BBC/MTV ORGANISING 14-HOUR ROCK SHOW

Though precise details are being kept under wraps for a while, it is a firm fact that the BBC is planning a spectacular new rock television marathon for late May. While it's on the same star-packed lines as 'Live Aid', it is not a fund-raiser but will be 14 hours of through-the-night non-stop pop,

mostly video clips. The BBC is to work in partnership with MTV, the US pop/rock channel.

BBC insiders confirm that the special will start late evening, probably 10 p.m., on BBC-2, with a 120-minute show in the 'Arena' series.

SPAIN TO ACCEPT PRIVATE CHANNELS

Likely Involvement From Berlusconi

The Spanish government has agreed, in principle, to end the country's state television monopoly by permitting three private networks to start up. The cabinet sanctioned the scheme but it's delaying offering the new TV package to parliament until 'broad agreement' with opposition factions has been sought.


But already there's something of a rush from Spanish radio and general media groups to get in on the act. And it's noted that Silvio Berlusconi, the controversial Italian television entrepreneur, has recently bought a Spanish film studio which he is to use as a centre for television productions.

According to government sources,

the private channel concessions will be open to Spanish or EEC capital, with no limits on participation and allocated on 10-year renewable contracts.


Spain currently has two nationwide channels, both state-run, and various local channels backed by regional governments. But there has been a mounting campaign against the management of the state company, RTVE. According to government spokesman Javier Solana, there were long debates about whether there should be two or three private channels, but it was decided there should be three 'at least as a starter', taking

BELGIAN INDUSTRY JOINS HANDS

Decline In Record Sales Seems To Be Over

The Belgian record industry seems to be slightly recovering from the decline in sales that started a few years back. From 1984 to 1985 record sales have gone up and total profits have risen from 2.211.531.000 Bfr to 2.215.785.000 Bfr. A modest improvement is apparent since the negative consequences of an inflation of 4.9% are not accounted for. Nevertheless there is a growing optimism amongst the record industry leaders and as Bernard Carbonez, managing director RCA/Ariola Belgium, puts it: "Although optimism is a big word, we are glad to see sales going up and the fall back of 82-85 seems to be over. The rise of CD sales is spectacular

and the only thing that still worries me is the sharp decrease in singles sales. Especially since Belgium is traditionally a country where singles sales were always very good".

As the figure below clearly shows, the rise in Compact Discs sales is enormous and it represents nearly 10% of the total profits. These figures will only rise when the production capacities for CDs improve.

The Sibesa further reveals that sales of national repertoire have also seen a solid improvement; their share has gone up to 6.8%, now taking 4.7% of the total year turnover. Classical repertoire increased with 18%, 11% of total turnovers.

Flairck (EMI Boverma) is a Dutch instrumental group that specializes in combining the elements of folk, pop and classical music, to evoke an atmosphere that is hard to match by any other contemporaries. With the help of various acoustic instruments the group has, over the years, built up a reputation in Holland and abroad and picked up several awards and gold/platinum discs for their albums.

For their latest album *Sleight Of Hand* the group teamed up with Mike Batt and was vocally assisted by Maggie Reilly (on the photo the 3rd on the left). The 9 tracks on this album are of an amazing variety that could give the band a good basis for success abroad. On the opening track, *At The Black Smith's Hands - part 1* the group improvises on a traditional theme. The track gets an extra dimen-

sion by the use of sound coming from a smudy and where one thinks one is hearing a snare-drum it is however the sound of a gasburner! Maggie Reilly supplies the leading vocals and the song is the absolute highlight of the album. The band further proves its versatility with tracks like *Trick Of The Night* (written by Mike Batt and the current single), the group's tribute to Astor Piazzola *Seven Card Tango* and the misty *Thin Air*. The album is already released in Scandinavia and the GAS-countries and is about to be released in the rest of Europe. The group will also undertake a European tour in May. The band has a definite 'flair', touching upon many musical pathways and their fresh and talented musical concept deserve to be heard everywhere.

VID CLIP DEAL

Apart from these sales recoveries there are several other positive developments currently taking place in Belgium. Quite recently Sibesa, the Belgian national group of the IFPI, reached an agreement with RTL covering use of video clips for transmission to Belgium, Luxembourg, France and Germany. Basically the deal means that RTL will pay fees for video clip usage directly to the

producer on the basis of an average 4,500 Bfrs per clip per broadcast.

The fee will vary according to the length of the clip and the area of dissemination. The basis of the fee is roughly the same as that agreed with the Belgian State Television operations, RTB and BRT.

Alongside this development Sibesa/Sabam announced the launch of the first official Belgian hitparade.

Compiled with the help of Sabam on the basis of real sales of the whole Belgian industry, the chart tries to reflect the Belgian record industry market as closely as possible.

Published weekly in several French and Flemish language dailies, the hitparade is also recognised by the French language network RTBF as the official one. Every Friday and Sunday RTBF's Radio 21 broadcasts special one-hour shows around this hitparade. In the RTBF sports programme 'Top Time' it is also heavily featured. Its acceptance both on industry and radio/tv levels is a good step towards lessening the rigid borders between the two linguistic areas, the French and Dutch speaking communities.

While the BRT, the Dutch public broadcasting service, is still programming its own 'BRT Top 30', hopes are set that they will eventually go along with the Sibesa/Sabam hitparade.

"The Belgian record industry is at the moment very active and really joins hands when it comes to strengthening its market", says Bernard Carbonez. "For a moment we are forgetting we are competitors and are combining our forces to realise different projects. Currently there is a joint campaign on cassettes, whereby initially 30 retailers get a free cassette rack that should be placed clearly visibly in the shop. This combined

cassette action will be evaluated after 6 months and probably new retailers will be added."

MINI-12-INCH VERSIONS & VIDEO'S CBS SONGS HOLLAND B.V.



The Dutch formation Frank Boeijen Groep recently signed a contract with Ariola and their first single for the new label is entitled 'De Beloning' (The Reward). In 5 years the group has risen to become Holland's most popular band singing in their native language. Their music is characterized by a combination of intelligent lyrics, crafted pop melodies and fine musicianship.

NO CHART PROGRAMMME

With the cultural separation of Belgium into a Flemish and a French part, national radio likewise has a Flemish speaking radio station, BRT and a French one (RTBF). With the rise of pirate stations that attracted a vast amount of listeners away from the state-owned broadcasters the national channels came up with their own stations containing a programming close to that of the free radios. A few years ago RTBF started two channels inside its own company, Radio 21 and Radio Cite. Now only Radio 21 remains. In the Flemish part, Studio Brussel was instituted on the national channel. It seems that the national channels finally have won the battle with the free radios, most of which only have influence in their very restricted local areas (of the 100-plus, only 25 to 30 are really important).

Up until now, Belgium is the only country in Europe that does not have a pop programme based on charts. The two popular pop programmes, Villa Tempo (BRT) and Rox Box (RTBF) have an alternative way of programming which moves away from trends and where the emphasis

is not on clips and hitparade. It looks likely that this will change very soon. As Tom Huybrechts, producer for Villa Tempo explains: "There are plans to start a weekly programme on the BRT channel, a programme that is far more youth-orientated (and should therefore attract more viewers) than Villa Tempo was in the past. This new programme will be hitparade-orientated although having a different presentation and approach than the usual top 40 programmes."

Although this new initiative is very much welcomed by industry and media people, there are others who are afraid that this will cause the record industry to concentrate even more on foreign acts than ever. At the moment no real rock industry exists in Belgium and only a few of the Belgian acts are picking up attention abroad. "Personally", says Carbonez, "I am not in mourning for the so-called rock industry in Belgium. Much of it was a media hype and in terms of money we have seen almost nothing in return. This does not mean however that we will sign an act if it has potential, the budgets are there."

The fact that companies are not investing much money in the signing

of new talent is the reason that most of the local acts find it very hard to produce their own clips and to compete with their foreign counterparts. In order to face this competition the RTBF programme Rox Box has to start making clips for local acts. Eventually with the help of record companies hopes are set that these produced clips will be aired on other non-Belgian tv channels. As Ray Cokes, producer of Rox Box tv, concludes: "At the moment there are only a couple of exciting Belgian acts left. Nevertheless, all signs are very positive and a change is definitely in the air!"



With all the media attention surrounding the OST and the movie *Absolute Beginners*, **Bowie** still tops the European Airplay with the theme track. Although the **Stones** stick at no. 2, due to Bowie's competition, the Harlem Shuffle single still had an increase in airplay compared to last week. **Cliff & The Young Ones** are still assured of good airplay and *Living Doll* even hits top 5 European Airplay this week. The photogenic Norwegian lads **A-Ha** are so far only charted in the UK and Ireland, but picking up masses of airplay with their latest *Train Of Thought*. In only two weeks the single is already no 14 European Airplay. Things are going very fast with **Simple Minds** as well, a Hot Radio Add last week, this week *All The Things She Said* highest entry at 15 in the European Airplay.

And the Brits continue to do well with **Big Country's** latest Robin Millar produced single *Look Away* shooting up (18-28) and **Style Council's** contribution to *Absolute Beginners* from 41 to 19. As expected **Madonna** enters Airplay Top 50 as well, her moody ballad *Live To Tell* enters at 20. We are very happy to see the RCA duo **Wax** (combining the creative talents of Andrew Gold & Graham Gouldman) getting so many favourable reactions on European Radio. Their *Right Between The Eyes* single has mass-appeal and deserves to enter the European Hot 100 very soon.

Katrina & The Waves make a quest for the ultimate hook with their latest *Is That It*, climbing from 43 to 23 this week. Don't lose out on the **Siren** act **It's Immaterial**, their single *Driving Away From Home* should be played by you all!

Many programmers seem to have trouble pronouncing **Big Audio Dynamite** latest single *E=MC2*. This does not however prevent them from playing this impressive single and it moves from 48 to 31 in the European Airplay Top 50.

Will Magnet act **Kissing The Pink** finally take off in Europe? Eleven issues ago their glorious pop-rap *One Step* was already one of our Sure Hits. This week they make a modest entry at 48 in the European Airplay Top 50, but it certainly deserves a better treatment than this.

Talking about weird names... RAK is releasing a single by a band called **Johnny Hates Jazz**

and as the name rightly implies, this has nothing to do with Jazz. It is however a highly polished and soaring melody in the Fiction Factory/OMD-trail that is sure to pick up good Airplay.

Virgin releases **Peter Gabriel's** first single since his 'Shock The Monkey' LP from 1982. It is a new track from his forthcoming 5th solo album entitled **Sledgehammer**. The record has a full sound due to a three piece horn section and three female backing vocalists.

Singer **Candi McKenzie** makes her debut on WEA with the single *Turn Me Up*. A soulful single by the former backing vocalist of Bob Marley and Aswad, aptly produced by the production team of Swain & Jolley.

Dureco Holland is about to release the single *You Keep Me Hangin' On* (no relation to the famous Motown track) of the group **Gazuzu**. This act already picked up some success in Italy, Spain and Portugal with their earlier single 'Go Go Gorilla' and this electro dance ditty stands a good chance of continuing this success.

In the Hot 100 Singles, the most surprising move is **Stephanie** (de Monaco)'s *Irresistible*. This Valerie Dore-like disco tune moves into Top 10 this week.

ON THE BEACH

The summer really starts with the new, 8th album of ballad/rocker Chris Rea, entitled *On The Beach*. His hoarse and laid-back vocals coupled with the romantic soft pop arrangements again yield some stirring highlights. Try the nostalgic *Little Blonde Plaits* with its restrained rhythms and the Mark Knopfler-licks. And Rea continues his sense of perfection and sophistication in the closing tracks of the album, *Light Of Hope* and *Auf Immer Und Ewig*. The perfect album to play on long summer nights.

With the *Peter Gunn* single currently at 12 in the English charts, the *Art Of Noise* are releasing their first album through their new label partner China Records this week. Entitled *In Visible Silence*, the band sticks to its mysterious base, hardly giving any information about its members and the sometimes incomprehensible sleeve notes. However the music is what counts and the band knows how to impress with its collage of atmospheric and industrial sound-effects and the repetitive themes decorated with colourful arrangements. In some tracks the group even tends to 'muzak' (*Camilla*) but on the whole this is a very strong and interesting release.

Another group that is well-known for its intelligent use of synthesizers and its avant-garde way of producing is the Swiss formation *Yello*. Dieter Meier and Boris Blank specialize in the progressive electronic genre and their latest double album *Yello 1980-1985 (The New Mix In One Go)* gives a clear overview of their best works. Currently at no. 64 in the European Hot 100, the new album features the obvious hits like *Vicious Games*, *I Love You* and *Bostich* as well as the more obscure

Base For Alec and *Live At The Roxy*.

Multi-media performer **Laurie Anderson** delivers her most accessible album project with *Home Of The Brave*, the soundtrack to her latest film. It is a mixture of new versions of well known tracks like *Sharkey's Night* and the Nile Rodgers produced *Language Is A Virus* (especially the latter has an addictive quality that could yield the same novelty effect as 'O Superman', her first and only Top 40 single so far) and more recent material.

A good move for **Van Halen** (16-23), an album that is also a favourite on European Radio and tracks like *Why Can't This Be Love*, *Best Of Both Worlds* and *Dreams* pick up the best responses.



The biggest jump however is **Jean-Michel Jarre** with latest album *Rendez-Vous* (19-61) which we discussed extensively last week. Other moves for **Joe Jackson** (23-33), **Absolute Beginners** (24-53), **Pet Shop Boys** (29-48) and highest entry this week for the MCA OST *Out Of Africa* (already charted in Germany, Benelux, Spain and Denmark).

Swiss musician **Phil Carmen** enters the Hot 100 with *Wise Monkeys*, his *Metronome* album that we discussed in issue 12. His Californian influenced melodic pop is already charted in Germany and Holland.

Metal band **Judas Priest** come up with a new Tom Allom produced album, their 10th and their first for two years. The new album *Turbo* starts off very solidly with the track *Turbo Lover*, a definite stand out and other likely airplay candidates include *Lock In* and *Hot For Love*.

EURORADIO ALBUM SMASHES

This week's most played albums on European Radio.



UNITED KINGDOM

England has it's first ballad at no. 1 this year with **Georges Michael's** *A Different Corner* in three weeks up to no. 1. It puts the 3 weeks chart topper *Living Doll* back to no. 2 and **Falco's** *Amadeus* follows at 3. In turn, **Queen** cause a reshuffle of the Top 10 with *A Kind Of Magic* moving to 4 (from 7) and **A-Ha** are in the meantime no. 8. **Simple Minds** are this week's Top 10 newcomers (9-15, only in it's second week) and they have to share this feat with the two weeks runners **Big Country** (10-18). More two weeks runners include **Five Star** (14-36), **Siren** act **It's Immaterial** (check them out! 28-58), **Whitney Houston's** *Greatest Love Of All* (33-46) and **Force M.D.'s** with *Tender Love* (42-52).

Talking about **Force M.D.'s**, this gives the producers of that single, **Jimmy Jam** and **Terry Lewis** no-less than five charting singles in the UK. Apart from **Force M.D.'s**, these include **Janet Jackson's** *What Have You Done For Me Lately* (16-37), **S.O.S. Band's** *The Finest* (17-23), **Alexander O'Neal's** *A Broken Heart Can Mend* (65-56) and **Patti Austin's** *The Heat Of Heat* (76-79). This makes them the most in demand production team appearing in the English charts at the moment.

Susanne Vega's *Marlene On The Wall* is finally taking off: 27-40. Her debut album is also doing well: 38-74.

GERMANY

Gell for the 3rd week at no. 1, followed by **Bangles** and **S.S. Spufnik**. Biggest jump in the German charts for the Monacan Princess **Stephanie**, her *Irresistible* jumps from 64 to 8! The new melodic pop single of **Muenchener Freiheit** is also doing well (14-30) and **Queen** bring their *A Kind Of Magic* up to no. 15. Further good moves for **Culture Club** (23-35), **Joe Cocker** (30-41) and highest new entry at 32 for **George Michael**. Other entries for WEA act **Alphaville** (new at 37 with their latest single *Dance With Me*), **Erste Allgemeine Verunsicherung** with their follow up to *Ba-Ba-Bankueberfall* entitled *Maerchenprinz* entering at 39 and **Bronski Beat** at 47.

FRANCE

Gold remains at no. 1 for the third consecutive week, followed by **Survivor** and **Indochine's**

3eme Sexe. If **Stephanie** continues climbing as she currently is, she should be a strong contender for the top. Her *Ouragan* this week rises to 6 from 13. Other good moves for **Sandra** (10-16), and **Sabine Patarel** with *Les Betises* which is at 13 after only two weeks (from 26). The latest song to be released by **Daniel Balavoine**, *Sauver L'Amour* enters the French charts, as do **Jean Jacques Goldman's** *Pas Toi* and the **Rolling Stones**.

HOLLAND

Cliff & The Young Ones have reached the no. 1 spot of the Dutch hit parade after only 2 weeks. The Young Ones always were very popular comedians on the Dutch tv and what initially nobody expected to happen did; a very fast selling single (already having sold more than 60,000 copies in 2 weeks!) that this weeks puts **Falco's** *Jeanny* back to no. 2. **Prince** moves up to 3 (from 7) and **Brooklyn rapping trio Whistle** to 6. New in the top 10 is **George Michael** (9-13) and **Paul Hardcastle's** *Don't Waste My Time* is still a heavy favourite in Holland (11-14). **Queen** (13-19), **Sheila E.** (19-25), **Nicole** (21-31) and **Bruce And Bongo's** *Geil* (24-39) are this week's fast movers. BELGIUM

For the 2nd week at 1, **Cock Robin** followed by **Modern Talking** and **Madonna** (*Borderline*). **Culture Club** 'move' into top 10 (9-14) and Belgium follows in Holland's footsteps with **Falco's** *Jeanny* on his way to the top (10-16). **Virgin France** singer **Bill Baxter** is, after Monacan princess **Stephanie**, the best selling French artist (11-20). Fast movers for **George Michael** (17-38), **Gary Numan** (the live EP from 26 to 18) and **Brooklyn trio Whistle** (25-32).

SPAIN

Jennifer Rush's Spanish version of the *Power Of Love* is again at no. 1. Her *Si Tu Eres Mi Hombre* *Y Yo Tu Mujer* is followed by **Lionel Richie** and **Ole Ole** with *Lili Marlene*. In only its second week in the Spanish charts **Brother Louie** rises to no. 6 (from 16) and **Sigue Sigue Sputnik** climbs 17 notches up to no 7. Only 2 new entries this week: **Eartha Kitt** with *This Is My Life* and

Culture Club's *Move Away*.

SWITZERLAND

Lots of moves this week and while **Muenchener Freiheit** sticks at 1 **Eros Ramazzotti** follows at 2 and **Mr. Mister** continue their popularity with *Kyrie* currently at 3. **Bangles** make a big move (4-13) and **Bowie** hits Top 10 (8-20). In Italy they know how to appreciate good music as **Magnet** act **Kissing The Pink** is slowly climbing the Italian charts and have put their single *One Step* firmly at the 16th spot (from 25). More moves for **Billy Ocean** (19-27), **George Michael** (24-29) and **Culture Club** (new at 26).



Nik Kershaw's backing band, the Krew, have signed their own record deal with WEA and release their first single 'Paper Heroes' this week. They wrote the song themselves, Simon Boswell producing.

After the number one success of Cliff Richard & The Young Ones 'Living Doll', WEA is releasing a Comic Relief album recorded live at the Shaftesbury Theatre. It features performances by Bob Geldof, Midge Ure, The Young Ones themselves, Kate Bush, Howard Jones, Bonnie Tyler and many other familiar names in British comedy. WEA may also be releasing another Cliff/Young Ones single, a new and suitably off-the-wall version of Cliff's 'Summer Holiday'.

IMMC GALA WORLDCOVERAGE

More and more stations are broadcasting the IMMC new international talent and video award gala recorded May 10th during the 1st International Music & Media Conference in Montreux. Apart from live transmissions by BBC 2 England, Music Box and Swiss television the show will be seen by audiences on both sides of the Atlantic. In Canada, MuchMusic will take the show while in the US MTV will present a one-hour edit with

highlights. In Europe deals have been made with Italy, Spain, Denmark, Sweden, Yugoslavia, Portugal and France, where Antenne 2 will broadcast the show a few weeks after the recordings.

The superstar Golden Rose rock gala, produced by Michael Hurll will be edited into two 90 minutes shows and will reach an audience of 100 million viewers.

ENIGMA ESTABLISHES EUROPEAN BASE

Marketing Based On Long-Term Commitment

The US independent label Enigma Records recently opened its European offices in Amsterdam in order to keep a close eye on the development of its acts in the European market. As William Hein, director of Enigma explains: "The European market needs a complete other approach than the American. That is why we decided to establish a basis here in Amsterdam. Holland traditionally is the visor to Europe and a much better place to start our European operations than London." The label's principles William and Wesley Hein formed Green World Records in 1978, an independent record distribution company in California. In 1982 Enigma Records was founded as a separate division of Green World. In the meantime the label has already achieved considerable success with albums by Motley Crue (who were soon after signed to Elektra Records) and the local group Berlin whose debut album *Pleasure Victim* reached gold after signing with Geffen. The label continued to act as a developmental segment of the music industry: the independent as the platform to find and nurture new talent. In this way Enigma broke acts like Stryper, the quartet that combines clear-cut lyrics, inspirational leanings and the power and outfit of the heavy rock slant.

In 1985 the label started releasing soundtracks. It sold its shares in Green World and the company reformed as the Enigma Entertainment Corporation (EEC).

In September of last year EEC signed a deal with Ruud Jacobs of Boudisque Records, whereby all the company's material would be distributed by the Dutch indie. "Most of the US labels don't know anything about Europe and once they have signed to a major they still don't know what actually happens with their material. I offered Enigma an overall European marketing scheme, one that gave them the opportunity to follow their label material in a very early stage and to give acts the potential to grow over a long period of time," says Jacobs.

At the beginning of the year Andre Otto, once Phonogram International, was appointed as general manager of Enigma Europe. "The philosophy of the label is simple and has many ad-

vantages above working with a major," states Otto. "We are working with finished product that gets distribution via high qualified licencees who feel as committed and motivated as we are. The marketing and merchandising is developed from our headquarters and in this way there will be no initial cost for the individual territories. Each artist will have an outstanding chance to develop success in a very early stage and with lower and more realistic sales expectations, every licencee has the ability to work on a project for a much longer period of time."

Elton John collected two trophies in the 1985 Ivor Novello Awards ceremony in London, one for the best song musically and lyrically, 'Nikita', which he wrote with Bernie Taupin, and the other for his outstanding contribution to British music over the years.

The awards, which commemorate a legendary British actor/singer/composer, are organized by the British Academy of Songwriters, Composers & Authors, and sponsored by the Performing Right Society.

The judges named 'We Don't Need Another Hero', by Graham Lytle and Terry Britten, as best contem-

porary song and '19', by Paul Hardcastle, Mike Oldfield, Bill Couturie and Jonas McCord, as international hit of the year. Best-selling A-side was 'I Know Him So Well', by Tim Rice, Bjorn Ulvaeus and Benny Andersson.

Most performed work in 1985 was 'Easy Lover' by Phil Collins, Philip Bailey and Nathan East. Songwriter of the year was named by the panel of judges as Roland Orzabel, of Tears For Fears. Best tv/radio theme: 'Edge Of Darkness', by Eric Clapton and Michael Kamen. Best film theme/song: 'We Don't Need Another Hero'.

HELSINKI CABLE LAUNCHES MOVIE CHANNEL

Helsinki-Cable TV is at last launching its movie channel early summer this year, following the company's purchase of the year-old Filmnet from its founders Esselte and Filmnet Sweden.

The network plans to show 12 new feature films each month and then repeat them 10 times over the course of the following year. Sign-on fee for the service is \$90 and monthly sub-

scription is \$18.

Filmnet, which is to handle cable rights and payments, is the local arm of Filmnet International, which sells movie packages to cable and pay-tv networks and which has worldwide links with Paramount, MGM-UA, Universal, Columbia Pictures and Dutch firm VNU. Initial blockbusters on offer include 'Yentl' and 'On Golden Pond.'

CVP LINES UP NEW MUSIC SHOW

Magazine Format Should Appeal To All Ages

A new music show designed specifically for international tv markets is in preparation in London. A pilot programme under the working title 'Livewire London' has already been completed, and will be launched at the MIP-TV international tv market in Cannes later this month.

The company behind the project is Complex Visual Productions, a subsidiary of the Central London rehearsal facility The Complex whose client list includes many major rock names. Owner David Panton believes this ready access to top artists will prove a key factor in ensuring the programme's success.

Also involved are broadcast facilities house Trilion, which has considerable experience of rock production, and recently privatised telecommunications giant British Telecom, which is providing finance. Not entirely coincidentally, Telecom also operates a 'Livewire' dial-a-disc service in the UK. International sales will be handled by Richard Price TV Associates.

An initial series of 13 one-hour programmes is planned, presented jointly by Paul Gambaccini and Lesley-Ann Jones and produced by Rod Taylor, who has previously worked with Gambaccini on the Channel Four series 'The Other Side Of The Tracks'.

The programme will have a magazine format covering not only rock but also other areas of entertainment including the stage, film and video. "We're aiming for the ultimate entertainment magazine programme", says Panton. "We want it to be lively and watchable, but at the same time intelligent and in-depth. Unlike some tv pop shows we are not going for the teenagers so much as the 18-35-year-olds, though we hope we can appeal to all age groups".

The pilot programme includes tracks by Status Quo and the Blow Monkeys recorded live in The Complex's new Tom Hidley-designed Studio A, interviews with Jermaine Jackson, Virgin chief Richard Branson, and film and video director Ken Russell illustrated with music and clips, features on Corey Hart and Depeche Mode, and in a New Band Video spot, It's Immaterial's fast-rising chart single 'Driving Away From Home'.

"We've been talking about this project for 18 months," says Panton, the show's executive producer along with Lloyd Beiny, his partner in Complex Management. "With the facilities we have here and so many high calibre artists from Britain, Europe and the US coming in every day it just seemed an absolutely natural development to us."

The complete line-up of artists has finally been announced for Sound Waves, the series of Greenpeace concerts at the Royal Albert Hall in the week of April 21st-25th. Monday 21st will feature amongst others Nik Kershaw, Kim Wilde and Belouis Some. Tuesday 22nd has Lloyd Cole and the Commotions and Blancmange. On Wednesday 23rd Big Country will be

appearing, as will Mike Oldfield, The Men They Couldn't Hang and Judie Tzuke. Thursday 24th features Echo And The Bunnymen and China Crisis and the last night, Friday 25th, stars The Cure and The Waterboys. An impressive line-up of artists all appearing in a good cause.

Rock Over London was present last week at the launch of the Hear 'n' Aid project at the Hard Rock Cafe, just by Hyde Park. Many of the names on the 'Stars' single, which features some 40 heavy metal luminaries, were in attendance, as was Bob Geldof, who pointed out that the project will continue to embarrass the world's politicians as it raises yet more money for Ethiopian famine relief. The single will be followed by an album featuring tracks donated by Kiss, Rush, Dio, The Scorpions, Blue Oyster Cult, and even Jimi Hendrix; there'll also be a 30-minute video called 'Hear 'n' Aid: The Sessions', about the making of the record. Plus a whole range of Hear 'n' Aid merchandise will be available. ROL had a quick conversation with Judas Priest's Rob Halford, one of the British contributors, and we'll be airing that very shortly on the show.

The annual 'Help A London Child' appeal over the Easter weekend by London's Capital Radio (their morning man is ROL presenter Graham Dene) raised a record £145,000 for needy children and produced some interesting guest appearances, including one by Bryan Adams, who played a live and acoustic version of 'Cults Like A Knife' on an acoustic guitar owned by Pete Townshend, no less. Pete had brought the guitar in to be auctioned off for the appeal.

Not so much Rock Over London as Rumpus Over Paris recently, when Whitney Houston appeared live on France's live family music show 'Champs Elysee' and was confronted by the notorious French singer/composer Serge 'Je T'Aime' Gainsbourg telling her "I would like to ... you. You are not Reagan and I am not Gorbachov so we can do it". Interesting argument, that, we must try it sometime.

Needless to say the clean-living, Godfearing Ms Houston was most (continued on page 27)





DUTCH BROADCASTING SYSTEM: UNIQUE FOR ITS COMPLEXITY

Mounting Pressure On Government To Introduce Commercial TV

"Commercial tv? If we get the permission, we can start tomorrow. We are ready for it," reports Lex Harding, radio director of Veronica; a remark that is typical of the Dutch broadcasting system in which 8 different broadcasting organisations have to share one radio network, making it very hard for an organisation to build up its own identity.

Over the past few years, the Dutch media system has come under heavy fire from the English satellite services like Music Box and Sky Channel. Both used Holland as the stepping stone to Europe and Holland is the country with the most household connections in Europe at the moment. Due to this competition from abroad, the Dutch media had to find alternative ways to shake off the yoke of the complicated Dutch media laws.

Summing up the different intricacies of the Dutch media system is a cumbersome and often tedious task. The Dutch broadcasting system is divided amongst several organisations that have either political or religious backgrounds. Although this basis has been obscured over the last 10 to 15 years, all these organisations have to share the pop radio network, Radio 3. Since these organisations have been granted only limited time on this pop channel, most of them receive less than 1 full day's programming per week. Moreover as all have specific musical tastes, one can enjoy MOR on one day, while hearing rock or New Wave the next. It is obvious that these different styles of programming on the same national pop channel do not breed loyal audiences.

Of the 8 broadcasting organisations, 6 have A-status (more than 450,000 'supporters'; AVRO, Veronica, TROS, KRO, NCRV and VARA) and 2 have B-status (EO and VPRO). The biggest organisation at the moment is the AVRO with its MOR-type of programming (787,227 supporters), followed by TROS which claim to reflect the 'man in the street' (721,314 'supporters') and the fast growing Veronica which is very popular amongst the youngsters (650,000 'supporters').

Apart from this sharing of airing time, broadcasting organisations have to rotate their evenings every year. This means for example that the Christian NCRV, which this year had its weekly pop programme 'Popsjop' scheduled on Tuesdays, now has to

move to Sunday evenings which caused great problems for the organisation because Christians are not supposed to enjoy pop music on Sundays. This rotation system could in turn imply that the programme might have to disappear completely from the scene.

Despite all the hassles and complexities, many try to get around the system in a legal way. The Veronica organisation, always quick on the mark thanks to its pirate-background, has secured a deal with Europa TV, the satellite programme where various European broadcasting organisations co-operate. Their own weekly pop programme 'Countdown' is shown 5 times a week on the satellite. "This broadcasting system isn't the

Rock Me Amadeus that stayed for 3 consecutive weeks at the no. 1 spot in the Billboard Hot 100 and was a charttopper last year in many European countries. At the moment the single is top 5 in the UK. Falco's third LP, Falco III, is also produced by the two brothers and has already turned gold in the US. "We are getting one offer after another. The duo is a very in demand production team and they will be working with Giorgio Moroder on the new Amii Stewart album", says Hirschland.

most ideal one for consumers. With 2 evenings of TV and 60 hours radio we are looking for other ways to exploit our possibilities," Harding says vehemently. This programme is produced by Rob de Boer, who formerly worked for Veronica, for his new company Rob de Boer Productions. In this way Veronica is trying to break the rigidity of the Dutch system.

Others however have chosen for the illegal route of setting up pirate stations. And because the Dutch government is anxious to preserve the national broadcasting system and to safeguard it against commercial influences, many of these pirate stations have been raided and this can sometimes lead to amusing situations. One pirate station, for example, was broken up by the police, only to air again the next day. Some of those pirate stations have been both influential and trendsetting and the former pirate Amsterdam-based station Decibel, modeled after US Urban sound stations, even supplied 3 disc-jockeys to Veronica. Of the pirate stations that are still in existence, the most popular ones are those that air local repertoire, an area that is sometimes neglected by the national broadcasters.

There is mounting pressure on the Dutch parliament to introduce commercial broadcasting. Most of the political parties however want to preserve the cultural or political identity of the different broadcasters as most of the political parties have pressure groups in the Dutch media.
