Irish Singer/Songwriter Escapes Cult Status

Artists like Tina Turner, U2, Bob Dylan, Eric Clapton and Mark Knopfler are crazy over his songwriting talents, but although he has some devoted fans, his name is unknown to the wider audiences: we are talking about the contemporary Irish singer/songwriter Paul Brady, and if PolyGram have anything to do with it, his unknown status will change very soon. An impressive range of merchandising materials have been produced to support Brady's new album 'Primitive Dance'.

Brady's new album, 'Primitive Dance' which sports an exuberant and colourful work of art by Fraser Taylor on the cover, is out this week and features nine new recordings including the new single 'Eat The Peach', his own version of 'Paradise Is Here' and, to return a compliment to Tina Turner, a version of the like & Tina Turner classic It's Gonna Work Out Fine! With an eclectic style, ranging from energetic boogle and råb ('Soul Commotion', 'Work Out Fine') to moody and restrained folk/pop ('The Awakening', 'In Case Of Accidents'), everything is topped by Brady's warm and distinctive versions.

In May Brady is off on a 11

city tour through England, including a gig at London's Hammersmith Odeon, The UK tour will be followed by festival appearances in Europe: a proper European tour. including Germany, Holland, Austria, Switzerland, France, Belgium and Scandinavia, will follow in September/October. Tieing in with the album's stunning art-work, posters, tshirts and postcards have been produced. Other merchandising material includes a biopack for the cassette and a special CD single including

one extra track, 'The Loving Of A Stranger'.




Immaculate Fools, More Than 'Dumb Poets'

If there's one thing characterising A&M act Immaculate Fools, it's their penchant for richly textured, epic pop. After an absence of two years, the band, consisting of two sets of brothers (Kevin and Paul Weatherill & Andy and Peter Ross) are back with a second album, 'Dumb Poet', reviewed in M&M two weeks ago. While the UK press compares the talents of song-writer Kevin Weatherill with the works of Karl Wallinger (World Party) and Mark Hollis (Talk Talk), his style is also reminiscent of 70s 'art-rock' bands like Cockney Rebel. His passionate but sometimes affected vocals are the most prominent feature of the band's sound and the album yields highlights such as 'Don't Drive The Hope From My Heart', 'Tragic Comedy' and 'Dumb Poet'.

Formed in '83 the band released their debut album 'Hearts Of Fortune' in spring '85 and singles such as 'Immaculate Fools', 'Hearts Of Fortune' and 'Nothing Means Nothing' were culled from that album, establishing the band as a 'cult act' to watch. But the strains of rock and roll took its toll and the band had to cancel half of their '85 European tour when Kevin Weatherill became ill with a serious stomach disorder and not much has been heard of them since. But the 'dumb poets' are now back with a Russ Cullum produced album and the band will be playing in Montreux at the Pavillion on May 14, during International Music & Media Conference (IMMC) and a new full European tour is planned for early autumn.

Cut Backs Affect Video Production Companies

Hope In Store From CD Video ?

The first two or three months of a new year are traditionally a quiet time in the video production business, but this year has been quieter than ever. Although record companies are loathe to admit that they are no longer automatically granting a video budget for each artist, all acknowledge that they are becoming more 'selective'. Both video production companies and the record industry are feeling the pinch due mainly to the decrease in the singles market, and if the former are to survive they will have to rethink their strategies.

All parties concerned agree that clips are essential promotional tools but one effect of the cut back in the budgeting allocated to promos is that the emerging artists are those most likely to suffer. Established acts are usually guaranteed a clip, whereas new acts now require an individual approach and a tactical decision, which, for financial reasons, could well be negative.

The total promotion budget at Virgin in Germany is 7.5% of the total turnover, 2% of which is spent on video clips. Managing Director Udo Lange admits that they are now rethinking their policy decisons when it comes to promos. "We are trying to decrease costs and decisions are obviously hard when it comes to newcomers." Lange believes that videos may well decrease in importance and he points out that in some countries they are already less important then they used to be. In Holland, for example, television shows tend to ask artists to appear live and in Scandinavia

where there are so few promo outlets, the value of clips is negligible. If a video is needed for international exploitation. between £10,000 and £25,000 will be allocated for a promo, whereas German-speaking artists such as Nicki would not

warrant a clip.

CBS UK's Jonathan Morrish is of a different opinion and feels that videos are as important now as they have ever been. "There is no getting away from the fact that the music business is now aural and visual and we wouldn't want to get away from that stand point." CBS's video video manager, Geoff Goy, admits that the company is becoming more selective and also points out that the number of videos made in the industry are always on a par with the number of tv programmes showing videos in that particular country. In the UK there are few pop outlets and since the clips are made with the UK market in mind, the number of promos will never be excessively high.

"The number of videos are on a par with the number of TV pop programmes.

Video production companies in France are suffering more than most following the demise of TV6. Bruno Gerentes, Marketing Manager Domestic Repertoire Polydor France comments: "As there are now fewer pop possibilities, the volume of production has obviously diminished and many of our local production companies are having serious problems. The only ones to survive will be those who adapt to the situation and, from a financial point of view, are now turning to commercials and feature films to help them out. We are going

through a period of transition and have to resign ourselves to waiting for things to settle in the French industry.' Georges Bermann, Manag-

ing Director of Midi-Minuit, a leading production company based in Paris, is fairly outspoken on the disastrous consequences of the closure of the sixth channel. "It was not only a problem for the clip industry but for French creativity in general. It is tragic for French artists and will signify a lack of quality since productions will now come more and more from the US." Bermann had anticipated the National Commission on Communication & Freedom (CNCL)'s decision to change the format of TV6 ever since November last year, and his company has therefore turned to the production of fiction series

Although Germany's Bayaria Atelier's Andreas Thiesmeyer believes that the clip industry is not declining, only two clips this year have so far been made through Bavaria, whereas a total of 19 were produced at the studios in 1986. However he feels confident that further orders for clips will be received from record companies within the near future and that these are only pulling back from financial considerations and certainly not because they are not believed to be sufficiently viable promotional tool.

One of the few production companies to express unconditional optimism was DoRo Productions in Austria. This is largely thanks to the international reputation they have acquired due to their videos of Queen and Freddie Mercury. Says DoRo's Rudi Dolezal: "If we manage to get three international videos per annum of the same dimension of Queen our costs for the year will be covered." Dolezal realises that record companies are cutting costs in the German market, but points out that Modern Talking's 'Geronimo's Cadillac'.

which was not promoted by means of a clip, was significantly their only song not to reach the no. 1 position of the German charts. Whereas a Oueen promo could cost up to £100,000, the budget for a good German clip would only be £30.000. "In order to survive," says Dolezal, "people have to try to work efficiently from lower budgets which is a learning process that people have to go through. Sometimes only £10,000 is available for an Austrian artist and the directors and producers therefore have to be more flexible."

Although things possibly look grim, there is hope on the horizon. The advent of CD Video is expected to put pressure on the record companies to increase the production value of the clips. For the first time, record companies will be able to receive commercial remuneration from clips. "The minute you start having a commercial return by putting a clip out on a CD Video disc, the pressure relaxes and the clip is no longer of straight promotional value only," says Michael Kuhn, Head New Business Division Poly-Gram International. Kuhn points out that during a recent meeting with round 18 promo production companies, all were very enthusiastic about the advent of CD Video and, furthermore, many were opening up branches in Los Angeles where the video business is seemingly

Our singles guide last week caused some confusion as, due to an editorial mistake, one paragraph was put in the wrong place. Last week's reference to the highest entry in the European Airplay Top 50 and the Hot 100 Singles was obviously referring to Spagna's Call Me and not to Viktor Lazlo. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Madonna remains the reigning queen in the European Airplay with La Isla Bonita at the top for the fourth consecutive week. It is already her second top Airplay single this year, following the success of Open Your Heart and if the Latin tinged single remains the favourite on European radio, it could surpass this year's longest Airplay runner (5 weeks), Aretha & George's 'I Knew You Were Waiting'. Much of this however depends on the boost that U2's With Or Without You will get in the coming weeks; with the forthcoming tours and the continued success of the 'Joshua Tree' album (already at the top spot of the Hot 100 for seven consecutive weeks), the single might take the no. 1

Two English acts crash into the top 10 of the Airplay Top 50: Living In A Box moves from 17 to 8 with the tight funk pop single of the same name (their debut album has just been released this week. look out for the review in next week's issue), while Level 42's To Be With You Again moves up from 19 to 9 (the band's former single, 'Running In The Family' keeps a steady position in the top 20, after 14 weeks).

Former Teardrop Explodes' singer Julian Cope is suddenly picking up some good reports on the continent and his Eve's Volcano jumps from 26 to 17. Another good move for Italian Spagna with Call Me (20-25) and Swing Out Sister (26-30). Johnny Hates Jazz (29-34) and Five Star (30-38) are among the

Little Steven's Bitter Fruit, featuring salsa artist Ruben Blades on vocals, is the highest entry in the Airplay Top 50 this week. Coming from his forthcoming album 'Freedom - No Compromise', the single enters straight in at 31. Second best entry this week is for Gary

Although all at the lower end of the Airplay charts, many new entries including Depeche Mode's Strangelove, Cameo's Back & Forth and a cautious entry for Europe's Carrie.

Australian act Wa Wa Nee are extremely popular in their home country and the single Stimulation has just been released here in Europe as well. Going by their looks and video presentation, they are Australia's own Kajagoogoo and the single, a tight dance rock single, is certainly worth checking into. Watch for a 'Spotlight' in a future M&M issue.

Two good dance singles on Atlantic arrived on our desks this week: Sache's Are You Attracted To Me? and Merge (featuring Debbie A)'s Let's Have Some Fun. The former is a teasingly slow pop ballad with a suggestive, lazy chorus from an LA female trio, all aged 16. The latter has Madonna-like pop leanings coupled with an irresistable, cheerful drive.

Loyal readers of M&M's New Talent Section will certainly not have failed to notice our passion for current Scandinavian pop music. Apart from the obvious examples of Europe and A-Ha, there is so much happening - often unnoticed by other European countries. Mark our words, a new Scandinavian wave of pop acts is about to happen and one of the best representatives of that wave is Swedish duo Roxette. Roxette were featured in this section last year (see issue no. 36, September 13) with the single 'Never Ending Love' (EMI), a perfect pop pastiche. Since the release of that single things have gone extremely well for Marie Fredriksson and Per Gessle, with the single reaching gold status in Sweden and the album 'Pearls Of Passion', released some months later, selling over 140,000 copies (platinum).

EMI Sweden have just send us a special version of 'Pearls Of Passion' called 'Dance Passion', including new 12" versions of seven album tracks, including the two singles mentioned above. Listening to it, it only confirms the duo's status as Sweden's next big thing.

That fuelled the feeling that Mick had somehow snuck back to EMI and released a real powerhouse piece of rock & LP 'She Was Only A Grocer's

roll. But no - the connection is 'Broken English', the title of a Faithfull LP and the name of the mysterious band. Anyway, no matter who it is, it's a strong single - and the band are being managed by Colin Johnson, the man behind Status Quo for most of their extraordinary career. He tells us he hasn't felt so strongly about a new band since he parted company with Quo. The single was out in Britain on

U2 are to headline the largest ever open-air concert in Scotland. It takes place at the Murrayfield Stadium in Edinburgh on Saturday, August 1.

Bowie has added another football venue to his UK itinerary: Manchester City Football Ground, Maine Road, on July 14. Scottish foursome Wet Wet Wet make their international debut in the ROL Top 5 this week but already they've played six nights at Wembley Arena supporting Lionel Richie. The current release 'Wishing I Was Lucky' is their first single, produced and mixed by themselves with a little help from a chap called Wilf Smarties - they've also worked with soul producer Willie (Al Green/Tina Turner) Mitchell. From a small independent label to a major signing looks like these lads are headed in the right direction. Not bad considering they're only 21.

Rock Over London is the UK's weekly rock music showcase presented by DJ Graham Dene and syndicated to international radio. The programme goes across America, Canada, Australasia and the Far East with expansion into Europe planned for later this year.



Highlights

UNITED KINGDOM

Even Madonna's La Isla Bonita was not able to stop Starship going to the top and Madonna dropped to third place. In second position is Judy Boucher's smooth Can't Be With You Tonight. Labi Siffre's declaration against apartheid (Something Inside) So Strong and Level 42's To Be With You Again are the only additions to the top 10, jumping from 18 to 7 and 24 to 10 respectively. Other fast movers are Fleetwood Mac's Big Love (13-21), Cameo's Back And Forth (16-30), The Cult's Lil' Devil (17-32), Carey Johnson's Real Fashion Resease Style (31-25) and Wet Wet Wet with Wishing I Was Lucky. Important entries are Depeche Mode's Strangelove, Zodiac Mindwarp's Prime Mover, The Fall with There's A Ghost In My House (check the single sleeve for the beautiful hologram!), UB40's Watchdogs and Go West's I Want To Hear It From You. Nice to see too that Curiosity Killed The Cat's album Keep Your Distance entered straight in at no. 1 of the album charts and Suzanne Vega's Solitude Standing came straight in at no. 2.

GERMANY

The battle between Starship and Madonna continues in Germany and this week the latter is the winner: Madonna jumps to no. 1 while Starship sticks at 3. In second position is John Farnham. Additions to the top 10 are for Mental As Anything's song from the 'Crocodile Dundee' movie called Live It Up (6-13) and U2's With Or Without You (9-12) (their album the 'Joshua Tree' jumped to no. 1). The Miami Vice series track by Jan Hammer, Crockett's Theme is this week's fastest mover jumping from 46 to 20. Highest new entry is for Depeche Mode with a track from their forthcoming album (to be released in September) called Strangelove. Other entries are for Bonnie Bianco (Miss You'So), Fleetwood Mac, and Falco's title song from his latest album called Emotional. Highest entry in the album charts is Yello's One Second.

FRANCE

The French charts are quite steady this week: Licence IV is still on top followed by Tina Charles' I Love To Love. In third position is Francis Cabrel with H. Faudra La Leur Dire (coming from 4). The only new entry is Mel & Klm's Showing Out. Good jumps for Paul Simon's You Can Call Me Al (16-22), Emanuelle's Rien Que To Pour M'Endormir (Nothing But You To Send Me To Sleep)(21-26). Nick Kamen's Each Time You Break My Heart and Christine Roque with Premiers Frissons DAmour (35-40).

BELGIUM

Ferry Ald stick at one for the second consecutive week. At two are Med & Kim (Expectable) and in third position is Dutch Piet Veerman's Sating Home. Viktor Larlo's Breathless jumps from 18 to 13, and other good jumps are for Starship (44-22), Dutch Richenel with Tempatant (18-22), Prederie Prancios with Tit MAS Laisse and Level 42 with To Be With You Again. Four new entries: Claudio Cecchetto produced P4F with Medley Notorious/Ee Preak, La Compagnie Crede with ALE, Duran Durau and German duo Mixed Emotions' You With Low.

SPAIN

Communards' The Multimix is steady on top for the second consecutive week. The Multimix is a 12" with 'Don't Leave Me This Way'. 'So Cold The Night' and 'Disenchanted'. The maxi single has been released throughout Europe, but a just finished tour through Spain is the reason for the immense popularity of the track here. The singles So Cold The Night and Don't Leave Me This Way are still at 12 and 38 respectively. At no. 2 is Level 42's Running In The Family (their 'Lessons In Love' is still at 28 and their 'To Be With You Again' will probably enter next week). Europe's Final Countdown is in its 23rd week(!) still in third position. And Europe appears again at no. 11 with Rock The Night. Only three additions this week; Italian Silver Pozzoli enters at 35 with Pretty Baby, Mirage with a cover from Steve Silk Hurley's Jack Your Body enters at 45 and Orquestra Mondragon enters at 48 with Corazon De



time with CBS," comments Paul Hertog, Managing Director of Polydor Holland. "The image of cassettes here in Holland is very bad and consumer acceptance is low. We are just trying to study the impact of the CD single and I am not very keen on the idea of introducing another format. No, I'm not even going to investigate its possible success," says Hertog.

Juergen Otterstein, Market-

ing Director WEA Europe, is more cautious: "We are going to dip our toe in the water, at least in the major markets. We must look at all the opportunities to combat the declining singles sales market, a problem that is not confined to the UK market. Therefore it might be useful to study its effects: I will discuss it at our next workshop." And although not really crazy on the idea, Pierre Sissman, Marketing Manager CBS France, feels that if it works in the UK, the cassette single should at least be considered for France. "But it is a bit strange to talk about yet another format when we are only now concentrating on the CD single."

President of BMG International, Rudi Gassner, is equally restrained in his comments: "We are currently investigating on a global basis whether the single cassette is a meaningful and profitable way to counter the negative development of single sales in our industry."

Behind the idea of the UK introduction is Maurice Oberstein, Chairman & Chief Executive of PolyGram Leisure and former Chairman of British Phonographic Industry (BPI). Oberstein: "Singles are in irreversible decline. Teenagers are buying cassettes, which have overtaken LP sales, and there are some 30 million tape players in the UK Investigating cassette singles as a potential growth area is logical."

He proposes that all BPI member companies release cassette versions of any single which makes the Top 50. Packaging will be left to individual labels but conform to standard dimensions for ease of racking. Releases should carry up to 20 minutes of music and he supplied at existing 12" dealer prices, selling at just under £3.
