Virgin Radio Adjusts Format; Adds ACE

The UK's first national commercial rock service, Richard Branson's Virgin Radio 1215 AM, is adjusting its output to include more ACE tracks and allow greater DJ profile following "lessons learned" by the station's programmers since it launched on April 30.

The station, which launched half way through this year's second quarter ratings survey, garnered a 2.2% share of its total survey area, representing 93% of the UK's 46.7 million adults—about 150.000 listeners short of its predicted 3.3 million.

The programming adjustments, which will include changing its one-man breakfast show to a two-man "Rock 'n' Roll Breakfast Show," are an attempt to respond to listener feedback which has at times criticised the station for lacking in personality and concentrating on "white male guitar music," says co-programme director Richard Skinner. The adjusted playlist will now include more veteran black artists and female vocalists.

Skinner concedes that in the early days the programming was somewhat one-dimensional. But since then he and joint PD John Revell have been adding new

French Nets Winners In Carignon's Radio Plans

The strict ownership regulations currently barring major operators such as NRJ and RTL from buying third networks may be loosened in the next year, according to a recent announcement made by French communications minister Alain Carignon.

The plan, revealed in an interview with CB News, addresses the contents of the recently drawn-up radio law, which is expected to be presented before the French Parliament this autumn. Current regulations limit network ownership at 30 million listeners.

In the interview Carignon suggested an ownership ceiling of up to 120 million inhabitants, "regardless of the number of networks and without conditions."

This goes much further than the radio law project prepared by previous minister of communications

Jean-Noel Jeanneney, which proposed a ceiling of 100 million potential listeners. Explained Carignon, "This will allow our radio stations to be in a better position to face competition. We are in a sector that can exist only if economic rules are respected."

The proposal will be regarded as a gift to major radio groups such as NRJ, which, alongside its second net Chérie FM (Gold), will be able to develop its concept Rires et Chansons, and even make a hoped-for purchase of full-service web RMC.

Luxembourg group CLT—which owns full-service net RTL, has a 39% stake in EHR web M40 and 34% of EHR web Fun—will not be limited in its plans to take over 100% of Fun. An RTL spokesperson tells (continues on page 25)

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
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BBC Radio 1 Dismisses Travis Following On-Air Resignation

Veteran BBC Radio 1 DJ Dave Lee Travis was sacked on August 11 following his announcement on air that he was resigning after 20 years at the station. Travis first

revealed his intention to quit during his regular show on August 7. Although he had hoped to work until his current contract expires in October, he was dismissed three days later for breaching the terms of his contract which prohibit him from discussing BBC affairs

through the media.

In announcing his resignation on air, Travis told an estimated four million listeners, "Recently there has been a lot in the press about the BBC. I really want to put the record straight at this point, and I thought you ought to know first. Changes are being made here which go against my principals. My only option, very regrettably, is to leave.

The BBC's decision follows recent attacks on the management style of BBC director general John Birt and Birt's vow to make the Radio 1 FM EHR web more "alternative" and "closer to its younger audiences.

Birt's claimed commitment to a more youth-oriented station was underlined with the recent appointment of Matthew Bannister as new Radio 1 controller (M&M. August 7). Bannister, former GLR managing editor, is reportedly determined to implement Birt's request quickly, with programming and personnel changes being predicted when the network reveals its autumn schedule in September.

Polydor Dovetails Int'l/Nat'l

Following the appointment of Jan Tekstra as A&R manager at Polydor Holland (effective August 16), several changes are being introduced to streamline operations at the company. National product and promotion departments will now all report to general manager Kees van Weijen. Van Weijen is also responsible for the whole international repertoire operations (marketing, product, promotion). National product manager Jacqueline Jansen and national TV/press Inge Verver will also now report to Van Weijen, though their

responsibilities will remain with national repertoire.

Tekstra, a former singer-songwriter and producer, will report directly to MD Albert van der Kroft and concentrate on national A&R. It is Tekstra's first position with a record company.

Van der Kroft says the changes have been made to create better cooperation between international and national product. "There is a strong focus on European repertoire in PolyGram now. One of our aims at Polydor is to try and incorporate national repertoire into other European territories and create more of a synergy between national and international product.'

Varner Buys Telegram Records

Continuing to build upon its dual company structure in Europe, Warner Music International subsidiary Warner Music Sweden on August 9 bought Telegram Records, one of Sweden's leading independent record companies. No price was disclosed.

The deal follows a one-year licensing deal between the two companies that was signed in February and which became effective on March 1. Telegram, like Warner subsidiary Metronome in

Sweden, will be run as a separate label. Telegram co-owner Klas Lunding remains head of A&R and reports to Sanji Tandan, deputy MD Warner Music.

Telegram transaction The comes seven months after Warner purchased leading Spanish indie the DRO Group. Within the past five years Warner has also bought Hamburg-based Teldec Records (1988), CGD Records in Italy (1989) and Carrère Music in France (1990).

Telegram was founded in 1988 by Lunding and its current roster of artists includes Neneh Cherry's

half sister Titiyo, Stina Nordenstam, Papa Dee, Rob n' Raz, Just D and Popsicle, which won a Swedish Grammy in 1993 for best rock group.

NORWAY: Political Party Addresses Parallel Import Issue At U2 Concert Hours before the U2 concert in Oslo on July 29, right-wing party Høyre handed out flyers telling people that if they vote for the party during the autumn elections the parallel import legislation will be removed. The party says it is against the current three-month jail sen-

tence for importing copies of recordings already distributed by the multinational record labels. Parallel import was made illegal in early Kai Roger Ottesen

GERMANY: RTL Der Oldiesender Number One In German FM Market A recent telephone survey covering the German FM radio market conducted by ILRES, the national research institute of Luxembourg, puts Luxembourg-based RTL-Der Oldiesender as the number one station in the German FM market (Saarland and the districts of Trier, Koblenz and Cologne). RTL Radio scored a reach of 32% of listeners aged 12+, ahead of EHR public SWF 3 with 27% and EHR/gold Radio RPR Super Radio Market with 19%. Other parts of the RTL FM market not included in the survey include parts of the Düsseldorf district as well as RTL's AM market in the rest of North Rhine-Westphalia and Rheinland-Pfalz. ITALY: FIMI Withholds Results Until September

FIMI, the IFPI-recognised industry body representing 18 of Italy's major record companies, has delayed until September publication of retail results for the first six months of this year. Inside sources say the results could reveal a calamitous drop in sales. Sources high up in two companies have said that sales in some sectors dropped by as much as 40% last April. Italy's political situation, economy and piracy are to blame, they say. One manager said that the drop in sales is precipitated by the cost of CDs which is squeezing the budget, especially of young Mark Dezzani

UNITED KINGDOM: Glasgow To Host Sound City '94

Glasgow has been elected host to "Sound City 94," a week-long annual music event partnered by record industry association BPI, BBC Radio 1 FM, the Musicians Union and Glasgow City council. Sound City, first launched in 1992 in Norwich, was staged in Sheffield this year, with the participation of over 2.000 musicians. BBC Radio 1 broadcast more than 23 hours of concerts and BBC Radio 5 and BBC Radio Sheffield featured the event. Live concerts from Sheffield were also carried on 12 continental European radio stations.

UNITED KINGDOM: Radio Must Grab More Ad Share

Radio advertising revenue will have to rise at least 50% in order for the planned new stations to survive, says a report by the London office of worldwide accountancy firm of Coopers & Lybrand. Coopers says that the planned 180 local and regional commercial stations and three national networks will have to take in 3% of total adspend by 1996 versus the 2% existing services current take in. "Unless this is accomplished, the industry will be in trouble by 1996," says the report.

SER Owner Prisa Looks Outside Spain For Expansion Prospects

Facing a recession and strong competition from TV, group radio network owner SER's turnover dropped 2.3% to Pta13.2 billion (app. US\$95 million) during 1992. Overall, radio advertising fell some 4% in Spain last year, while total adspend grew 6.9%.

Pre-tax operating profit for the company, which is owned by Prisa, Europe's 40th-largest media company, fell 31.2% to Pta1.29 billion. Net income slumped around 29% to Pta924 million, due mostly to a Pta442 million charge, largely taken to cover losses at its 48%-owned new 70-station EHR web M-40 in France and Belgium.

Prisa is taking these problems in its stride, however, as it concentrates on establishing itself as one of Europe's major up-andcoming powerhouses. The group made its first incursion beyond the Pyrenees in September '91, buying into M-40 owner Sodera. In 1992 it acquired the Spanish government's 25% share of SER for Pta2.781 million, bringing its ownership of the net to nearly 100%. One month later, the group acquired a 49% interest in fifthranking private Antena 3-a move which has sparked off accusations of monopoly from a group of former Antena 3 employees. Shortly afterwards Prisa then launched a new station M-80, as the fusion of SER's ACE/gold net Radio Minuto and Antena 3's gold net Radio 80.

Prisa now has little room for more investments in Spanish radio, according to director of corporate relations Daniel Gavela. However, the group will now turn its attentions to increased foreign investment, with M-40 as its beachhead in Europe. Says Gavela, "We have three music formats which function excellently here in Spain, and we think there is a possibility of creating a unified musical format at a European level. M-40, for example, pays special attention to national products, with an important international component. Creating a European audience is an idea we are very interested in."

Majors Find TV Outlet In Viva

Four of the biggest media concerns in the world will be producing, broadcasting and advertising their product via the German music and entertainment cable TV channel Viva, following changes in the line-up which leave Time Warner, Thorn EMI, Sony Entertainment and Philips (Poly-Gram) as equal shareholders in the channel.

POPKOMM MD Dieter Gorny, who played a large role in initiating the Viva project, is excited by the support of the four media giants. He comments, "It is an interesting development for the entertainment industry to have some of the biggest media concerns building up their TV outlets. It's a step into a new way of thinking. Record companies are now saying, 'Let's try and broadcast our music too.'"

The change around in investors came as a great surprise to Gorny, especially Thorn EMI's decision to rejoin the project after pulling out of talks in May. He says the

suddenness of the changes was necessitated by a deadline hanging over the Viva project, which meant it had to present a firm layout of its finances to the LfR-North Rhine-Westphalia media authority by July 31 in order to receive a licence by September. Last minute talks were held in New York, with contracts drafted and signed by German lawyers, according to Gorny.

OK Radio MD Frank Otto is still very interested in making a project, but was not able to make the deadline for signing a contract agreement. As all the other investors are non-German based. Gorny says that they are all keen to have a German partner in the project. Insiders suggest that Otto is now wanting to have a 19.8% stake in Viva, along with the four majors. Viva Medien (DoRo, VAP, Me Myself & Eye) would then have a 1% share.

Graham Heads Sony's New Int'l **Exploitation Department**

Sony Music Germany is planning to step up the profile of German product in other territories and is bolstering its international exploitation department accordingly, with a special focus on marketing German artists in Europe, US and Japan. including such acts as Die Fantastischen Vier and Culture Beat.

Former press chief Ian Graham has been appointed as head of international exploitation. Graham has formerly worked as product manger for Sony Music offices in London and Paris.

He will be backed by internamanager tional coordination Christa Zentgraf. Replacing Graham as head of press/artist marketing is former editor of Sony's Talk magazine Andreas MW

POPKOMM Attracts 11 Countries, 88 Groups Set To Attend

Eleven countries will take part in the fifth annual POPKOMM, the German music industry pop music trade fair to be held in Cologne on August 19-22. Exhibiting at the event are trade groups and record companies from Austria, Belgium, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Holland, Norway, Slovakia. Sweden and the UK. Some 88 companies and trade bodies will take part at the country stands.

It's the first time POPKOMM has allowed foreign recorded music trade associations to exhibit at the event. Private companies can only participate in conjunction with their country's trade group.

Comments French Export Office international co-ordinator Marie-Agnes Beau, "France and Germany have a lot to share. French professionals have to start being more aggressive in these markets."

About 50 people representing 15 different companies and organisations will attend from France. Activities sponsored by the country will include a presentation of the French market, various showcases of local acts and a meeting between various governmental agencies supporting European music.

Commenting on that meeting, Beau says, "We'd like this meeting to be a first step towards creating a movement in favour of European music; something that has been lacking so far.

Also attending POPKOMM will be the BPI (British Phonographic Industry). Comments BPI director of communications Jeff Clark-Meads, "In recent months we have had acts from Germany, France, Belgium and Scandinavia in the British charts, which is an indication of the open door we show the world." He adds, "The fact that an Icelandic act like Björk has made a huge impact in Britain is something that would have been a fantasy a few years ago."

RMC Privatisation Set For September, says Carignon

The lead up to the privatisation of full-service net Radio Monte Carlo is in the final stages, according to a statement made by communications minister Alain Carignon in the weekly CB News.

Following the presentation of an official report to the French authorities at the beginning of summer in which the two commissioned experts put forward their suggestions, a call for auction will be made public before the end of summer, pending a report from the CSA. Carignon stresses that the call for auction will include clear terms and conditions, and that candidates will be selected by a commission of independent judges.

The government will remain

outside the proceedings, assured, although it is widely anticipated the industrial group Alcatel-with or without NRJwill be among the stronger contenders, with the blessing of the government.

The winner will not only acquire the financially troubled net, but also the highly profitable FM network Nostalgie. Tele Monte Carlo, which was part of the group, will not be affected by the privatisation, nor RMC/Moyen Orient, an RMC subsidiary broadcasting in the Middle East. Meanwhile, an agreement between Prince Rainier of Monaco and the French government is reported to state that RMC should remain a full-service station.

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

EHR Eyes Teens Going "Back To School"

The summer holiday season is quickly coming to an end, which means school is just around the corner, bringing teens in close contact with each other on a daily basis for the first time in months. In the US, one report estimates teens have an annual buying power of US\$95 billion, and comparable figures surely apply to Europe. Reaching this younger demo with special "back to school" promotions and programming can prove a windfall for EHR stations.

One such station that capitalises on

"We've been doing more and more music research over the past one-and-a-half years. But we're working on completing our image and are investing more and more on packaging the station. We're doing a lot of research into our DJs: what kind of DJs do listeners want; what kind of language should they use; how long should they talk. This information is especially useful for our AM and PM drive-time shows. You cannot test the way a DJ talks on air in auditorium music tests."

Borsum says the station's approach to teens is just as important as the music. "You have to speak their language," he sive image study. I think it's important that we go this way to find out the important trends which might affect the station in the future."

Jan Steeman, programme director at pubcaster Het Station in Holland, which is a part of Radio 3, agrees with Borsum's ideas on image.

"I think it's important to look at the whole programme," says Steeman, whose net targets the 16-25 demo. "The younger audience likes our station because we provide more than just music. The music is just one part. Younger audiences are just as interested in news and information and other things as older listeners. People might say the music is the most important thing, but we have listeners who tune into programmes with a lot less music just because they like the whole show."

While Steeman doesn't make any programming changes during the "back to school" week to try and lure more teens, the public web features a daily live interlude at schools. "We have a daily programme where we visit a school and do a live broadcast there each day," he says.

"In that show we ask a class to tell us their top three songs. We mention numbers two and three on air and then play the top song. We also ask the students to tell us who their favourite teacher is, and we do the same thing with that person. It

makes for an interesting comparison of songs."

Other special promotions, whether they are targeted to teens or not, are combined with other organisations which are a part of Radio 3. "We don't have any major special promotions for teenagers at our station," he says. "Things like that tend to become part of the entire Radio 3 station, like our 'Rock Against Racism.' As a public broadcaster, we have a big-

started. Then we announce the winner at

a big party at a nightclub in Liverpool."

The station is also setting up a teen/school promotion at the moment called "Class of '93." Details will be unveiled soon.

"We've tried to do more of these things in the past," says McKenzie, "but I think the sponsors are only now just starting to catch on to it and use radio as a medium."

However, McKenzie cautions EHR programmers trying to appeal to teens, especially if the station serves a wide demo. "You have to be careful when you have a broad demographic. If you pick up a lot of kids, then you are perceived as a kids radio station, and that's a dangerous thing to do with wide demo.

"We cover a broad demographic, the 15-35s, so it's specific dayparts that are targeted to kids. The evening show is targeted more to teens, and we pick up more 15-25 year olds."

the teen market is **OK Radio**/Hamburg. The station—which targets an 18-34 demo and is number one with the younger audience in its market—gets interactive with teens, usually turning over the hourly listener requests during the first few "back to school" weeks to students. It also spends a lot of time seeking their opinions about student life and activities.

An Active Period

Comments GM/PD Ingo Borsum, "The 'back to school' subject is of special interest to us because the target audience has more to tell during this period than the rest of the year, and we take full advantage of that. We are already starting to cover that during our morning drive programme and try to do so throughout the day.

"OK Radio, in conjunction with various news organisations and trade groups, is quite active in working with this audience. For instance, we have created campaigns for first-time voters and programmes for protecting the youth at work."

The station also attends soccer matches and promotes local concerts. Sponsors mostly are local shops, music retailers, bicycle shops, as well as toys and games retailer Toys'R Us.

"We believe, especially with younger audiences, that they recognise when they are being used," says Borsum. "Therefore, we emphasise a direct approach to our target group without alienating the younger end of it."

That direct approach includes a lifestyle analysis using focus group studies and image analyses.

"Everybody is doing music research and a lot of stations are getting the same results and playing the same songs," he says. "But one wins and the other loses. That tells me music is an important element, but not the only element. Image is now the important thing.

Using Focus Groups

Focus groups, says Borsum, are the key. "During one research session we had 300 teens and 10 DJs in an auditorium and they discussed the station, music and a lot of other things. As a result of this, we changed a lot of things in our PM drive-time programme.

"The station and its DJs can learn from every focus group and every time the DJs go out to attend special events. They learn what is important for the kids, for their friends, for the young adults and so on."

length, Borsum is integrating teamwork into his image building efforts. "We have created two big teams at OK Radio: a morning show team with eight people and a 10-to-10 team, which includes the 10am to 10pm team. The teams include all the DJs, creative directors, the head of music and one researcher. They work together every day in music research, focus groups and image studies. And every half year we conduct a comprehen-

ger role to play in such things."

Steeman is a firm believer that if your station appeals to the teen demo, then you have a great chance of winning the 18-34s and picking up a nice slice of the 25-44s. "I agree with that strategy. It's interesting that in studies in which people are asked 'How old do you feel?", they all give a younger age, and it's no older than 35 years old; even for people 55 years old. Most people feel young. If

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
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



What would you do if you had supple vocals and you had to shop for the right producer? In the past you would have taken the next flight to New Orleans to call in the help of Allen Toussaint, the grandmaster of all productions coming



from the "crescent city," from Irma Thomas and Lee Dorsey to the Meters and later the Pointer Sisters.

In the '70s some white blues and rock singers like Frankie Miller and Joe Cocker could afford the luxury of hiring the midas touch of Toussaint. These days, while the maestro turns down jobs left, right and centre, German Maxim Rad's guts and the vocal abilities won him Toussaint's attention straightaway.

The debut album *Old*, out on **Mercury** in the GSA territories and Holland, is a monument of soulful pop that will make **Simply Red**'s **Mick Hucknall** green with envy. The atmosphere may be laidback, but that doesn't mean there's no action. His band is no bunch of boring sessioneers; these are musicians who challenge Rad to do his utmost. Chased by guitarist **Albert von Oswald** and

Expensive hairdo's, tuxedoes, ties and pleated skirts will be no protection against this underground combo when it hits the stage. Call your insurance company before you step into "the fiery pits of hell."

The censorship board will have to work overtime, because these gunslingers, who spend most of their time in the alternative film industry, are their natural enemies. For Mutter a taboo is only there to be broken. Censorship and double standards are on top of their priority list. Their wall of sound is more or less under control on their latest album release *Du Bist Nicht Mein Bruder*, but anarchy breaks loose when these guys plug in for their live show. If you've ever



Okay, let's keep it simple. X-Mix-1 is a CD and a video. The album contains a continuous mix of tracks earlier released on MFS, the dance sub label of DSB. The computer-animated video is cut and synchronised with the music on the *The MFS Trip* sampler. Mastermind behind the CD is Paul van Dyk, Ger-

many's leading trance-house DJ. The video is a product made by **Studio K7**, MFS' partner in crime, and in the past responsible for the slightly less advanced **3Lux** project.

Probably the best way to describe this outfit from the Ruhr/Münsterland area is "neo-traditional avant garde folkrock." Don't be misled by this apparently paradoxal description, because that is excactly what they are all about. They stick to traditional instruments virtually exclusively, but they don't stick to traditional music by any means. Instead they chose to experiment with the music, ranging from bright, polka influenced rockabilly with psychedelic overtones to deeply romantic ballads with ironic undercurrents.

This may seem more than just a little bit strange, but upon hearing, it is all perfectly natural. Of course it is certainly no drawback that they are all highly

skilled musicians, who worked long and hard to master their craft, so it comes as no surprise that they pull the whole thing off so well. As could be expected they are skillful performers who have no problems whatsoever in translating their studio and rehearsal room abilities to the stage. Another feat they accomplished at an early stage was to win the appreciation of radio programmers and their listeners.

The debut single Küss Mich was well received in general, including North Rhine Westphalia pubcaster WDR 1. It is featured on the weekly "Schlagerralleye" show on which the listeners decided what has been played for the past two months All this

We have rappers in Italian now, with Jovanotti, in French, with Soon E MC, and in German, with Die Fantastischen Vier. The latter quartet is the most famous hip hop combo outside of its home country, but it's certainly not the one and only. Jezt Sind Wir Dran!-"Now It's Our Turn!"-is the aptly titled debut album of another leading German-language rap foursome, Reim Banditen ("Rhyme Bandits").

Their initials "RB" coincidentally point in the direction of "R&B," and since they have the most "ebony" sound of German rap acts, there's nothing wrong with that. As a port their hometown Hamburg has always had one of Germany's

blackest populations. More than other rap posses, Die Reim Banditen have constantly had the chance to soak up black musical influences. Band leader DJ Thorsten Balzke a.k.a B-Seite has an enormous record collection to sample from. Best recognisable sample is supposedly Stevie Wonder's electric piano rif out of I Wish, as seamlessly integrated into Wo Ist Die Party.

In a crossfire of words, rappers OST and West rapidly spit out a great variety of subjects. Gewalt is an interesting topical track about TV-fuelled violence causing international worry. Scratcher Tempo, the Benjamin of the band, pro-

HOW RADIO BACKS MAINLAND EUROPEAN TALENT

Innovation in pop music is a valuable thing, but sometimes an "old fashioned" pop song is much more preferable. Just as eating "haute cuisine" everyday makes you long for a good plate of Ma's apple pie once in a while. Savage World does what Roxette is so good at—it sings songs—which is often far more difficult than providing all those musical experiments.

From the artwork of the self-titled debut album, frontlady Stephanie Ann Savage looks us straight in the eye, and her singing is just as direct. Two songs stand out instantly on the 12-track pop/rock set—Timebomb, with its bass line not unlike Steely Dan's Rikki Don't Loose That Number, and Turn Back Time

recalling the heyday of Eurythmics.

Part of the album has been recorded in the London-based Church Studios. owned by Dave Stewart, who left all the "dirty" production work to Chris Bostock, bass player in his current band the Spiritual Cowboys. Stewart him-



Becoming A Better Broadcaster Means Learning Stronger Listening Skills

Musicians call it having a big ear. Astute conversationalists refer to it as being polite. Successful broadcasters know it to be part of the foundation of a great show. Listening is an art form unto itself; it is the best source of material.

The fear of dead air has, for some reason, prompted programme directors everywhere to issue a fill-every-hole edict. This has resulted in a brand of radio that is unrealistic and upsetting. Pregnant pauses are filled with contrived laughter, comments, uh-huh's. Real conversations are not that way. A conversation, by definition, is an exchange of thoughts and ideas, opinions and facts and, perhaps even a learning experience. It is punctuated with natural pauses so that the thought process may work.

What it should not be is a wall of babble or a barrage of incessant talking with two separate conversations going on. It is simply two people participating in a discussion about a subject. The conversation should have you both traveling down the same path with the intent of enlightenment, education and entertainment. These rules apply to on-

curtains if you have to. Request that people refrain from milling around in your field of vision during an interview or phone call.

5. Don't let your mind wander. Occupy your thoughts with the interview only.

6. Ask questions. Probe and have a genuine curiosity about the subject matter. If you are not interested how do you expect the listener to be?

7. Paraphrase what the speaker said. Clarifying in your own words the context of the interview.

8. Anticipate what the speaker will say next. Mentally prepare for the next thought process.

More often than not the caller or studio guest is the element of entertainment. Assume the role of your listener and ask questions that prompt responses based on

Eight Steps To Becoming A Better Listener

air telephone conversations, studio interviews and cross talk with fellow air performers.

The art of listening doesn't come as naturally as one might think. Much of the emphasis on performing is on what we say rather than what we hear. This conditioning is difficult to break unless a concerted effort is made to listen to what others are saying and how they say it.

As the performer you must hone your listening skills. To do this you should start with the four stages of listening. They are:

- Sensing: Hearing the information/message sent by the guest.
- Interpretation: Understanding the meaning of the message.
- Evaluation: Deciding about the relative importance of the message.
- Reaction: Your response to the information.

The two most important rules to remember are:

- Don't react until you have completed the first three stages.
- Wait until the speaker has finished his thought.

Here is an eight-step process that will help you to become a better listener:

- 1. Analyse/research the topic in advance. Do some advance reading on the subject. Be aware of proponents and opponents.
- 2. Mentally prepare to listen. Fight urges to blurt. Pauses are not necessarily a tune-out factor.
- 3. Focus attention and concentrate. Give your guest your undivided attention. Use eye contact
- 4. Overcome distractions. Close the studio

your perception of that specific target group.

At Air Support we teach our clients "perceptual awareness training," a process designed especially for the DJ who has lost touch with his listening audience. The prime candidate for this training is the breakfast host who, because of a great deal of success, has adopted the lifestyle of someone making a great deal of money. It is this lifestyle that

what they think you want to hear. In other words, keeping a low profile about your job will guarantee you some candid responses about your station and, perhaps, your show.

If you live in a large metropolitan area make a concerted effort to get away regularly. Go into the suburbs or into the country-side. Try to go to restaurants, bars and events that attract the largest numbers of the average, middle class working person. If your listeners like to frequent horse shoe matches or markets, that's where you should spend time.

will be topical, local and obvious.

Personal polling can be disguised as polite conversation with the patrons of the events you attend. For some it may be difficult. The very nature of the radio broadcaster lends itself to being cloistered. Very few performers possess outgoing personalities when not in front of a microphone.

Look at what we do for a living. We sit in a windowless room talking into a microphone and generally get nervous when someone is watching. This is not a text book description of a type A personality. Be bold and talk with your listeners. It is this personal polling that will enable you to gain a greater understanding of what they are all about. You will be able to see what works and doesn't

Most of your target audience is not that complex. They are not analytical in their thinking, especially when they are listening to the radio. Complicated subjects like politics or the nations deficit should be presented in everyday speak. Saying something that is understood by a great number of people is more important than saying something in a complex fashion in order to verify your intelligence to yourself. Being "one of the guys" or speaking the language of your target audience will make you a more believable communicator than being too hip for the room. Never lose sight of the fact that you are in the communication business; so communicate!

removes him further from those he talks to over the air. The average listener doesn't drive an expensive car, wear Italian suits and dine in the finest restaurants in town. Certainly an individual should enjoy the fruits of his labour. However, talking about it on the air is another story. The listeners perceive you to be talking down to them. They cannot identify with you. You lose touch with your target. Live any lifestyle you choose, but never lose sight of the needs of your audience.

Here's how listening can help you to get back in the game. Techniques used outside of the studio can help in developing a broad base of knowledge about current events or the buzz of the day. This allows you to key in on what your audience is talking about.

When you are searching for the feelings, attitudes and opinions of your listeners to use as show preparation you should step outside of your circle of friends. To be most effective it should be done with some degree of anonymity. When people don't know who you are they won't try to impress you with

To be a great communicator requires the skills of eavesdropping. Have dinner or a drink at the bar in close proximity to a number of people having a conversation. Observe and listen. Wherever your target listeners like to feed and drink is the best environment for the topical talk you are looking for. Local breakfast restaurants are the best places for taking the pulse on town politics and scandal. Look at a map of your region. Study it for cities, towns and suburbs to visit. Check the newspaper for weekend activities that your listeners might attend. Get as much input as you can so you







"We have headed a little more ACE, which includes new material on the playlist and the core material of classic tracks. Although you do still hear Led Zeppelin and Pink Floyd during the day, there are now more tracks from artists such as James Brown, Muddy Waters and Sly And The Family Stone, and a little more investigation into female vocalists, from Linda Ronstadt to Julia Fordham, even Madonna," says Skinner.

Comments Branson, "There have been a few suggestions over the past few months that we have listenend to. In a purely commercial sense, women are important to the station and there were a number of women who felt we needed to give a slightly greater bias to them." He says that the station has now "struck the right balance with the music.

Revell adds that one of the most important lessons the station learned from in-house research and data from listener focus groups is that "it takes more than great music to make a radio sta-

He defends the station's initial policy of placing total emphasis on the music. "We set the music above the presenters, and I think that was the right way to go. If we had started out being 'presenterled,' we could have been accused of being exactly like BBC Radio 1 FM or Capital FM. Now we have set the bedrock of music and we are opening up the station a little to give it some more personality. It is a process of evolution.'

Branson defends the station against consumer press criticism that it ignores new music, while CEO David Campbell points to new material the station has promoted. "Look at the Surfing Brides. No one has really played or exploited them the way Virgin

has. They found a place on the [UK] charts as a result of what we are doing. Another example is tracks from 4 Non Blondes," says Campbell. "We were playing their material three or four weeks before anyone else."

A check of Virgin's 20 most played songs during its first three months on air shows them all to be new or playlist material from artists such as Tasmin Archer, Ugly Kid Joe and Manic Street Preachers, as well as new material from long established artists like Rod Stewart, Bruce Springsteen and k.d. lang.

Campbell says the station's ratings figures are on target with Virgin's forecasts. He points out that 64% of the 3.13 million listeners represent the station's demographic target of 25-44 year olds, with 57% male and 43%

"The figures put us almost precisely where we want to be," says Campbell. "They prove that we were right in identifying a huge audience who felt disenfranchised by what was on offer elsewhere. We are getting right to the heart of the core audience we wanted."

M&M that the proposal was very positive. It is something we have been asking for some time already. Our development in France was blocked because of the previous 30 million concentration ceiling."

The minister also addressed the issue of local advertising, stating that "local advertising must be reserved for operators broadcasting local programmes." However, he continued, these operators may include independents or those linked to a network as subsidiaries, subscribers or as franchisees. All stations requesting access to the local advertising market will be required to devote at least 20% of total time to local programming.

This concession does not satisfy the independent radio associations SIRTI or SNPR (whose motto is "local advertising for local operators"). SIRTI president Eric Hauville believes the measure is far too lax and generous towards the majors, branding the 20% local programming quota as "a joke." "For 10 years it has existed and nobody has ever respected it," he says. "I don't see why it should change.

Carignon acknowledged the importance of assessing the advertising resources in each frequency area when he called for the use of three criteria when authorising frequencies: 1) the diversity of programming; 2) the value of each applicant to the local community; 3) the possibilities offered by the local advertising market.

Meanwhile, although the contents of the new law sound positive, many members of the industry remain sceptical about the fact that none of it has been officially published. Europe Développement GM Martin Brisac comments, "I don't know what is in this text. We've heard things. We've read things. But nothing precise. It is not very pleasant."

stopped the record from selling and getting favourable radio airplay. Debut is currently number 40 with a bullet in M&M's European Top 100 Albums, while airplay on European radio—predominantly pubcasters—is building steadily.

Through her own Icelandic company Bapsi, Björk has licensed her album to independent label One Little Indian (OLI) for the UK market. For mainland Europe, OLI licensed the record to Mother Records, the label cofunded by U2 manager Paul McGuinness. Mother, in turn, is marketed and distributed by Polydor for continental Europe (although in France, PolyGramowned Island handles the record). In the US, where the album has just entered the Billboard 200, Debut is released on Elektra.

According to OLI MD Derek Birkett, the album is selling a lot faster than originally anticipated and UK numbers have reached 55.000, while the US figures are up to 170.000 in just two weeks time. "I would love to take credit for that," he says, "but she controls everything. She sorts out the artwork, the remixes, the producer, the video, etc. All we do is coordinate and act as her business management.

Birkett says that Björk can be demanding to work with. One bone of contention was the art-

work of the album; Björk wanted to use nothing but a plain photo, and OLI had to fight to reach the compromise of attaching a sticker to the plastic case, announcing the artist name and album title. "I don't support a few of her decisions," continues Birkett, "but people go beyond the call of duty for her. The labels involved were chosen for artistic reasons, not for commercial ones, and have to be prepared to give her complete artistic freedom. They don't have the rights to choose the single, the video or anything. The only right they have is to pay the bills."

Polydor UK international marketing manager Alastair Farquhar believes that the current radio airplay levels of the single might be driven by the quality of the video and the heavy rotation on MTV Europe. "We got excellent support by them and that helped a lot in converting radio programmers.'

The next single off the album is Venus As A Boy, which will be released on August 23 and contains a remix by Simply Red's Mick Hucknall.

Polydor Germany manager Mike Eberhardt says the single registered 32 plays, not enough to put it in the national airplay chart. Describing the artist's style as very "eclectic," Eberhardt feels that despite the good critical reactions received on the album, "we don't expect it to sell more than 50-100.000 copies.

Reactions from radio executives are unanimously positive, although airplay mainly comes from the pubcasters, probably a reflection of the latter's less restricted programming philoso-

Christine Goor, producer at Belgian French-language pubcaster Radio 21/Brussels, describes the single as "unusual and surprising." She says, "It's that voice. It sounds so strange. Yet the overall production is not too left of field to scare off radio audiences.

Riksradio P3/Stockholm producer Mikael Agnedil points to the song's unique blending of eccentricity and accessibility and feels that it appeals to a wider age group than most radio programmers assume. "It can attract listeners between 10-35," he says. "The younger people will like the dance beats, while the older will appreciate the voice and the unusual production.'

At BRTN Studio Brussel, the song perfectly fits the pubcaster's wide selection of material that ranges from the Breeders and Cypress Hill to Apache Indian, Bon Jovi and Manic Street Preachers. According to producer Jan Hautekiet, Björk's talents are unmistakable and truly original. "The song's a bit exotic but cast in the right production, making it suitable for more than fringe audiences only.

totalled 14 million units.

It's the second highest second quarter total since 1986 and, while shipments of 7" and 12" singles dropped by 36.6% and 20.8%, respectively, on last year's second quarter figures, a 78.3% rise in trade deliveries of the CD format is claimed to be largely responsible for the current growth in the singles sector.

A total of 30.64 million albums were shipped between April June, representing a 15.1% rise on last vear's second quarter total of 26.62 million units. CD deliveries totalled 18.57 million units, a 28.8% increase on 1993's second quarter and an annual increase of 20.4% units. Cassette deliveries

totalled 10.81 million units, a volume increase of 2.6% on 1992's second quarter total of 10.54 million. This is seen as a significant achievement following many quarters of shrinkages, although the value of sales did drop by 2.9% on last year's second quarter total of £38.96 million.

BPI research director Peter Scaping is keen to point out that the volume increase in cassettes does not indicate a long-term resurgence of the format. "It's a sign of a strengthening market," he comments. "People who prefer to buy cassettes have gone out into the shops again. It's just another encouraging aspect to a very encouraging set of figures. The major influence on the record industry is undoubtedly the current state of the economy and the ability and willingness of consumers to spend. Other effects such as the variations and quality of music and competition from other sectors such as computer games are minor in comparison to that major effect, which is the general state of the economy. Sales statistics over the last six months show a significant turnaround."

Adds BMG chairman and BPI vice-chairman John Preston, "There's reason for cautious optimism. The economy is clearly beginning to recover and we tend to see the front end of that because ours is a young market and less affected by some of the perceptions that older consumers have. But the proof will be in the pudding at Christmas. I've always believed that the market would recover by this Christmas and,

while the latest results are slightly earlier than I would have predicted, they're encouraging neverthe-

Blondes Have More Fun

US label Interscope scores its first number one hit on EHR this week. After the six-week reign of UB40, 4 Non Blondes have taken over the top slot.

It's only the second time for Interscope, the label of producer Jimmy Iovine, to make an impact on EHR, following the modest '91 radio hit of Marky Mark & The Funky Bunch with Good Vibrations.

There is a remarkable similarity between the sales and airplay levels of the What's Up single in the various European markets. In those territories where What's Up scores its best sales results-Austria, Holland, Norway, Sweden and Switzerland-airplay levels are equally good. Other markets where the link between airplay and sales is strong include the UK (no. 3 sales chart versus 90% EHR penetration) and Germany (2 versus 60%).

Since the launch of the EHR chart in December 1990, the Eurochart and the EHR Top 40 shared the same number 1 only five other times. The longest tie occurred in August '91 when Bryan Adams's (Everything I Do) I Do It For You was number 1 on both charts for 12 consecutive weeks.

Adams is followed by Michael Jackson (Black Or White on pole position in both listings for eight weeks), Whitney Houston (I Will Always Love You; seven weeks), Madonna (Erotica; three weeks) and Roxette (Joyride; 1 week).

The fact that a debut single has achieved such a feat is even more striking. And, to top off our chart trivia statistics on the Blondes, it marks the second time for a debut single to have conquered the top slot of the EHR Top 40, following Tasmin Archer with last year's Sleeping Satellite.

Billy Joel scores the biggest increase in points this week as The River Of Dreams moves up from 6 to 4. By collecting an impressive 20 new adds along the way, Joel becomes a challenge to the 4 Non Blondes.

The highest entry this week is another US act, who also records for Columbia-Mariah Carey. Her Dream Lover single—taken from the forthcoming Music Box album—crashes the chart at number 8.

That the single was highly anticipated is proven by the number of new additions in its first chart week: 41, the second-highest ever. Only Sting's If I Ever Lose My Faith In You collected more new adds (44).

The Spin Doctors are clearly one of the more unexpected rock bands to break through on EHR. While their debut album has already gone gold in Europe (500.000 copies sold) and has reached double platinum in the US (two-million), their very first radio single Little Miss Can't Be Wrong (Epic) is now being re-promoted and enters the chart while Two Princes still manages to hold on. Best radio markets for "Little Miss" are currently the UK and Sweden.
