

Kiev Connolly- Ariola
 Kiev Connolly, son of the Irish composer and actor Kevin Connolly, began his career in the Seventies with bands like The Warehouse Bluesband and Smog. In 1976 he joined the group Southern Comfort and for a period of over 4 years he toured all over the world. During one of the tours in Europe, he left the band and stayed in Berlin "Cause there's always something going on there". It was there where he started the band Missing Passengers, a ten-piece big band who's repertoire consists mainly of Kiev's own compositions. *Did She Tell You* shows the band from their best side: a full and energetic sound backed up with solid horns and Connolly's strong voice.
 One other Ariola artist who deserves to be mentioned is Udo Juergens. He had his first hit in 1960 with a song entitled *Jenny* and his international career started in '64 with his contribution to the Eurovision Song Contest entitled *Walk Away*. 1984 was really the crown year for Juergens with three further highlights of his long career: his new album *Hautnah* was in the charts for months (and was his best sold album in 6 years), his first book *Smoking And Blue Jeans* was a bestseller and sold 50.000 copies in the first four weeks after its publication and his concert tour 1984-85 became the most successful tour in his career.

THE SHARE OF FOREIGN MUSIC IN MAJOR GERMAN ARD STATIONS

Big debates are going on in the German media about the share of foreign music as played on the national German channels. Not only in Germany there are people who say that national radio should give far more attention to local products and should likewise decrease the amount of foreign (mostly UK and US) productions. A trend towards nationalism in music programming and the re-evaluation of one's own local product.

On most of the stations the share of foreign music has increased. Bayerischer Rundfunk lifted this share up to 0,42% in the year 1983, the SWF 1,11% and the NDR 1,28%. Striking exception to this upward movement is the DLF who gradually decreased its share of foreign music with 3,59%. The station that plays the most foreign music is the NDR, closely followed by SR, WDR and RIAS. It would be interested to find out how this situation is in other European countries and to see if this trend towards nationalism in music programming also exists on the same scale.

Basically it is all James Brown recycled and recycled all over with the emphasis on a live-ish atmosphere, filled with call and answer style rap (*Say What? Let's Get Small, Holler At Me, Numb To The Max* etc.) and live percussion. Some exponents: Troublefunk (*Drop The Bomb- Sugar Hill*), Pump Blenders (*Love Boat- Cool Tempo*), Chuck Brown And The Soul Searchers (*We Need Some Money- Mastermix*) and D.C. Allstars (*Bustin' Loose- Streetsound*)... Say What?!



Humpe/Humpe- WEA

One WEA act on which big hopes are set for 1985 are the sisters Humpe And Humpe. Anete & Inga Humpe, both living in Berlin, joined the band Neonbabies in 1978 and released 2 singles that year. In early '80 Anete formed a new band, Ideal, while sister Inga carried on with the Neonbabies. Ideal's album was released end of 1980, followed by their 1st German tour. This debut album went platinum for over 500,000 units. Anete & Inga joined forces with the Austrian duo Tauchen and Prokopetz to form DOF in 1983 Inga on vocals and Anete as producer. The single *Cado* earned gold in several European countries. In October 1984, they've started recordings for their album at Hansa Studios with producer Roma Baran (Laurie Anderson), with musicians like Martin Gore (Depeche Mode), Daniel Miller, Carol Coleman (King Creole), Phenix Horns, Jimmy Bralower (Madonna) and Sue Hadjopoulous (Joe Jackson). Last month their album entitled Humpe/Humpe was completed and will be out on the European market very soon.

Yello- Phonogram

The success story of the Swiss trio Yello strangely enough started with igning a deal in 1978 with an indie label based in San Francisco, where they released their debut album in '80, called *Solid Pleasure*. A few copies were imported to Germany, caught the attention of Phonogram, which resulted in a signing and the release of *Solid Pleasure* in '81. 1982 saw the release of the 2nd lp *Claro Que Si*, but 1983 was the big breakthrough with the album *You Gotta Say Yes To Another Excess*, consisting of 2 hitsingles. Meanwhile, Yello signed a deal for the UK and USA with Elektra Records. *Stella*, their 4th album has just been released. Creating a big buzz, the new single *Vicious Games* is expected to be their next sure hit. Currently *Stella* climbs to no 3 in the Swiss charts. (See also separate review).

Phonogram acts with new products coming up: *Ina Deter Band*, *Trio*, *Palais Schaumburg*, *Warlock*, *Blonker*, *Novalis*, *Electric Theatre* and *Boytronic*.

RADIO GUIDE

One of Europe's hottest releases at this moment is definitely *Some Like It Hot* by The Power Station, with a line-up consisting of John and Andy Taylor of Duran Duran, Robert Palmer on vocals and Chic drummer Tony Thompson (see separate story in last week's issue). The record itself is a nice mix of funk and rock and deserves some extra plays to get noticed. Another record heating up the airwaves at the moment is Tears For Fears' new album *Songs From The Big Chair*. With this second album the group establish themselves as one of the major bands of the Eighties with a long history yet to come. Their new single *Everybody Wants To Rule The World* has the same compelling quality as their last smash *Shout*. And we have so many more tracks we love, like *The Working Hour*, a song that gradually builds up into an irresistible sound with nice sax backings on the end; *I Believe* is dedicated to Robert Wyatt and the song has indeed the same vulnerable atmosphere of some of Wyatt's compositions; and finally *Head Over Heels*, another contender for rock radio (by the way, the cassette contains six more tracks than the album version!). Bob Geldof's initiative is getting an equal follow-up in the UK now, Jerry Dammers (of 2-Tone and Specials fame) organized a band-aid to assist famine relief in Africa with members of Madness, UB40, Afrosisac (Costello's backing vocal band) and two members of the original

Pioneers to do a re-make of the Pioneers' ska classic *Starvation* on the Madness owned Zarjazz label. The single is catchy, uptempo, has a good production and good chances to chart. Alison Moyet has a great single out called *That Old Devil Called Love* and there is some exciting product from the Simple Minds entitled *Don't You*, their contribution to the A&M Soundtrack *The Breakfast Club*. We are very glad that WEA released the Matt Bianco single *More Than I Can Bear*, it was always one of our favourites on their debut album. Another sure hit for Nik Kershaw, *Wide Boy*, very catchy and suitable for pop programming.

A COMPLETE DEPARTURE
One record that is very hot in the UK at the moment is Stephan Duffy's *Kiss Me*, it is a re-recorded version of the original single as it was released two years ago under the name of Tin Tin. The sound is now very much improved and should do equally good on the continent. Roman Holiday's new single *One Foot Back In Your Door* (from the Teachers soundtrack) sounds very Americanised and is in fact a complete departure from their earlier jive & swing style so prominent on their earlier releases. Agnetha Faltskog has a new single out called *I Won't Let You Go*, produced by ex-10 CC member Eric Stewart. The result is commercial and bound for AOR radio. English band The Fixx were extremely popular in the States but never broke in Europe. MCA tries again with the beautiful and atmospheric ballad *I Will* of their last *Phantoms* album, well suited for nighttime play. One record that should be released all over Europe is Loose

Ends' *Hangin' On A String*, a strong modern sounding disco record with nice percussion overdubs and Shalamar-type of vocals (check out the 12" version). Added to the European Airplay Top 50 this week is first of all the Austrian group Opus, their single *Live Is Life* is one of Austria's best played singles and is now getting heavy airplay in Germany as well. The single has a very live-ish atmosphere and does remind us of Art Company's hit of last year *Sussana*. Another hot radio add is *Let's Talk About Me* by the Alan Parsons Project which is closely followed by yet another Austrian band Relax (*Ein Weisses Blatt' i Papier*).

A NEW NO. 1
Other records that are new to the European Airplay include Bronski Beat's *Why* (due to heavy play in France), Alison Moyet and Eddy & The Soul Band with their rendition of Isaac Hayes' *Theme From "Shaft"*. Brand new on the market is the Geffen Soundtrack *Vision Quest*. Quite a commercial release with tracks from Journey, John Waite, The Style Council and two new tracks from Madonna (Gambler and Crazy For You). Their is a new no. 1 in the European Top 100 Singles, due to (a rather late) entry in the UK and France and movement in Germany; Philip Bailey jumps up from 18 to no. 1! Other fast movers include Commodores, Mick Jagger, Elaine Page & Barbara Dickson (new in Germany this week), King and Madonna (with Germany yet to come, the single will undoubtedly move up further). Most important new entries this week include *Midnight Star* (the second Solar act breaking in Europe?)

ABOUT THE CHARTS.....

THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):
 In many European countries one chart is recognised by the
 music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hit parade and is therefore
 used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP 100. However
 there are other countries where various charts are in existence
 and often equally important. For these countries we have
 compiled a number of these charts into one representing the
 sales in that market.
 Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to
 that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied
 by a factor determined through the latest known sales
 percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country
 holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different
 percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly
 provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such
 as IFPI-BPI-Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc. For the
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16
 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20 charts
 are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a
 few countries are too small to get their hits into the
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted
 in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE
 list each week.
 The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our

SUPPLIER OF A CONTINUOUS

FLOW OF INTERNATIONAL HITS

This is already the third of a series of articles around European markets and its artists that could have impact outside their own country. November 1984 saw the first article completely dedicated to Continental European Cross-Over Artists. Last week EUROTIPSHEET had a special on new English Artists and in this (Basic) issue we will take a closer look at the history of the German (pop)product and we will combine this with some spotlights on current international German stars. Later on this year more specials are to be expected on other European markets as well and one more on Germany is scheduled late '85.

credit ok?

Germany is without any doubt the major market on the continent responsible for quite a continuous flow of international hits. It stands ahead of England with regards to the yearly amount of album sales in Europe and is third best on singles. Not only is the German audience more willing than ever to hear English language music, but the climate for local product to chart elsewhere has seen an improvement over the last 3 to 4 years. On top of this, even local products sang in the German language were able to make impact in Europe and even in the US and Australia. And although the German chart is still filled with international products, the last two years surveys seem to indicate that the German audiences are taking a stand in favour of their own local products (see also the figures on page 6).

UNWILLINGNESS

Due to the unwillingness of the German audience to hear English language music, many American and British acts recorded German language versions of their songs. In the Fifties, people like Conny Francis and Wenda Jackson tried their own brand of German. Little Peggy March was even so successful that she decided to move and live in Germany. And even the Beatles recorded some of their earlier tunes in German. During their stay in Germany in the early 60's, when the Beatles played the Star Club in Hamburg, they inspired numerous German groups to write their own material. Among them were The Rattles, winners of a contest at the Star Club in 1963, who had their first hit Lalala two years later on. After supporting the

Beatles on their German tour, they were the first German band that toured England. Together with the Lords they were the best-known German group during the Sixties.


COSMOS SYNTHESIZER MUSIC

By the end of the Sixties, the German music scene was gradually developing. Influenced by American underground, groups like Kraftwerk and Can (Dusseldorf), Ash Ra Temple, Tangerine Dream and Amon Duul (with Klaus Schulze on drums) started to create their own music; often referred to as 'cosmos synthesiser music'.

After leaving Amon Duul in the early 70's, Klaus Schulze started a career as a synthesiser player. He was quite successful, but by 1975 the interest in his rather monotonous 'wall-to-wall music' and almost faded.

On the whole, one can say that in the first half of the Seventies many bands (Embryo, Curu Curu, Kraan, Grobschnitt, Novalis) played a symphonic kind of music, known abroad as Krautrock. But of course there were some exceptions. Some bands stuck to their British

EMI's no 1 singer. Artist of the year 1984, best album 1984 (according to the official analysis by Germany's leading trade magazine, Musikmarkt), 38 weeks in the official Top 10 charts: Herbert Groenemeyer, the 29 year-old actor and singer, is unquestionably the shooting star of 1984. No other German or international star sold so many records as he did during this period of time. The lp is called *4630 Bochum*, named after his home town, in the industrial mining heart of West Germany. His songs, however, go well beyond a sentimental, and at the same time, critical appraisal of the town with which he is now unmistakably identified, warning his audience of the dangers of living a life in a comfortable,

uncritical cocoon. In his hit single *Maenner (Men)* he throws the old cliché about masculinity at his listeners, makes them reconsider these autocratic attitudes. His career as an actor got off to a good start as one of the characters (Lieutenant Werner) in the world-famous motion picture (now also a successful full-length tv film) *Das Boot (The Boat)*. 1984 saw him sweep through Germany on one of the most successful rock tours of that year. A star is born...it is no exaggeration and there is no doubt that we are going to be hearing a lot more from this young man. Other important EMI releases include: **Klaus Lage Band** (album *Schweissperlen*); **Wolf Maahn** (album *Irgendwo In Deutschland*) and **Bap** (album *Zwische Salzbaeck Un Bier*).

and American examples; among them Frumpy with the excellent female singer Inga Rumpf. By the mid Seventies, at a low tide of the German music scene, a new phenomenon emerged: Udo Lindenberg, a rock singer with German lyrics (see separate story).

NEUE WELLE

But it was not until 1979, when the British punkwave invaded Germany, that the Neue Welle was born. A new generation of young


musicians with entirely new values stood up against the Establishment (including the establish music industry). Energy was the message! And Nina Hagen was one of Germans most promising products for export with her exciting blend of opera, rock and controversial lyrics.

But very soon many bands tried to get rid of the Anglo-American musical influences and developed their own German tradition. And although bands like Einsturzende Neubauten

and Kowalski never made any chart impact (and never intended to do so either) they built up a large cult following especially through their unique and shattering live sounds.



Other important CBS acts to look out for in 1985 are: **Spliff**, **The Ace Cats** and **Andreas Vollenweider**.

SHATTERING LIVE SOUNDS

In the late Seventies Germany was suddenly in the center of attention if it came to produce international hits. Kraftwerk even hit the English charts with the song *Autobahn*, Falco was the first Austrian artist to cross the Atlantic, his disco dance smash *Der Kommissar* was very popular in the US; Spider Murphy Gang had a hit in the Benelux with *Skandal Im Sperrbezirk* and of course Nena, Alphaville, Trio and Peter Schilling are the obvious examples of Germany's most successful popstars of the Eighties.

It remains to be seen if Germany can keep up its role of supplier of international hits (especially if the trend towards nationalism in music programming gets stronger) but a couple of promising acts are still there waiting to be picked up by the international audiences.

DO YOU KNOW THIS MAN



Udo Lindenberg - DGG/Polydor

One of Polydor's leading artists is Udo Lindenberg, who first appeared on the German scene in 1973 with *Andrea Doria*. Since then he recorded numerous other albums such as *Panische Naechte*, *Panische Zeite* and his first album on the Polydor label *Odysee* which went gold 3 months after its release.

In addition to this, Udo has done many highly successful tours in the federal republic and invited well-known performers to join him on the stage including Nina Hagen, Helen Schneider and Gianna Nannini.

1983 was a major year in Udo's career, he received the award of the golden album for *Odysee* (sales over 250,000 units in West Germany, a grant sell-out jubily concert to celebrate 10 years of the 'Panic Orchestra' where all the above mentioned ladies joined Udo to celebrate this special event held on West-Berlin's famous Wald Bushne. And if this was not enough, Udo's wish to perform in

East Germany came through when he was invited to play at a peace concert in the people's palace of the republic of East Berlin. After so many years of recognition in his own market it seems now that Udo has a fair chance to reach beyond the German borders; this single *Sonderzug Nach Pankow* (Chattanooga Choochoo) was a minor hit in the Benelux and his latest single *German's* has been released in the Benelux countries and will shortly be out in the UK.

Apart from his musical talents, Udo is an active member of the peace movement and a lot of his music and lyrics do refer to such issues. In fact he was one of the several German musicians who performed in public relinquishing all royalties for the Ethiopian cause. A single entitled *The Gruene Mauer* (The Green Wall) will be released (together with three other German artists, Hans Hartz, Rolf Zuchowski and Heinz-Rudolf Kunze) of which all the proceeds go to Africa.

Who says the German cannot laugh at themselves... Udo's rendering of *German's* proves they can...


Special mention should be made to two other very successful German artists, James Last and Nino de Angelo. James Last's career stretches from over 175 golden records to his outstanding ability to perform anything from Beatles' melodies to classical music.

Nino de Angelo earned gold discs in Germany, Austria, Switzerland and in France with his song *Jenseits From Eden*, further to that he was awarded with a golden record for the Italian version of this song *La Valle Del Eden* and in fact he hit the charts all over Europe, either with *Jenseits*, *La Valle* or the English version *Guardian Angel*. Tri-lingual Nino (German, Italian and English) has great potential and could be one of the stars for the future.





LOCAL PRODUCTS TO WATCH




Yello - Stella-Vertigo

With their 3rd album *You Gotta Say Yes To Another Access*, Yello made the final move to a wider audience; this new album continues this commercial line and it is fascinating to hear vocalist Dieter Meier and the musical brain Boris Blank in tracks like *Desire* (the single), *Stalakdrama* and *Domingo*. *Vicious Games* is quite simple as a composition but could produce the same effects as their last hit *I Love You*. Some songs are mini soundtracks in their own right and are even suitable for daily radio programming. Atmospheric and electronic music on a very high and intelligent level.



Al Corley - Square Rooms- Mercury

Instead of playing the highly praised role as Steven Carrington, the tormented son of an oil baron, Al Corley left the 'Dynasty' clan two years ago and took up the challenge to record a contemporary pop album. His single *Square Rooms* was a minor hit in some European countries (still no. 2 in France) and the follow-up *Over Me* is his next try. And although Corley is not a German artist in the true sense of the word, he was signed directly to Phonogram Germany and is therefore regarded by us as a local German artist with lots and lots of potential to chart on the continent.



Tom Petting Und Die Silhouetten- Echo Der Liebe- Schallten/Ariola

Tom Petting is one of Austria's leading rock journalists and also presenter of a daily midnight show on the Austrian National Channel OE 3. People that are willing to go beyond the threshold of the German lyrics could enjoy tracks like *Ein Stueck Von Himmel*, *Echo Der Liebe* and *Ich Und Du* where Petting shows himself to be a lover of romantic pop tunes. And although the production could be more adventurous and tends to be anonymous in the long run, this album deserves to be heard outside of the Austrian market.
