Albertini Reshuffles PolyGram Staff

FRANCE

PolyGram Disques president Paul-René Albertini will increase his involvement in the day-to-day activities at Poly-Gram France's labels Polydor and Phonogram following major shake-ups announced during the PolyGram convention in Paris on August 28. As part of the changes Albertini will act as operating MD of Polydor for an interim period, replacing general manager Nagi Baz, who has left the com-

Underlining that the changes at the two labels came about for different reasons. Albertini attributed them also to his will to "refocus the company" and to "prepare for the market of the next two or three years.'

Polydor has recently been seen as a weak element in the PolyGram France group of labels. It was managed by Marc Lumbroso for many years until he set up his label, Remark, in the early '90s in partnership with Poly-Gram. Baz, former commercial director of ad agency Publicis and an outsider to the music industry, was then appointed GM of the label in mid-1991.

There were gaps in the decision making process at Polydor, says Albertini, especially in financial aspects such as cost control. "I have a lot of respect for Nagi and I think he did the best he could at Polydor," he says. "Polydor has signed and developed what I believe is the best catalogue of new acts of all the (continues on page 21)

Europe 1's Ozannat Sees Crucial Year Ahead

The coming year will be crucial for the French radio industry, with the country's leading operators eventually all offering four or five services, says Europe 1 Communications vice-president Jean-Pierre Ozannat, who unveiled the new programmes for full-service Europe 1.

He says, "Ten years ago there were only four major radio stations. Today, there are 18 different national programmes offered to listeners, plus countless local services. What is more, things are becoming much more complex. In the very near future, major groups will have different types of programmes to reach different

On the subject of Europe 1, he comments, "Our group is financially sane and well managed and we are ready to invest whatever is needed wherever it is possible to

achieve that goal. Our ambition is soon to have three or four different programmes." Ozannat admits that his group may be interested in the acquisition of the RMC group, due to be privatised this autumn, once the exact financial situation of the group and the price of acquisition are revealed.

Meanwhile, the option remains to transfer the sister programmes of ACE Europe 2 from the status of programme supplier to an owned and operated network. He underlines, however, that these plans are all pending changes in the current regulations which are (continues on page 21)

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

International Trade Groups Bullish On POPKOMM '93

FUROPE

International trade groups, who were allowed to exhibit at German trade fair POPKOMM for the first time this year, are reporting positive results from their efforts.

Some 88 trade groups and record companies from 11 European countries were represented at the fair by country stands under the POPKOMM "Meet The Nations" banner. The panels also reflected the growing international involvement in the fair with eight panels held in English (compared to just one last year) and an increase in the number of non-German panelists.

The French music industry, which attended the POPKOMM convention for the first time with a collective stand, is making positive comments about the move. Over 50 French delegates representing over 20 companies were present in Cologne. Labels report strong activity and increasing

interest in their productions.

Jean-François Michel, director of the French Export Office, which co-ordinated the French presence at POPKOMM, says, "This first experience not only allows commercial exchanges and the launch of French acts in Germany, but also enables the Export Office to target demands better and organise a commercial and promotional follow-up with all the French professionals."

The French showcases (Les Tambours du Bronx, Jimmy Jay's "Cool Sessions," Soon E-MC, Denez Pringent and Marie-Laure Béraud) were well attended. He adds, "Cultural and commercial exchange between France and Germany has now become a reality." A similar operation is likely to be organised next year.

PR/international promotions manager at Dutch rock and pop foundation SPN Laurence Hoen says, "The response to Dutch music was very good at the fair. I

noticed most visitors to our stand were professionals from radio, labels and press who were asking about specific bands. We also handed out a lot of our special compilation CDs."

Director Jaap van Beusekom, who has regularly attends the annual Berlin Independence Days trade fair, says he was impressed with POPKOMM. "It's very big and alive with a good atmosphere. My only complaint was that our showcase with Burma Shave and Gotcha! took place outside, which attracted lots of beer-drinking Germans instead of professionals. It was disappointing. I would have preferred to have a proper venue." SPN says that it will definitely be back at POPKOMM next year.

Flemming Madsen, director of the Danish Music Information Centre, which was represented on the joint Scandinavian country stand at POPKOMM, says POPKOMM was "much more of a public, social event than MIDEM, which is strictly business. To my knowledge most Danish companies were happy with the response they got at POPKOMM. Deals and contracts were settled just as an international fair should work."

Over 40 companies and 60 people attended POPKOMM, and if anything, the Scandinavian stand was too small, says Madsen. Seven Danish bands performed in showcases and the Danish Minister of Culture also attended.

Comments Jeff Clark-Meads, head of press at UK music industry body BPI, "We made very valuable contact with German and other continental European industries and we plan to be back even bigger and better next year."

Clark-Meads, who was formerly international editor with **Billboard**, adds, "I've enjoyed seeing the growth of POPKOMM. I like the fair's special atmosphere combining music and business."

RMC Sharpens News Service, Privatisation Nears Completion

FRANCE

State-owned full-service net Radio Monte Carlo is increasing its news coverage as part of programming tweaking announced by director general Jean-Noel Tassez and new operations director Jérôme Bellay at the station's press conference held on August 26.

Under the slogan "more information, more up to date," the station will be adding several new slots to its schedule including a daily sports programme and a Saturday morning "week in view" programme. Meanwhile, plans to add local news hook-ups in the major southern towns, starting with Lyons, Marseilles and Toulouse are awaiting authorisation.

Tassez also announced at the conference that the process of privatisation is now in the final phase. A call for offer is expected to be made soon and a decision is planned before the winter. The privatisation will include RMC, 51% of gold-formatted Radio Nostalgie and the advertising rep GEM. No price has been set so far by the French government.

The financial losses for the station came to a total of Ffr40 million (app. US\$6.6 million) for the fiscal year ending September 30, according to Tassez. who forecast losses in the region of Ffr20 million in 1994. As GEM is expected to deliver profits up to Ffr9 million and Nostalgie in the region of Ffr 40 million, the group is likely to be profitable. EL,JS

NAB Unveils Operations Seminar At Euro Disney

US radio/TV trade group the National Association of Broadcasters is returning to Europe to conduct a two-day operations seminar at Euro Disney on November 22-23.

Called the 1993 European Radio Operations Seminars, the NAB will conduct three simultaneous meetings focusing on sales/marketing, audience research and radio programming. "Building A More Effective Sales And Marketing Team" will be presented by Dallas, Texas, management consultant Norman Goldsmith and Radio Advertising Bureau executive vice president George Hyde.

"Radio Audience Research Methodologies And Applications" will by conducted by Coleman Research executive vice president Pierre Bouvard and NAB senior vice president of research and planning Rick Ducey. "Personalities To Promotions: Refining The On-Air Product" will be led by Dennis Clark, production manager for KISS-FM/Los Angeles's "Rick Dees In The Morning" show.

Comments NAB executive vice president/operations John Abel, "While we recognise that there are national differences in how professionals deal with sales, marketing, research and programming, the fundamental manage-

ment techniques are universal. These seminars will address the management topics that private European radio broadcasters have told us are important to them."

Sponsoring morning breakfasts are UK syndication company Unique Broadcasting and Coleman Research. Euro Disney is sponsoring the welcoming reception.

One June 10-13, the NAB held its first "Radio Montreux International Symposium and Technical Exhibition" in Montreux in which a delegation of 100 US broadcasters joined nearly 800 others from 37 countries From Europe, Africa, the Far East and Australasia. SW

UNITED KINGDOM: BBC Keeps "Top Of The Pops"

"Top Of The Pops," the BBC TV's weekly chart show which was first launched in 1964, has escaped being axed, but will be radically revamped next year. The programme's future format will be decided by BBC 1 FM controller Alan Yentob and David Liddiment, who takes over the role of head of BBC Entertainment Group in October. Viewing figures for the show have dropped from a one-time 15 million to between 6.5-9 million.

FRANCE: Ozannat Replaces Sautter As Head Of SNRG

Europe 1 Communications vice president Jean-Pierre Ozannat has been elected president of the association of national generalist privates, the SNRG. He replaces CLT's Remi Sautter, who didn't seek re-election. Ozannat says the discussions on the new radio law will be his immediate priority, but he set as a general goal the establishment of a single representative body for radio as a whole. The SNRG was created two years ago by the three commercial full-service stations known in France as "periphériques" (RTL, Europe 1, and RMC). Together, these three stations attract some 30% of the total radio audience and half of the total radio advertising revenues.

Cologne Continues Anti-Racist Protest With "Arsch Huh"

GERMANY

The organisation of musicians against racism operating under the banner "Arsch huh" is extending its political involvement by scheduling an anti-racist conference to be held in December, in response to the violence in Solingen earlier this year.

The organisation, which includes musicians, record companies, publishers and artists in Cologne, came about last November when rock artists including acts such as BAP, Black Fööss, Brings and L.S.E. grouped together to show their anger at the rising level of violence against foreigners in Germany by staging a concert under the banner of "Arsch huh, Zäng usseinander."

An eponymously-titled CD featuring the groups in the concert was then released by EMI/Electrola. All proceeds from "Arsch huh" CDs, books etc. now go to establish new groups and initiatives to deal with the theme of racism in an artistic and cultural way. Money is also directed to educate school children about racism and support leisure institutes for young people.

MD of the "Arsch huh" organisation Karl Wachtel comments, "The recent spate of violence against foreigners led to a desire to express ourselves more politically. The idea of the congress is to hold a meeting between industry people, media and politicians to discuss how we can

create an atmosphere which is more sympathetic to non-Germans and establish more flexible asylum laws." The organisers hope to be able to point to Cologne as foreigner-friendly, fully integrated and a role model for other German towns.

A day of "silence" is also planned, with a general musical boycott, intended to underline the fact that cultural life and activity is impossible in a racist climate. Says Wachtel, "This is a followup to the concert last year attended by some 10.000 people. Many people wanted to see a repeat of that event this year, but we decided instead to have a day of no music to show how destructive racism and violence can be to cultural life.

ILR station Pirate FM102, which covers Cornwall, Plymouth and West Devon, is expanding after 16 months on air. As part of the expansion, Richard Edwards has been appointed field sales manager, while ex-Plymouth Sound executive Julia Hardwick becomes regional sales executive.

Marketing and sales director Joseph Swain aims to increase regional and national revenue as a direct result of the new appointments and will himself spend more time on regional and national revenue. "Local sales are

growing 20% year on year, so it makes sense to look further afield," he says. "Enthusiasm for radio has never been stronger among client marketing departments and, providing one has something relevant and logical to say, brand managers are more responsive than ever to radio.'

Swain also confirms that the station has been acting as consultant to the local group Bay City Radio by helping produce a business plan and conducting music research. "If the station wins a licence we will have a shareholding of around 20% in it," he says.

EMI Norway Increases Local A&R Activities For Autumn Season

One year after restructuring EMI Norsk, MD Jan Østli is continuing to increase emphasis on A&R and promotion, with big plans for the autumn. The company is already beginning to reap the benefits of its restructuring, as the label is now ranked number two in the market, behind BMG Ario-

The label recently moved to the centre of Oslo as part of the restructuring, together Virgin Records and Eva Records, to come closer to media and retail. "Our new offices will increase our availability and efficiency," says Østli. "The efficiency," says Østli. artists will become more integrated in the company and the sales staff will have more opportunity to meet international

acts in person, which in itself is very motivating.

Østli will also be appointing an assistant to the local A&R manager Per Østmark in September. This new position will focus on new and developing

Releases are scheduled for this autumn from six of EMI's 10roster-a considerable amount for a Norwegian record company, "It's dangerous to have too many [Norwegian] artists," says Østli. "Instead we will be selective.'

New releases include newly signed act Trine Rein-exvocalist in the group WIP, which spawned the hit Ghost Jam two years ago-and Jahn Teigen, with his album Rondo expected in September. Jørn Hoel will also release an album, his first on EMI. Other EMI new releases include Vagabond, Yellow Pages and The Rambelins.

The autumn will be tough with a glut of releases from all the companies," says Østli. "We have to work seriously and achieve the maximum. After the parallel import legislation was implemented it was expected that the labels would reinvest money in Norwegian music, which is what we are doing already."

Local Radio Tightens Grip, Holds 50% Of Irish Audience

Although Irish national pubcaster RTE has increased its share of the national weekday audience, independent local radio is continuing to consolidate its position in Ireland, holding 50% of the listening audience, according to the latest six-month ratings released by JNLR.

RTE Radio One remains the most popular station in the hotly contested Dublin market, gaining 4% in its weekday listening audience, up to 49%. While RTE partner 2FM held its 18% share and ACE FM104 rose 1% to 12%, Dublin-based ACE station Classic Hits 98FM showed a dramatic 6% drop to share second place with 2FM. Donegal's Highland Radio showed the biggest improvement among regional stations, increasing its market share by nine points to 64%.

FM104/Dublin chief executive Dermot Hanrahan was quick to point out that the station had continued to increase its market share, gaining three points over a full-year period.

Meanwhile 98FM PD Dirk Anthony admits the results were 'quite a surprise and disappointment," adding that the drop was not indicated in their own

Station bosses were quick to point out that Classic Hits 98FM remained the number one station for its core ABC1 target audience, and was running "neck and neck" with RTE's 2FM in the 20-44 demo.

The most positive trend to show up in the survey was the continued growth in radio listenership, according to IRTC chief executive Michael O'Keefe. "We now have a very healthy independent sector complementing and offering an alternative to the wide variety of services provided by RTE," he says.

Radio Fighting To Increase Market Share In Finland

FINLAND

One in every four of the 49 local stations currently in operation has financial problems, according to a new survey carried out by the Turku School of Economics. Only half of the stations generate sufficient income to cover their expenses, and only every fourth station is making a good profit.

Kai Salmi, MD of the Association of Finnish Radio Broadcasters predicts that by the end of the '90s there will be 30-40 full-service and some specialised stations. "At the moment there are between five and 10 stations in

the risk group, of which some will go bankrupt and some of them will survive the next few vears.

Salmi says the strong points of the local radio business are an established market position, improved professional skills and new enthusiastic radio perso-

Salmi believes that Finnish radio may reach its target of 10% of the media advertising business by 1999. Radio currently commands a 4.6% share of total advertising. Local advertising represented an average 83% of station income in 1992 compared to 78% in 1991.

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Private Broadcasters Unhappy About Gaps In Radio Bill

The private radio bill passed by the Austrian parliament last month is causing unrest among many private broadcasters, who complain that the restrictions on media ownership are insufficient and will not allow privates to compete with public giant ORF. Meanwhile, many claim that the 26% limitation on print media in one area and 10% for two additional districts is not sufficient to prevent crossownership.

Comments Walter Tributsch. MD at EHR private CD International, "The media limitations won't prevent cross-ownership. It will be possible, for instance, for Austria's biggest daily newspaper Die Neue Kronenzeitung, which has a reach of over 50% in Vienna, to own a 26% share in a radio station in Vienna. Experience in Germany has shown that print editors are quick to gain total control over radio stations, although they don't have 100% ownership. But with their powerful print me-

dia they can suppress the dynamics of a competitive market.

Tributsch says that private broadcasters who don't have the backing of powerful print media will be at a disadvantage when it comes to gaining advertising and listenership. He adds, "The bill limits networking in programming as well as in advertising, which still gives the ORF a monopoly on nationwide broadcasting and advertising."

IFPI Austria MD Franz Medwenitsch does not believe print should be banned from private radio, although he is not certain whether the media limitations set down by Parliament are sufficient to stop media concentration. "Print media have a lot of know-how which can be transferred to radio," he argues. "It wouldn't be logical to ban them from private radio."

Die Neue Kronenzeitung and Austria's third largest paper, Kurier, are owned by Media Print. According to Medwenitsch, many people think that this is too much concentration and object to

the idea of print media investing in private radio also.

Private stations also claim that the media restrictions are to their disadvantage as a number of owners must be found to run one station, which they say complicates things. Tributsch points out, "More people means more opinions and more personal interests. This makes things very difficult if you are not lucky enough to find partners with the same thinking."

Medwenitsch agrees that having several owners could be a problem for a private stations. He points out, however, that non-print media related owners may well come forward as investors in Austria's private radio, in which case 100% ownership would be

Another problem for private broadcasters, says Tributsch, is that only a few frequencies are to be made available and the large number of applicants means that commissions will force applicants to form groups.

Meanwhile, potential commercial broadcasters also confront considerable technical problems, faced with finding antenna and transmitter positions in the ORFdominated landscape.

Says Medwenitsch, "The ORF antenna system covers around 98% of Austria. Private broadcasters can legally use this system, but they have to work out a solution with the pubcaster. I don't know if the ORF will be cooperative or not." He suggests that private broadcasters might well decide to build their own antenna systems, though this could be expensive in the mountainous areas of Austria.

Medwenitsch expects around two frequencies to be distributed for each of the nine districts—this could be less in the smaller regions and more for the bigger areas. A seminar on Austrian private radio will be held in Vienna on September 23.

Radio Antigoon Joins IP, Expected To Add 33% More Sales

BELGIUM

Flanders' second largest private, Antwerp-based EHR Radio Antigoon, has signed an advertising deal with major ad sales house IP Transistor following a dispute between station MD Piet Keizer and Patrick Herroelen, chairman of the Flemish local radio federation the VFLR. The decision is expected to boost IP's sales in Flanders by some 33% and further weaken the only competing ad house BRM. IP Transistor's current client list in Flanders represents an audience share of 11.9%, via Radio Contact and Nostalgie.

Radio Antigoon had been receiving its advertising through the recently founded sales house the BRM. That group was

founded in 1991 by Keizer and MDs from EHR/rock-formatted Radio Sinjaal and EHR Stadsradio Halle to coordinate national advertising for a number of independent private stations. Shortly afterwards it was used by pubcaster BRTN's sales house VAR as a means of offering an additional medium to potential BRTN radio clients. BRM stations in Flanders together represent a market share of 16.8% according to BRTN/VAR figures, June '93

The BRM grouped together all the members of the VFLR. Both are supporters of private radio in Flanders, and against the com--mercial networks represented by IP Transistor. However, an argument between the VFLR and Antigoon arose recently when Herroelen raised objections to the station's licence "due to administrative problems," according to Antigoon's Keizer, who adds, "We then decided to look elsewhere for our advertising, as did Stadsradio Halle." Antigoon will remain a shareholder in BRM, however.

IP Transistor marketing manager Birgitta Desmet is happy about the move, as it strengthens IP's position in Flanders, along with the recent signing of top station EHR-formatted Radio Reflex/Mechelen.

"BRM's turnover was below expectations," comments Desmet. "With Radio Antigoon added to stations like [ex-Radio Contact] VRM, Radio Expres and Radio Nostalgie/Antwerp, I think we will boost our sales figures in Flanders by 33%."

Miramar Ratings Explode After Form At Flip To EHR

A format change to EHR and a DJ exodus from a close competitor propelled Radio Miramar to a 3.4% share from 1.0% in hotly contested Lisbon. Five DJs from EHR Radio Cidade joined Miramar-which formerly offered a blend of ACE, N/T and EHRwhen it moved to a more clean EHR sound. Miramar is now Lisbon's sixth most-listened-to station and the number four EHR in the capital.

Full-service pubcaster RR Canal 1 remains the perennial ratings leader with an 11.8% share, virtually unchanged from year-end. News talker TSF Radio Iournal held onto its number two rating, but slipped 0.6 points to a 7.3% share.

There are now four EHRs battling it out in Lisbon. Radio Energia remains the leader and the third rated station in the city with a 6.2% share, barely changed from December. It is also number one in the 18-24 demo with a 15.4% share and in a virtual tie with Cidade in the 15-17 demo with a 15.2% share.

German Programmers Chart The Future

The record industry isn't the only German media sector undergoing profound structural and operational changes. While label execs debated the music industry's future at POPKOMM in Cologne on August 19-22, German radio has its hands full with the prospect of an increasingly competitive and fragmented market when additional national and local frequencies become available.

Comments Raimund Wagner, head of music at state-wide private ACE Antenne Bayern/Munich, "We have more and more competitors-local, national and cable stations, for example—with more coming up. The main question in the future will be choosing the right position within the chosen music format

"We already have some specialised stations in Germany, particularly in our market. We have a classic rock and a schlager station. We will probably see more format fragmentation in the larger cities, but most new stations will probably try ACE first when they launch because it has the smallest risk.

'The sound of public and private stations has also become more and more similar since competition started, because both changed their styles, and this will continue.

Too Much ACE

Arno Müller, PD at Hot ACE 104.6 RTL Berlin, agrees with Wagner that following the ACE lead in the future will be dangerous. "Operators in Berlin are all

going for the younger listener with the same type of ACE format," he says. "It's bad for the listeners and the stations because there is too much competition within that target audience. There are so many different audience groups that are not being served.



The same goes for older demos. There are no schlager, volksmusik or gold stations. These are all good formats that can reach very good audiences and get a very good share. The market for mixed formats is closed."

Audiences are "absolutely ready" for niche formats in all German cities, says Müller. "We know it from our research that people prefer one style of music," he comments. "When RTL changed to a gold format from ACE, ratings doubled or tripled at our small, local stations. Niche formats are easy to promote and the people know exactly what they get. That change was a success in half a year. It's also a good sign in that it works in smaller markets, especially in areas where the stations don't have the bud-

The real question now, says Müller, is how broad a niche format can be. "A few radio stations have already tried a niche format, but with a more broad appeal. Many people point to [classic rocker] Radio Xanadu/Munich for example. I believe Xanadu has done it wrong. They created their format from a completely producer-

what music they really like or what music they are used to and really know. You cannot go and transfer a classic rock format from America to Germany. That won't work. I have to find out what type of rock music to play here.

Broadcasting's Still In

For Hermann Stümpert, founder of Schönkirchen-based FunkBüro Radio Consulting, tight, niche formats are still a few years out in the future and broadcasting, not narrowcasting, is still the best way to go. "One thing the industry has to learn is that this is Germany and not America," he says. "In the beginning, radio executives didn't know about America. They did what they thought was right. Some of it was right, but most was wrong. Now they know America inside and out.

"But now they must learn that it will be a long time before tight formats will work in Germany, outside of one or two big cities. This is still a family country, where families listen to the radio together.

Competition will double or even triple, says Stümpert, as more stations are awarded. "For instance here, where I live, for the last eight years or so we have had two pop stations from the public and one private station, RSH. Now we have two private stations, and a third one will be licensed around the new year. Also, a third public channel will be launching in April.'

Competition will increase at a faster rate than advertising revenue, forcing stations to be more frugal in their operations. "The

next thing that has to happen is that investors and the regulators have to learn that if you have a lot of competitors in the market, then you can't spend as much money on programming as you did in the past. You have to learn new techniques to do radio cheaper.

But in order to win a licence you have to promise a lot of things. You have to promise a 24-hour service, news every hour, a lot of political magazine shows, local original programming, and so on and so on. Regulators will have to be aware of this in awarding new stations. Greater Berlin will be the first city in which stations will be forced to operate more cheaply. "The privates have taken away a share of our public as was expected," he says. "However, they no longer have the charm

Support Your Local Artists

On the topic of supporting German artists, Heinemann has been the most vocal and visible of the country's programmers. A public broadcaster has a certain responsibility towards the artists working in his country. But I don't know if our public will appreciate this type of presentation of local, regional or national artists. What I know is that by programming mainly Englishsinging artists for the past 20-30 years we

have accustomed our German-speaking public to one foreign language.

That's quite a strange thing. You could never imagine that in Great Britain or America. We proved we were successful in getting them used to those songs, so I think we

will become successful in concerting our public to our own language.

For RTL's Müller, though, German music in the charts is "either too aggressive or too conservative." He says, "There's not much in there that appeals to a 20-40 demo. There is not enough mass appeal product made in Europe or in Germany. What is made for a younger, adult audience is either young techno and progressive rock or old schlager, volksmusik. There's nothing in the middle. There's not much with an international standard of mainstream pop, like Herbert Grönemeyer. Radio needs more mainstream music. We had some in the past, but listeners are burned out on those artists. There's nothing new.

Adds Antenne Bayern's Wagner, "We have to be very careful of what we programme because our audience has grown up for decades with Anglo-American music and to try and change their tastes is not too

Making Karaoke Work For Your Station

Karaoke, literally "empty orchestra," is the Japanese entertainment tradition that's been increasing in popularity for the past 25 years or so in which customers in a bar take turns going up to a microphone and signing the lead vocals of a popular song.

In the '90s, karaoke has moved from the 8-track tape to the laser disc. Patrons of the bar are entertained not only by the live singer buy also by a custom-produced, conceptual music video.

Now, that karaoke has taken over Japan, can be found almost everywhere in America, and is on its way to Europe, how can your station take advantage of this new fad?

In the late '70s, album rock stations across America got many months of promotional mileage by sponsoring "air guitar" contests in local bars. Listeners got up on stage and pantomimed playing guitar to popular rock songs.

Just as stations benefitted from that craze a decade ago, it may be possible for your station to get some mileage out of the karaoke kick. Your radio station might, for example, sponsor karaoke nights at local pubs. Going even further, your station might buy a system to bring

to various promotions.

To maximize your station's exposure, display your logo between songs on all video monitors. There is a pause of 10-30 seconds between selected songs, depending on whether the disc has to be changed or not. During that time, it would be ideal if you could put your station's call letters on the screen. You could do this by using a video switcher to a second video source that delivers your logo.

Also, consider making do-it-yourself karaoke videos. There may be legal complications here, but there should be ways around them, assuming the sponsoring bar is paying appropriate music licensing royalties. Consumer audio and video gear now allows you to take a music video, wipe out the vocals and superimpose the lyrics. You could have fun making these in your station, or you could run an on-air contest inviting listeners to make their own.

One of the big hazards of sending air personalities out on appearances is that they tend to look like either arrogant jerks or mindless idiots, because they don't have anything to say or do. Give them a specific framework to work in, like being the host of a karaoke night, and you can help them look smart, friendly and useful.

New Location Mixer From Soundcraft

Soundcraft is attacking new territory for the company—the location mixer market. Used primarily by film and video recordists, the location mixer is also extensively utilised by radio engineers for outside broadcast work where a large desk is either un-necessary or impossible to use. The Soundcraft LM1 is available in three frame sizes; 6, 8, and 12 inputs and a rackmount option is available for the 8-input version. There is a choice of three input modules; mono mic/line, stereo mic and stereo line and the LM1 has a four bus routing system with four independent output faders. For stereo TV the LM1 will encode and decode MS/LR on each channel and will decode MS to LR on the monitor section. Ruggedly constructed using aluminium castings and extrusion, the LM1 will operate from an external CD input of 8 to 30V or on internal D cells giving up to 18 hours of use

Sony DASH Sales To Poland, Kuwait

Polish Radio has purchased two Sony PCM-3324S digital 24-track recorders along with 10 CDP-2700 CD players and four DCDK-3600 CD jukebox players as part of a project to automate its 19 stations. Meanwhile in the Middle East, Eastlake Audio, which has been rebuilding the studio complex of Kuwait Radio following the 1991 Gulf War, has supplied a PCM-3348 48-track recorder via local distributor International Music Centre to the project. This is the first sale of a 48-track DASH recorder to a Middle Eastern client and Sony is confident of further sales in the region.

Long Live Audix Broadcasting

Following the decision by the Tannoy Group to pull out of broadcast related products and sales, lan Jennings, former MD of Audix, has purchased the rights to all broadcast products and started Audix Broadcast Ltd, operating from the original works and offices in Saffron Walden, Essex. Since the re-launch Audix Broadcast has scored several successes with sales into UK radio and TV stations.

Cut The Crackle!

Cedar, hot on the heels of its DC-1 de-clicker, has turned to another of the banes of the old analogue world with its plastic discs being scraped with metal needles—crackle. Using their expertise in impulse noise reduction and their "Split And Recombine" signal processing technology, Cedar's CR-1 can eliminate crackle, buzz and also reduce distortion. The beauty of all this in real time has not been lost on the mastering industry who have been quick to take up the CR-1. Broadcasters who spend a lot of time playing older material could stand to benefit from the CR-1. Cedar has released a new Audio Restoration Systems brochure available free via their UK distributors HHB.

Trantec Notch Up 10.000th Sale

23-year-old DJ Richard Wilkes was the recipient of the 10.000th Trantec S1000 radio mix sold. Wilkes has been a Trantec user for three years and upgraded to the S1000 on the advice of a friend. It was supplied by HW Audio in Huddersfield. The S1000 can be configured as a hand-held, head set boom or guitar system and features the S1000RX precision quartz optimised receiver.

First Broadcast Goes To Hospital

Hospital radio has never been viewed as a highly lucrative market, but Brighton-based First Broadcast has hit a rich vein. Southampton Hospital Broadcasting Association (SHBA) broadcasts to five hospitals in the vicinity entirely voluntarily and were recently handed a golden opportunity. A local superstore development found that the only available site for an approach road was right through SHBA's studios. Subsequently SHBA has been handsomely compensated and will be moving to purpose built studios about 100 metres down the road, designed and installed by First Broadcast. The complex will house five studios and an apparatus room. Three of the studios will be equipped with MBI series 20 mixers, Sonifex discarts and a range of other equipment. First Broadcast will house the equipment in custom designed woodwork.

NSM Launch Domestic CD Jukebox

German-based NSM Aktiengeselischaft, makers of the 100 disc CD jukebox used by several CD playout systems, has launched the CD 3101 hi-fi version. The CD 3101 is a



user-friendly CD player and library, storing 100 discs but, unlike the professional version, the 3101 comes with selection control via an infrared remote control. The user can programme in sequences of tracks and alter these while the 3101 is playing. The 3101 may prove to be a useful tool for small-scale broadcasters who want a cheap way of providing overnight sustaining programme or for live assist in the studio.

It's very different, but that's no problem for Top Music/Strasbourg head of music Hervé Petit. "On the contrary, versatility is the man's trademark. He is a melting pot of influences, and it's quite normal that plain rock comes out this time."

Now joined by vocalist Janis Alexander, Coldcut have signed to Arista UK and rank alongside artists to the stature of Eros Ramazzotti, Haddaway and Kenny G by being placed immediately on BMG's European priority list. That's quite an achievement considering that Coldcut have yet to establish significant sales for BMG.

Dreamer, the act's infectious debut single released on August 23, received imme-

diate radio acceptance in the UK, says Julian Wall, head of international at Arista UK. "It was C listed at BBC Radio 1 FM three weeks before the release date; it then moved to the station's B playlist and should move up to the A list when it charts. It is also on the playlists of seven major ILR stations which is pretty good when you consider that a low number of ILR stations playlist a record before it's charted."

At presstime, the single was playlisted on 13 stations (regardless of format) and especially Italy looks promising with the airplay support from Radio Dimensione Suono/Rome and pubcaster StereoRai/Rome.

Initial European promotion was centred on a digi-pak CD entitled *Then & Now*. The "Then" CD features old Coldcut successes with artists ranging from Eurythmics to Jade, while the "Now" CD features *Dreamer* plus a lush version of the classic song *Autumn Leaves* which could be Coldcut's second Arista single before the release of the act's debut album *Philosophy* on October 11.

Comments Wall, "The digi-pack CD gives a perspective in terms of past and present. It summed the whole thing up in a coherent and easy to grasp way. When you are marketing internationally there is a value in keeping things as clear cut as possible. We are not looking to re-invent the wheel."

Wall acknowledges that the Coldcut project was launched at a difficult time of the year with companies closing for holidays and many media stations pre-programming through July, August and the beginning of September. "But we were eager to get it out," he stresses. "We wanted to go for it from day one in a fundamental manner and not necessarily wait until the deluge of product that inevitably occurs when all these people come back from holiday in September."

Wall says that this quick of the mark strategy paid off and reaction has been terrific. "Companies within BMG are very interested and we've set up a number of promotional trips to Germany, Holland and Belgium during which Coldcut will do some press, TV and local media."

All that happens before the release of the album and Wall confirms that each individual territory is currently putting together its own marketing plans. Adds Wall, "There's an international marketing meeting at the beginning of September headed by Chris Stone [BMG International's VP A&R/marketing]. We'll discuss in intricate detail the nuts and bolts of making this happen all over Europe. It's great that BMG can feed the product in and have a coherent and intelligent plan as to how to go about selling records in these markets."

A promo video for *Dreamer* has been shot by **Michael Goeghan** whose credits include **Roxette**, **Michael Oldfield** and **Jesus Jones**. **MTV Europe** filmed a special mini-documentary on the band which was screened 11 times within the space of one week. "MTV usually waits for records to show signs of action before it commits to that extent," comments Wall. "I think it's very encouraging to get that sort of commitment from very early on."

SHORT TAKES

• Following the split of Spanish pop flamenco act Los Manolos, singer Joan Herrero has recruited two other guitar players and signed with BMG Ariola/Madrid; Chocolate will probably be the name under which the band will record. The remaining members of the band have signed with Madrid-based Horus and will continue recording under the old band's name.

• Sony Music Holland has produced a special package of the new Ten Sharp single *Lines On Your Face*. The first 3.000 maxi singles will be avialable with a free video clip, shot in the Oekraïne.

● The new Frank Sinatra album for Capitol is entitled Duets and will contain collaborations with Luciano Pavarotti (My Way), Luther Vandross (The Lady Is A Tramp), Barbra Streisand (Crush On You) and Tony Bennett (New York New York). Other artists featured on the Phil Ramone-produced album include Bono, Cher, Bette Midler, Diana Ross and Aretha Franklin. Some even say that Axl Rose may record a track.

• To promote John Hiatt's latest album Perfectly Good Guitar, A&M has produced a special sampler, called Beyond Words: A Lyrical Tour De Force Into Music (freely available to the consumer buying the album). The 12-track compilation features one album track and one previously-unreleased live song from David Baerwald, Suzanne Vega, Jann Arden, Kevin Montgomery, Sheryl Crow and John Hiatt.

• Next year will see the release of a Kiss tribute album. Released on Mercury, artists contributing include Anthrax, Garth Brooks. Extreme. Lenny Kravitz & Stevie Wender and Megadeth.

Nice Device Goes Dutch With Debut Single

DENMARK

Denmark isn't planning on sitting back while its neighbours Sweden and Germany fill the melting pot of dance. It's donation? None other than Nice Device, a group whose unique sound is charming EHR programmers and Dutch consumers alike.

The group's BMG/Genlyd debut, Cool

Corona, is rapidly picking up airplay on stations like Italian EHR station Radio Club 91/Naples and fellow EHR Sveriges Radio P3/Stockholm, with the most significant airplay results in Holland, Belgium, Scandinavia and Germany. The song is currently charted at number 22 in Holland

and at number 33 in Denmark, with a forth-coming album to maintain the momentum.

For the first single, Nice Device has indirectly picked up the art of humouristic wordplay and rap from A Tribe Called Quest, the surf sound of The Beach Boys, the fusion of jazz and dance from US3 and

adapted it to its own ecstatic and happy style. "It's a good, energetic rap record full of sunshine," says EHR outlet TROS Radio 3/Hilversum DJ/producer Daniel Dekker, whose station picked up the song after it was made "Megahit" by another Dutch broadcaster on Radio 3, earlier in the summer.

Erik de Zwart, station manager at EHR Radio 538/Bussum placed it in A-

rotation when it first came out and it was made the station's "Alarmschijf" (Powerplay) in week 26. "The song was played 35 times in one week only! We thought it was a good song and that it had good potential," adds De Zwart. He has moved the song into B-rotation, because

the song has dropped to number 13 on the Dutch chart.

M&M's TrackFax data shows a total of 27 EHR stations reporting the song including major pubcasters like Ö3/Vienna, BRTN Radio Donna/Brussels and DRS 3/Basel. At presstime, the single had

entered the EHR Chartbound section.

BMG/Genlyd promotion assistant Sanne Avidsen, responsible for local repertoire, says Cool Corona, sent out several weeks ago, has received a lot of airplay in Denmark. The debut album, titled The Album, was sent out in week 31, and Avidsen will serve the international affiliates with promotion copies soon. The band's follow-up single, Love Is The Message, entered the Danish charts this week at number 48.





company's labels. It has a very strong team and this can be reflected in the success the label enjoys. My goal now is to enhance its efficiency."

Meanwhile, Phonogram jointgeneral/marketing manager Michel de Souza has moved to the sales division. De Souza, who will report to PolyGram sales director and deputy GM Laurent Gallavardin, will be in charge of strengthening the company's commercial activities, with special regard for artist development and decentralised marketing. Joint GM Philippe Vidalenc's position will be looked at over the next few months, according to Albertini.

De Souza admitted he wasn't given much time to decide, but accepted because he thought he had something to contribute. "PolyGram has one obsession—developing new acts, both international and national. I thought I could be one of those to help nurture those new talents within the sales department."

Comments Albertini. really needed to put more emphasis on the commercial aspects of things and we agreed that Michel de Souza's resources should be put at the service of all in the sales department. In terms of catalogue and talents, I don't think we'll have any problems. We have the artistic resources we need. In terms of financial results, we have been doing extremely well since the beginning of the year, with very good sales in June-August [with Johnny Hallyday, U2 and Dire Straits]. I think it will not slow down with the flow of releases we are expecting. But I want us to be fully prepared for the changes that will occur in the next two years. We have to rethink our way of marketing and promotion and we have to adapt the structures of our companies to the realities of today's market."

PolyGram Disques encompasses all the musical activities at the PolyGram group in France, such as the labels (Polydor, Phonogram, Barclay/Island), music publishing and merchandising.

limiting the group's development.

"Most of our regulations are outdated. If a new law is not discussed and passed by Parliament, it will be devastating for the radio industry."

Ozannat welcomes communication minister Alain Carignon's recent announcement that the ownership ceiling be lifted from 30 million potential listeners to

120 million, which leaves room for a maximum of three national networks for one single group. However, he questions the logic behind the new figure. "The 30 million ceiling was absurd, but why 120 million?"

On the question of local advertising, Ozannat endorses the views of one organisation of local operators who said that it was necessary to distinguish between the authorisation to broadcast and the right to carry local advertising. He condemns the fact that a station like

Europe 1 is not authorised to make local programmes and is therefor excluded from local ad markets, while national musical networks are entitled to simply because they include local commercial affiliates (category C).

"I am sure that if Europe 1 started to broadcast a local news programme in the city of Lyons, it could have a very important impact on the local life, certainly more so than a musical station whose playlist is decided from Paris."

afternoon drive time slot and will be launching a rock album chart. We have an open field in a unique music niche and have everything to gain."

Since EHR net Rete 105 dropped its afternoon "Johnny Rocket" programme and Peter Flowers' demise there has been no major station programming rock music apart from specialist shows. The station is also one of the only tightly formatted rock-oriented stations in Europe, others being classic rocker Radio Xanadu/

Munich and AOR national net Virgin 1215 AM in the UK and pubcasters VARA/ VPRO in Holland and BRTN Studio Brussels in Belgium.

Rock FM, which covers the Milan area on 98.7 FM, plans to extend to national coverage at the end of this year by syndicating its programming to affiliate regional stations in major markets. Rock FM targets a 20-45 demographic with 30% classic rock tracks from the '60s and '70s such as **Jimi Hendrix**, the **Doors** and the **Rolling Stones**; 35% '80s tracks and recurrents and 35% new music. Core artists on the current

playlist include Bon Jovi, Aerosmith, Coverdale/Page, Deep Purple, Steve Miller, 4 Non Blondes, Nirvana, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Stone Temple Pilots and Jesus Jones. Italian rock acts playlisted include Litfiba, Ligabue and Quartiere Latino.

WEA Italy international radio promotions manager Sando Mallasz welcomes the developments at Rock FM. "There is a large audience for rock music, but only a few local stations or specialist programmes cater for them. Rock FM's plans to become an interregional network are an important development."

fabric of British music and is no longer restricted to the Asian community.

Apache Indian has taken Indian Bhangra one giant step further by fusing it with Jamaican reggae. His unique brand of music has earned him the title "The Originator Of Bhangra-Muffin" and his track record since signing with Island Records last year includes a string of UK hit singles plus the debut album No Reservations.

Hailing from Handsworth, Birmingham, 26-year-old Apache Indian started out by recording the three singles *Move Over India*, *Chok There* and *Don Raja* for the **Indie Jet Star** label. Aided mainly by airplay on pirate radio stations, each release reached number 1 in the reggae and Asian charts, attracting the attention of Island Records.

"We just judged him from those singles," comments company MD Marc Marot. "We felt that he had commercial possibilities regardless of where he came from and what background he had."

Marot acknowledges the importance of radio in breaking the artist on the UK market. "His debut single for Island was Arranged Marriage which we released in January this year. The single got playlisted at BBC Radio 1 FM and that was absolutely crucial for us. We also got a lot of regional radio support."

Arranged Marriage peaked at number 16 in the UK chart. The artist's second single, Chok There, released in March, reached number 30, and his latest EP Nuff Vibes—featuring the tracks Caste System, Warning, Fun and Boom Shack-A-Lak—reached number 5.

It is especially the latter track

that is bringing Apache Indian recognition on the Continent. M&M TrackFax data shows a total of 33 EHR stations reporting Boom Shack-A-Lak, and apart from the UK, Holland and Sweden are the strongest foreign markets for the artist. In the UK, the album has been nominated for the prestigious Mercury Music Prize award.

Despite current success, Marot is hesitant to predict any great new trend for Bhangra-muffin as a musical genre. "Somebody asked me whether we'd go out and sign any other Bhangra-muffins that came along, but I'd still apply the same rules that applied to Apache when we discovered him," he says. "Although it may happen, I can't see any major trend starting with other record companies."

Apart from Island, the only other major record company involved in Bhangra is BMG Records UK, which acquired a majority share in Britain's Multitone Records last year.

Pedro Carvalho, head of music at the multi-ethnic station Spectrum International Radio/London, is a staunch supporter of Bhangra music. He says that Bhangra mixes on singles released by Ace Of Base and UB40 are fine examples of its growing popularity. He's also a long-time supporter of Apache Indian.

"I playlisted him on a late-night Bhangra programme I presented well over a year ago," he comments. "I also interviewed him long before Island signed him. I still play him on my Saturday night international show which features anything from Italian and Spanish music to Bhangra dance tracks and Apache Indian."

Carvalho has his own theory on the reasons for Apache Indian's crossover success. "Asian kids shy away from Western society in their leisure activities," he claims. "But now white English and Afro-Caribbean kids can turn around and say, 'Hey, we've such and such a show that you can listen to as well. It's really good and trendy.' That's where Apache Indian comes in. Asian kids can now say, 'This is Apache Indian. His music's not only good for us; you guys will like it as well'. His desire for broad appeal has brought a lot of people together."

Mambo Sharma, Apache Indian's manager, has plotted his artist's career course with precision. His first priority was to target territories with Asian populations, but adds that the seeds have already been sown in the US with concentration on both the Asian and reggae communities. Canada is another priority and the artist will tour India in October following a recent triumphant promotional trip where he performed shows to audiences of more than 18,000 and was given the title "The Ghandi Of Pop.

"We're also ready to do as much as we can in Europe," says Sharma. "But only where there are things there for us to do. There's very little TV exposure available and I've prioritised territories which can provide us with maximum exposure. I need to utilize time very well at this stage."

Sharma says that Apache Indian has already been on successful promotional visits to Austria, Holland and Germany before he signed to Island. These three territories remain high on Sharma's current European priority list. "He'll get to Europe," stresses Sharma. "When he performed in Germany it was the first time I saw a totally white audience getting down to Apache Indian. The barriers he's broken down in the last three years are amazing.

Astley Armed With Adds

In an otherwise rather stable week at the EHR surface, UK crooner **Rick Astley** proves to have the hottest record on his hands. While booking the highest new entry of the week at number 25, *The Ones You Love*, the taster for his *Body & Soul* album, collects no less than 32 first-time reports—an impressive 56% of his station roster! Most of these are scored in Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Italy, Belgium and Holland. The single is best spread on Swedish and UK radio (penetration figures of 78% and 76% respectively). Since the launch of the chart in December 1990, Astley scored two EHR hits before—*Cry For Help*, peaking at number 1 where it stayed for two consecutive weeks, and *Move Right Out*, peaking at 11—both in 1991.

Fastest mover of the week in terms of chart points, as well as performing the biggest leap (17 positions up from 33 to 16), is SWV's *Right Here*, last week's highest new entry. The US act also qualifies as second most added, with 22 adds to their disposal. These are recruited from practically all over Europe, notably from Germany, Denmark and Holland.

Other good movers in the chart's upper half are Mariah Carey who claims a top 3 position now, thanks to incessant substantial gain (in the East Central region she enters straight at one); UB40's Higher Ground (15-11), now almost sharing a tie with its predecessor (I Can't Help) Falling In Love With You at the bottom of the top 10; Haddaway's Life (19-13) and Lenny Kravitz's Heaven Help (27-18).

As for Haddaway, it is interesting to see him chart in the top 5 of the Eurochart Hot 100 with two singles at the same time: Life at number 3 and What Is Love at 4. In the Regional EHR Top 20, Life is currently number 2 in Central and number 1 in the West Central listing.

When we look at the additional EHR statistics, **Bitty**McLean catches the eye by topping the "A" Rotation
Performance section, thanks to the high ratio of heavy
rotation—80% of his roster—dedicated to his rendition
of It Keeps Rainin' (Tears From My Eyes). The British
newcomer also enjoys the second new entry in the
EHR Top 40, driven by massive playlisting in Holland
(100% penetration, powerplay status at the national
pubcasters and a top 3 debut in the West Central chart)
and the UK (86% penetration, top 10 EHR). Denmark,
Germany, Belgium and Austria are also showing good
interest in the new Fats Domino cover, but are still
open to substantial expansion.

The upper part of Chartbound looks packed with songs that have a fair chance to enter the chart next week. The Pogues, Tina Turner, Apache Indian and the Urban Cookie Collective come closest to entering the top 40 in terms of chart points, but Eros Ramazzotti's Un'Altra Te (recorded and titled as Otra Como Tu for the Spanish market), Stakka Bo, 2 Unlimited, Kate Bush and Terence Trent D'Arby all provide strong competition, as they are being served by promising proportions of adds.
