## Dutch A&M Sampler Goes European

Hilversum - Polydor Holland has launched an attractive dealer and consumer campaign to overcome the usual August lull. It has manufactured a premium four-track CD sampler, entitled *Female Attraction*, featuring four A&M artists: Joan Armatrading, Sam Brown, Amy Grant and Toni Childs. A consumer buying an LP or CD from one of these four artists receives the premium CD for free.

Window streamers, nationwide advertising and

standard advertising prints to be used by dealers, have been pressed into service to make this campaign a resounding success. The effort is the brainchild of Ruud Vinke, A&M Product Manager at Polydor and according to him, retail reactions have been very encouraging. The CD's initial run of 5000 sold overnight and the idea has now grown to pan-European dimensions as Germany, Switzerland and Sweden are to do similar campaigns. ■

## Regional Restructuring At PolyGram

London - Rather than being organised along label lines, PolyGram's Pop Division is to be structured regionally.

Following the resignation of its Pop Division President Mathieu Vanswoestel (who reputedly disagreed with the move away from A&R) and the dismissal of several other employees (see M&M issue 33), many of the company's former A&R functions will be disbanded.

"We will return to what has historically been PolyGram's greatest strength, namely 'decentralisation,'" says Wolfgang Munczinski, PolyGram's International PR Director. "Labels will be merged at an international level, and PolyGram will

concentrate on the marketing of its artists."

Regional Director A J Morris is temporarily running the company, and major announcements can be expected at any moment. PolyGram also operates a small office in Hamburg. How this will be affected by the changes is still unsure.

Currently, PolyGram employs four executives in the marketing field: Tom Steenberg (who formerly handled the Polydor labels); Adrian Berwick (Phonogram labels); Gibson Kemp (A&R & Artist Development); and Charles Shiddell, Director Marketing Services. ■

## World Beat Series For C4

London - A brand new music series for Channel 4 Television (C4) will focus on "global forms of pop", thereby confirming the current vogue in Europe for ethnic music. The series, provisionally known as "World Beat", will go out next January at 22.30 hours on Wednesdays.

Although the music will be wide ranging, black music will definitely feature, and a possible venue is Brixton Academy in London. The new series represents one of the first commissions for the Newcastle-based Zenith North, recently set up by former

Tyne-Tees Television programme chief Andrea Winton for an offshoot of the established Zenith Productions. Zenith's co-producers in London will be Spellbound Pictures, who will make the shows.

Spellbound's principals are Mick Sawyer, formerly with the now defunct pop show, 'The Tube', and Vivien Goldman, presenter of C4's 'Late Shift'. Goldman will also be one of the hosts of the new series. She cites Mory Kante's *Ye Ke Ye Ke* and Gipsy Kings as the kind of music they would like to feature. ■

European TV Indies Unite

Six European countries are uniting to form an alliance of independent TV producers. The organisation will cover all aspects of film and video production for television, including music programming. Called Co-Ordination Européenne Des Producteurs Independents (CEIP), it brings associations in West Germany, the UK, France, Belgium, Denmark and Italy under one umbrella.

The alliance follows months of planning between UK independents - who have succeeded in getting government support for a 25% airtime quota for independents on UK channels - and their

European colleagues. CEIP has two main objectives: to establish a code of practice for deals with broadcasting organisations, and to lobby governments of member countries, as well as the EEC Commission and the Council Of Europe.

First priority for CEIP will be to try to change the wording of the draft convention on television, due to be ratified by the Council Of Europe in November. CEIP wants to see a 'significant proportion' of European audiovisual works from independent producers. ■

MTV Is 'Support Act' To Maffay

MTV Europe is providing the support material for German rock artist Peter Maffay's current tour of Germany and Switzerland. During the tour MTV, which fulfilled the same role for Sting's last European tour, will screen 45 minutes of selected video clips, VJ segments and animations before each concert, and a further 20 in the interval.

Maffay's tour takes in Berlin,

Frankfurt and Munich - cities where MTV is already cable to some 500,000 homes - and closes in Zurich on October 9.

Meanwhile, clothing giant Levi Strauss has signed an advertising agreement with MTV. The agreement ties Levi to a three-year commitment and to the sponsorship of a weekly MTV programme - likely to be a non-music show. ■

Super's Autumn Schedule

Super channel is returning to 'stripped' or horizontal programming for their autumn schedule, with each programme having the same daily slot. September's Music Specials include Jamie Brown, Police, Prince, Eurythmics, Meatloaf and Tom Petty. New programmes consist of comedy and quiz shows and a Seoul Olympics Update, sponsored by Philips.

TRK is sponsoring Super Channel's show 'Amsterdam's Firafo'. The programme will be presented in Dutch with English subtitles, and will feature performances by Dutch bands, fashion shows and a 'Hot Spot' containing latest pop news updates. ■

Invicta Looks To France

Kent's independent station, Invicta Radio, has taken over the 'Tas Sale' sign and is looking closely at investing in French commercial radio. Recent talks with a number of stations in the Boulogne area are expected to lead to an announcement of a firm deal shortly. Invicta has, however, abandoned discussions with the RBL station in Boulogne regarding financial investment.

"We are on the acquisition trail," confirms Hugh Davies, Invicta's Marketing Manager, who has been closely involved with the station's return to profitability in the past few months. Not long ago Invicta was the

target of a number of UK commercial stations. Now, with audiences up by as much as 25% and local advertising solid, the station is no longer for sale. "There will certainly not be a takeover," assures Davies.

Instead, Invicta will continue to build on its new-style programming, which includes more music, shorter news and the introduction of a non-stop music hour from 18.00 to 19.00. The station will also be looking at ways of exploiting further the increasingly close links with the Continent, where Boulogne is only 35 minutes away by Hovercraft. ■

EEC Favors Vat Reduction

London - The record industry has received a welcome boost in its bid to secure a reduced rate of Value Added Tax on sound recordings in EEC territories. As the EEC Commission's plans to harmonise VAT rates throughout the community continue, industry support has come from the EEC's Economic and Social Committee (ECOSOC).

The committee decided that recordings should be taxed at the reduced rather than the standard rate (4.9% as opposed to 14.20%). In London, IFPI expressed its "delight," saying the ECOSOC decision implies the recognition of sound recordings and videograms as cultural material. ■

Simmons Joins BMG/RCA

New York - RCA Records and BMG Music International have finalised a deal with the newly-formed label, Simmons Records, to promote, market and distribute Simmons product worldwide.

Gene Simmons, who is still an active member of the rock group Kiss, formed the label a year ago. "Groups kept coming to me and crying on my shoulder. I wanted to help them make the records they believe in," he says. ■

# Manchester Airwaves Battle

Manchester - The battle for Manchester's airwaves is heating up. With Piccadilly Radio service to start its new Key FM service on September 3, BBC Radio Manchester plans to relaunch itself as GMR (Greater Manchester Radio) in October. GMR boss Martin Henfield, whose brother Mike is programme chief at neighbouring Red Rose in Preston, says GMR will target itself at a younger audience in future.

Piccadilly also faces increased competition from BBC Radio 1, which is extending its FM stereo coverage to Northwest England and other areas on September 1. Key FM will aim more at the album and CD buyer than the present service, which will be carried on AM. The stations will split for 19 hours a day. Key FM is also expected to carry elements of Virgin's Radio Radio nighttime service. ■

# HTV/TSW To Merge?

Rumours of a possible future merger between Wales' HTV and Television South West (TSW) have strengthened. TSW's Managing Director Harry Turner is quoted as saying his company "may well consider bidding for a single West franchise" if the ITV regional boundaries are changed.

At present, HTV provides the ITV regional service for Wales

and the West of England, while TSW covers the Southwest region. Combining the two areas is seen as inevitable by many observers if the companies are to survive competition from cable and satellite.

The link would be even stronger, some maintain, if Wales were made into a separate commercial franchise. In the past this has always been opposed by the broadcasting authorities. However, a proposed new Commercial Television Authority could accept radical changes in the boundaries if it is set up before 1992. ■

# Wider Service On Trent AM

Radio Trent is splitting frequencies on October 4, Chris Hughes, Trent's Senior Programming Executive, has confirmed. "Our new regional AM station, to be called Gem AM, will cover the whole area. Its target audience is the 30 to 60 age group and there will be good news coverage, events and chat shows as well as music," said Hughes.

The local FM stations (which include Leicester, Derby and Nottingham) will be aimed at a slightly younger market. Both services will be presenter-based.

Also from October 4, the station is extending its successful Asian programming from two to three hours a day. Hughes said the scheme has "worked in all ways: programming, financially, and in terms of the station's image." ■

# Confidence At County Sound

In its bid for the popular Oxford/Banbury franchise, Guildford-based County Sound has joined with Capital Radio, Blackwell's booksellers, and Oxford & County Newspapers.

County's Head Of News and Deputy Programme Controller Malcolm Deacon: "We are regarded by the industry as the front runner. There are seven consortia bidding for the franchise, and we are the richest and most experienced. We are very confident."

He pointed out that, despite its broadcast area being overlapped by both Capital Radio and LBC, County's ratings are high because it takes good account of its audience's needs. # Audience Shares Consolidated

Hamburg - A second radio audience survey within two months (issue 27) has been conducted in Hamburg. The latest one carried out by two science journalists from the University of Hamburg confirmed that state broadcaster NDR 2 has maintained its top position.

However it only picked up 37% of the audience share compared with 48% in June. This loss of listeners is one of the main reasons that NDR is restructuring (M&M 349).

Radio Hamburg (RHH) came in second place with 23% (no

change from 1987), while 1987's strongest contender, Radio Schleswig-Holstein (RSH), kept only 18% of the listenership this year. Radio 100, which started its 1987 tour to 10% of the city's music fans, NDR 1's regional programme "Welle Nord" and "Hamburg Welle" received 17% and 16% respectively, while even NDR 3, a classical music station, could boast 10%.

Because the survey was based on frequency of listening, accumulated percentages exceeded 100%.

## Increase In TV Licence Fee

Paris - To underline their commitment to public television, the French Ministry Of Communications & Culture is raising the licence fee by 6.9%. This will take the cost of a colour licence to FFr 541 and the black & white licence to FFr 346.

The Ministry is disturbed by the public channel's current dependence on advertising. Antenne 2, for example, takes 70% of its revenue from this source.

The extra revenue gained from the increased fee will be shared among TV channels. Antenne 2, FR3, satellite channel La Sept, and state radio stations Radio France and Radio France International.

The Ministry hopes that these channels will then be better equipped to fight the ever-increasing competition of private TV and radio. ■

Targeting an audience of locals and tourists, he intends to encourage economic and sponsorship links within the area. The scheduling comprises four main

areas: music, sport, economics and an information service covering eight-and-a-half hours per day, plus four hours of the station's own programming which will concentrate on local elements.

Financial backing is provided by a consortium of 13 shareholders. Major investors are Pierre & Vacances (11.33%), Campana's own company Lucie SA (8.85%), Secovia TV (8.83%), and Communication Development (11.33%). ■

Milan - The Italian record industry's bid for recovery is strengthening all the time, according to Giorgio Rignano, President of Dischi Ricordi and of AFI, the national IFPI group.

## Greece Defeats Piracy

London - Trade body IFPI (International Federation Of Phonographic Industries) has said its anti-piracy campaign in Greece has been a success.

When IFPI began its campaign, Greece's 1920 copyright legislation gave no real protection to rights owners. A Supreme Court resolution in 1983, however, stated that piracy 'amounted to forgery and fraud against the public' and allowed Greek criminal law to be applied. This automatically meant much

heavier penalties for offenders. According to IFPI legal adviser David Attard the ruling has had an 'astounding effect in reducing piracy'.

At the first trial where the ruling was applied, many pirates were convicted, with one operator being sent to jail for more than six years. Since then, hundreds of pirates have been successfully prosecuted and many thousands of cassettes confiscated, says Attard. ■

## Berlusconi Seeks Stake In Madrid TV

Madrid - Madrid's council has put forward a proposal for a local private TV channel which would cover the capital and its surroundings and reach a potential five million viewers.

## Network Chart Show In Denmark

Copenhagen - The UK's Network Chart Show, produced by Capital Radio and DJ David Jensen, will soon be heard on nearly 20 Danish local radio stations.

The show can already be heard on Copenhagen-based private radio station Uptown FM, and looks likely to be a success throughout Denmark. Capital

Radio's representatives in Denmark, Media Management, who are also the agents of leading US syndication company, Westwood One, are set to launch more new radio programmes in Denmark.

"We felt that with the recent legalisation of commercials in Denmark it was the right time to launch a show like the UK Network Chart," says Media Management's owner, Kurt Andersen. The company is still looking for more takers, but thinks a regular listenership of 250,000 is realistic.

The six minutes per hour of advertising that Denmark allows will be split 50/50. "Local stations can cover three of these minutes with local advertisers, while we will take care of the other three, concentrating on nationwide sponsors," says Andersen. It is likely that the show will be heard nationwide from September 1. ■

## Uptown Launches Twin Station

But now that our second station will be transmitting from the centre of town, the broadcasting scene in Copenhagen will be a lot healthier."

## Flemish Channel Gets Underway

The site for Vlaamse Televisie Maatschappij (VTM), the first commercial Flemish TV channel due to start in February 1989, was inaugurated in a ceremony attended by Flemish government officials on August 5.

VTM will have its offices in the new buildings, as well as two television studios. It will order the bulk of its programmes from production companies. Former Miss Belgium, Lynn Wesenbeek, was named first station host at the ceremony.

Nine newspaper editors (representing 85% of the Flemish press) was so far joined Director Jan Merckx in VTM.

Several cable distributors, however, have been discussing the practicalities of having VTM on their cable network by next February. Due to overcrowding on the Flemish cable network, it now seems that in about 16 regions in Flanders, either RTL-TV or TFI will have to leave to make way for VTM.

"We are not aware of such discussions," comments RTL Secretary-General Jacques Denore, "but it would seem fair to us that TFI should be the one to disappear, because we are in fact Belgian...10% of our viewers are Flemish, and the Flemish market provides 5% of our advertising." ■

## Benelux TV Needs More Cash

Hilversum - Benelux TV, the Dutch-language commercial satellite TV-station planned for early 1989, has been unable to raise sufficient funds.

The channel's founders Willem Van Kooten and Ad Ossendrijver had originally said they would not be looking for foreign investors. So far, however, the DFI 60-80 million needed to

get Benelux TV (also known as Kanaal 4) through the first year has failed to materialise.

Van Kooten and Ossendrijver had extensive talks with Dutch publishers, none of whom reacted positively. "In any event, they haven't come up with the money," said Ossendrijver. The only Dutch investors to date are corporations. ■

## Super-VHS Launched At 25th Firato

Amsterdam - The high point of the 25th Firato, the bi-annual international consumer audio and video fair, seems likely to be the Super-VHS system. The system is already on release in the US and Japan, but is new to Europe, and several companies will be displaying it.

Running from August 26 until September 4 at the RAI Exhibition Centre, Firato will attract some 178 exhibitors, of which Dutch-based electronics group Philips has the show's largest single stand.

Philips will introduce its first two CDV players, the CDV 475

and CDV 185. Simultaneously, Philips' subsidiary PolyGram, will present 12", 20" and 30" CDVs. Technics will launch the ultra-compact DAT recorder, the SV-MDI, although a price on this controversial player has not yet been set. Also on display will be large-screen television receivers.

Several Dutch broadcasters, including TROS, VARA, AVRO, Veronica, Cable 1 and Radio 10 will be doing live programmes from the event.



### SINGLE OF THE WEEK

**John Farnham**  
*Age Of Reason* - RCA

A swaying tune building to epic proportions and featuring the Australian's passionate vocals. Although it does not have the direct hook appeal as his last European smash, *You're The Voice*, you will find that this one definitely grows on you. A haunting track, richly textured and featuring a melodic piano solo that could have been played by label mate Bruce Hornsby. See next week's Spotlight for full details on the new LP.

### Jellybean

*Coming Back For More* - *Chrysalis*  
Sturdy, rollicking soul track convincingly sung by Richard Darr, byshire of Living In A Box fame.

### UB40

*Where Did I Go Wrong - Dep. Int./Virgin*  
A steady, comfortable beat moving along, to great effect.

### Level 42

*Heaven In My Hands* - *Polydor*  
Festive and funky single underpinned by that famous, ever pumping groove. From the forthcoming LP, *Staring At The Sun*.

### Vixen

*Edge Of A Broken Heart* - *Manhattan*  
Produced and arranged by Richard Marx, this flashy new American female band deliver a steamy and spicy tune, neat and ready for rock formats.

### Climie Fisher

*I Won't Bleed For You* - *EMI*  
Mid-tempo pop track by the highly talented British singer/song-writer/performer duo.

### Debut De Soiree

*Nuit De Folie* - *CBS*  
Mid-tempo love ballad in a Tiffany/Debbie Gibson mould. Strong hook and glossy production by Deodato.



The French equivalent of Modern Talking with a typical good-time summer hit; an inescapable hook and a nice pop rap in the middle (no. 1 in France). A massive European hit!

### Toni Childs

*Don't Walk Away* - *A&M*  
A very swinging R&B-like tune, fuelled by a solid beat and brass section and interrupted by an attractive short guitar break. The composition itself falls a bit short.

### A-Ha

*Touchy* - *Warner Brothers*  
Being tipped by many Euro-DJs for months now, this highly commercial track just cannot fail.

### Scritti Politti

*First Boy In Town* - *Virgin*  
Green Gartside's squeezed vocals and the slick, compressed beat combine into a highly accessible and easy-to-programme track.

### Midge Ure

*Answers To Nothing* - *Chrysalis*  
Underpinned by a massive tribal beat (courtesy Mark Brzezcki of Big Country), Ure returns in grand form with his first solo single since 1984's *I/I Was*. Much in the vein of the works of Rupert Hine.

### Brenda K Starr

*I Still Believe* - *MCA*  
Mid-tempo love ballad in a Tiffany/Debbie Gibson mould. Strong hook and glossy production by Deodato.

### Koreana

*Hand In Hand* - *Polydor*  
The official '88 Seoul Olympic song, performed and arranged with the usual pomp that fits such mass events. Produced and co-written by Giorgio Moroder.

### Billy Ocean

*The Colour Of Love* - *Jive*  
Sentimental and smouldering soul ballad in the typical Ocean style.



### ALBUM OF THE WEEK

**Eric B & Rakim**  
*Follow The Leader* - *Uni Records/MCA*  
Whereas many contemporary rap acts have long since proven to be one hit wonders, Eric B (carrier) and W Griffin (Rakim) seem to be here to stay. Underneath the rapping and scratching, there is always a strong melodic strain. Check out the pumping *Just A Beat* and *To The Listeners*. Written/produced by the duo, and with all music played by Rakim's brother, Stevie Blass Griffin, this is essential stuff.

### Rai Rebels

*Various Artists - Earthworks*  
Debut album by Lancaster, South Carolina (US), based white rap trio. Fine mix of soul, funk, reggae and heavy metal with cool scratching, sampling and rapping. Cover samples include Wild Cherry's 1976 hit *Play That Funky Music*. This is hardcore, is it not? The rap ballad *Only A Dream* is a surprise and reminiscent of LL Cool J's *I Need Love*. Definitely chilling: *We Live To Rock and Listen Up*.

### Cheb Khaled & Safy Boutella

*Kutche* - *Zone Music*  
More Rai from two of its most acclaimed exponents. As in most of this music, the traditional forms a sharp but intriguing contrast to the present: calculated, dense layers of guitars and synthesized percussion form the stirring basis to Khaled's pleading Islamic vocals. Don't miss *La Camel, Kutche and Chebba*.

### Robben Ford

*Talk To Your Daughter* - *Warner Brothers*  
An extremely pleasant mix of blues roots with jazz influences, straight R&B/Rock 'n Roll and some effective covers. And, the man play some guitar! Highly recommended: *Ain't Nothing But The Blues, Can't Let Her Go* and the title track.

### Michael Anderson

*Sound Alarm* - *A&M*  
Debut album from an American who stands in a no-frills R&B tradition with his often restrained, but passionate and solid material. Terry Manning produced and the musicians provide a tight backing behind hooks that count. Try *Sound Alarm* and *Until You Loved Me*.


### Freddie Jackson

*Don't Let Love Slip Away* - *Capitol*  
Jackson's third album contains eight soft-soul gems, plus two mid-tempo tracks. With a voice smooth as silk, Jackson again creates a basically very romantic atmosphere.

### The White Boys

*On A Mission* - *Tin Pan Apple/Polydor*

The incidental vocals, as in *(He's A) Shape In A Drape*, are dealt with by Jackson. The music varies from bebop to classical, via jazz and a lot more.

### Andy Summers

*Mysterious Barricades* - *Private Music*  
"The objective of my music is to stir the imagination," states the ex-Police guitarist, setting out on an instrumental journey. Touching, classical blues and jazz-music, sometimes bordering on psychedelia. Summer sculptures and paints with sound.

In the meantime, her debut album *Kylie*, on which all three hits appear, remains in third position of the European Top 100 albums. She has certainly fulfilled the expectations of *Play Magazine* in its 1181 issue 5 of this year: **Michael Jackson's Another Part Of Me** has the highest entry in the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles at no. 32. Also entering are **Chris Rea**, **Robbie Robertson** and **Big Country**. **Johnny Hates Jazz's LP** has, thanks to the UK, a quite remarkable re-entry at 43. **Europe's LP** *Off The World* enters at 63.

UNITED KINGDOM

Yaz, the ex-model with the band *The Plastic Population*, who also sang on *Coldcut's Doctorin' The House*, sticks on top with *The Only Way Is Up*. **Kylie Minogue's** version of *Little Eva's* 1962 hit, *The Loco-Motion* remains in second position and Miami-based **BVSRP's** *I Need You* follows in third. **Breathe's** *Hands To Heaven* moves from 17 to 6 and **Parlophone/EMI** act **Brother Beyond** shoot from 24 to 8 with the *Stock, Aitken & Waterman* written and produced *The Harder I Try*. Also fast movers are: 18-year-old **Tanita Tikaram** with *Good Tradition* (15-23); **Julio Iglesias** & **Stevie Wonder** with *My Love* (7-13); **Chris Rea's** re-mixed version of *On The Beach* (*Summer '88*) (9-33); **Robbie Robertson's** *Somebody's Dreaming* (*The Salt Of Love*); and **Van Halen's** *When I'm Love* (28-38). The highest new entry is for **Big Country's** return to the chart with *King Of Emotion* (24). **Status Quo's** *Running All The Time* (24). **Stevie Wonder, re-recorded for *Sport Aid*, enters at 30 and **Guns N' Roses** debut at 35 with *Sweet Child O' Mine*.**



## Going Independent...

The Creation label's innovative marketing push is paying off handsomely. The buzz created by the cut-price *Doing It For The Kids* compilation LP and last weekend's sold-out record-launch concert sees three singles in the indie top 10 (two by current favourites House Of Love) and the Weather Prophets' *Always The Light* just missing out at no. 11. The LP itself has entered the indie chart at no. 1. All the singles are currently retailing at 99 pence and Creation has also been shifting a range of overstocks at bargain prices. Two indie dance LPs make the highest en-

tries on the albums chart this week. The Coldcut compilation *Out To Lunch With Ahead Of Our Time (Ahead Of Our Time)* comes in at no. 6 and *Acid House Vol I (BPM)* at no. 7. Another in the same vein which may follow is *Jack The Tab* (Castalia), ostensibly yet another house compilation, but actually all the work of people who brought you M.E.S.H.'s *Meet Every Situation Head On*.

A release certain to be big for the cartel is the long-awaited Smith's live LP *Rank*. The album features 14 songs recorded in London in October 1986 and is released by Rough Trade on September 5. The 14AD label releases *Gigante*, the best track from the Boston-based band The Pixies' no. 1 indie LP on 12", along with three other tracks, on August 22, to tie in with a brief visit by the band.

*Til Things Are Brighter* is a Red Rhino LP featuring versions of Johnny Cash songs by the likes of Voice Of The Beehive, Marc Almond, Pete Shelley, Marc Riley, The Mekons and Steve Mack of That Petrol Emotion. All proceeds go to the Terence Higgins Trust, an AIDS charity. The Imaginary label's LP of Captain Beefheart covers, *Fat & Bulbous*, has sold well, as did their Syd Barrett tribute, and the label now has plans for a similar LP of Byrds songs. ■

### The Moody Blues - Never Reaching The End

**It has been 24 years since The Moody Blues were formed in Birmingham. It has been 21 years since their legendary album Days Of Future Passed was released, 15 years since their split and 10 years since their reunion. And they are still going strong as the recent release of their 14th album, 'Sur La Mer' (Threshold/Polydor), proves.**

**T**he Moody Blues are one of those few bands that have known commercial success right from the start and it has stayed with them practically throughout their career. Hit singles like *Go Now*, *Nights In White Satin* and *Question* immortalised them in the 60s and 70s. And this is not to mention their albums such as *Days Of Future Passed*, *Seventh Sojourn*, *Long Distance Voyager* and *The Other Side Of Life*.

*Sur La Mer* was recorded in Good Earth Studios in London's Soho, as was their previous LP, *The Other Side Of Life*. The

Moody Blues have travelled along some very revolutionary and experimental roads in the past, and their fusion of the classical music of Dvorak with pop has often been applauded. Today however, The Moody Blues can hardly be labelled as 'revolutionary' - but is that really a wonder, knowing that the youngest band member, Patrick Moraz, celebrated his 40th birthday in June!

The LP's first single, the catchy *I Know You're Out There Somewhere*, has just been released and is vaguely reminiscent of ELO's *Living Thing*. With other tracks like *Hunt To Be With You* and *Vintage Wine* the band slow down, while the romantic mid-tempo *No More Lies* features the characteristic harmonies of Justin Hayward, John Lodge and Patrick Moraz. All songs were written by Justin Hayward and John Lodge and produced by the renowned Tony Visconti (Bowie, leggy Pop, Stranglers). He has succeeded in producing a well-polished LP without losing the rocky edge, at times associated with the group. The band will be available for promotion in Europe after returning from their US tour mid-September. ■

## SPOTLIGHT

### The Eastern Philosophies Of TAO

**As musicians in many of Germany's most influential and successful rock and jazz-rock bands, the members of TAO have played a significant role in the history of German rock since the mid-70s.**

**T**AO members have, in the past, performed with Laker, the Inga Rumpf Band, Charlie Mariano, Ina Deter and Kraan. Their goal now is to create a musical style that crosses barriers. They are looking, they say, for a combination of dynamism and meditation, of reflection and danceability.

"Our name is not coincidental," explains TAO keyboard-player and singer David Tao. "Here in the West there is too much emphasis put on logical thinking, science and technology. We tend to leave the intuitive side of life, the emotional, to women in our 'man's world'. But music appeals primarily to our intuitive emotions, one 'understands' it immediately.

"I related very strongly with what I had read by the ancient Chinese teacher Lao Tse. With Tao, which is more a set of guidelines than a philosophy, I have tried to combine our music with the idea of this moment of understanding. Tao is what is common to all men, and it is what we, three vastly different personalities, have in common in our music."

With *Magical Moments* Tao, B.H. Cremer (bass) and Udo Dahmen (drums) debut with an al-

bum and single of the same title on Hamburg-based Metronome. The record has succeeded in capturing the imagination of the Chinese government who, according to TAO's Manager Allan Eaton, has invited the group to play in the People's Republic.

With tight and often grandiose arrangements - supported by Peter Weiche, one of Germany's most sought-after guitarists, and members of the Hamburg Opera House woodwind and strings sections - TAO's songs evoke a sense of balance and harmony. A mixture of sound and rhythm, with oriental colours and vocals playing prominent roles.

TAO's music is not a cheap attempt to ride the New Age or ethnic-pop waves. "We used oriental sounds and instruments only in so far as we could play them ourselves," explains Dahmen. "We did not want to indulge in any musical tourism."

*Magical Moments* was recorded by the group in Tao's private studio, and co-producer, Udo Arndt (Rainbirds) was called in for extra help. Arndt was responsible for mixing TAO's special blend of modern rock, improvised music and 60s pop. References to the Beatles and others, especially in the song *Regent Street* for example, are unmistakable. After spontaneously agreeing to get involved in the project, Arndt set about delicately intertwaving the group's wealth of compositional ideas into a unique and ever changing tapestry of sound and mood that certainly lives up to Lao Tse's main teaching: "Find Your Own Way" ■
