EMI - Building A System For The Exchange Of Talent

To meet the challenge of a single European market in the 1990s. EMI Music recently created a separate marketing structure to exploit regional artists. This European marketing division is run by Roel Kruize, Senior Marketing Director for EMI Europe. He is based in Holland and also has an office in London.

Kruize: "We're trying to lay down a basic system for the exchange of talent that comes out of continental Europe and, hopefully, also to sell European artists in the UK and the US. In the past, when a record by a local artist was released in one country, the local branch tried to make its colleagues abroad enthusiastic about it. This still happens but I try to bring some structure to it. In the past, we have neglected the potential of artists coming out of Europe - but this has changed." Artists with crossover poten-

tial are put into two categories. The priority is for artists who are well established in their own territory and have a chance to cross borders quickly. The second group are the artists in development who are starting to get recognition in their own country and these are carefully watched.

The cancellation of the Montreux Rock Festival (see front page) is bound to have some advantages for IMMC and things are buzzing at the Amsterdam headquarters. IMMC's TV shows will attract some major superstars - names will be unveiled within 10 days. In the meantime, a record number of European and US radios are planning live broadcasts from the event (April 30 - May 4). There's also talk of a unique world premiere (for delegates only) to an amazing Euro rock opera.

Sweden's Karissima Television. the company behind the weekday breakfast show 'Good Morning, Scandinavia', is apparently setting up its own station, Nordic Channel. The move follows the recent launch of Astra which has meant 'Good Morning Scandinavia' is no longer allowed to use the Sky transponder. Nordic hopes to start transmissions in March or April.

Now that Pilar Miro has left Spain's state broadcaster RTVE, there are rumours that Fernando Salaverri, currently Music Co-Ordinator for television, is about to move on - or perhaps back to radio?

The SRIA claims that an album by Runrig which sold 30,000 copies in Scotland should have been higher in the UK chart as a result. Phillippa Hayes of Gallup's Chart Department: "What Runrig sold, that 30.000 figure, is exactly the figure we had, but it only made no. 61 country-wide in comparison to other sales that week. Obviously, a local chart would put it much higher - that

goes for Wales, Yorkshire or anywhere, but Gallup is a chart for the whole UK market, of which Scotland represents 10%."

Local charts are not new to Scotland. Edinburgh-based Radio Forth features a weekly twohour chart show based on a phone-round of shops in all Scotland's major cities. And Radio Tay runs the 'Tay Top 30' every Saturday, calculated from charts in local shops in the Perth/Dundee area.

Donald agrees that the local market can differ greatly from the Gallup indications. "Deacon Blue, who have a huge following up here, were in our Top 10 four weeks before they showed at all on Gallup. By the time they made the Gallup Top 20, they were no.

Two English-language radio stations in France have been closed down. Normany-based Contact 94 and Sunshine Radio on the French Riviera were shut down by the CNCL in the last days of its administration of French media. A spokesman for Sunshine, which is owned by Owen Ovston's Miss World Group in the UK, says he had expected an order to close, in order to apply for a licence. They are using the shutdown time to refit the station. Contact 94, however, is a licensed station; its major shareholder is a Channel Islands travel operator Stephen Clipp, A spokesman there says it was unclear what the problem was. He says the CNCL did not reply to any letters sent after February 1988. Both stations are now dealing with the new authority, the CSA, and are confident of being back on air soon.

The San Remo shortlist

The 39th annual San Remo Song Festival looks set to be the biggest yet. New organiser Adriano Aragozzini has attracted a host of international stars and the allimportant Italian song contest is now divided into three categories: I Campioni (champions), Gli Emergenti (upcoming) and Le Nuove Voci (new). A record 262 songs were submitted before a jury drew up the shortlist of 76. Music & Media profiles the 11 Champions lined up to compete.

Enzo lannacci -'Se Me Lo Dicevi Prima'

Enzo Jannacci makes his first ever San Remo appearance with the song, Se Me Lo Dicevi Prima. His talents seem limitless. He has recorded more than 25 albums. worked in the cinema as an actor and composer and appeared on TV as a presenter. Jannacci has a continuing involvement with the theatre and his last album, Parlare Con I Limone on the DDD label, ended up as a theatre production.



Born in Milan in 1935, he studied medicine and then gained a diploma in music at Milan's Conservatory. He loves the cabaret tradition and his special brand of delivery is popular with young and old alike.

Rossanna Casale -'A Che Servono Gli Dei'

Rossanna Casale started out her musical career as a backing vocalist for artists like Edoardo Bennato, Adriano Celentano, Lucio Dalla, Ricardo Cocciante and Mina. By 1987 she had released the album La Via Di Misteri on PolyGram and that same year appeared at San Remo with the song Brividi.

Casale sings A Che Servono Gli Dei at this year's Festival. Born in the US in 1959, she has an ballad Mi Manchi.



"We call our music dramatic metal," explains Zed Yago's lead singer, simply known as Jutta. And the band's recent 'Pilgrimage' album, the first fruit of a worldwide deal with BMG/Ariola in Hamburg, is certainly a piece of theatre.

On stage the band's guitarists Cunnar and Jimmy, bassist Tatch, drummer Bubi and vocalist Jutta concentrate on building up the romantic drama of Wagner's work. "We're hoping to develop the Zed Yago theme into something like heavy metal opera on stage," says Jutta.

The band will have plenty of opportunity to do this on their European tour which starts this spring through West Germany, Austria, Holland and France, "We supported Deep Purple in Europe last year, so we're pretty much ready for anything," Jutta laughs. And they recently visited the UK to film a promotional video for the LP Pilgrimage. which is based on the track, Black Bone Song.

The spirit of Wagner is also present in their debut album, From Over Yonder, and this latest, which was produced by Ralf Basten at Studio M in West Germany's Machtsum. Jutta: "We think our music is a good way of bringing classical writers and rock musicians together. Metal has a very bad image because people think everything is blood and horror and destruction. We're trying to bring some intelligence into metal - that's why we're using classical influences." Jutta adds that commercial

success is not a priority for Zed Yago: "We aren't exactly a 'safe bet' when it comes to the charts. but we're not afraid of being pioneers. All we want to do is explore the possibilities of Zed Yago." Some tracks are, however, particularly worthy of airplay. Strong contenders include Black

legendary guitarist from The Meters, Leo Nocentelli; Don Pullen (Charlie Mingus etc) on organ and electric bassist Steve Swallow, Not forgetting Robbie Ameen on trap drums, Eddie Harris on tenor sax and vocals, Olu Dara (trumpet, vocals, harmonica) and David Murray on tenor saxophone.

The Conjure sound has been described as "setting the absurd and mystical to a droll backbeat". Unlike other attempts at World Music and commercialised ethnic music, Cab Calloway relates black music to the traditions in blues and jazz. The track Bitter Chocklate is particularly worth a listen. At times a funky sound backs poetic lyrics, as on the track 'Sputin. There is also humorous a capella, on Callowav's own Minnie The Moocher. Hanrahan, who produced the

album at New York's Skyline Studios roughly this time last year: "At the heart of Conjure is this rhythm section that swings so strongly and intelligently that you can hear the joy the players have... and at its sharp centre are the words and stories of Ishmael Reed reintegrating themselves into the tradition from which they come'

Hanrahan may have a vested interest, but he is right, Cab Calloway exudes pleasure. This is an important record, which no one interested in any form of black music can ignore.
