Since the fall of the Wall and the reunification of Germany, private radio has been mushrooming in the former DDR, with a constant stream of new stations setting up.

Desperate to take as large a share of the audience as possible, stations are flooding the market with broad-based ACE formats, which is reducing the collective chance of survival in the fragile

east German economy. In the state of Saxony, the market is fast approaching saturation like Berlin, say radio executives, who fear a shake-out is looming.

Berlin/Brandenburg is most advanced and most competitive of the five east German states with over 20 private, public and cable stations broadcasting. Many privates in the state complain that the competition has reached "cannibalistic" levels and that the media authority MABB should

not grant new licences. But competition is also hotting up in Saxony, with four private stations and two publics, a further local net planned, and stations broadcasting from neighbouring states.

The other three east German states show a different picture, lagging behind Saxony and Berlin. Sachsen-Anhalt only has two private stations, while Mecklenburg-Vorpommern and Thüringen have just one private station each. More stations are already in

the planning; a second private station is already on the cards in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern.

ACE-formatted statewide private BB Radio Landeswelle Brandenburg launched December last year. Based in Potsdam, the station broadcasts over six frequencies, including two in Berlin and Frankfurt/Oder. BB Radio's direct competitor is Potsdam-based MOR-formatted pubcaster Antenne Brandenburg

# Sky Radio Plans Euro **Expansion By Autumn**

Dutch cable/satellite ACE station Sky Radio plans to expand its operations throughout Europe in the next couple of years, with the nearest launch planned for as early as next autumn.

MD Ton Lauthouwers says that while it is too early to reveal who potential partners are, the station has a long-term plan to acquire frequencies and cable licences in both northern and southern Europe. Some plans involve partnering with local stations already in place.

The Rupert Murdoch-backed station was refused terrestrial frequencies in Holland last January, but plans to file legal actions against the Dutch government for what Lauthouwers calls illegal licensing procedures (M&M, April 30). Considered the commercial market leader in Holland. the station has been operating in the country since 1988 and is said by industry analysts to be "very

Sky Radio's former chairman Gary Davey was recently transferred to Asia to oversee Murdoch's satellite TV operations there, and media analysts believe that a possible Sky Radio could be planned for the burgeoning Asian market.

# SNEP Elects Carbonez As New President; Takes Over July 1

**BMG** France president Bernard Carbonez has been appointed the

new president of music industry organisation SNEP, replacing PolyGram France president Gilles Paire, who didn't seek re-election. Paire will continue to serve until July 1. Carbonez's



Carbonez mandate will last two years.

The unanimous election took place on April 21 after the annual SNEP board meeting. In a brief speech, Paire outlined the main changes that occurred during his two-year term. He said SNEP has moved to become a more professional and economics-oriented organisation, instead of simply being an institutional body representing the industry. He pointed out how this change was highlighted by the way two key industry tools--sales charts and airplay monitoring systems-had been reshaped in order to better serve the needs of the whole industry. These moves were necessary to adapt the industry to the challenges of the current situation. He

expressed his confidence that

SNEP's policy on these matters

will be continued. He said the two main challenges for the coming year were the issue of retail record prices and the lowering of VAT, which are currently under discussion with the ministry of culture.

During the board, SNEP also renewed its executive committee. under the presidency of Carbonez, with seven vice-presidents: Paire, Gilbert Ohayon (EMI), Jean Grandchamp (Musidisc), Henri de Bodinat (Sony Music), Marco Bignotti (Warner Music), Louis Bricard (Auvidis), and Patrick Zelnik (Virgin). HOLLAND: Dutch Public Broadcasters Granted 10-Year License

The Dutch senate approved Minister of Culture Hedy d'Ancona's proposal on April 26 to extend the public broadcasters' licences to 10 years. D'Ancona believes the extension will allow the publics time to ward off competition from the commercial stations. Only three senators voted against the proposal, which they said caused an unwarrant-Mary Weller ed petrification in the broadcasting system.

ITALY: Renzo Arbore Comes Back On CNR

Italian broadcaster and musician Renzo Arbore has chosen national syndication network CNR to make his radio comeback. Arbore, who became famous for his innovative programmes on state radio RAI in the '70s, moved to TV and music. Although he was expected to rejoin the recently revamped RAI Radio Networks, Arbore is now presenting a weekly programme on CNR spotlighting the history of Neapolitan music and featuring his own "Orchestra Italiana." The show, which goes out every Wednesday at 13.30, will describe the history and background to a different "classic" song each week. Mark Dezzani

**PORTUGAL: Pubcaster RDP Launches EHR Channel** 

Portugese pubcaster RDP has launched its long-planned youth-oriented channel 100 FM following delays due to changes in the financial plans. Twelve DJs and producers have been waiting to start on the new station since leaving EHR Radio Energia last year. The station will face tough competition in the EHR field-the most competitive but lucrative format in the country. EHR Radio Cidade and RFM are the current market leaders in both Lisbon and Porto. Following the initial decision to launch a youth-oriented station under the influencial RDP banner, the new administration at the pubcaster opted for a lower investment, which delayed the launch. # Naples' Radio Kiss Kiss Launches "Show Format"

ITALY

Disco, comedy and familiar hit music are being used at Naplesbased EHR web Radio Kiss Kiss Network to spice up the programming as part of a new "Show Radio" format, which was launched on April 18.

The changes follow the arrival of new music director Roberto Mancinelli, who replaced Gianni Simioli. Says Mancinelli, "The new general management wanted to take the opportunity to respond to some of the recent surveys and freshen up the schedules. For example, we introduced an afternoon dance music programme 'Disco Live' when our last survey showed that dance is popular with teenagers tuning in after school in the midafternoon."

The last Audiradio survey covering 1993 showed Kiss Kiss

in eighth place against competing national networks with a 2.7% share and an average daily audience of 1.39 million listeners. Despite almost doubling their audience since the previous survey two years before, Kiss Kiss dropped from sixth to eighth.

Says Mancinelli, "Our music policy remains practically the same as before with a mix of 65% international and 35% national music. Apart from the afternoon dance music sweep, we will be mixing more adult music with the comedy in the mornings and evenings."

Core international artists on the current playlist include Prince, Roxette, Madonna, Primal Scream, Brand New Heavies, Urban Species, Haddaway, Pink Floyd, Take That, Roachford and Whitney Houston. Although Kiss Kiss is Italy's first station to adopt "show radio" as an official format, BMG Italy radio promotions manager Carlo Martelli says it is an extension of what they were doing previously. "Most national networks have a comedy thread in the mornings, but Kiss Kiss were one of the first radio jokers, often taking risks verging on excess and upsetting some people, including the record industry on a couple of memorable occasions."

Among other management changes at Kiss Kiss network, exprogramme director Rosanna Lannacone becomes station coordinator, while Nina Mazzarino returns to the station from state broadcaster RAI to become programme director.

Simioli, who had been with Kiss Kiss for 10 years and helped to build the station into a national network, has joined Bergamobased EHR web RTL 102.5 Hit Radio to host an afternoon show.

# Low Ratings Force YLE-TV To Overhaul Chart Show "Top 40"

**FINLAND**

Battling low ratings on its chart show "Top 40," pubcaster YLE-TV in June will move the programme to Fridays from Thursdays in an effort to avoid competition from other stations and has named Nina Honkanen as sole VJ, replacing co-presenters Alex Nieminen and Baba Lybeck.

"Top 40," the official TV chart show based on the EHR YLE-Radiomafia's top 40 album programme "Lista," is backed by record industry trade group IFPI/AKT and debuted on January 7. Ratings have declined for

"Top 40" since its launch; the pilot attracted 202.000 people, but recent shows are pulling around 150.000. Radiomafia's "Lista" pulls in around 500.000 listeners during its Sunday 12.00 slot.

Commenting on the changes, a "Top 40" spokesperson says, "We originally expected some 500.000 weekly viewers, but got nowhere near our target. So, we decided to make some changes rather than axe the programme altogether.

"We are constantly looking at ways to improve "Top 40" and make it more attractive. One possibility is to make it more young adult/adult-oriented."

# BRTN Nightowls Celebrate Five Years Of "De Nachtradio"

BELGIUM

The BRTN's night-programme "de Nachtradio" celebrated its fifth birthday on May I with a special broadcast featuring live interviews and performances by Clouseau, Raymond van het Groenewoud and Axelle Red.

The programme, which caters for night time audiences in Flanders on Radio 1, 2, Studio Brussel and Radio Donna, was introduced in May 1989 as an alternative to private radio or Dutch pubcaster Radio 1's programme. The pubcaster's third classical channel has its own night-programme called "De Nachtegaal" (The Nightingale").

Comments Nachtradio head of

programming Karel Devijver, "The initial idea was to run a live broadcast over all the BRTN's channels to allow us to include regular news-updates."

He adds that competition against the privates was also a major factor, in an effort to extend Radio 2's command of the daytime audiences. Many of the private stations run pre-recorded nighttime programming. "We thought we should programme a mix of ACE, EHR and Flemish material after 02.00, while we allow ourselves to air more album material and concert reviews between 23.30 and 02.00. Broadcasting is the key word rather than narrowcasting."

Popular day-time programmes are o re-run for the night-

audiences between 03.00 and 04.00. Meanwhile, special events are also covered when they occur, such as Oscar-night and a special UFO-night.

The "Nachtradio" programme has a comfortable market share of some 78.4% in the first quarter this year compared with Radio 3's 3.8% and private radio's combined 17.4% at the same time.

# Ultimo De La Fila Keeps Best Spanish Group Award

Spain's third major 1993 pop/rock awards ceremony was held in Madrid at a six-hour concert on April 20 by pubcaster RNE's EHR web Radio 3.

Once again, best Spanish group was voted to be Barcelona's El Ultimo de la Fila and best Spanish artist was Seville's pop/flamenco veteran

Kiko Veneno. Sin Documentos by Los Rodriguez was voted best Spanish single, and the award for best female artist was left void.

Pearl Jam was voted best international group, Björk best foreign female artist and Lenny Kravitz best international male artist. Best international single was Creep by Britain's Radiohead. Special awards were presented by Antonio Vega, Los

Especialistas, Surfin' Bichos and Los Planetas. The awards were decided by listener's votes.

Among the 18 artists and groups which played until past 03.00 were the Counting Crows, Ama, Manolo Tena, Vega, Manuel Illan, Martirio, Complices, Vargas Blues Band, La Marabunta and Danza Invisibile.



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# Radio 5 Offers 24-Hour News

Spain's first 24-hour nationwide all-news net went on the air at midday on April 18. Radio 5 Todo Noticias, part of the staterun Radio Nacional de Espana (RNE), is in fact a revised form of the old commercial Radio 5.


The format change was agreed

by RNE director Diego Carcedo in return for a state subsidy last year of Pta29 billion (app. US\$216 million) for the loss-making RNE. Carcedo says the new format was agreed on "fundamentally for reasons of public service." He adds that the consumption of information in Spain has increased over the past few years because of their greater

economic and cultural capacity. He also says the future of radio was in "specialisation."

Radio 5 Todo Noticias' 63 stations carry general news summaries every half-hour, with 15-minute blocks dedicated to single topics such as sport. There are 47 disconnections every day between for local and regional news.

# Balance Remains Key In Spicing Up 'B' Playlists

Balance — it's what every PD seeks when drawing up the playlist. 'A' list titles, naturally, tend to get the most attention at hit-oriented stations since they're the songs that bring in the big numbers during primetime. Neglecting the other parts of the playlist, however, can result in an uneven sound and possibly lead to big ratings drops during other key dayparts.

Like many of his colleagues, Mike Stewart, PD at British Hot ACE combo

Broadland FM/SGR in Norwich, seeks to achieve that balance within his 'B' list. Overall, Stewart's current playlist is comprised of six powerplay songs that receive four-five plays daily, around 16-18 'A' list records that receive three spins daily and 16-18 'B' list records that receive two-three plays per day.

Stewart's approach has paid dividends for the combo, which will celebrate its tenth birthday in October. Broadland FM is number one in the market with a 29% audience share, up four points from a year ago. It's nearest competitors are full-ser-

vice-formatted pubcaster BBC Radio Norfolk (19.6% share) and EHR BBC Radio 1 (18.2%). Broadland FM has an audience share of 55.5% among women 25-34 and 56.7% among women 35-44. Overall, women comprise 51.6% of the audience

Discussing his 'B' list strategy, Stewart says, "We view them basically as spice records. They're a mixture of the big hits on the way down, new releases that are generally unfamiliar to our audience that we want to drip-feed in, or records that are not likely to be hits but really suit our audience and our style. Songs like Joshua Kadison's Jessie or Bonnie Raitt's Love Sneakin' Up On You, which are more suited to the American market, but fit in nicely with our format. They're records that might even go on the 'A' list after a while if they're strong enough.

"To some extent we test them on the 'B' list or we just put them in as spice to give listeners a little something different. It helps us balance the sound so that it's not all chart music.

"We also venture out into other styles. We'll play [US country singer] Collin Raye and some of the new country music that doesn't sound too countrified. There's strong feel for country in this area, but I would stop short of playlisting more than one country record. It depends on the sound and not the artist.

"We might even go on a left field record if we are particularly short of good 'B' list songs, but only if it sounds strong.

"We also realise that we'the not in a major market area. We're not a London, Manchester, Birmingham station. That's not to say that people think of Norwich as being out in the sticks. Norwich is in fact a very lively city. But we have to be care-

ful that we don't become too laid back.

Like most PDs, Stewart restricts 'B' records out of AM drive-time. "We don't play any 'B' list records at 07.00-09.00. We want total familiarity during our peak hours. That's even true for some of the less familiar 'A' list records."

Stewart doesn't have a set formula in defining spice records. In true PD style, he says, "It's what's in the groove. It's just a feel that it's a good adult record; that it's got something extra to it; strong musically, but perhaps just doesn't have that certain something that could make it a hit record." 'B' list records also are the first on the drop list when ad loads increase.

In managing the flow of records, Stewart moves about one-third of the songs to the 'A' list, keeps one-third and drops one-third drop into recurrents. "Songs don't stay on too long because if they come in as straight spice records they'll stay a maximum three-four weeks, or they get moved up or out. That hasn't changed at all in recent years. feel in deciding when to make the changes. We don't do any call-outs or music testing. I guess I'm a little bit of the old school when it comes to picking records."

# PD Poll: No 'B' List Changes At EHR Privates

The rotation and number of 'B' playlist songs on EHR/Hot ACE stations has remained consistent during the past year, according to an informal PD Poll of Europe's leading private broadcasters.

# Identifying Future Hits With Your 'B' List

Talk to 100 programmers and you'll probably get 100 different strategies about how a 'B' list should be structured.

Future hits is how EHR/ACE Radio 24/Zurich views them. About 10 titles are chosen as future hits, which is changed

every two weeks. Each song is played twice a day, with a future hit appearing each hour. Songs can either move up to the 'A' list (17 songs aired once a day) or to power rotation (three songs spun twice daily) or move down to a 3.500 library, which is comprised of recurrents, gold songs and image records. On average, about two songs move up and one drops out each month. Records stay on the 'B' list for about four-six weeks.

Comments head of music Dani

Richiger, "Future hits are what we believe will be hit songs in the next two or three weeks. Most of the hits are decided within a few days after we play the record. If the song becomes a hit, then we'll move it up to the 'A' list or the powerplay list. But once the song moves up, it can't move back down to the future hits category.

"We started this system because about five years ago we didn't have enough playlist restrictions. DJs played too wide of a selection of music, so we had to impose some rules in order to make the sound of the station more consistent. What was once an eight-lane highway of songs going on the air was reduced to a four-lane highway.

"What we learned in our market is that people don't want to hear the same songs played too many times per day. If we play a song three times a day, we'll get telephone calls complaining about repetition."

Like Broadland FM/SGR PD Mike Stewart, Richiger relies on gut instinct when selecting future hits. "We've never done call-out research before. We use the old standbys: trade magazines and their charts, listener requests, etc. There isn't any strict criteria. You just listen to the

song and trust your instincts. It's something that comes from your heart, that you feel this song will be a hit."

Richiger aims for a balance of musical styles in building his future hits. "We have all different styles on the 'B' list. We have some rock, reggae and ballads. We also have some foreign-language songs, especially French or Italian because of the region. We are really Italian-based as we

started out as a pirate in Italy beaming into Zurich; those artists we look at more

"But if there aren't any quality songs around, we won't add an Italian or French record as a future hit just because we feel we have to fulfil some artificial foreign-language quota. Currently, we don't have any foreign-language songs on the future hits playlist. About 40% of the year it occurs. It's quality first, then a good mix of styles."

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# N1 Changes Programmer, **Keeps Dance Commitment**

GERMANY by Mary Weller



With so few people in the radio world with a passion for dance, it's very sad to see one

That is the case at Hit Radio N1 as PD Cetin Yaman recently packed his bags and left the station destination unknown. While Germany's dance labels keep their eye on the station for any programme changes, NI wards off panic with one simple message: no format changes planned.

Although N1 can only be heard in the Nuremberg area, having a total of 93.000 average daily listeners and being the number one station in Northern Bavaria for the 14-29 audience makes the station a perfect outlet for breaking dance, something that most of Germany's dance labels are more than aware of.

Says Intercord promotion manager Harry Sigler, "NI is of course very important for us. Lots of kids listen to the programme and the station plays a good majority of our acts, including Maxx, Intermission, Captain Hollywood, Urban Cookie Collective and German act Index featuring Caro, with their latest single You Keep My Heart.'

Adds one promotion person for the Coconut label, who wishes not to be named, "The larger stations in Germany usually focus on the 'safer' formats like EHR and try to be as broad as possible. But if you watch closely, it's the regional and

Munich-based Sigler adds that Yaman's absence is a loss to the dance indus-"Yaman is very dedicated to dance product and has a very creative mind. If you told him there was an important release in Munich, you could count on him to be there "

### Read My Lips: No Changes

However, Yaman's exit doesn't mean the death of dance at N1, claims station MD Stephan Schwenk. "We have no intentions of changing the format or programming policies of the station. Everything will stay the same-no more dance and no less dance.

Although Yaman will not be replaced, the music side of N1's programming will be taken over by Stefan Meixner who has been with the station for four years. "Stefan has been in charge of the station's music for the last two years," adds Schwenk. "He is used to our music and our format, and I'm sure he will do a good job." The rest of Yaman's responsibilities

are taken over by Gerald Kappler who will be in charge of all other aspects of programming.

Meixner confirms the station's plans to keep the programnew



grammes and new games and campaigns for our listeners, but I can't be too specific on this now as I want to take a few weeks to analyze the programme."

Edel head of dance promotion Carsten Stäcker sees Hit Radio N1 as a good outlet for his company's commercial product, but hopes that the station will choose a harder route. "When we have something we know is right for the station, we give it to them and they play it, no problem. However, although the music they play on the station isn't completely commercial, it isn't what I call dance, either. It's something in-between. The

harder stuff that we have seems to be too complicated for stations such as N1.

Meixner, however, considers his station unique for the German radio market, with its programmes and playlists. 'After all," stresses Meixner, which other radio station here plays consistent hits such as Doop's Doop or Reel 2 Real's I Like To Move It? Our special programmes set us apart as well, like 'Die N1 Club Nacht' which features notorious DJs who mix 12 hours live on the

"Most stations with the same target group as N1 [14-

35] are still very careful about playing dancefloor music. I hope this will change in a positive way in the next few years.

# The Pretenders Return To Their Rocking Roots

Although the classic rock ballad "I'll Stand By You" has been the record company choice for the first single release from "Last Of The Independents," the new album from the Pretenders and their first since 1990's disappointing "Packed," is very much a rock album and a return

to the original early '80s sound.

Both band and management would have favoured the release of Night In My Veins, an ass-kicking rocker, chosen for single release in America. In fact, the choice of I'll Stand By You has proved an inspired marketing choice for European radio exposure and, although a ballad, an ideal introduction to the album. Its message is simple: the Pretenders are back.

The single has already achieved a strong UK chart position after just one week of release and is already playlisted on all national stations. In Germany the single made number 65 on the national playlist chart after its first seven days of release.

In America, lending proof to the adage "horses for courses," the rockier Night In My Veins single has been the most added on alternative and adult listening playlists alike.

Warner Music UK head of marketing

Mark Crossingham believes the strength of the single, combined with the reputation and attraction of Chrissie Hynde and the Pretenders, is enough to carry the album to the success that is clearly expected of it. Says Crossingham, "All our European marketing people heard the single last September in Barcelona and they all thought it was stunning. The whole album wasn't even finished at the time but the single created a great buzz of enthusiasm for the

A promotional CD for radio programmers was released three weeks in advance of the single. "It was well received. The single is so strong the marketing is radio-driven, with lots of promo visits to European stations. Chrissie simply is a star. Everybody wants to talk to her and hear what she has to say. She's the complete rock 'n' roll legend."

Matias Fricker of Warner Music Germany attributes the warm media reception both to the strength of the single and to

the attraction of Chrissie Hynde. "If you have a great single and a great band it opens doors in press and radio. There is tremendous good will and enormous demand for

interviews. Journalists are raving about the album already. You get what you want from a Pretenders' album: classic sound, her voice, jangly guitars, great songwriting.

Last Of Independents is undoubtedly packed with a little for everyone even remotely familiar with that combina-

tion of voice, guitar and attitude that frequently raised the sound of the Pretenders out of the realm of the mundane into the magnificent.

Familiarity will be an important ingredient for this album as Pretenders' manager Gail Coulson agrees. "It has been eight years since the band toured and the last album was not that successful, but the Pretenders' back catalogue is so strong. One of Chrissie's songs is heard at least once a day on radio somewhere."

Another ingredient is the return to a sound many people can now readily identify

as "classic Pretenders," skirting the issue that such a sound has been nigh on impossible to recreate because of the band's ill-fated mortality rate. The return of original drum-

mer Martyn Chambers and the recruitment of former Katydids guitarist Adam Seymour have contributed that added ring of authenticity.

"When she recorded this she took her vocal off each track and heard a playback, because everything had to sound like the original Pretenders' sound," reveals

Coulson. "Chrissie sees this album as a rock album. She's got the right line-up-with Adam she's got someone to talk to and share the work-and now with Martin back, everything's in place."

And despite her outspokenness on environmental and animal rights' issues in the past, this time around Hynde is letting her politics take a back seat. There will be no interviews ("if we can help it") in America, says Coulson, "Chrissie told me for years she was the most politically correct person she knew; now she's the most politically incorrect person.'

# Daryll Hall Sings The "Gloryland" World Cup Theme

UNITED KINGDOM

Daryl Hall is about to play a starring role on the biggest stage of all: the World Cup Finals in the US. Hall will sing Gloryland—the Phonogram record that is the official theme of the championships—at both the opening and the closing ceremonies in front of one of the biggest-ever television and radio audi-

The World Cup is regarded as one of the world's largest sporting events, and Phonogram is helping celebrate it with both the single and an album of the same name. The album contains 17 anthemic tracks, including the Scorpions' No Pain, No Gain

recorded with the German international squad, Queen's We Are The Champions, Tina Turner's The Best, Jon Bon Jovi's Blaze Of Glory and Daryl Hall's Move on Up. Two versions of the album are being, released, one for the European market, one for Latin America.

Hall, who says he follows no sport, admits he was impressed when he was informed of the potential multi-billion audience for the World Cup ceremonies. "It's amazing. The number of people who are going to watch this thing is truly incredible," he says, "I think it's great when the whole world concentrates on one event, but I perform the same whether the audience is a hundred or a hundred million.'

He adds that the World Cup experience may not be very different from that at Live Aid where he performed in front of a global audience for the first time. The Gloryland single is based on the American Battle Hymn Of The Republic, and Hall recorded it with gospel choir Sounds of Blackness. He says, "I think we worked together well because we have the same background. I did my first singing in gospel choirs."

Gloryland co-writer Rick Blaskey says the intention with the single was to encapsulate something of American musical culture, and he maintains that it conveys the two most time-honoured indigenous musical forms, soul and gospel. As the official theme of the World Cup, Gloryland will be used extensively in television and radio feeds from the US.

Blaskey says he hopes it will capture public imagination in the same way that Luciano Pavarotti's Nessun Dorma theme did at the Italian World Cup finals in 1990. The exposure for Nessun Dorma is estimated to have added two percentage points to classical's share of the European record market in the six months after the World Cup.

The Gloryland single and album are due out at varying times in different European territories, but the bulk of releases are slated for the second week in May.

# Tony Di-Bart Represents Blue Collar Soul

The majors must be going completely nuts watching the apparent ease with which vari-· ous indies have been scoring hits. Every now and then new labels appear in the Eurochart, and through their solid network of licensees they often make it to the upper regions. Pop dance singer Tony Di-Bart's The Real Thing has put Cleveland City Records on the map.

After six years in business, Mike Evans, MD of the Wolverhampton-based company. comments, "We have just had our 12th consecutive top 10 UK dance hit. Actually, right now Screen II is holding the top slot. With Di-Bart, however, we've got our first top 20 pop hit in the UK, plus some international chart entries.'

Evans' no-nonsense approach is of a directness and simplicity rarely seen at majors. And the blue collar mentality is manifest as he points at falsetto Di-Bart's curriculum vitae. "The man's got his own luxury bathroom shop. Until last week he was working as a plumber. That's the way it goes. Now we have to follow this up with an album, which won't be released before Christmas. We will now release the second single Do It in July."

After the initial club release on blue vinyl, a few remixes by the likes of the Joy Brothers and Rhyme Time (of D:Reamfame) were added to the commercial release. Then all the licensing deals had to be secured by Evans. "It was complicated, but we coped. We found partners in most terri-



### JENNIFER BROWN





Both top 3 positions in this week's Hot 100 Singles and Top 100 Albums give evidence of how fierce competition at the top currently is. Both chart's number 1 titles are "bulletless" for the second week yet still hold firmly to their chart's top spot. Just how firmly Bruce Springsteen's Streets Of Philadelphia holds on to the Hot 100 driver's seat can be measured by the fact that The Symbol's The Most Beautiful Girl In The World features as this week's Hot 100 Sales Breaker but only gains one position, climbing to number 2.

The Top 100 albums shows much the same although there. Roxette--last week's highest new albums entry--remains stationary at number 3 despite earning the Sales Breaker award in this week's albums chart. It is not enough to budge Mariah Carey's Music Box nor can that album, despite earning yet another bullet, come close to Pink Floyd's The Division Bell.

The highest new entry--on number 24--in this week's singles chart is **Metallica**'s *One*. Originally written for and included on their ... And Justice For All album, the version currently in the charts is a live recording taken from their Live Shit: Binge And Purge box. Although the band is one of the heavier stalwarts of the rock fraternity, its hugely successful '91 "Black"

album saw the band enjoy its biggest single successes to date following modest entries by 1988's Harvester Of Sorrow (peak 68) and the release of One's original version in '89 (peak 42). The first single release of the "Black" album--Enter Sandmen--set the tone in '91, it entered the Hot 100 at number 20 and charted for 13 weeks. Its peak position of number 8 is still Metallica's highest. Follow-up The Unforgiven did not fare as well; it charted for five weeks and peaked at number 46. Metallica enjoyed their longest lived single success with '92's Nothing Else Matters. Although it entered at number 62, it went all the way up to number 11, charting for a total of 38 weeks. Wherever I May Roam peaked at number 19 that same year, charting for 10 weeks. Then in 1993, Sad But True, taken from the same "Black" album as its four predecessors, also charted for 10 weeks peaking at number 22. Meanwhile the "Black" album itself entered the Top 100 albums at number 2 in '91 and over the past three years it has accumulated a total of 107 chart weeks including a run of 74 consecutive weeks. The album is currently still featured in the Dutch and Danish charts, the latter also listing ... And Justice For All.

and Berlin-based stations r.s.2 (ACE), 104.6 RTL (Hot ACE), Berliner Rundfunk (Gold-based ACE) and B2 (ACE).

BB Radio PD Susanne Matthiessen says regulators have gone too far in awarding new licences. "The media authorities are allowing more and more stations without first testing whether the market can support them." She estimates that the 11 Berlin/Brandenburg stations have to split DM130 million (app. US\$76 million) in yearly advertising. In addition, says Matthiessen, there is a host of terrestrial and cable programmes which don't carry advertising, but which nonetheless attract listeners and add to the competition. "The east German radio market is not going to be able to settle down, as long as there are constantly new stations launching. It will result in ruinous competition." Advertisers, she says, are still focused on the quantity of listeners rather than the quality of programming.

With more stations launching, Matthiessen sees formats becoming increasingly narrow in the years to come in the former DDR. Like west Germany, ACE will continue to be the format of choice in the east because of its appeal to a wide audience demo. "In Germany, the successful stations run broad formats, targeting broad target groups with a wide range of music based on an ACE format. Stations in the East are formatted in the same way, the only difference being that they also add old East German nostalgia titles to the programme.

SAW/Magdeburg Radio launched in September '92 and notched up 128.000 listeners per average hour in the last EMA Ost ratings. Broadcasting on six frequencies from the East German state of Sachsen-Anhalt, Radio SAW's main competitors are public stations MDR Life and MDR 1 and private national-music-only formatted Radio Brocken.

Radio SAW PD Thomas Schnell took over the reins last September from Alexander Heukemes and tightened up the format from broad-based to pure ACE. Schnell agrees with Matthiessen that most programmers go for ACE formats in east Germany as it's the best way to reach the most listeners. "The publics have more networks and can target across the board. Privates look at how best to cover the market, and find that the ACE format is the best way to reach the most people 14-50 years. Tightly formatted stations wouldn't work here yet as they reach too few

"It is a problem because there is so little variety in the marketplace. No one wants to risk running a specialist format when they don't know if it will bring in enough money."

Format radio, other than ACE, will take a long time to establish itself in east Germany and become economically viable, says Schnell. "The market will become increasingly competitive in the next five years and we will see lots of attempts to set up new stations,

many of which will go bust."

Dresden-based ACE Antenne Sachsen launched in April '93 with six frequencies (including Chemnitz and Leipzig) and two weeks later scored 38.000 listeners in the EMA Ost ratings. PD Norbert Seuss says that with four private networks and a fifth to come the Saxon radio market will soon become hyper competitive. He disagrees, however, that the glut of ACE stations means lack of programme variety. "Although in Saxony you have [pubcaster] MDR Life, Radio PSR, Antenne Sachsen and the Stadtradio Kette all running ACE formats, there are interesting differences in the programming. There seems to be a divide between ACE formats targeting 25-37 years and those targeting 34-48 years, for instance."

Energy Sachsen, owned by French radio network operator NR.I. launched in June '93 in Saxony. Broadcasting on three frequencies in Leipzig, Dresden and Chemnitz, the station runs a rockbased EHR format.

PD Arno Küster says it's still early days for east German private radio. "Most stations have been onair for a very short time. Some will establish themselves and some will disappear. I think overall the competition here isn't hard as in the old Bündesländer though, such as Bayern and Baden-Württemberg."

Energy's format is tighter than many of its east German competitors, such as Radio PSR and Antenne Sachsen. "We went for a rock-oriented EHR concept. It meant we narrowed our target group age-wise, but it also meant we were more targeted to younger people, who want to hear more progressive music."

Radio PSR launched in July '92, as Saxony's first private station, broadcasting over five frequencies (including Chemnitz and Dresden). In the last EMA ratings PSR notched up 297.000 listeners per average hour and over 1.6 million

Energy's Küster says the east German market has many advantages. "There are bigger programming possibilities than in the old Bündesländer [West Germany]. Personnel are generally more flexible and idealistic. Our staff is highly motivated and doesn't put making money or self-interest first, but having fun at work, which creates a special commitment to the programme. The east Germans also seem to have a better feel for language, and the presentation is not as Americanised as in the West. Because of this, we ended up with larger speech content, especially for local news/features. In east Germany many things are possible, which simply wouldn't work any more in the West."

The main advantage of setting up a station in the new Bündesländer, says Antenne Sachsen's Seuss, is that the radio market in west Germany is already firmly structured and saturated; whereas in the East, the market is still very young and many new ideas and concepts can be explored, since listeners are just starting to get their first diet of

western private radio. "On the basis of experience gained from making radio in the West, you can avoid many conceptual mistakes in the early stages.

PSR PD Jürgen Vogel says making radio in the new Bündesländer is an attractive proposition because of the medium's very high acceptance in this area. In east Germany, says Vogel, people listen to radio on average 189 minutes per day, some 25 minutes longer than in west Germany. "It is interesting to set up stations in east Germany because the market is still very young and still in the process of shaping itself. This means there are countless possibilities for positioning a station on the market."

There are disadvantages, however, says Seuss. "In many areas of east Germany, the infrastructure urgently needs building up and it is difficult to find staff with the necessary know-how. But it's also difficult now to get colleagues from the West with this know-how to move over here. It must be stressed that without colleagues from the East setting up radio stations wouldn't be possible. In an ideal world we'd have a balanced mix of colleagues from east and west Germany and have experience in all areas.

One of the main disadvantages of making radio in the former DDR, according to SAW's Schnell, is that there is a severe shortage of qualified radio personnel. market is empty. It is really hard to find good DJs and presenters and most stations have to train them themselves. With little preparation time and resources, it often results in stations practising on air.'

The only disadvantage Energy's Küster sees is that the advertising market is hard to tap in east Germany, with clients more cautious due to the bad economic situation.

Record executives are already working with east German stations and see the area as a welcome avenue to expand radio promotional opportunities.

EMI Germany head of promotion Winni Ebert says he works with all the private stations in east Germany which subscribe to EMI/ Electrola's record service, the most important stations being Radio PSR and Radio SAW. Smaller stations like Antenne Sachsen and Antenne Thüringen are also high on Ebert's list. "Any station with listeners over 100.000 is important to us. I appreciate the fact that we have a new part of the country to work with and I think in five years time it will just be like western Germany."

Ebert is prevented from working with public youth station MDR/ Sputnik in Halle because MDR doesn't subscribe to EMI/Electrola's record service.

MCA Germany promotion head Katherina Landahl has much the same story to tell, saying that MCA works with all stations who take MCA's new release record service. "We are actively working with east German private stations. We have a promotion office in Berlin and plan to open another in east Germany so our promotion people there can visit the stations more."

# Allocation Of Last FM Bundle Needs More Thought, Says AIRC

The economic state of the UK's private radio industry should be fully explored before any decision is reached on the introduction of the country's last batch of FM frequencies, says the Association of Independent Radio Companies (AIRC).

The private radio trade group says that there are so many uncertainties over how the market will develop-both economically and in terms of government policy—that it is vital they are taken into consideration when discussing how to allocate the 105 to 108 MHz frequen-

The Radio Authority, which will decide whether the frequencies go to national, local or intermediate services, closed its three-month consultation period on the issue on April 22 (M&M, February 19) without raising the wider concerns. By the deadline, INR rock station Virgin 1215 had submitted a 600.000-name petition supporting a new national FM service. The station ran its on-air campaign for this option under the banner "Let's get Virgin on FM," further demonstrating its oft-stated enthusiasm to swap its current AM waveband for an FM frequency. The Authority has consistently pointed out, though, that even if it does opt for a new national service, the franchise will go to the highest

However, the AIRC, which represents the local radio network, says in its submission to the authority that the options for the FM frequencies should not be considered without also looking at "how each of these would be affected by different scenarios for growth, ownership, licensing policy and future BBC activity." The authority's consultation document makes no mention of these issues.

The AIRC document states that the association's principal recommendation is for a comprehensive industry study. It adds, "It has taken 20 years for independent radio to reach the present very promising position, where it is now poised to become a major force in British media for the first time-provided the right decisions are made.

"But, the AIRC believes that at present there are too many imponderables—the lack of economic analysis, uncertainty about the government's plans for the BBC, no decision yet on the rules for ownership, the prospects for digital audio broadcasting-for a decision to be made on the use of this spectrum at this point. After 20 years, is it not reasonable to take, say, just another eight months or so to remove or at least clarify some of these areas of doubt?"

In addition to advocating further study, the AIRC also calls on the Authority to remove the ban on operators owning more than one FM franchise in their area and for a clearly defined status for community radio. The Authority's consultation

document on the FM frequencies puts forward four options:

- A fourth independent national station:
- A new frequency for each of the existing ILR regions;
- A new national network of community stations;
- Franchises centred on major cities that could be coalesced into a quasi-national network.

The Authority says at the launch of its consultation document in February that it hopes to reach a decision on the allocation of frequencies by the autumn and to advertise franchises by the end of the year.

COLUMBIAN WATER LEAVES ITS MARK ON CARBONEZ: All our wishes for a prompt recovery to BMG France president Bernard Carbonez, who returned recently from a BMG International meeting in Columbia with a rare tropical disease which has completely wiped him out and forced him to take a few weeks off.

MALLON MOVES TO COLUMBIA: OTR hears that Pierre Mallon, product manager at Columbia, is moving to BMG's label RCA as marketing director for national and international catalogues, reporting to the label's MD Antoine Chouchani.

MERCURY PRIZE UPDATE: The third annual Mercury Music prize competition for the best album from the UK and Ireland began accepting entries from record companies April 28. A shortlist of 10 nominated albums will be announced July 26 and will be the focus of a major retail promotion leading up to the announcement September 13 of a the single prize-winning title.

TONY IOANNOU LEAVES BMG MUNICH: M&M hears that BMG Ariola Munich A&R head Tony Ioannou has left the company.

target a 25-40 demo. Whitney said that a May '93-March '94 survey conducted for the company by RSGB shows that two-thirds of Londoners under the age of 55 said they want to listen to ACE, with support among 25-40s even greater. Core British artists tentatively cited to be on the playlist include, among others, Phil Collins, Elton John, Simply Red, Dina Carroll, Beautiful South and Chris Rea.

"London 106 FM will add considerably to listener choice in London," said Whitney. "It will complement existing services and fill the very clear gap in existing radio provision."

TWC is one of many bidders applying for the two new FM and two new AM London FM licences, which are scheduled to be awarded in September. Many applicants are

expected to offer ACE formats, as the Radio Authority for the first time will allow bidders to broadcast such programming. ACE is the UK's second-most popular format, according to an M&M analysis based on RAJAR data from March 22-December 19, 1993 (M&M, February 26). During that period audience share at 14 leading ACE stations grew 5.1 points to 15.1%. In contrast, listening share at 39 EHR-based stations jumped 10.1 points to 15.7%.

Whitney will lead the bidding team and programming will be overseen by **Piccadilly Radio** PD **Mark Story**. London 106 FM will broadcast from central London if selected.

TWC, the second largest radio group in the UK, operates eight local radio services in the country in Manchester, Cardiff, Leeds and Preston.

my overall impression of the album. Having had his biggest hits in Switzerland with his ballads, I don't know how our listeners will take this new direction. But so far we haven't had any negative feedback; besides, there's still enough balladry on the set."

For the reasons behind the rockier approach, Unterschütz speculates that it "can perhaps be explained by his long absence on the recording front, to reload his artistic battery. His previous album was the sampler *Le Mie Canzoni* in 1991. I take the tracklisting for a big hint, as he has written the songs by himself for the first time. Maybe this is the real Tozzi. Another ground for more guitars in

the soundscape is that it happens to be trendy in contemporary Italian music in general. Look at Vasco Rossi and Eros Ramazzotti for instance. They all do it."

The album—at number 7 in Italy in its first week with 180.000 copies sold-indeed heralds a new episode in the artist's career, if you ask CGD A&R director Fabrizio Giannini. "It's a very important step for Tozzi to have split with his former producer and co-writer Giancarlo Bigazzi after a 20-year collaboration which spawned 15 albums. In came producer Greg Mathieson to achieve an American pop rock sound, not exactly louder but more guitar-oriented. Out went the computers, which were replaced by real musicians. Umberto was very keen on trying a new direction, and Italian radio hasn't let him down on his single.

ILR listening climbed 1.5 points to a 36.2% share while INR saw its audience share rise 0.8 points to 8.9%. Conversely, BBC network radio's share fell 2.2 points to 52.3% while audience share at the pubcaster's local and regional stations slipped 0.4 points to 10.5%.

Nationally, EHR Radio 1's audience dramatic decline continued, falling 2.4 points to a 14.7% share, while INR listening rose at both Classic FM (up 0.2 points to 3.1%) and rock-formatted Virgin 1215 AM (plus 0.5% to 2.8%).

In London, market leader EHR Capital FM added another quarter of audience share gains, improving 0.8 points to an 18.5%, while its sister gold station Capital Gold inched up 0.3

points to 8.1%, making it the number five station in the capital. Radio 1 declined for the second consecutive quarter, dropping 0.8 points to an 8.8% audience share.

at presstime the company was said to be in the process of renewing contracts with existing radio partners.

Coca-Cola director external affairs European community group Carol Martel says "Coca-Cola is the Music" is the first instance of a fully integrated marketing programme centred on a music theme across all sales channels in the countries involved. "Music has long been an on-going strategy for Coca-Cola," she says, "and we want to be a long-term partner to the music industry-not just a sponsor of individual tours or concerts. That's why we plan to continue the commitment throughout 1994, primarily through radio programming and local concert sponsorships followed by additional concert activities in 1995."

The campaign scored the best results in the UK, Germany, Belgium and France, and Martel says the positive impact revealed the strategy to work with European radio was linked to the success of the syndicated radio programme ("One on One" artist spotlights and exclusive concert recordings in "Coca-Cola Concert catalogue"), which was carried by some 400 stations. "Both radio and concert sponsorship have been effective since they were designed to meet different objectives. Radio is the long-term continuity vehicle while the concert sponsorships provided the promotional focus," says Mar-

The net's 6.4% share of the total radio audience puts it in the lead among national private musical nets, overtaking NRJ (5.8%) for the first time, and leaving it as fourth network in France, trailing 2.2 points behind full-service France Inter.

With a 1.8 point jump in cume share from the end of last year to 9.1%, the net consolidates its position as the second national music FM net as far as numbers of listeners tuning in, after NRJ's 9.6% and ahead of Skyrock and Europe 2's respective 5.4% and 5.3%.

The net's sudden rise is being attributed to the publicity surrounding failed attempts by the CSA to restrict its sex-talk programme Lovin' Fun. MD **Benoit Sillard** maintains, however, that this programme is but one in a new series of phone-ins increasing the interactivity with the station's audience.

On average it's played eight times a day at all major networks."

Recorded at the Burbank, California-based O'Henry Studio, the album was finished in September. in time for the 1993 Holiday season, yet CGD decided to wait with the release of the album until April 15. Comments Giannini, "His previous two albums both sold 500.000 copies, so a bit of strategy was required. We wanted to conceive a solid marketing plan first, and at the time we were still looking for a new touring agent, which we found in the person of Trident's Maurizio Salvadore, the man behind Ramazzotti's tours. An extensive Euro tour will now take place in the autumn. Tozzi prefers to do managerial work himself, while a lawyer takes care of the legal affairs. This ensures direct contact with the artist, who has complete control. With Laura Pausini we work the same way."

Pausini is CGD's other major "border breaker," and Giannini senses that the "time is right" for Italian music. He says, "For the Spanish-language market we've put together a special version of the album, with four tracks in Spanish and five in Italian. The same concept will be followed for the UK in September, but there it will be a

reworked version of the old compilation CD, including the singles of the new album. The most receptive markets are the Benelux, Spain, France and Germany, where our marketing machinery is working full steam, having secured three major TV appearances already."

At Warner Music Netherlands the album is part of the "summer attack package," which consists of albums by Pausini and young Italian Irene Grandi, plus two Spanish acts Presuntos Implicados and Duncan Dhu. Comments senior product manager Michiel Ten Veen, "To be honest, we were a bit jealous of Ramazzotti's success. To lift the album out of the pile, we presented it to the media in a luxury box containing the CD and cassette formats, plus a biography and picture. With the summer ahead and the big sports events like the World Cup Finals and the Tour De France -during which Dutch radio always adjusts its programming in favour of 'Mediterranean' music- we're on the right track with the single.'

Danny De Bruyn, head of music at the Flemish side of EHR network Radio Contact/Brussels, also points at the "summer holiday feel, which Tozzi is able to generate like no other. Old hits like *Glo*-

ria and Gente Di Mare still remain in everybody's memory. To service the fans, we have already recorded an interview with the artist for broadcast at a later date. On our side of the station we play the single three times daily, because we strongly believe in its hit capacity."

ACE Radio 7/Ulm has given the single a slow but steady start. Says music programmer Michael Rot, "For the time being we've put this single in B-rotation, which is about four plays per week. In a meeting of our music department we always decide which tracks we'll feed the computer with. We usually play around 5% of Italian titles, whereby our criterium is not possible success in its local chart, but simply if we like the song itself. We do the same for French-language material, as opposed to records from the US and the UK. Singers like Tozzi add a bit of colour to our programming palette."

The sun is shining in Estonia too, and Radio 2/Tallinn head of music Sven Aabreldaal lets his listeners bathe in it. "Tozzi in particular was quite popular here in the '80s. Since our target group is the 20-40 year olds, he will surely be remembered. We wanted to surprise them with this first sign of life in a long time."

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# Mmm Mmm Mmm Mmm

While the Symbol occupies the EHR top spot for the second consecutive week with The Most Beautiful Girl In The World-still augmenting his support base both in terms of stations and chart points-Madonna's I'll Remember sneaks into the top 3 as she manages to collect another nine new additions,

One of this week's newcomers in the top 10 is Always by Erasure. With 18 first-time reports at their side (second-best of the week), the British act accumulates a total roster of 72 stations. In Sweden, where the single was already welcomed most fervently two weeks ago, Erasure's new offering is now unanimously embraced: no less than 100% of M&M's EHR reporters in that country have the song on their playlists. The UK is next in line, as the song's penetration ratio mounts to 80%. Germany, Italy and Denmark show less spectacular, yet significant figures.

The song that registers the biggest chart-point gain of the week, therefore qualifying as Radio Active record, is Mmm Mmm Mmm by the Crash Test Dummies, the taster from their forthcoming second album God Shuffled His Feet. The Canadian band jump up nine places from number 22 to 13, the highest new title in the top 20. They receive abundant response, especially in Holland, where 83% of the Dutch EHR stations have dedicated rotation space to the track (in the West Central the track is already top 10—see Regional Airplay, page 23), followed by the UK with a 60% acceptance level.

Also new in the top 20 is Big Mountain's interpretation of Peter Frampton's 1976 hit Baby I Love Your Way (also a hit for Will To Power in 1988). The American act's cover version of the song, also featured in the "Reality Bites" film, jumps up from number 25 to 18 in its second charting week, while already charting in the Southwest top 5 for two consecutive weeks (see Regional Airplay once again). Best penetration ratios are scored in Portugal, Russia, Sweden, Switzerland and Turkey (between 60 and 100%), followed by Italy, Holland and Spain (50-53%).

Completely skipping the Chartbound section, Jon Secada's If You Go, the lead-off single from the forthcoming album Heart, Soul And A Voice grabs the highest new entry in this week's EHR Top 40 at number 33. Secada also leads the Most Added category with 24 first-time reports in his pocket. Italy and the UK are sharing a tie as the best supporters of the US singer's new material with penetration ratios of 40% each. In Denmark, Germany, Spain and Sweden, its airplay is also starting to count, but as yet on a more Pieter Kops limited scale.

For all artists appearing on this chart, the Region Of Signing is North America.



This week's highest new entry in the Border Breakers chart is seized by German top producer Michael Cretu's Enigma project with The Eyes Of Truth, the second single from Enigma's second album The Cross Of Changes.

The new single, which is the follow-up to the still charting

ex-number one *Return To Innocence* (now at number 7), debuts at number 19 with a roster of eight stations. Although this may seem a rather insignificant number at first sight, we will soon see that the stature and calibre of the stations concerned is far from meager.

Signed to Virgin Germany, Enigma crosses over to four different "foreign" regions—most powerfully to the West Central, where two platinum EHR broadcasters (Dutch TROS Radio 3/Hilversum and Belgian BRTN Radio Donna/Brussels), as well as one gold-ranked cable network (Dutch EHR Radio 538/Bussum), have put his track on rotation. In the South, two stations are championing it, including platinum-ranked Radio Kiss Kiss Network/Naples, whereas in the Southwest region, national mega-network Cadena 40 Principales/Madrid has put it on heavy rotation. In the Northwest, British hit radio "Nestor" BBC Radio 1/London has added The Eyes Of Truth onto their B List. All in all quite a powerful roster at this stage!

Finally, it remains to be said that, although not yet collecting enough points to produce a listing in the Border Breakers roster, playlistings are being registered in the North (Sweden), the East Central (Poland) and the Northeast (Lithuania) as well. *Pieter Kops* 

The Regional Crossover charts track the cross-regional movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their region of signing (airplay achieved in the original region is excluded from the calculations)

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful North American artists according to regional airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Region Of Origin" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M wants to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.

For each record, "Crossover Regions" are listed in order of firsttime airplay appearance.


