 2nd best album entry; and finally! **Huey Lewis'** concert tour through Europe paved off, the Sports album is charted in Germany, Denmark and Norway and is new this week in the Album Top 100 at 58; strong following on the heels of their very successful single The Wanderer (moving from 25 to 12 in the European Airplay this week), the compilation album of **Status Quo**, 12 Gold Bars Vol. II enters the European Album Top 100 at 73. Other new entries for **Al Jarreau** (81) and **Stevie Wonder** (compilation at 83). **Cliff Richard** has a new album out called the Rock Connection, containing his latest Shooting From The Heart as well as some striking covers of old rock 'n roll songs such as Little Richard's Lucille, Gene Vincent's Be Bop A Lula and a duet with Phil Everly called She Means Nothing To Me.

We should specially mention **Richard Clayderman**, the romantic piano player from France. At the moment he is charted with no less than 8 albums in 4 different countries!

Four different albums are charted in Belgium, One in France, Two in the UK, One in Germany and One in Italy. All with different titles and different track listings. If sales of these different lp's could be combined he would reach a high placing in our album charts.

X-MAS 1984

A new album for **Tracey Ullman** called You Caught Me Out on Stiff includes her latest two singles Sunglasses and Helpless, for which Peter Collins was again responsible for the production. Two corrections should be made on slight mistakes made in earlier issues. First of all **Fee Waybill** is not the ex-singer of the Tubes but still belongs to that group and a new album for Capitol produced by Todd Rundgren is scheduled for next January. The **Eurythmics** have not left their label RCA and are planning to record a new studio album for that label in the coming future, although their present hitsingle Sexcrime is on Virgin. One way to become aware that Christmas is coming very soon is to take a closer look at the release lists of the big companies: at present we have already received five singles of famous artists with some Christmas messages. First of all **Alvin Stardust** with So Near To Christmas (from his I Feel Like ... album, further containing the hits I Feel Like Buddy Holly and his current hitsingle I Won't Run Away); **Paul McCartney's** We All Stand Together, together with the Frog Chorus; **Queen's** tribute to these special days Thank God, It's Christmas; a high entry in the UK this week for **Gary Glitter** with his anthem Another Rock 'n Roll X-Mas; and last but certainly not least **Kenny Rogers** together with **Dolly Parton**



More and more European radio personalities are using the European Top 100 on the air!! And if you would like to join this growing group, we could gladly supply you with jingles, announcing the European Top 100 as well as your station identification. A number of shows play the Top 15 and mention the new entries of the Top 100 Singles list. Others use the European Top 3 and/or the Airplay Top 50. All in all there are now 43 European Radio and 4 TV stations using our information on the air and we thank you for your faith shown in our chart calculations.

Germany is using our Top 100 Singles/Albums on the air. Deejays like Joerg Eckrich (HR- Frankfurt), Wilfried Eckel (SR1- Saarbrücken), Claus Kruesken (BR- München), Horst Hartwich (SFB- Berlin/DEUTSCHE WELLE- Cologne), Joachim Bobzien (NDR- Hamburg), Wolfgang Jansen (DEUTSCHE WELLE) and Frank Vandenrath (BRF- Eupen) are all using the European charts in their programs. News sections and/or Top 3 are used by Axel P. Sommerfeld (RB- Bremen) and Peter Illman (BR- Munich).

In **Italy** Alex Peroni, program director of STUDIO 105, has a weekly program on Friday, starting at six, called the European Top 100 and it is repeated Saturday nights. Also in Italy, RADIO MONTESTELLA, which has a large chain of radio stations especially in the Northern part of Italy, has a weekly show based on the Top 100. Further Italian stations using the European charts (Singles, Albums as well as Airplay) include RADIO ONE in Florence, RADIO PETER FLOWERS in Milan, RADIO KISS KISS in Naples, RADIO SUBASIO in Assisi and RADIO BOLOGNA 101 while the popular Radio and TV guide SORRISI e CANZONE is printing this info as well. Stations using the Top 3 and/or our News sections on the air include RADIO T.I.R. and RADIO DEEJAY both based in Milan.

In **France** it is POSTE PARISIEN using both The Airplay Top 50 and the news sections on the air in a weekly program while WRTL's Gerard Nublat reports good use of The Top 100 Singles/Albums for his programming. In **Holland**, Frits Spits (NOS), who has the very popular daily Avondspits show each night mentions a different National Chart from a European country provided by EUROTIPSHEET. KRO's program chief Hubert Van Hoof is using the Top 3 in Europe to compile his 'Worldparade' while VERONICA uses the no. 1 in the European Top 100 Singles every Friday during the presentation of the Dutch Top 40. In **Belgium** Guy de Pre, dj/producer for BR2 West Vlaanderen reports good use of our news sections.

On the TV front, both Sky Skannel and Musibox have weekly programs on the European Top 100 going out each week as does KMP Musibox in München, Germany. Further Southwards, in **Spain**, Rafael Revert musical manager for SER RADIO MADRID is using the Top 3 in Europe on the air while his colleagues Paco Enrique (RADIO SEVILLA) and Jorge de Anton (RADIO ESPANA DE MADRID) are using the European charts on the air. In **Portugal** Luis Filipe Barros and Antonio

Sergio both from RADIO COMERCIAL in Lisbon are using the European charts in their shows. Their colleague Ana Christina uses the News sections for her programming. More Up North Pasi Saari from DISCONET in Turku, Finland is using the Airplay Top 50 and the News Sections for his disco programming. In **Switzerland** RADIO 24 and RADIO Z, both from Zurich, are using Airplay and news sections on the air while RSR in Geneva is using the Top 100 Singles. Leaves us with Austria where Guenther Lesjak (OE 3/ORF/BLUE DANUBE- Vienna) is using the Airplay and news sections on the air. His colleagues for OE3, Herbert Paget and Udo Huber report good use of the Top3 in Europe.

NEW CHARTS ADDED

French chart ratings have also been updated as reported in our issue of next week, and with the NIELSEN chart (combination of Europe 1, Canal Plus and Tele7jours), we will be able to give you a more accurate picture of France. This change is reflected in the singles chart. We are now combining the new chart with the various other lists (rack-jobbers; radios) and can thereby include more singles from the French market giving it equal chances to the other major European markets UK and Germany.

Belgium was another problem market as there existed a few different charts, but they never could give a clear picture of sales in all of **Belgium**. They either spotlighted the Flemish part or the French speaking part. The Belgian musicindustry has worked together and is now providing a new Top 50 Singles and Albums (HIT-PARADE OFFICIEL SABAM-SIBESA). Both the new French and the new Belgium charts are used from this week onwards in the calculations of our European Top 100 Singles and Albums.

EUROPEAN MEDIA SPECIAL

Our issue of December 17th will spotlight the development of the radio and television formats in Europe and also will give a number of spotlights on key experts. 

GERMANY CALLING

Most tipped records during the last two weeks in Germany re (for national product) The **Ace Cats** (Rockabella), **Muenchener Freiheit** (album: Herzschatz Einer Stadt) and **Spider Murphy Gang** (Sch-Bum) and **Nik Kershaw**, **Honeydrippers**, **Bryan Adams** and **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** for international single product, while there are strong reports on the albums for **Duran Duran**, **The Kinks** (Word Of Mouth), **Fee Waybill** (Read My Lips), **Wham!** and **Alison Moyet**.

Media Control, the well-known institute checking Airplay on all major German radio stations, reported that **Stevie Wonder**'s I Just Called To Say I Love You, received the highest number of plays in one week ever recorded in the German playlist history. No less than 145 times in one week the German radio audiences heard Stevie's Love Call.

Mal Sandocks hitparade, which celebrated its 25 years anniversary just recently, will no longer be broadcasted by WDR, the Cologne station. It was one of the few straight pop/rock/country programs existing on WDR and therefore the termination came as a surprise to the industry. German produced music continues to do well around the globe, with **Alphaville**'s Big In Japan reaching no. 1 on the US dance charts last week.

An act which doesn't reach big numbers internationally, but is an enormous seller in the German market, **Spider Murphy Gang**, just released a new single called Sch-Bum, which will be a big hit for them again.

Last week two of the biggest European television shows were recorded, both in Dortmund (Westfalen Hall) for ZDF Television. **Tommy's Popshow Extra** had an unbelievable line-up including (a.o.) Limahl, Spider Murphy Gang, Klaus Lage Band, Depeche Mode, Alice, Slade, Eddy Grant, Duran Duran, Gianna Nannini, Nena, Barclay James Harvest, Thompsons Twins, Spandau Ballet, Talk Talk, Billy Idol; the program will also be broadcast in other European markets as will be **Rock Pop in Concert**, produced by **Peter Baalke**. This last show contained strong rock groups like Bryan Adams, who certainly can claim victory after this performance in Germany; Spandau Ballet, who were flown over by Chrysalis especially from Japan where they were touring, which caused some fatigue problems for their drummer; further acts in this show were U2, Talk Talk, Italian artist Gianna Nannini and The Waterboys. The Cars cancelled their performance a week prior to the show.

NDR's Reinhold Kujawa, again produced a European Pop program, this time from Madrid. The program which in Germany is broadcasted by **NDR 2 Club**, is also taken over by BBC (German program), OES in Austria, RNE Madrid and in Budapest Hungary. It contains performances by both internationally known and local acts. The program NDR 2 Club exists 15 years and will have a 6 hr. live program from the Weser Emshalle in Oldenburg with acts appearing like Lake, Shakatak, Herbert Groenemeyer and Rodgau Monotones.

Andreas Vollenweider, the very successful CBS act released the third part of his trilogy called Wide Winds and this should follow the great successes of the former two albums.
