### **Radio Explosion Changes German Market**

Future Of TV Pop Shows Uncertain

by Cathy Inglis

Hamburg/Munich/Cologne- The current explosion of new radio stations in Germany is drastically changing the radio and record market. The present success in northern Germany of Radio Schleswig Holstein (RSH) (winning more than 40% of the listeners from NDR) and the addition of two other strong radios in the area, Radio Hamburg and FFN in Hanover, has not only broken the monopoly of NDR, but is also triggering off a number of

changes in personnel. At the same time the major FM stations in Bavaria, in existence for over a year now, continue to draw listeners away from BR. Over the next six months more than 30 new radios may emerge and this figure could rise to around 80 by the end of 1987. These will cover the whole German territory with the exception of the West and Berlin federal states which are both under socialist councils, a factor

### Voice Of America Loses Europe

Voice Of America (VOA) is to discontinue the direct broadcast to Western Europe of VOA Europe, the pop music channel. VOA, which mainly transmits news features, will continue to operate but the VOA European Service will gradually phase out its operations and cease actual broadcast by December 31st 1986.

"This is a decision," says Richard Carlson, director VOA, "that was difficult to make. By all accounts, this new service, which began broadcasting in October 1985 was well received by those young Europeans who tuned into it."

The decision came about because the present budgetary climate made it impossible for VOA to follow through the original mandate to expand the VOA Europe Service into vernacular services in the German, French, Italian and Spanish language. Carlson explained: "These measures would have added an additional \$4 million in start up costs for each language to our already depleted operating

Major record companies in Greece are engaging in what they describe as "an informal gentleman's agreement" to avoid undercutting each others television advertising campaigns. Results already show improved sales, say key

Vasos Tsimidopoulos, PolyGram Greece international repertoire manager, insists something had to be done. because previous simultaneous smallscreen advertising of rival hit albums meant "heavy casualties" among the titles. And Miltos Karadsas, CBS marketing manager, reckons the market was descending into "chaos". Now each ty-advertised album gets an equal chance, with overall sales results better

In Greece, some years ago, the tyadvertised compilation album emerged as the Greek labels' only effective marketing tool in what was a lingering aura of economic recession. Most product was of international repertoire. Says Neil Sarsfield, EMI's Athens-based chief for Greece and the Middle East: "People had less money to spend. Hit compilations enabled us to reach reasonable valumes?

### **Finnish Indie Radios Compete** by Kari Helopaltio

After operating for a little over a year, the two independent commercial radio stations in Helsinki, Finland, are running neck-and-neck in terms of listener ratings

Radio City emerges the more popular in the 12-34 age bracket, with its rock-orientated ad-lib style of programming, whereas Radio Ettan is having the better of the ratings with older listeners, with a format of easy listening, Top 40 and chat. But Radio Ettan is planning an injection of more rock to re-heat the ratings battle.

Financially, both stations spent their first year in the red, through insufficient advertising revenue and unexpectedly high running costs. But business is reported to have improved greatly during the summer months.

### German Vid Market Faces Piracy Boom

West German video firms are facing a new upsurge of piracy. Copyright society GVU says the industry is now losing 200 million dollars a year. despite increased efforts by police and GVU investigators which have led to nearly 500 criminal actions this year alone.

GVU chairman Wolf-Dieter Gramatke says excessive leniency by the courts is partly to blame. Despite last year's amended copyright legislation, and clear evidence that pirates are linked to organised crime, the most severe penalty handed down to date has been a 21 month suspended sentence. Most offenders receive fines which are far too small to act as a deterrent: one was caught again only

days after his court appearance. Illegal copies made by local pirates

pose an additional problem. GVU estimates there are now up to 1,000 neighbourhood video libraries in West Germany, most of them based in the urban industrial areas. Copies made from stolen film prints appear on the black market within days, and may sell thousands of units at up to 75 dollars apiece.

With an official six month window between theatrical and video release pirates can cream off most of the potential business before legitimate tapes are even released. So far around 15 neighbourhood libraries have been raided, and GVU/police action is being stepped up.

### The The's Infected Album Guarantees Major Media Buzz

Johnson's Cinematic Views Shift Away From Usual Pop Imagery

The release of The The's second LP sound like a Walt Disney record!", "Infected", the follow up to 1983's "Soul Mining", may well lead to some controversy, due to the unusual videos that will accompany all 8 tracks of the album. Shot in various locations all over the world like Peru, New York, Bolivia and Istanbul, the video images are quite explicit and radical in content. The The's sole member, Matt Johnson, has a powerful statement to make and his cinematic views are expressing his uncompromising and rebellious nature. Filmed by a team of directors, Tim Pope, Mark Romanek and Peter Christopherson, the swirling and powerful images depict the state of the human condition and civilization in all its aspects. Not traditional pop video imagery, but raw and naked shots with an overwhelming sense of realism. Sometimes violent, shattering and shocking, but always in line with his bitter and cynical lyrics. "The result is absolutely stunning", says Andy Frain, product manager of Epic. "Although it certainly won't be shown on children's TV, it

commented Andy Stevens, CBS head of International. "There is a real progression in his works and the album sounds more mature than ever",

Much of the sales of the first album (250.000 copies worldwide) were in part achieved by word of mouth, as Matt Johnson is keen on keeping a low profile. The new LP is already guaranteed of much publicity and it will go silver when it is released, as pre-orders have already exceeded 60,000

Somehow Matt Johnson automatically gets media coverage these days. The release of his first single for 3 years, Sweet Bird Of Truth, was a cause of some controversy between CBS and Johnson. The lyrics, about the thoughts of a US pilot as he is shot down over Arab territory (the song was actually written before the US bomb attacks on Libva), led CBS to believe it was better not to release the single. It was consequently deleted by CBS the day it was released and (as

definitely puts a strong message across. It is music and visuals for adults and the two go amazingly well

Musically speaking, Matt Johnson has grown over the years. His voice is bluesier than ever and the melodic touch of "Soul Mining" has shifted towards a more raw and pure sound. Pure emotion is at the heart of everything Johnson does and the album is a direct reflection of that. "Listening

"The album is a statement and our whole campaign is aimed at getting people talking about it"

Phonogram Act Attracts New Fans

'Slippery When Wet' hit the stores in the USA. Less than a month later it was certified platinum for sales of more than one million copies. Poly-Gram America's executive Vice President International Steve Pritchitt expects to reach the no. I spot in the Billboard Album Charts within a few weeks, with sales surpassing the 2 million mark well before Christmas. "In other words", Pritchitt enthuses, "this is a monster record."

Although it sometimes looks like hard rock bands can only achieve popular 'crossover' success in the States, Bon Jovi's story in Europe is also one of amazing success. 'You Give Love A Bad Name', the first single of 'Slippery When Wet', reached no. 14 in the UK, catapulting the album into the Top 10. Phonogram UK originially thought to sell 60,000 albums in the first three months of its release. As this figure has nearly been reached after only two weeks, product manager Dave Thorne had to adjust his expectations drastically. "It's a triumph of artistry", Thorne says about the collection of ten hard rocking songs on 'Slippery When Wet'. "Bon Jovi have the ability to play extremely well and write very good songs. There's a lot of heavy metal bands out there and people tend to

Phonogram International flew in record company and media people from all over Europe to showcase Warlock, Def Leppard, new signing The Scorpions, and their priority act Bon Jovi. Since then, things have gone very smoothly for the band. Going to press, the lp was 26 in the European Hot 100 Albums with good positions in the UK, Germany, Switzerland, Sweden and Finland, Phonogram Germany, obviously most affected by the 'Monsters Of Rock' concerts, surpassed after four weeks the original three-month sales expectations of 45,000. A remarkable result considering Bon Jovi's previous album '7800 Fahrenheit', that has so far sold just 35,000 copies in Germany.

Bon Jovi is currently touring the States, and will return to tour the UK in November - where all dates have already sold out, some in as short a time as six hours. A tour of the major cities in continental Europe is currently in



programming to attract the young, their previous monopoly now seems over. Some of the key radio executives are changing stations (see for details Moving Chairs, page 3) and this is adding to the existing turmoil. More media personality changes will be announced very soon from HR Frankfurt, SWF Baden Baden and Rias Berlin.

The German record industry has mixed feelings concerning this new shift in radio. On one hand they welcome the improved possibilities for promotion and the move towards a more modern style of programming, whilst at the same time they are expressing doubts concerning the declining singles sales. With the example of Italy (where too many radio stations ruined the singles market) they feel that the recent mushrooming of

stations have to pay for their samples and the German industry has even convinced such major stations as RTL and BRF to pay also. An element of criticism is being voiced regarding the fact that the new stations only play hits and oldies, not giving enough attention to newer acts.

At the same time the future of some of Germany's most popular pop tv shows is uncertain. It is already definite that Rolf Spinrads' nationwide 'Kangaroo' show and ZDF's 'Na So Was', presented by popular Thomas Gottschalk, will have their final broadcast in December. 'Kangeroo' was one of the most influential programmes for breaking artists but ratings went down during the last year. Spinrads may be doing a cabaret show next year while Gottschalk is rumoured to produce a Saturday night show.

The leading pop show for the German industry, Bavaria's 'Formel Eins' is also struggling for survival. The special structure of this programme,

### Springsteen Box Shows Maturing of Rock 'n Roll Superstar

Bruce Springsteen's manager Jon Landau treated the CBS attendees to an eight song preview of the 5-LP Springsteen Live Box, out mid November. "Springsteen Live is a different live album because it really shows the maturing of Bruce from the early club dates to the big stadium presentation during the 1985 Born In The USA tour," said Landau. 'I saw the future of rock 'n roll and his name is Bruce Springsteen' has not only become one of the most quoted lines by any rock 'n roll journalist, but has also proven to be a self-fulfilling prophecy.

Landau explained that the idea of a live album was discussed between Bruce and himself after practically each tour, but, he added: "the timing never felt quite right. After the Born In The USA tour we started to listen seriously for the first time to the many live tanes which we had and slowly the idea formed to do something different. We wanted to really cover the entire development; not only of Springsteen as an artist but also his whole maturing process"

It resulted in five albums of 3 1/2 hours length with an extremely powerful live sound. The remixing took 12 weeks and was done by Bob Clearmountain, "At one point", added Landau, "I felt unsure about the whole project as I feared it would take something away from people's memory of the uniqueness of Bruce Springsteen's concert, but friends who heard some of the finished mixes assured me it would just bring back these sweet memories". The special presentation for the CBS crowd included a one-off LA concert recording of 'War' as well as some of the famous Springsteen hits like 'Born In The USA', 'The River', and 'Born To

cessful black entertainers of the last 25 years; over 100 recordings for five different labels and making a glorious return last year with the Rocky IV track 'Living In America'. His new album for Scotti Bros, Gravity, marks another successful chapter in Brown's career. With the title track already on its way to become an airplay favourite on European radio, the Godfather's familiar brand of hot 'n hard funk gets an eighties styling by Dan Hartman in Let's Get Personal (co-written by Alison Moyet who can also be heard on the backing vocals), Turn Me Loose, I'm Dr. Feelgood and Goliath.

Miles Davis is one of the most influential jazz musicians of the last 25 years who started recording with CBS in 1957 and since then released some 30 albums as well as 4 compilations. He has shaped the course of modern music with albums like 'In A Silent Way' and 'Bitches Brew', by many regarded as the first successful attempts of fusing jazz with rock. Since then, his way of working has became more and more eclectic, mixing African roots with rock and jazz as well as covering pop singles, like last year's 'Time After Time' (Cyndi Lauper) and Michael Jackson's 'Human Nature'. After recording for nearly 20 years for CBS, Davis suddenly switches to Warner Brothers for a new album entitled Tutu. The album features eight instrumentals, mostly funky and jazz-rock themes plus one cover of a pop song: Scritti Politti's Perfect Way. Other recommended tracks include Don't Lose Your Mind and the moody Portia.

Miami Vice star Don Johnson tries his hands at a musical career and, what nobody honestly expected, not without success. On his debut for Epic Johnson surrounds himself with musicians like

Ron Wood, Stevie Ray Vaughan, Willie Nelson James Brown is undoubtedly one of the most sucand Bonnie Raitt. Johnson has a distinctive voice that, coupled with his enormous popularity as a tv personality can make the album a big seller.
