This week we want to put the spotlight on Top Italia Radio (TIR), very loyal

correspondents to Eurotipsheet.

At the moment there are more than 2,500 private radio stations in Italy Most of the stations have an American way of programming with their programs filled with music games and news. Heavy discussions have been going on in the media the last few months to reduce the number of private stations, but until now there is still no legislation controlling them. Top Italia Radio is the first radio circuit in Italy which ties together 100 radio's on a national level and the influence of TIR on the Italian radio world has grown substantially. The national production is divided into 4 daily sections: BUONGIORNO TIR (7:00 - 8:30); GRAN MATTINO (10:30 - 12:00); TUTTI INSIEME RADIOFONICAMENTE (14:30 - 16:00) and GRAN SERATA (17:30 - 19:00). This hour division leaves space for each local radio to program its own airplay. The cast of professional animators organize various programs on music, shows, news and holidays. These animators are more than DJ's. Their interest is the direct contact with the listener and with the vast selection of programs, to satisfy every type of

person.

Gianni de Berardinis Program Director, divides his time between radio
TIR and the private TV network Canale 5. Antonio De Via is the animator
for Gran Mattino. He used to be part of the cast of Radio and TV
Montecarlo and further to that, he is a highly quoted Journalist, speaker and dubber. Mauro Micheloni is one of the most known announcers for the national TV RAI (Discoring). For the section Buongiorno there is the sparkling Nicoletta Zema and the Italian Parade is under the thumb of Simona Ruggeri. Then there is Dido, Technical Director for TIR and Maurizio Palmeri with his particular musical verve. Last but not least the p.r. man Guido Robustelli, who takes care of the contacts with EUROTIPSHEET and is on the air every afternoon.

Prince is this week's best played album in Europe and despite some loss of piaces in the UK, he is climbing up the European Top 100 'ladder', from 19 till 10 in its second week. The USA For Africa album is the second best played album in Europe and moves further up to 19 in the European Top 100 Albums (from 33). The single by the way has a Top 3 position in no less than 11 European countries! Due to high positions in the UK, Germany and Holland, Mr. Bad Guy Freddy Mercury is new at 24, while the Eurythmics are second highest entry at 46.

Following the success of the So Far Away single and the upcoming world tour, Dire Straits' Alchemy is a re-entry this week at no. 50 due to France and the UK. But you should all receve your sample of their new Ip Brothers In Arms (See our CD pagel) this week. One of the hottest singles and albums in France at the moment is the French charity collective Chanteurs Sans Frontieres, with Ethiopie. It is France's 2nd Band Ald project and this one is exceeding the sales of the earlier single for Ethiopia, Tam Tam Pour l'Ethiopie (For details

see our Radio Guide issue no. 13). New to the weekly listings of our Album Route are, first of all, Miles Davis, world's greatest fusion artist; Lone Justice, cow-punk from L.A. and Nomo, an album filled with good songs (see also our review section). Chris Isaak (with his remarkable Roy Orbison diction) was already one of our favourite.



First of all, congratulations should go out to the Bobbysocks' La Det Swinge, the Norwegian winner for this years's 30th Eurovision Song Contest held in Gothenburg. This cheerful poppy tune even defeated this year's favourites Germany, (Wind- Fuer Alle) and Sweden (Kikki Danielsson- Bravi Prationer). Spanish, German and English (Let It Swing) versions have already been made and the original, very small record company (Bahama Records) suddenly sees itself in the middle of all attention. This year's contest was finally again a festival in which quality prevailed: of the 19 competing songs, no less than 14 got the maximum of 12 points from one of the voting countries.

Apart from Norway, the other Scandinavian countries Sweden and Finland both recieved high ratings of the jury (Sweden was 3rd and Finland 9th).

Let's see how international singles are doing in Scandinavia. The USA For Africa single is obviously the most popular single in the Scandinavian countries, charted high in 3 of the 4 countries. Although it is not charted in Finland yet, this is mainly due to the fact that Finland only publishes a monthly hitparade and we have no doubt this single will enter high next month. It is surprising to see that only two international singles are doing well in all 4

Scandinavian countries at the same time! Billy Ocean's Loverboy is popular in Sweden, Denmark and Finland, as is Foreigner's I Want To Know What Love Is.

GOSPEL-TINGED DISCO

This week's hottest additions to the European Airplay Top 50 are Paul Hardcastle (who's single 19 was our Sure Hit last week) and Steve Arrington. Feel So Real is the first single of the ex-Slave member that breaks in Europe First only available through import until Atlantic picked it up. The single is already a hit in the UK and is now spreading to the Benelux and Italy as well. This gospel-tinged disco song has a very danceable beat and was already for weeks at the top of our Maxi Route. We recommend you to check out his album Dancin' In The Key Of Life (thank you Stevie Wonder?), with other favourites such as Gasoline, and the titletrack. Other Hot Radio Adds are Bailey's new single, Modern Talking latest You Can Win If You Want and our favourite record, *Marcia Baila* by Rita Mitsouko (No, we will not stop talking about them!). A View To A Kill is Duran Duran's latest single, the theme song to the forthcoming James Bond movie of the same name. This commercial medium-tempo song has a very memorable chorus and was composed by the group together with long-time Bond musicmaster John Barry, who also produced the instrumental B-Side. COMPACT DISC ON EUROPEAN RADIO!



A GROWING PROGRAMMING PHENOMENON

The terrific boom in compact discs sales around the world in 1984 has led to a strong interest from the European media experts. There is no doubt amongst the leaders of the record industry that this new carrier will be of growing importance in the next few years. There are already those saying that the traditional ip will vanish but we believe this is still a long way off. Obviously there are a great number of advantages to compact disc and they are certainly not limited to the better sound quality alone. During the first years of OD existence record companies mainly pushed this "quality-sound" factor in all their marketing and advertisement campaigns. But lately more and more emphasis switched to the many other advantages of CD.

The worldwide sales of CD's could have been almost double already, if production capacities would have been sufficient, but no one could foresee the immediate impact on the public. Although during the first year of CD, sales mainly came from classical music, this picture is now drastically changing as the major labels succeed in releasing albums, cassettes and CD's of their major artist simultaneously. With the growing number of Eurostations using CD, we have decided to have a special CD section in Eurotipsheet every month. We will inform you about the progress of CD programming on radio and television. We will give you background on the technical development of CD hardware and spotlight good new CD product. As you can see we also print a recommendation list for CD's in popular music. The choices we make for that list are not too adventurous. This is because various European countries will only have their CD's a few weeks later than the major territories due to the production problems.

START OF A NEW SOUND ON RADIO

Various European radio stations were pioneers in programming CD's. Probably the first chain of stations to have a special CD program every week was Italian Radio Montestella, a chain of 80 stations. Alberto Crippa who was then head of programming introduced the new sound carrier to the Italian public and since then various other Italian stations have followed. Another major station which was concentrating on CD at a very early stage was TROS, Holland, still today they present a weekly CD program. There Is no doubt that many other countries have followed and we will inform you not only who has jumped on the CD band wagon but also how they use CD's, what special tracks they are playing and what kind of news they present to the audience of this new medium.

SPONSORING DIRE STRAITS

Philips has been the biggest force to push CD, like in the old days they did with cassettes. Not only have they developed popular hardware and also developed excellent machines for professional use by radio stations (see separate story). Due to their direct link with various production facilities they have been able to maximize sales through the availability of a wide range of repertoire. While last year there was still a very strong publicity specially focused on CD, the Polygram companies are now incorporating CD in their normal publicity for product. This also acknowledges the fact



that CD is now an intregal part of sound carrier turnover. However there are still special ways of promoting CD to a new audience and in one of their biggest campaigns ever, Polygram spending multi million dollars, sponsor the year-long world tour of Phonogram group Dire Straits, an act that already had very healthy sales on CD. A special marketing team has been formed to follow the world tour on a day-to-day basis and Philips is planning extensive television advertising campaigns in key markets. There is also a Philips' demonstration team accompanying the tour and they will arrange player demonstrations at the concert halls. A special CD including 4 Dire Straits' songs is presented to the retailers backed with an enormous amount of merchandising material including special stickers, posters, etc. etc. As you all know sponsoring rock tours has become quite fashionable in recent years but sofar they were mainly done by companies involved in jeans, beers, and soft drinks. This is the first sponsorship involving various sides of the music industry. Continued on Page > 7

GRAPHIC DISPLAY

The CD system also makes it possible to record additional text and graphic information on the disc which can be shown on a TV screen during replay, adding an extra dimension to the music. This information could show the words of a song, or a translation of them, for example. Supporting graphics such as a picture of the performer or animations could also be included. Information of this type can be recorded on channels on a CD which are at present not fully used, so it will have no effect on the disc's music capacity.






