

DIRTY CHEAP ? ... NO! BUT CRAZY DC YES !!!

Although Hard Rock does not get heavy airplay on the radio, besides special features from time to time, it usually sells in big amounts, standing in an oneven relationship to the extent of media attention. Hard Rock concerts are mostly very well attended by a very loyal following of headbangers which proves there is a good market for this sort of music. Ofcourse there are exceptions, bands like Iron Maiden who hit the top of the European Top 100 with their album *Powerslave* (their single *Two Minutes To Midnight* even went to no. 1 in the UK) or Van Halen's *Jump*. The hard rock scene is however more flourishing in the USA where many of these groups get lots and lots of airplay and do not find the same trouble as in Europe making the charts. A group like Def Leppard are far more popular in the US than in their home country and even sold 4 million copies of their *Pyromania* album in the US alone. But remember, even the real Heroes like Bruce Springsteen started their career in a Heavy Metal Band. Unlikely? But true. Hard Rock can't be denied and has been around for ages and it'll stay as long as there is music!

MAKES YOUR TEETH CURL Some may ask, what's the difference? Well, a lot we dare say. Hardrock is in fact only one aspect of the headbangers scene, whereas it can be defied in Black Metal, Heavy Metal, Trash Metal (which quite likely makes your teeth curl), or the more melodic Hardrock, Rock or whatever the name may be. The real heavy boys are bands such as Dio, Helix, Accept, Iron Maiden, Kiss, AC/DC, Scorpions, Michael Schenker etc. Trash Metal like Motorhead, Slayer, Venom, Metal like Motorhead, Slayer, Venom, Metallica, Twisted Sister. Heavy Rock like Def Leppard, Lionheart, Nightranger, Whitesnake, Bon Jovi, Giuffria, Shy, Robin George, Survivor, Foreigner, and many others. Too many to name them all. But all with their own sharms and attractions. their own charms and attractions. Of course listing all these names is not enough to explain differences.

Metal versus Hardrock do differ in some respects. At first in tempo, secondly in melody. Metal usually has no synthesizers underlining the melody and drives mainly on speed, double bassdrums (fast & loud), hammering bass and guitars upfront. But best would be if one listens to records just to notice the difference clearly. Motorhead versus Bon Jovi, that should explain it surely!

Another fact is, up until not so long ago, Heavy Metal seemed to be the sort of music, that was a typical macho mans scene, but recently girls seemed to have entered the scene too. Take for example Girlschool, Lita Ford, Rockgodess, Lee Aaron, Joan Jett, Headpins, Warlock etc.

IN A STATE OF UNDRESS

Every week, singles and albums are released, with accompanying video clips, usually featuring the band in their well known leather gear, or ripped up T shirts, spike braceletts, and pretty girls who seem to be little slaves and more in a state of undress than dressed. But it all is part of the music. There's not one country around the world who hasn't got their own Metal heroes, even the Japanese have a very flourishing Metal scene (Earthshaker, Loudness etc.)

All in all it'll go on as long as there are guys or girls who like to use the guitar for what it's made for. Hit the strings hard, enjoy yourself on stage, and give the punters what they came for: METAL-ROCK.

From time to time we will pay attention to some of the major bands. And what better opportunity is there to start with AC/DC who will have their new album (their 10th!!) released this month? An album that undoubtedly will result in massive sales all around the world.

NON-STOP DELIRIUM

The history of AC/DC stretches over a period of more than 10 years and brought them many silver, golden and platinum awards. Without any doubt, they are the world's Number One Hardrock Band and are famous for their exciting live act. Against tons of decibels, lead guitarist Angus Young springs

back and forth across the stage decked in a school uniform (even carrying a satchel), jumps up onto the speakers, or ends up playing his solo on the back of vocalist Brian Johnsson. Their show is "non-stop delirium without absolutely no holds barred", they never take a step back and deliver full power and relentless

Their new album for Atlantic has just been released, entitled A Fly On The Wall. The first single drawn from it will be Danger and sees the band in a more restrained tempo than we're used to, although the basic "No Frills" attitude remains the same. But let us first take a few steps back into the history of this (re-VOLT-ing?) heavy metal outfit and follow the traces from the very beginning. And after? ... Play their new album at high voltage and there will be rock !!!

HYSTERIA-GENERATING PROPORTIONS

1974: AC/DC formed in Australia by Scottish-born brothers Angus and Malcolm Young, with the subsequent recruitment of vocalist Bon Scott, drummer Phil Rudd and bassist Mark Evans

1975: Their first Australian album High Voltage is released in February. Production is by the famed team of Vanda and Young (Ángus and Malcolm's older brother, George Young, and his partner Harry Vanda). Their second release Down Under T.N.T., appears in December. Both albums eam Australian platinum, gold and silver awards. Meanwhile, AC/DC's live following has reached hysteriagenerating proportions.

1976: AC/DC sign to a worldwide contract with Atlantic Records. Their first release for the

label, High Voltage, a compilation of the first two Australian albums, is unleashed. In the spring AC/DC arrive in the UK and takes the country by storm, with a similar reaction provoked across Europe. Before the end of the year, AC/DC have built up fervent American interest and release a second album, Dirty Deeds Done Dirt Cheap.

UNPARELLELED ENERGY

1977: The next AC/DC album, Let There Be Rock, released in June and is the band's first simultaneous worldwide release. In the summer, joined by British bassist Cliff Williams, AC/DC make their eagerly-anticipated debut US tour - a marathon journey which finds them criss-crossing the country, rapidly building true

grass roots support.

1978: Two new AC/DC albums release this year - Powerage (May) and their first live outing, If You Want Blood - You've Got It (November). Establishing a clear- cut pattern, each album far outsells its predecessor and the band's loyal following swells with each release. Credit for this is due to AC/DC's releatless assault on the global concert circuit, where they ear reputation for live shows of unparalleled energy and excitement.

1979: AC/DC change strategies for their new album. Moving their recording base to London, the band enlists famed producer Robert John 'Mutt' Lange and lays down Highway To Hell.

Released in July, it quickly emerges as the breakthrough album they had long been working towards. Their first US platinum seller its staggering success was repeated around

1980. In February the rock world is shocked and saddened by the sudden death of vocalist Bon Scott. After a period of reassessment, AC/ DC decide to continue and, after extensive auditions, discover the perfect match for their inimitable style in Geordie vocalist Brian Johnson. The first album with the new line-up Back In Black is recorded in the Bahamas and New York City. Released in July, it confirms AC/DC's ever-growing power with astonishing force, selling over eight million-plus copies worldwide. By the end of the year, AC/DC has garnered 27 platinum or gold album awards in eight countries.

HIGH VAULTAGE

1981: Due to industry and consumer demand, in March Atlantic releases the semi-legendary Dirty Deeds Done Dirty Cheap album in the US, where it had only previously been available on import. Despite the fact that it was recorded five years earlier, AC/DC interest is running at such a feverish pitch that it becomes a multi-platinum, Top Five US alburn, with heavy 'new lp' airplay to boot. By the middle of the year, AC/DC's entire US

American and worldwide sales. After just three weeks it becomes the first US album in the band's history to enter the hallowed multi-

platinum category.

1982: Following extensive global touring in support of For Those About To Rock We Salute You, AC/DC take a long-overdue break after literally years of non-stop recording and

performing.
1983: In August, Atlantic release the longawaited album, Flick Of The Switch, the first new album in 21 months. The band's first entirely self-produced effort, it was recorded at

Compass Point Studios at the Bahamas, with engineering and mixing by Tony Platt. Coinciding with the release of the album, Simon Wright, a 20-year-old Mancunian, joins as new drummer. Simon makes his debut with AC/DC on their North American tour, which stretches into 1984.

1984: Triumphant world tour culminates with a bill-topping appearance at the Castle Donington Monsters Of Rock Festival. 1985: New album A Fly On The Wall is released July 1st preceded by the single Danger. Stay tuned...

TRADITIONAL APPROACH

The accessibility and the more traditional song approach on the Talking Heads new album Little Creatures leads to greater acceptance on retail level compared to the live set Stop Making Sense; while the latter entered at 25 in the European Top 100 Albums, the Little Creatures album is new this week at 19 making it (together with Prince), the fourth highest entry an album ever made this year. Alan Parsons Project (new entry at 12), Tears For Fears (13) and Phil Collins and Dire Straits (both 15) all had higher album entries.

The other new entry this week for Sting (at 29), his album also belongs to the 2nd best played album in Europe: tracks like Russians, Love Is In The Seventh Wave and Fortress Around Your Heart are airplay favourites. Some deejay's also report good reactions on the Billy Holliday-like Moon Over Bourbon Street

as being very suitable for nighttime play. Other high entries for Mink DeVille (with the single Italian Shoes failing to make impact, it is good to see his album enter at 40) and OMD, their sixth album Crush is new at 65.


With the Kayleigh single still growing after every play, the Marillion Misplaced Childhood album is this week's fastest mover closely followed by the double live set of The Scorpions World Wide Life. The husband-and-wife duo Womack & Womack, release the follow-up to last year's beautiful Love Wars album. Although Radio M.U.S.C. Man lacks a strong single candidate, we recommend Strange And Funny, Eyes and No Relief. Summer is back (at least in some parts of Europe) and so are the Beach Boys! The perfect and distinctive harmonies have not lost anything of their impact and impress the most in tracks like Getcha Back, California Calling (a nostalgic surf trip) and the Stevie Wonder penned I Do Love You.

JAPANESE INDUSTRY

A-Ha, we were pleasantly surprised by the discovery of this Norwegian group on Warner with their synth based featherlight song Take On Me, produced by Alan Tamey. The song was no. 1 in the Norwegian charts last year, and it looks like becoming Norway's most successful export group after Bobbysocks. And there are more Euro-chartmakers... Dutch group Art Company release a strong infectious follow-up to their huge

European summer hit of last year, Susanna. This Is Your Life carries the same live-ish atmosphere, with the audience even more present now. Japanese industry will be very delighted to hear the new single Yama-ha by the 2 German sisters Humpe-Humpe; a funny vocal succession of Japan's most wellknown trade articles set against a sparkling electronic backing. You should also check out the Italian singer Gianni Togni with his mid-tempo moody song Giulia (CGD), another Italian summer romance hit.

A close-look at the European Airplay Top 50 learns that Euro talent still takes dominant positions; with renewed interest from the UK, Live Is Life from Opus not only continues to be one of Europe's best played singles, it also dethroned the USA charity single from its no 1 position (where it stayed for 10 consecutive weeks). This marks the first time that a local hit reaches the topslot in Europe in our history. Also from Austria comes Falco and he 'raps' himself to the top 10. Dutch pride Mai Tai make history as well, they have this week's best played single in the UK (!) and move further up the European Airplay charts to no 18 (29).

And to top it all off, the hottest add for Euro- radio this week is also a Continental production, Axel F by German artist Harold Faltermeyer is new at 25.

LOVING YOU

Taylor/Richards (of Queen fame) deliver their second successful moody and atmospheric production (after Jimmy Nail) this time for ex-Undertones singer Feargal Sharkey. Loving You is Frits Spits' record of the week and no doubt will be big in many territories. More down to earth material from Jeff Beck & Rod Stewart, the two legendary Sixties artists, who are re-united for the Impressions classic People Get Ready. Two more tips this week deserving your attention. After the indie success of UnAmerican Broadcasting the Swamplands' band Win deserve more success with the single You've Got The Power, a dynamic and lively track where the catchy vocals immediately strike. Check your local Virgin company for the single Big New Beginning by the Scottish band The Big Dish. Well-crafted acoustic pop cast in the same mould as Lloyd Cole.


