PolyGram unites Switzerland, Austria

LONDON - PolyGram has brought its Swiss and Austrian affiliates together under a single management unit.

The move, part of a fundamental restructuring of the two companies. PolyGram will see current Switzerland managing director Vico Antippas head the combined operations as president of PolyGram Switzerland and PolyGram Austria by the end of this month.

Previously MD of PolyGram Greece from 1983, Antippas moved to Zurich in 1996 after his appointment as MD of the Swiss company. A PolyGram statement emphasises that the reorganisation "is not connected with Seagram's recent agreement to acquire PolyGram," and had been planned "for some time." As a consequence of the

restructuring, PolyGram Austria MD Chris Wemcken will leave the company to pursue "new career opportunities" after a seven year stint at the helm of PolyGram's Austrian affiliate. A PolyGram veteran of 15 years, Wemcken previously worked for the company in Germany and Australia. Universal Music

Austria MD Jörg Eiben is tipped to eventually assume control over the merged PolyGram/Universal Austrian operations once the merger is completed. However, it remains whether unclear presstime at

LONDON — Capital Radio is expanding its interests in the U.K. record industry, in a move which will also develop its Capital Gold "great time oldies" brand.

The music entertainment group, which runs its own Wildstar label in association with Telstar, has signed a deal with archive compilation specialists New Millennium Communications (NMC) to release at least 12 CDs over the next 18 months containing material from the radio station's archives. MNC will establish a new label for the project, which will feature the Capital Gold network's branding.

Capital's archives contain 25 years worth of sessions and artist interviews as well as coverage of sporting events.

The line-up of acts for the CDs has yet to be confirmed. NMC managing director, Barry Sanders, comments: "As soon as we have concluded the daunting task of cataloguing the archives we will announce details of our first release."

Meanwhile, Capital has appointed John Kershaw, currently managing director of United Southern Newspapers, as group radio regional director. He will join on July 7; reporting to group MD Sally Oldham, he will be responsible for the financial performance of Capital's regional radio operations outside London.

On Kershaw's appointment, Oldham says: "John joins Capital with a totally fresh perspective on commercial radio plus an impressive track record in regional media."

Gerentes confirmed at BMG France

PARIS — The new president of BMG France, Bruno Gerentes, will bring "a fresh, aggressive approach to business" according to BMG Europe supremo Richard Griffiths.

The London-based BMG Entertainment U.K. & Ireland chairman and executive vice-president of Central Europe was commenting on the formal appointment of Gerentes, exclusively revealed by M&M (June 27).

The former Polydor France managing director replaces Hervé Lasseigne, who departed BMG on May 14. Gerentes, who will report to Griffiths, will join "when his current contract expires," according to a BMG statement. Sources say Gerentes is currently negotiating his way out of PolyGram, and no final agreement has vet been reached.

Gerentes is credited with having increased Polydor's turnover by 50 percent during his four-year tenure. Commented Griffiths: "After 15 years in the industry, Bruno not only has the proven ability to run a company, but his experience in retail and obvious music marketing savvy make him an excellent candidate for this position.'

Gerentes takes over a company

which has seen its market share slump during the past few years. In 1997, BMG was the fifth largest record company in France, with a 6.7 percent market share. "Gerentes has the reputation of being a hands-on manager, and that's what the company needs now," notes a

'VAT reduction' scores in Spain

MADRID — For the second consecutive year, the three Spanish megastores owned by French music-and-books chain FNAC claim to have proved that the level of VAT on recorded music is a barrier to broadening music sales.

To coincide with Spain's official Music Week (June 15-21), FNAC reduced its prices on recorded music to those which would be charged if the level of VAT on music was down from 16 percent to the 4 percent charged on most other cultural products. FNAC music purchase manager Javier López reports that, despite the distraction of the World Cup, sales doubled during the week, although he could not give exact figures.

"Most importantly," López claims, "many of the buyers were new to the market—they are not simply existing record buyers who purchased two records instead of one. Our radio-backed campaign for the Madrid, Barcelona and Valencia stores was half a commercial exercise and half making people aware that the government does not consider music to be culture."

Spain's annual Music Week is organised by artists' association AIE, and backed by COPE's CHR/AC station Cadena 100 and SER's three biggest music networks—Los 40 Principales (CHR), Cadena DIAL (Spanish music), and AC/gold M-80. Highlights of the week—the third of its kind in Spain—included a two-day free Music Marathon in a Madrid park, and a festival in Barcelona featuring 100 drums.

Flanders gets new radio landscape

BRUSSELS — The Flemish Parliament has passed the longawaited radio decree which will create a new three-tier radio structure in Flanders, comprising national public radio (VRT), "conurbation radio" and local radio.

The legislation, passed on June 24, permits networking amongst local commercial stations, allows for foreign ownership of commercial broadcasters, opens up cable radio frequencies in the territory and proposes the creation of a new terrestrial frequency plan to be drawn up in co-operation with the authorities in French-speaking southern Belgium.

Powerful FM "conurbation" stations will be created in Antwerp, Ghent and Brussels (M&M, June 6), although stations holding these licences must carry at least nine hours per day of locally produced programming.

Under the new frequency plan, the number of local stations in Flanders is likely to fall from 330 to 200, but stations remaining on air will all benefit from improved, interference-free FM stereo signals and will be able to network programmes for the first time. However, at least four-and-ahalf hours per day of programming must remain locally-produced. The decree also states that local stations must devote at least 10 percent of news and information bulletins to local matters.

Government officials estimate the basic outline for the new frequency plan could be ready by September. The allocation of the new frequencies will then be the task of Flanders' new Media Commission, which begins its work later this month.

> Following recent comments by Jan Paulsen, head Norway's of association of independent record labels FONO, local quotas for music Norwegian radio are back

on the agenda. Here, NRJ Norway's newly-appointed music director gives his views.

Q: NRJ is known to operate a strict music format, and is strongly against airplay quotas in its native France. What is your attitude towards Norwegian music? A: We don't make any distinctions between Norwegian and international artists—we give all artists a fair chance. There are no set percentages [in our scheduling system]. The Norwegian artists are in the same [music] categories [as international artists], and are evaluated at the same playlist meeting.

Q: Does NRJ's head office in Paris or its regional office in Stockholm influence your playlist?

A: We're standing on our own two feet in Norway now, so they [NRJ] don't really have much say. There's an NRJ policy in many areas, but not much that has anything to do with me. However, I'm aware of the need to consult with them.

Q: What are your criteria when considering playlist additions?

A: I really can't reveal that, but we use probably the same tools that others do: charts, looking at what the record companies have to offer, looking at airplay in other European territories.

Q: Do record company promotion executives understand when you decline to add a song because of your music format?

A: I think so. It's important for me to always explain why I don't add a song, and not just to say "no." I believe the record companies appreciate that. It's important to be honest.

Q: Retail sales of Norwegian artists are falling. How do you perceive the current quality of Norwegian artists?

A: I believe they're becoming better, based on what I see on the [Norwegian] hit40.no chart, with artists like D'Sound, The Tuesdays, Jan Bang and Noora. Norway is more guitar-orientated, while in Sweden they have [the producers] Denniz Pop and Max Martin, who are the kings of pop. I don't understand why sales of Norwegian artists are declining. There is so much quality music out there, it's a shame that the public doesn't get to hear it.

Southern sound for new RMC

PARIS - Full-service station RMC will be sounding younger-and with a distinct southern accent-under new owners Sud Communications.

Pierre-Yves Revol, CEO of Sud Communication's major shareholder Sud Radio, says RMC will remain full-service, but-reflecting its new ownership—the national station will focus particularly on life in the south of France, with close links to Sud Radio's own full-service regional station.

RMC's new programming team will draw on NRJ's music research data in formulating a new-look music policy, targeting a younger 30-50 year-old audience. "This is good news, because previously RMC was not

able to afford its own research," says an RMC source. Jean-Pierre Foupreviously deputy GM

RMC's

and programme manager, as well as a presenter, left the station on June 22, following what he described as "a disagreement about the future of the programming." Adds an RMC executive: "The departure of Foucault, who has been at RMC since 1966, represents an end of an era. We are waiting now to start programming newer tracks-it is a matter of survival."

Sud Radio's Revol says RMC has the potential to become profitable again, but drastic cost-cutting measures need to be implemented, According to sources, this is likely to result in around half of RMC's current 240 employees losing their jobs.

"RMC will break even in 1999/2000 and will be profitable a year later," predicts Revol, who also reveals that the station is targeting a national audience reach of 4 percent over a period of two years-the figure currently stands at 3.4 percent.

Dance station gives Power to AM

BERLIN - "The only way to make an AM station popular is to make it a cult.'

That's the philosophy driving the programming team at northern Germany's new medium-wave station Power 612, which is aiming to attract listeners with an innovative grassroots approach which mixes CHR with hip-hop, techno and trance.

"Because we don't have the benefit of FM stereo, we can only offer good music and close contact with our listeners," admits production assistant Guido Szepraniak. "Our station is permanently open to the public-we have a café-bar here in the studio where people can come sit and listen to live DJs every evening.'

The Kiel-based commercial broadcaster has already established close links with popular dance clubs throughout Schleswig-Holstein, and regularly invites their DJs to play at the station, with the aim of attracting their fans to Power 612 as well.

"There's a very big gap in the radio market in northern Germany," says Power 612 managing director Thomas Thimme. "But to attract listeners, you have to have the right image.'

Power 612, which was launched in May, can be heard throughout the northwestern state of Schleswig-Holstein, in parts of Hamburg, northern Lower Saxony and even across the border in Denmark.

"With its wide-ranging AM signal, Power Radio will reach a huge area with the unprecedented chance to attract a very large following-one AM station has the same range as 12 FM frequencies," says Claudia Schützhoff, an official with Schleswig-Holstein's Independent State Radio Authority. "Most of the stations currently on AM are either classical or talk radio, so this is a first," she adds.

Power 612 is planning to make digital broadcasts next year, and negotiations are also currently underway with domestic supplier German Telekom for an FM cable radio licence.

GALA TOPS ITALIAN DANCE AWARDS



- The second Italian Dance MILAN -Awards have honoured Do It Yourself artist-and new Universal signing-Gala as Artist of the Year. Hosted by Radio Deejay presenter Albertino at the Genux club in Desenzano, Lake Garda, the awards were voted for by visitors to the web site of organisers Gig Promotion, plus a jury of industry and radio professionals. Tamperer won the best new artist accolade, with Molella and Phil Jay picking up the best producer(s) prize. Other

key honours went to Mario Fargetta (best re-mixer); Alexia (best video); Time (best label) and Mousse T. and Paradisio, voted best foreign artists.

PARK UP FOR RADIO FESTIVAL LECTURE

LONDON - Capital Radio group programme director Richard Park is to give The Times lecture at the Radio Academy's Radio Festival in Birmingham on July 13. Park will summarise the current state of the radio industry and look ahead to the next 10 years. Says Radio Academy chief executive John Bradford: "Richard Park is the foremost commercial radio programmer in the U.K. I've every indication that this will be the most challenging view of British radio we shall hear for some time.

BEATLES TOP DUTCH AIRPLAY CHART

Almost 30 years after splitting, The Beatles were the most-played artists on Dutch radio in 1997, according to figures published by Dutch musicians' rights body Sena. The Fab Four were trailed by home-grown megastar Marco Borsato, the Spice Girls, No Mercy and Abba. According to Sena managing director Hans van Berkel, the Beatles' high score can be explained by the number of special Beatles tributes on Dutch radio in 1997, mainly revolving around the 30th anniversary of their Sergeant Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band album.

PRODUCERS INK UNIVERSAL DEAL

BERLIN - Production duo Buelent Aris and Toni Cottura's Booya Music company has signed a worldwide label deal with Universal Music Germany. The production duo have enjoyed chart success with the Back-Boys, 'N-Sync and street A.K.S.W.I.F.T., in addition to



Booya artist Nana. Booya has collaborated with Universal since June 1997; recent projects include Pappa Bear's single Cherish, which charted in 12 countries and sold over 650,000 copies in Germany. Future productions under the deal will feature artists such as Alex Prince feat. Mazaya, Jonestown, Jan van der Toorn, Pappa Bear and, from 1999, Nana.

IN TOUCH: VIA ESP

HILVERSUM - Legendary jazz label ESP is to be resurrected by Dutch indie VIA Records after a 15 year absence. VIA has acquired the rights to use both the trademark of the former Woodstock-based label (owned by Bernard and Flavia Stollman) and the original ESP logo for 12 years, with an option to buy the company after the first six years. Classic ESP albums from the likes of Billie Holiday, Charlie Parker and Bud Powell will be released again through VIA. "We were looking for ways to get inroads for our own catalogue into the international market, including the U.S.," explains VIA GM Ben Gieskes. "It's much easier to use a well-known name to break into a new territory.

Jazz walks down eclectic avenue

As an essentially inventive, improvisational genre, jazz both draws from and contributes to other kinds of music, occasionally creating hybrids which enlarge its appeal beyond the traditional core audience. As the this vear's Montreux Jazz Festival gets under way, Terry Berne examines the commercial impact of jazz's eclectic side, and lists some of the important dates and artists in this year's European festival season.

azz has always lent its imprimatur to popular music, from Tin Pan Alley to R&B; from latin rhythms to rock. With the appearance of big bands in the '30s it became the most popular music of its day. This periodic alliance with trendy styles from samba to funk has often brought commercial success far beyond the genre's traditionally small but faithful fanbase. Recently, new hybrids have arisen which are attracting entirely new audiences with a combination of rhythmic drive, instrumental virtuosity and improvisational invention.

These new forms mix jazz with cutting-edge urban styles such as hiphop and club-savvy dance music, and are often more relevant and accessible to consumers than so-called straight-ahead or acoustic jazz, appealing both to a larger demographic and a broader spectrum of musical taste.

History of fusion

Many of these hybrids were pioneered decades ago by the first wave of fusion artists, some still active and now enjoying renewed respect and popularity. Herbie Hancock, Joe Zawinul, Wayne Shorter, John McLaughlin and Chick Corea-all alumni of various Miles Davis formations and all with current CDs in the racks-ushered in the era of funk-laden electronic jazz and jazz rock. Soul jazz heroes of the '60s such as Donald Byrd, Grant Green, Lou Donaldson, Eddie Harris, Jimmy Smith and Cannonball Adderley were the forerunners of today's hip-hop accented and acid jazz, led by such young players as Ronny Jordan, US3, Charlie Hunter, Graham Greg Osby, Havnes.

Galliano, Courtney Pine, Don Braden, Steve Coleman, Guru, Bill Evans, Gary Thomas, Marcus Miller and the James Taylor Quartet.

Another offshoot of jazz's appropriation of pop forms and formulas is socalled "contemporary" or "urban jazz," exemplified by the likes of Acoustic Alchemy, Spyro Gyra, George Benson, Special EFX, the Rippingtons, Grover Washington Jr. and Fourplay. Characterised by an unrepentant pop sensibility, with crisp, unassuming solo work melded to shimmering synthbased surface textures, multiple overdubs and radio-friendly production values, its demographic is both older and less adventurous than that of the far edgier, more experimental work of hiphop and dance inflected jazz.

New styles/new labels

Independent as well as major labels have created imprints to channel these new styles to a wider public.

They include Verve's Forecast. Alex Merck's Lipstick, Challenge's A Records and Silva Screen's Hip Bop, while the GRP, JVC and Warner labels have large rosters of contemporary and fusion jazz. Opinion varies from label to label, and from territory to territory, about the relative popularity of these fusion forms compared to straight ahead jazz.

"Fusion is the largest market for jazz now," declares Graham Griffiths, co-director of New Note, the U.K.'s largest distributor of independent jazz labels, who have had recent success with albums by Marcus Miller (Dreyfus Jazz), Joe Zawinul (Escapade) and Michael Brecker (GRP). "In terms of what stores order, there's a definite trend towards contemporary and crossover jazz.

Credit for that is partly due to the influence of U.K. regional commercial network Jazz FM, which programmes a broad range of crossover titles. "Fusion is the kind of jazz which, when heard, does sell," Griffiths says. "Besides radio, fusion gets more instore play in the large stores. Also, there's more awareness of the artists, who are often already known as session players, producers or even composers.'

New Note, which represents such key indies as ECM, Concord, Dreyfus, GRP and Enja, has also seen an increase in the number of such releases by individual labels. "Obviously, the majority of sales are through the big chains such as Virgin and HMV, who tend to favour the fusion end of jazz, though small stores are just as conscious of what's selling," says Griffiths.

"One problem is that the number of speciality jazz shops in the U.K. has plummeted in the last decade, so there are just fewer outlets who sell straight jazz. Labels like Concord have been broadening their repertoire to encompass styles other than straight jazz," he explains.

Sales: a song of the south

JVC promotion manager Marc Conner agrees with that assessment. but feels that although airplay is better in the U.K. and northern Europe generally, crossover material actually sells better in southern European markets such as Spain and Italy, where both media and public are more open to fusion.

"There's a big gap between what consumers prefer and what media and radio attend to," declares Conner. "Media outlets for fusion are few and far between. It's far easier to get a jazz artist interviewed or featured than a



fusion artist, at least in the U.K."

Exceptions exist-for example, the upcoming tribute to bassist Jaco Pastorius, featuring a who's who of contemporary jazz: Randy and Michael Brecker, David Sanborn, Bill Evans, Mike Stern, Bob James, John Patitucci, Marcus Miller and Peter Erskine. While Conner feels the consumer base for the two styles does coincide to a degree, they are by no means identical, though fusion product goes to retail along with jazz rather than pop.

"Whilst, in the U.S., crossover product invariably sells more than straight-ahead, that's not necessarily Europe," he claims. in true "Paradoxically, retail will generally take larger initial orders of fusion releases, but sell through, which is influenced by such factors as airplay, press coverage and concerts, is consistently greater in the jazz field."

A fragmented market

Alex Merck, director of Alex Merck Music, defines the pop and soul oriented jazz on his Lipstick imprint as "contemporary rhythms and contemporary instruments." The imprint features artists such as Bill Evans, Adam Holzman, and the Vibe Tribe, whose newest outing, Foreign Affairs, nicely elaborates their soulful mix of African textures and jazzy funk.

"It's the core label by sales," says Merck, "with a worldwide average of ten times the sales of acoustic jazz label Jazzline. The young record-buying public want the rhythms and sounds they're used to. We know from our own research that a large percentage of Lipstick's consumers are people who usually buy pop;

they define themselves as a pop audience. The music seems to be popular everywhere it's actually heard," he adds, echoing Griffiths, "though the market is very fragmented."

How fragmented? Warner's experience in France, with the kind of instrumental pop which has proved so successful in the US with the extensive support of radio, is indicative. Artists such as Bob James and Earl Klugh who enjoy huge popularity across the Atlantic are often not even released in France.

"Straight jazz is closer to the French market" affirms Pascal Bussy, director of Warner France's jazz department. "Joshua Redman and James Carter both sell well here, while our pre-order for contemporary jazz superstars Fourplay will not exceed 1,000 units. Their natural market will be the big urban chains, but in the provinces they will have almost no impact."

For Bussy, the problem is not just one of underexposure, but one inherent in the genre. "There's a lack of identity to much of contemporary urban jazz, he notes, adding that hip-hop and clubinfluenced jazz, on the contrary, does connect with the French audience.

In fact, Warner Jazz France has just released its first local signing, saxophonist Julien Lourau and his group Groove Gang's hip-hop drenched and trans-national City Boom Boom, a rhythm-heavy collection of tunes incorporating Eastern European, African, latin, gospel and other influences into one of the most stimulating and accomplished sounds in contemporary jazz. World music melded to the latest urban sounds is

at the current cutting edge.

Targeting Europe

At GRP they've got the message. According to Richard Ganter, catalogue manager of Universal Music International in London, the label plans to focus on compiling and remixing material from their extensive catalogue of contemporary jazz from a European standpoint, to be targeted specifically at European markets.

"That's a very important part of our future plans for the label here," he explains. With major artists of the calibre of George Benson, Diane Krall and Robben Ford aboard, and given the label's major efforts in Europe over the last several years, that should provide the icing on the cake.

"On the one hand," says Challenge Records' promotion manager Colette Pannemans, "fusion projects are easier to promote because you can promote them to the pop side of the industry as well as the jazz side; but pop people receive many more CDs, which makes it more difficult. Also, jazz people often have stricter ideas about what is jazz, and usually ignore fusion. For the same reason, it's harder to get good reviews for it in the jazz media.

Challenge's A Records imprint focuses on fusion, and their recent release of the outstanding second album, More! Soul Jazz Latin Flavours '90s Vibes, from the acclaimed and eclectic New Cool Collective, is a breakthrough of sorts for the label, and their best seller to date.

However, as Pannemans explains, there are identity problems. "At radio," she says, "since it really isn't pop music, pop stations aren't gener-

ally interested, and jazz stations are usually mainstream. There is no equivalent in Europe to college stations, nor are there the popular jazz formats which exist in the U.S. So you could say that sales of fusion are potentially higher than mainstream, though not always easy to achieve."


But mainstream jazz is far from being dethroned by fusion. At Challenge, overall sales of the two styles are virtually equal, despite nearly three times the number of fusion releases. That is because many of the jazz artists on Challenge, from Gary Bartz to Jasper Van 'T Hof, are well known, and their albums have staying power, while many A Records artists are just starting out and sales fall off quickly.

Redefinition called for

B*Witched put spell on radio

Having conquered the U.K., New Zealand and their Irish home market with the chart-topping debut single *C'est La Vie* (Epic), B*Witched are casting their spell over Europe. Their first promotional

tour of Germany, Italy, France and Sweden has coincided with signifi-

cantly increased airplay for the single, including record of the week at CHR station NRJ in Sweden and a number 7 airplay hit in Norway.

"My objective is to make *C*'est La Vie the smash hit single of this summer," says Jon Fowler, director of international marketing at Sony Music. "We've also promoted the single and mixes to major European holiday resorts—hopefully holidaymakers going to the Costa Del Sol will be hearing it a fair few times."

B*Witched have created a catchy hybrid of pop and traditional Irish music, with a fiddle player featured prominently in their stage show. "You don't know whether Irish music is going to fit in properly with pop music until you try it," explains B*Witched member Sinead O'Carroll, who adds that the traditional element was introduced when experimenting in the studio. "It was a team decision between the producer, manager, choreographer and us."

Sisters Edele and Keavy Lynch already know something about the ups and downs of pop stardom as their brother Sean is in Boyzone. Like her brother, Keavy used to work as a mechanic and she and the group's youngest member, 17 year-old Lindsay Armaou, met at kick-boxing classes.

"We have actually been named the first



'tomboy' band," says O'Carroll, "partly because of that and the way we dress very casually. We just want to be comfortable and appeal to young children. We have loads of energy and we're very positive as well."

Earlier this year, the

girls toured about 50 British schools, organised around a support slot with Virgin Record's teen trio 911. "When we did *C'est La Vie* and the Irish music would come on, they would all start jumping around," says O'Carroll. "It's nice to see you have that effect on people."

In April, B*Witched took on an entirely different crowd at a London showcase for European media. It worked so well that they will repeat the four-track, 20-minute show at Sony conventions in France and Spain this August.

"You need to see these girls and meet them," says Fowler, "and they'll be spending a lot of time in European territories this summer. We're very lucky—the girls and their management lend themselves to doing this kind of hard promotion."

For manager Tommy Jay Smith, this seemingly swift success follows 18 months of careful preparation. "I went to see them performing in Dublin and saw a lot of fire, a lot of enthusiasm and a lot of talent, so I signed them up. We did quite a lot of work with the girls up front signed to Epic about eight months ago."

Now based in England, B*Witched are in the final stages of recording an album with producer Ray Hedges for a fourth quarter release, with a second single, *Rollercoaster*, due out across Europe at the beginning of September.

Europe to go with Le Flow?

France is arguably the second largest market in the world for rap and hip-hop music—and now its vivid local repertoire looks set to cross over to other nations.

Many of the artists contributing to French rap's commercial success feature on Le Flow, a



cess feature on *Le Flow*, a new compilation from Virgin France imprint Delabel and released on June 22 in most European territories. Subtitled *The Definitive French Hip-Hop Compilation*, it shows a vibrant scene, ranging from top Marseilles-based group IAM to the "bad boys" of

the nothern Parisian suburbs, Ministère A.M.E.R.; from soft-spoken Doc Gynéco to the rebellious Assassin.

"When the international media flocked to France to check out Daft Punk, Air and the French electronica scene they took home the knowledge that the biggest scene in France was actually hip-hop," says Virgin France export product manager Vincent Clery-Melin.

"French hip-hop can be attractive to foreign ears despite the language barrier," Clery-Melin argues. "French rap has developed a degree of creativity over the years which today can challenge U.S. peers. Rappers in France display a sense of rhythm and flow that is unique—and France is also home to some of the best rap producers in Europe, like Akhenaton, Time Bomb or le Secteur A."

For the compilation, explains Clery-Melin, "we tried to browse the entire French rap scene." Some familiar names are missing, but he points out that: "With MC Solaar for instance, we felt he was already established outside France, and NTM refuse to appear on any compilation." Underlining the growing buzz around French artists in Europe's hip-hop underground, the project is sponsored by U.K. hip-hop magazine Trace.

"In most European countries, there is a market for French hip-hop," declares Clery-Melin. "IAM sold 7,000 units of their album *L'Ecole du Micro d'Argent* (Delabel/Virgin) in Germany and are well-known in Italy. In the U.K., we'll try to reach the audience that's interested in French electronica and techno in the first place and build it from there."

Althought no single is scheduled from *Le Flow*, radio is a key element in Virgin's marketing plan. "Our promotion will focus on French hip-hop as a genre rather than on specific artists," explains Clery-Melin. "[U.K. CHR network] Radio One, for instance, has dedicated two shows to the French rap scene."

Each European territory will work the CD according to its specific market but there will be common ground, with genre features in print titles, street marketing with posters/stickers, club promotion and in-store exposure. Clery-Melin adds: "In the long run, our ambition is to prepare the ground for future solo releases by artists featured on *Le Flow*."



THAT CASABLANCA FEELING

London Fiesta's *Keep That Feeling High* (Discomatic/Byte, Belgium) is so close to the original '70s disco sound that it even features the dreaded syndrums... Apart from that, the song packs an uplifting chorus, attractive faux-brass riffs and a full-blooded production style reminiscent of the trademark sound of legendary label Casablanca Records. With its nononsense radio edit and a couple of good remixes, a summer tune *par excellence*.

GROOVIN' WITH MR FLUTE

Mr. Flute's Mr. Flute (Clubtools/Edel, Germany) is not, as might be expected, a bland flute-soaked house track. Unlike most tracks featuring the genteel tones of that instrument, it avoids sounding like a '70s jazzfunk number by using a deep'n'grungy house groove and a heavily filtered flute sound. Exciting, slightly strange and pleasantly different.

BEATS FROM BRAZIL

Borrowing the percussive aspects of samba, Tanimoody's *Quaquaqua* (Distinct'ive, U.K.) makes full use of a breezy, melodic Brazilian vocal chant. The ethnic aspects of the track should guarantee dancefloor action; the track's various remixes cover everything from a funky house feel on the original to the awesome scat vocals and big beat interpretation by the Prophets of Sound.

BASS CITY ROLLERS


The main keyboard riff might be dangerously close to being really dumb, but UF's *Remixed* (Parking, Spain) has a well thought-out, dynamic arrangement that makes the best of a simple yet effective idea. Allowing the rolling, hypnotic bass figure to do the work, *Remixed* features time-stretched voices, mad drops and a cranky, uptempo house groove.

FUNKIN' IN AMSTERDAM

The second compilation from Amsterdam-based indie Quaint, *This Is Quaint*, picks-up where inaugural release *Asphalt Darling*, left off. With the help of artists from all over Europe, a dash of funk, elements of jazz and tough grooves,

the label has created a sound all its own. While undeniably owing something to labels like Ninja Tune and Cup of Tea, Quaint's contribution to dance culture is fresh, mildly eccentric "tough love pop."

In pursuit of that elusive crossover market, label manager Alexia Walker has prepared a multifaceted campaign including a sampler of *This Is Quaint* with 3 tracks from the

Europe's songwriters facing new frontiers

The days are over when songwriters used to hide behind the scenes in glorious isolation—these days, Europe's music publishers actively encourage their signings to strike up working relationships with other writers across geographical and stylistic borders at specially organised workshops.

Such an approach is not merely a technical exercise; Billie Myers' current European Radio Top 50 hit *Kiss The Rain* (Universal), for example, was the outcome of an EMI Music Publishing U.K. workshop, where Myers met established U.S. writer Desmond Child. She later signed to Child's production company.

"The idea is to bring writers and artists together who, under the normal scheme of things, would not work together," says EMI Music Publishing U.K. A&R director Sally Perryman of EMI's annual writers workshop.

This year's EMI writers workshop took place from June 11-18 at Huntsham in England. Among the 15 participants were 10cc co-founder Graham Gouldman, former Go West Peter Cox, Simon Law (Soul II Soul, Neneh Cherry) and Lem Springsteen—the man behind Ultra Nate's *Free*—as well as next-generation EMI signings like Katie Cook and Phil Campbell.

Despite the setting—15 artists locked away in a remote castle—it was not all rock'n'roll debauchery at Huntsham. "I've never been under the pressure to write a song a day and perform it on the same evening," says Cox. "It's really a motivator." Perryman argues that setting a onesong-a-day target during the workshop teaches writers a useful tool of their trade. "It's a good discipline to learn and you might not pick it up if you don't have the incentive."

Now a solo artist signed to Chrysalis Records U.K.—his selftitled solo debut was released across Europe on June 22—Cox sums up the week's proceedings by saying: "The workshop made me feel more confident of what I can achieve as a writer. It's a positive experience to meet other writers and I have taken home two songs which I intend to record for a demo."

The workshop was the fourth of its kind since 1993, according to Perryman, who organises the event. "It's a great motivation for us to be able to help our signings to flex their songwriting muscles and try different music styles."

Helping writers to flex their muscles

across geographical rather than stylistic boundaries is the target PolyGram Music Publishing set for its first ever Benelux writers workshop, held between June 14-18 at Chateau de Chession in the Belgian Ardennes.

This first "low countries" workshop featured 16 songwriters from the Netherlands and Belgium, including

Jo Lemaire, Jean Bosco Safari, Camron Edsel and Paskal Jakobsen. Unlike EMI's Huntsham event, the PolyGram workshop's final showcase on June 18 was open to PolyGram executives and the media.

"We hope to establish a long-lasting border-breaking collaboration between writers in Holland and Belgium, which feasibly will deliver good songs for the Benelux market," comments PolyGram Music Publishing Belgium general manager



Luc Standaert. He adds: "It is also important for us as a publishing company to work actively with our signings to create new repertoire. [The workshop] is a way to enhance the creative friction between our signings [in different territories]."

PolyGram Music Publishing Holland copyrights and royalties manager Bert van Wier is confident "that Belgian composers can have a positive influence on their Dutch colleagues and vice-versa." He adds, "This year's Benelux workshop is a test case, but plans exist to organise similar events more often." Clearly, there are other likely regions in Europe where the idea of a cross-border workshop for songwriters could be productive. Scandinavia, for example, is a candidate, while the G/S/A countries and some Eastern European markets share similar tastes in dance music. An event combining Spanish writers with their Latin American counterparts would seem likely to produce commercially viable results on both continents.

The possibilities are, if not endless, certainly intriguing—could this be the way forward to Hit Factory Europe?

Wilson's Imagination runs riot

The man behind one of pop's most universally influential catalogues has rebuilt his life and his career: former Beach Boy Brian Wilson has jumped off the pages of the history book and back into the sales and airplay charts as a contemporary artist to be reckoned with once again. *Imagination*, Wilson's new album

Imagination, Wilson's new album for Giant, distributed internationally by BMG, has built on the momentum of its positive media reception to give Wilson a new industry foothold. In the U.K., the album sold some 5,000 copies in its first week, securing Wilson a top 30 placing for the first time with new material in over 20 years. Speaking to M&M in his Beverly Hills home, an upbeat Wilson described the chart news as "wonderful."

The infectious lead single Your Imagination has supporters in U.K. AC network BBC Radio 2, Belfastbased full-service station Downtown Radio and German AC station WDR 2 in Cologne. BBC Radio 2 senior producer Colin Martin describes the track as "a very melodic track with a 1960's-style sound," and says he is pleased the station has the opportunity to play new music by Wilson. "[Wilson] has given popular music so much fun over the years," he says "and there's no reason not to play it."


Wilson's reputation as one of the key figures in popular music has continued to grow in recent years, with the 1966 Beach Boys album *Pet Sounds* (Capitol) now routinely emerging at the top of reader and listener polls. Cutting edge rockers pay their respects in their own music, the most recent being Garbage, whose chart hit *Push It* (Mushroom) included a nod towards the Beach Boys' *Don't Worry Baby*. Wilson is clearly fired up by such compliments. "It's what they call a pump-up," he says.

A documentary film about the making of *Imagination* is in preparation for international screening later this year, and Wilson speaks of the possibility of selected live shows. "I hope I'll go on a good tour, a handful of dates," he says.

Wilson co-produced the album with Joe Thomas, a neighbour in his "other" home town of Chicago. "A lot's built up inside of me since my last record, so I put it into my music," he says. "It started out slow, but after about two or three months of writing songs with Joe Thomas, it started to cook. It was so peaceful [in Chicago] and the people were so friendly, the atmosphere is very conducive to recording."

While the tone of the record is positive and instantly accessible, it ends with *Happy Days*, a song containing some darker passages which Wilson says is autobiographical. "That's probably the main song of the album for me, because it depicts my mood, what I went into and how I came out of it. It's pretty much my story."

The recording of Imagination and



the promotion of it in recent weeks has been an intensive schedule for the 56-year-old Wilson, but one that he's enjoyed. "It's good for me to work hard," he says. "That's how I did it with the Beach Boys, I worked very hard on my productions and it paid off for the boys. I'm just glad I'm still alive to make music."

MALCOLM MCLAREN BUFFALO GALS-BACK TO SCHOOL Virgin Records

International release date: September 14 At the peak of the "Old Skool" revival of 1980's hip-

hop fashion, musical maverick Malcolm McLaren announces his return-although whether that particular bandwagon will still be rolling in September when this appears remains to be seen.

McLaren's 1983 solo debut Duck Rock (Charisma) did a lot to popularise hip hop in Europe, and Buffalo Gals-Back To School is basically a time capsule incorporating tracks from the Duck Rock period, excerpts from vintage radio shows and

McLaren's recollections of the "good old days" of Old Skool hip-hop. The incredible development of the genre over the past 15 years is demonstrated in the contrasts between the original 1982/83 versions of songs such as Buffalo Gals, D'You Like Scratchin'? or Hey DJ and their 1998 remixes. Virgin haven't skimped on the remixes, with top hip-hop artists/producers like Rakim, KRS One and De La Soul updating the originals.

The selection of tracks includes a couple of semirare 12 inches mixes but omits McLaren's biggest

U.K. hit of that period, Double Dutch. At face value, the whole package is a fascinating piece of hip-hop history-you could easily base a whole radio show around it. Indeed, the album is already sequenced like a programme hour rather than a commercial pop album-maybe Virgin should take it one step further and produce a syndicated Buffalo Gals show?

Rakim's remix of Buffalo Gals will be released commercially as the first single on August 31. If this manages to capture the imagination of the

new hip-hop generation in Germany, France, the Netherlands and the U.K. it could be massive. The timing could just be right, especially in Germany, where the annual music and entertainment industry trade fair Popkomm. from August 13-17 will be dominated by local hip-hop repertoire. Meanwhile, Virgin France is

heavily promoting French rap on the back of the popularity of dance acts like Air and Daft Punk with

the compilation Le Flow (see story on page 9) and in the U.K., the re-release of the mother of all hiphop movies, 1984's Wild Style, has roped in new disciples among 14-18 year-olds. With Freundeskreis, Fettes Brot, IAM and NYCC, a whole new generation of European hip-hop-influenced acts is claiming a place in the charts. Buffalo Gals takes you back to their roots.

Beasties are not afraid to experiment. This time around, they've opted for a heavily electronic approach, with nods to Kraftwerk and old school hip-hopand along the way, they've inserted of a couple of samples from Rachmaninoff's Prelude In C# Minor, as adapted by Les Baxter. In spite of all that, the Beasties sound remains instantly recognizable and the numerous remixes on offer should be of interest for those music programmers with more left-field tastes. Pierre Dubois, is one of the heads of music at Belgian alternative/CHR station Radio 21 which covers the French-speaking part of the country from its Brussels base. He says of Interglactic: "A record like this is clearly well suited to us and our feelings were confirmed by a lot of response from our listeners." Dubois continues: "We've liked the Beastie Boys for a long time anyway, and this track has an excellent radio edit which we have played about 16 times per week on average for some time now. Although the other mixes are quite interesting, they are confined to our specialist shows."

Talk radio by programming editor Mike McGeever

Of late, we've seen broadcasters such as Capital Radio in the U.K. and NRJ in France emphasising their A&R credentials in the most direct way.

Those companies have set up their own record labels, with programming people playing creative roles. Such activity begs an intriguing question: when it comes to A&R staffing, why do record companies regularly look in the next county when the answers might well be in their own backyard?

In the U.S. the record industry frequently turns to the radio industry to recruit A&R executives. Dennis Clark, a Los Angeles-based radio consultant, who works extensively with major market broadcasters in Europe, says he's puzzled that this practice hasn't been really adopted on this side of the pond. "Programmers have what the [U.S.] record companies judge to be the best sets of ears," he says.

The one genre where this kind of border movement does take place looks to be in dance music, but that seems to be a fairly isolated example. The European record companies could well be overlooking potential goldmines of information on what the public wants.

Programmers, heads of music and producers are close to their audiences and markets, and many of them are well aware of just how and when music trends are developing. After all, radio people are "out in the field" meeting their audiences on a regular basis; they run roadshows, they visit record stores to find out what's moving, they go to gigs and showcases of unsigned or emerging acts (and can generally actually recall the previous night's performance...). They discuss music, and how an act sounds live-not just how its records might sound on their radio stations. Music radio people also conduct in-depth listener research, and that involves a lot more than simply asking the audience what their favourite tracks are.

Among the new breed of radio-parented labels, the success of Capital Radio's Richard Park and its Wildstar label has been particularly notable. The label's first two signings, Conner Reeves and Lutricia McNeal have enjoyed U.K. chart success-and Park certainly didn't find Reeves in the Yellow Pages. He says he was fed up with seeing many emerging acts with real talent being overlooked by the big labels because they might not fit in with marketing strategies, or didn't have the appropriate image.

No-one's suggesting that the record industry should instantly be launching widespread raids on the radio industry for A&R people. But perhaps labels should widen their focus when it comes to recruiting their talent-spotters. After all, there's a good reason for many radio programmers having "the best sets of ears"; their professional lives depend on it.



Life is certainly looking up for Des'ree.

After earlier attempts with Feel So High (number 16 in M&M's European airplay chart in 1992) and You Gotta Be (number 12 in 1994), Des'ree can celebrate her first No.1 position with Life (Sony S2) on the European Radio Top 50 this week.

That chart-topping position is thanks to pretty widespread support across the continent, with top 10 positions in Italy, Scandinavia, G/S/A and Spain on the Major Market Airplay listings. In the U.K., Des'ree's record is number 16 in the regional list; British radio's most popular record is Looking For Love by Karen Ramirez (Manifesto), which climbs to number 31 in the overall list.

Indeed, the Major Market Airplay listings

make for particularly interesting reading this week. In the G/S/A territories, 4 The Cause have the top airplay record with Stand By Me (RCA), which is starting to break elsewhere, resulting in a number 24 position on the main chart. However, Italy's No.1, If You



Can't Say No by Lenny Kravitz (Virgin) is nowhere to be seen outside that country, and it slips to 29 this week in the pan-European Top 50.

In Scandinavia and Spain, regional acts hold the No.1 positions. In Scandinavia, Meja has pole postion at radio with All 'Bout The Money (Columbia), while Mecano's new single Stereo-Sexual (Ariola) does the same trick in Spain.

In Poland, Chris Rea's Sweet Summer Day (Magnet/East West), is Poland's most played record, and provides this week's highest new entry on the overall list at number 38. Rea's high profile in Eastern Europe is emphasised by the fact that 27 out of his current 52 stations are situated east of the river Oder. Elsewhere, most of Rea's plays are in Germany and Denmark.

Other new entries on the European Radio Top 50 include the fourth single from Aerosmith's album Nine Lives. The track, I Don't Want To Miss A Thing (Columbia) comes in at number 41, with airplay in 15 different countries. At 47, alternative rockers Fastball found The Way (Hollywood/Polydor) to enter after huge success on U.S.college radio, because of early support in Italy, Switzerland and Finland. And at 48, Espen Lind's Lucky For You (Universal) is climbing again thanks to new additions in Poland.

Finally, at 49 the folky triphopsounds of Morcheeba sneak in with Blindfold (Indochina).



The single, a flop in their U.K. homeland, first received recognition in Italy and is now climbing in Switzerland, France and Germany. Bernd Albrecht, producer at Ger-CHR/Rock-outlet man ORB/Fritz in Potsdam

near Berlin immediately quotes the poetic lyrics ("I'm so glad I have you, and it's getting worse") as he praises the track.

Albrecht says he isn't surprised by the success of Blindfold in Italy: "The Italian psyche is very open to this deep moodiness." Although Albrecht doesn't think it will be a hit in Germany, the song is currently A-listed at his station: "It doesn't sound mainstream enough for the bigger stations in Germany, but for us it is one of those records which helps build our profile."

NRJ's golden age of Nostalgie

PARIS — NRJ's image as a swift-acting company has been reaffirmed following its acquisition of Radio Nostalgie.

Just two weeks after concluding the deal, the AC/gold network's format has been changed and its key management reshaped, with general manager Henri Laurent departing after 11 years following "a common agreement with [NRJ GM] Alain Weill."

Two NRJ executives will now run Nostalgie—Marc Laufer, previously NRJ network manager and MD of NRJ Bel-

gium, who will be in charge of management and networking, and NRJ group programme director Christophe Sabot, in charge of output. Former programming director Nicolas Lespaule stays as operational scheduling director, while Christian Savigny remains head of Nostalgie's music programming.

RSL retains U.K. ratings contract

The company is expected deliver a new RAJAR methodology, devised in conjunction with the RAJAR committee, within the term of the contract.

The RAJAR committee, comprised of top-level executives from the commercial and public (BBC) radio sectors and from the Institute of Practitioners of Advertising, was unanimous in its decision to award the contract to RSL.

However, some programmers and senior sales directors—who use RAJAR data in their day-to-day jobs—claim they were not consulted by the committee about the tenders. One source says: "Arbitron had a good

industry pricing by the anti-trust authority. It found five major labels in Italy guilty of operating a price-fixing cartel (M&M, November 1 1997). Membership costs for smaller labels are also being reduced under the new regime.

The reforms echo those recently undertaken by French major labels body SNEP (M&M, June 27); the Italian majors are also hoping to heal a rift in the industry which developed six years ago when the major labels left existing music industry association AFI to form FIMI.

Previously made up of representatives from the five major labels, two medium-sized labels, and three small labels, FIMI's executive committee will now be comprised of representatives from five majors (BMG Ricordi, EMI, PolyGram, Sony, and Warner); two medium labels (RTI Music and Universal), and five smaller, independent label executives (who will be elected).

"This means that the independent labels can make a proposal and have it accepted with the support of just one of the other labels, medium or major," explains FIMI president Gerolamo Caccia Dominioni. "I am very happy with the changes, although it was not an easy motion to pass. We have now created an ample opportunity for more In order to avoid overlap with NRJ's own AC network Cherie FM, Nostalgie's programming has moved towards a classic gold format, closer to Europe 1's RFM gold network. The playlist has been trimmed in favour of a more select number of up-tempo "good-time" classic hits, with only a very small number of new tracks remaining. Meanwhile, Cherie FM will become "younger and softer," according to Sabot.

Airplay monitoring statistics from Ipsos Music reveal that the percentage of oldies on Nostalgie has

increased by 20 percent in the past two weeks (from 69 to 88 percent), while the overall number of titles on the station's database has dropped from 1000 to 830.

Sabot is hoping Nostalgie's new focus on genuinely classic, more uptempo material will attract younger listeners than its traditional over-50s core.

presentation and ideas. It would have made sense if we were asked for some degree of input."

Despite the setback, Arbitron is committed to maintaining a presence in the U.K. and the rest of Europe, according to Jay Guyther, the company's vice president of international business development. Arbitron set up shop in Europe when it acquired U.K. research firm Continental last year.

"We are disappointed, but we are not going away," says Guyther, noting that Arbitron is licenced to use RAJAR data to produce reports on applications and interpretation of audience surveys for programmers He explains: "We are going to turn Nostalgie into an 'oldies but goodies' format with 100 percent gold programming. We don't want it to be tacky—but it must put people in an upbeat mood when they listen to the station."

It is clear from the changes that Nostalgie will cease to meet the 20 percent new music content required by the French quotas law. But sources suggest NRJ believes broadcasting authority CSA will not object, providing Nostalgie meets the overall quota of 40 percent French-language music.

Further major changes are almost certain to follow, according to sources. Says one: "NRJ's strategy consists of setting up maximum synergies with the group at any level—sales, programming, technical, regional activities and, as in any sector when such things happen, it is quite probable that there will be lay-offs among the 330 Nostalgie employees in the medium term."

and sales teams. "This kind of added value is something programmers have shown a great interest in."

Meanwhile, the new methodology to be carried out by RSL/RAJAR is expected to take into account the complexities of the changing radio industry, including the arrival of digital radio.

RAJAR says the benefits of the new methodology will include: a better diary design to deal with the increasing number of stations; one-to-one contact with "difficult" demographics such as 15-24 year-olds; rolling three-month data to reduce fluctuations; and all stations' performance to be reported quarterly instead of every other quarter.

Ernesto Magnani, who retired in April. Jarre, renowned for his interest in new technologies, adds: "There are certain threats that can undermine the identity of artists and creators." He elaborates: "European artists, and most notably those who are established, have to mobilise.

"It is important at this stage for artists to fight for their future, and to be present on the European scene, where many of the decisions that will be made in Brussels could affect the identity and very existence of creators."

Music & Media/Radio Academy award for Outstanding Contribution To Music Radio in London on April 23.

Billie's debut single Because We Want To, released on June 29, is already picking up U.K. airplay on public CHR station BBC Radio 1, and, according to Virgin Records international manager Helen Gilliat, the European campaign is already well underway.

"We were doing promotion in Europe as early as April," she explains, "and all the groundwork there is now complete. Press coverage is coming out in June and July [magazine] issues, and radio has been serviced with the single so that once we get the U.K. chart position, Europe is ready to kick in."

An album, as yet untitled, will be released in mid-October, with a second single due in late September. "Billie will appeal to girls of her own age as well as much younger kids," predicts Goldsmith, "but there are some cool, sultry R&B offerings on the album which are very grown up.

"We have a sequence of singles in our minds which will take her from the pure, playground pop of *Because We Want To* right through to a much older sound by the end of this album campaign." Given enough momentum in the market, Goldsmith says he would like to release the ballad *I Dream* in time for Christmas.

"I think the first single will appeal to a younger audience," agrees Billie. "As I grow, the main target audience will still be teenagers, but I want to be taken seriously and grab older people as well, and I think the rest of the album will be good for them."

A graduate of Sylvia Young's, a London-based stage school which numbers a Spice Girl and some All Saints among its alumni, Billie came to the attention of Goldsmith—who had recently left BMG and was about to start up Innocent—through a starring role in the advertising campaign for Smash Hits.

"Cheryl Robson, my head of A&R, and I were particularly keen to work with a young solo female," recalls Goldsmith, "and at that time Billie was being used by Smash Hits and I thought 'this girl looks like a star.' We knew she was a fantastic dancer, but we didn't know how well she could sing; when she did her first ever demos, she blew our socks off with her voice."

Innocent then put Billie in the studio with writers and producers Wendy Page and Jim Marr. Expect an announcement next week on the formation of a new joint venture between the U.K.'s

labels body the British **Phonographic Industry** (BPI) and its retail counter-

part the British Association of Record Dealers (BARD), which will own and exploit the "official" U.K. charts. Since 1990, the charts and their exploitation rights have belonged to Chart Information Network, a 50-50 joint venture



between the BPI and Miller Freeman, a subsidiary of the United News & Media conglomerate. That deal expired on June 30, but OTR understands that the new body will continue to use research company Millward Brown to collect charts data from retailers.

Italian dance/pop crossover artist Gala has signed to Universal Music Italy on a worldwide contract, stretching over "several albums." Gala's latest single, Suddenly-currently in the Top 10 of Italy's AFI/Musica E Dischi singles chart-will be the last record for Milan-based indie Do It Yourself.

U.K. radio group Chrysalis is understood to be looking to expand its station portfolio with the possible acquisition of Choice FM, which operates two black music stations in Birmingham and London.

OTR hears that Polydor Holland's attempt to premier the single De Bestemming by Dutch artist Marco Borsato on 60 stations simultaneously (M&M, July 4) failed-but by the narrowest of margins. Apparently, oldies station Radio 10 Gold broke ranks and played the song 10 minutes before the official premiere on June 25.

Former artist manager Jorge Cebrian-Lopez has been appointed to the newly-created post of manager new business development at German TV station Viva, effective July 1. Cebrian-Lopez will be responsible for licensing, merchandising and barter deals involving the Viva brand and reports to Viva director of marketing and communications Kerstin Ruffmann.

Paul Robinson, MD of national U.K. speech station Talk Radio, is being backed by newspaper publishers Guardian Media Group in his management buyout bid for the station (M&M, July 4).

Celine Dion was set to join producer David Foster in Miami this week to begin recording a Christmas album, due later this year.

A number of Dutch broadcasters are reportedly interested in cable radio frequencies in the northern part of Belgium, which have been made available for the first time (see news story, page 4). They are believed to include Sky Radio (soft AC), Radio 538 (CHR) and Arrow Classic Rock.

At time of going to press, two records were competing to become the 'theme tune' for Berlin's Love Parade, the world's biggest techno event, which will take place on July 10. For the first time ever, the status of Berlin-based label Low Spirit as unofficial supplier of the Love Parade theme has been challenged: Berlin Berlin (Universal) by Doozer, alias Vienna DJ Roman Tuma, has been adopted by local radio stations Kiss FM and Radio Fritz in the run-up to the event. Love Parade co-founder Dr. Motte and veteran DJ Westbam, however, have responded to the challenge with One World One Future (Low Spirit/BMG).
