

Court suspends Radio 105 shares

MILAN — Dealing in shares of Italian CHR network Radio 105 and its advertising sales house 99 Pubblicita has been suspended by a Milan court.

The ruling, by the Milan Tribunal court, follows a court case brought by

Luxembourg-based media SBS. It prevents Alberto Hazan, the majority shareholder and president of Finelco (Radio 105/99 Pubblicita's privately-owned holding company) from selling or transferring any shares in the company whilst Finelco's legal ownership is being resolved in a court case between Hazan and SBS, which began at the Milan

Tribunal on October 24.

SBS (Scandinavian Broadcasting Systems), which owns TV and radio interests throughout Europe, signed a contract to acquire 60 percent of Finelco in November 1996, paying \$7.5 million, with an option to purchase the remaining shares in the company over an unspecified time period.


Final UniGram offer is open

EU to launch piracy inquiry

BRUSSELS — The European Commission is launching a broad multi-industry inquiry which will attempt to quantify the economic impact of piracy and counterfeiting in the EU,

and set the framework for Europe's policy on these matters.

On October 22, the Commission adopted a Green Paper on "Combating Counterfeiting and Piracy in the Single Market." This document will serve as a basis for discussion with all the industries involved, plus the member states

and institutions of the EU.

The consultation exercise is expected to be completed by March 1999, following a March 2/3 session with all interested parties in Munich, organised by the European Commission under the German presidency of the Coun-

U.K. report raises digital concerns

LONDON - Britain's commercial radio industry is calling on the government to allow a quicker and more extensive development of digital radio at the local level than previously envisaged.

The move comes in the wake of a report published on November 3 by the Institute Public Policy Research (IPPR) on the future of U.K. commercial radio. The report, entitled future.radio.uk, rec-

ommends government intervention to enable the commercial sector's digital radio services to complete on a level playing field with those from public broadcaster the BBC.

The IPPR is an independent, nonprofit making body formed 10 years ago by figures from the academic, business and trade union communities to "contribute to public understanding of

social, economic and political questions." U.K. trade body the Commercial Radio Companies Association, which commissioned report from the IPPR together with the Advertising Radio Bureau and transmission provider NTL, contends in a statement: "Delaying any Ralph Bernard experiment of small digital local area

broadcasting until 2007 is likely to...stifle innovation and ultimately jeopardise the laudable effort to move the industry into digital."

Currently there is only enough digital radio spectrum available for local commercial radio services to cover around 55 percent of the U.K. Additional room on the spectrum for more local digital radio services will not be available until at least 2007, if

The IPPR study, which suggests the life of a commercial radio licence should be extended from the current 8 years to between 12-15, also recommends a "sliding scale of ownership limits, which is more permissive for companies who are only active in one media sector and becomes progressively tighter for companies active in several [media] markets."

Meanwhile, leading radio group GWR has commissioned accountancy firm KPMG to study various scenarios of future control of radio ownership which might be acceptable to both the industry and the government. The findings of the report are expected in a week's time.

GWR chief executive Ralph Bernard comments: "Current regulations are hindering the ability of commercial radio in the U.K. to be diverse and competitive, which why we have to argue a case for change."

Semaphore showing signs of life?

BERLIN - Following the bankruptcy independent label/distributor Semaphore Musikproduktions in May, a new company called Semaphore Musik Entertainment (SME) has emerged.

"All it [SME] has in common with the former Semaphore is the name,' says product manager Robert Karczynski. Based in Nurembourg, SME is being helmed by music industry newcomer Klaus D. Urban, while Semaphore's former managing director, Markus Roeder, has been appointed creative director. SME has signed a sales and distribution deal with Moenchengladbach-based ISS Records, which traditionally specialised in German schlager.

"Despite the former company's many problems, labels trusted us [as a distributor]," says Karczynski. "It didn't matter whether we were dealing with a release of 10,000 or 100, we worked just as intensively. That's why we decided to keep the name."

According to Karczynski, a number of problems eventually led to the former company's demise, including an unsuccessful foray into "T-Pop"— Turkish pop music. "While there is a market for it, the old Semaphore did not really research the best outlets for Turkish music," says a source.

Although SME is still in its start-up phase, it has already signed some new acts, including Irish/German act Freud, whose album Time Passengers mixes traditional Celtic with electronic music.

Amongst the labels Semaphore and ISS will be distributing is U.K. label Kickin' Records, whose roster includes Paul Mac and R&B/jazz artist Charles Dockins, as well as a number of dance compilations. It will also be distributing British female pop duo 2 Die 4's first single in Germany, Women Who Love To Love Women.

Open mike

Antonio Campo Dall'Orto Managing director, MTV Italy



MTV Italy recently celebrated its first anniversary as a 24 hour a day terrestrial TV serwill vice. In addition, Milan Is the venue for this year's MTV Europe Music Aw-

ards on November 12.

Q: What effect has MTV Italy becoming a terrestrial channel had on the local music industry?

A: MTV Italy has experienced a phenomenal growth in terms of audience reach and, therefore, its effect on the music industry. We have been influential in establishing previously "alternative" local artists such as Prozac+, 99 Posse and Bluvertigo. Previously, they had received no exposure on the generalist TV and radio networks here.

We have also had a similar effect with established international acts such as Smashing Pumpkins and Morcheeba, who previously made no impact in Italy. All the record companies have found MTV Italy very useful. One year ago we were not regarded as crucial, today we are strategically important. One year ago it was unusual for so-called "alternative" acts to reach the top of the charts in Italy; now this is happening regularly.

Q: Has locally originated programming helped MTV Italy compete with

other local music channels?

A: Match Music has limited distribution via satellite only, and The Box is distributed on a syndication basis via regional TV channels for several hours a day. Before our network deal with Rete A, we had the same sort of distribution and found it difficult to generate significant viewing figures. Our real competitor is TMC2, a youth-oriented network with a lot of music programming. In the past year we have doubled our advertising revenues and are currently 20 percent ahead of target. There is no doubt that the policy of regional autonomy and production has been the right one.

Q: What sort of programmes has MTV Italy been making?

A: We are constantly introducing new programming, including a new alternative music programme, AltMTV, and a cooking programme with the stars called Kitchen. Our studio-based live music show Sonic has also been very successful.

Q: Are you disappointed that no Italian artists have been nominated for the MTV Europe Music Awards? A: That is really more of a concern for the Italian record industry. The choice of the nominations is made by our viewers, and despite the international breakthrough by Nek there have been relatively few Italians selling abroad so far this year. Nek and Zucchero will be there presenting awards, however. I am very pleased that Milan was selected as the venue for the awards—it's a great way to consecrate our arrival in a big way in Italy.

Mega chart wins TV deal

HILVERSUM — The Netherlands' Mega Top 100 singles chart has closed a sponsorship deal with the Dutch government's national lottery game, and has secured daily airtime on national TV thanks to a deal with media group HMG.

The chart's official sponsor will now be BankGiroLoterij, a national lottery game based on bank account numbers, and the chart will be broadcast on HMG's commercial TV station Veronica each weekday from 17.00-17.30.

Both deals have been signed for one year, with an option for two more years. The TV chart show will debut on Veronica on November 23, and will be presented by Renate van der Zalm.


Mega Chart Top 100 managing director Machgiel Bakker describes BankGiroLoterij as a "brilliant sponsor" for the chart.

He adds: "The TV deal with Veronica has been decisive in finalising the sponsorship agreement, as the chart show will attract potential lottery players. Obviously our own brand awareness should also be boosted through the TV exposure."

A Veronica spokesperson says that the TV deal with the Mega Top 100 chart won't affect the Veronica Top 100 Countdown currently broadcast by its CHR radio station, Veronica FM. Public CHR station Radio 3FM will continue to be the Mega Top 100 chart's official radio partner.

ON THE BEAT

FILLIOUD TO HEAD VIVE LA RADIO

PARIS — Independent commercial radio stations in France will have a louder industry voice following the election of BFM/Paris managing director Patrick Fillioud as president of Vive la Radio, the organisation which represents all radio stations in France. Fillioud, one of the pioneers of the French pirate radio movement in the late '70s and early '80s, replaces Eric

Baptiste, who has become general secretary of authors' societies body Cisac.

VIA TAKES BMG'S JAZZ

BRUSSELS — Ghent-based independent VIA Records has announced that it has taken on the distribution, sales and promotion of BMG's jazz catalogue in Belgium. "Jazz is quite a specialised repertoire to work on," explains Frank Aernout, managing director of BMG Belgium, "and we think it's best handled by the experts. Our promotions team, however good at dealing with the current catalogue with the Belgian media, is not trained to handle jazz in depth." VIA has also started distributing indie labels Carbon 7 and Oorwoud, in addition to the company's own labels of ViaJazz, ViaBlues, ViaWorld and ViaKra.

CHRISTIAN STATION SEEKS SALVATION

BERLIN — Christian broadcaster Radio Paradiso, which has been on air in Berlin since 1997, faces closure in the next few weeks unless it finds new financial backers. Paradiso recently tried to extend its broadcast area into Saxony and Schleswig-Holstein in an attempt to expand listenership and ad revenues, but encountered opposition from local public broadcasters SFB and ORB, who claimed that the station was essentially a commercial AC/MOR pop service.

ARCADE'S TURKISH DELIGHT

HILVERSUM — The Arcade Music Group is to target western Europe's five-million strong Turkish population with the Europe-wide release on November 24 of Türk Hitfestivali, a compilation album featuring 40 Turkish artists, including Tarkan, Candan Ercetin and Serdar Ortac. The album will be TV-marketed through advertising spots on popular Turkish satellite station Show TV. In addition, a pan-European tour featuring 15 leading Turkish singers is planned, in conjunction with Delft-based promoter Mojo Concerts.

WISE APPOINTMENTS MADE

London — Radio production company Wise Buddah has strengthened its management team with two new appointments. Alison Vernon-Smith, formerly a radio producer for national public networks BBC Radio 1 and BBC Radio 4, joins as executive producer, radio programming, while Samantha Dawe takes the new position of manager, talent development. Dawe, who formerly worked in press and PR for the BBC's digital radio division, will manage Wise Buddah's key air talent and develop the company's website.

STARS RECORD FOR BOMB VICTIMS



DUBLIN — U2, Boyzone and Sinead O'Connor are among the artists who have contributed songs to a fund-raising album for the victims of the Omagh bombing in Northern Ireland this August. The album, Across The Bridge Of Hope, is due for release in the U.K. and Ireland on November 30, and takes its title from a poem written by 12-year old Sean McLaughlin shortly before he lost his life in the tragedy. The poem is read on the album by actor Liam Neeson. Other contributors include Enya,

the Divine Comedy, Van Morrison, Paul Brady, the Corrs and Ash. The album will appear on the specially-formed White Label, distributed by 3MV.

NRJ feels AC heat in Sweden

STOCKHOLM — NRJ's five-year reign as Sweden's most popular commercial radio network is coming under increasing threat, according to latest audience figures from official ratings body RUAB.

The gap in daily reach between NRJ (CHR) and Rix (Hot AC) has narrowed to just 41,000 in the third national survey of the year (July 27-October 4), compared to 143,000 in the previous survey (April 20-June 14). Rix has already passed NRJ in terms of market share and weekly cumulative audience. And AC broadcaster Mix Megapol now has a daily reach of 8.2 percent, only 0.3 percent behind Rix, despite Megapol having half the number of stations in its network.

MTG also owns CHR station Power Hit Radio, which has gained from its recent move towards a more dance-based format. Power's daily reach is up from 5.1 percent to 6.3 percent in Stockholm, and from 4.3 percent to 6.7 percent in Gothenburg. In

Stockholm, Power is now the most popular network in the youngest (9-19 year-olds) age category, ending NRJ's five-year dominance in that demographic.

Mix Megapol marketing director Stefan Nero says he is "delighted" with the figures for his network, and particularly its growth in the major urban centres of Gothenburg and Malmö.

Ministry launches radio show

LONDON — The U.K.'s leading exploiter of dance culture, the Ministry of Sound, has rolled out a two-hour syndicated dance show to international broadcasters.

The first half of the show, The Ministry Dance Party, features "accessible" new dance music mixed with classic dance, while the second hour, the Ministry of Sound Session, showcases big name international club DJs. The programme is produced by London-based production company Somethin'

Else Sound Directions.

Producing a syndicated dance show is a natural progression for Ministry of Sound, which already owns a London club, two dance labels (Ministry of Sound and FSUK), a monthly magazine (Ministry), and also has interests in club tours, clothing/merchandising and artist/DJ management.

Ministry's radio syndication manager, Barney Glover, comments: "Ministry has a reputation as being on the cutting edge as well as supplying the mainstream sounds. Our strength is that we have our hands in every phase of dance every day." He adds: "The brand is known throughout Europe's youth culture."

Currently the show is being aired on 18 European stations, including Chrysalis's Galaxy dance stations in the U.K., urban outlet Kiss FM/Berlin, national CHR station DR P3 in Denmark and Kiss 909/Athens. The company is also hoping to forge links with U.S. college stations, according to Glover.

Added Byte for Belgian stations

BRUSSELS — Belgian independent label Byte Records is inviting listeners to Flemish commercial stations to create their own mixes of its latest dance releases.

Some 45 radio stations in northern Belgium (Flanders)—including the FM Limburg, FM Kempen, C-Dance, RGR and Spitsradio networks—are participating in the competition, which is offering Sony Mini-Disc digital remix consoles as prizes:

"The idea is that we invite the audience to make their own mixes using at least three of the tracks played in the [Byte] commercials being run on the stations," explains Byte Records product manager Hansbert Vanhove. "In addition to established acts like Sash! or 2 Unlimited, we have included important newcomers such as

CB Milton, Omega and Starfighter." Vanhove hopes that the radio competition will be "instrumental" in breaking new Byte talent to a welldefined national dance audience.

The competition is also being promoted in specialist dance publications and 25,000 flyers in clubs and retailers.

Warner Music operates in each of Europe's five key territories with two stand-alone companies. WEA and East West, each with its own managing director, A&R, marketing and promotional team-and sometimes its own sales force. This unique setup has been established over the last decade, mostly through acquisition. It increases the company's capacity to sign and develop both local repertoire and international catalogues, Emmanuel Legrand reports.

e have done some gardening to create space for new plants to grow," says Warner Music president Europe Manfred Zumkeller, his horticultural metaphor describing the company's development strategy in Europe during the past decade.

Warner Music has chosen a slight-

ly different path from its competitors to major expand its presence in Zumkeller's Europe. "space" has been created by adding, at the end of the '80s and early '90s, a second layer to the original companies launched in the early '70s by the late Nesuhi Ertegun, president of Warner Music International (WMI).

Those additions have largely come through the acquisition of independent companies: Teldec (Germany); CGD (Italy); Carrère (France); and DRO (Spain) have been turned into fullyfledged Warner labels under the generic East West label.

"When I joined WEA in 1983, we were pretty much the marketing arm of the US labels, since 90 percent of our sales were from our US repertoire," recalls Zumkeller. However, in the late '80s, Warner was confronted by a crucial growth problem and needed to address the issue of local repertoire. "Even CBS at that time were more into local repertoire than we were," admits Zumkeller.

Local strategies

The arrival of Ramon Lopez, current, chairman of WMI, in the mid-'80s marked a change in strategy for the company.

"We decided that we couldn't rely on US repertoire only," Zumkeller. "So the question waswhat can we do? That's when we started to do some gardening."

Zumkeller says U.S. material from all the Warner labels was so important that it was simply too much to handle for the existing companies, and many acts suffered from a lack of focus. A former Warner executive adds that further incentive to take the dual companies route was provided by Atlantic chairman Ahmet Ertegun's threat to licence material to another company if no action was taken. "We had to open it up," Zumkeller sum-

The original idea was to split the U.S. sources of repertoire in two-the WEA companies would be assigned Warner Bros products, and Atlantic and Elektra would go to East Westand thus make more room for other sources of repertoire. The complex part of the equation was "to build up catalogue without affecting Warner's U.S. repertoire," says Zumkeller.

The acquisition trail

Acquisition was a way of entering the market without having to start from scratch, which, insists Zumkeller,

"would have taken years. So," he adds, "whenever it was possible, we would buy local companies with local repertoire. This way, we had a foundation to build from, except in the U.K., where we did it from the inside because nothing was available [for acquisition].

We don't simply buy a company," Zumkeller adds, "we buy the expertise of the people who created it, and we

keep them in the company. The people at DRO are still

there. In Italy, Gero [Caccia, president of CGD] has been with us for some 10vears. The label has a great catalogue and a fantastic reputation."

Dual benefits

Increasing cross-border activity and the growing market share of domestic repertoire in Europe, were the key challenges Warner's strategy was originally designed to meet.

According to Zumkeller, it has brought a number of benefits. "We have been able to refocus our [international] catalogues," he says, "while strengthening our domestic repertoire. I believe that having two different companies in these countries has been good, because we have been able not only to develop local repertoire faster, but to increase sales of local repertoire in other territories.'

Zumkeller says there's no doubt that the new "space" created has been fertile ground for acts such as Alejandro Sanz from Spain, and Nek or Laura Pausini from Italy, who have each achieved success in their native countries and across borders.

The MDs of the different East West and WEA labels get together regularly for A&R meetings, at which they discuss the four or five domestic acts who will become international priorities for the company. East West labels are given the first option on artists signed in other territories to East West. If they pass, the artists will be offered to WEA companies and vice versa.

"During these meetings, we discuss the acts that have potential to cross borders. If I can get the people to agree among themselves on five priorities, I don't have to crack the whip," smiles Zumkeller.

Mark Foster, vice president marketing for Warner Music Europe, is convinced that the dual system has given labels more focus and more marketing leverage. "If you go out to retailers and media with a strong market share of local repertoire, it gives you more power to push international repertoire," he asserts.

Zumkeller believes the effort and the investment have been worthwhile, and that Warner's achievements will have to be assessed over the long term. "In a way," he admits, "we are newcomers. We are building a catalogue. We've done it during the last 10 years, and I think it's quite an achievement.'

XXL's sharp cut fits young Germans' style

There was a time when German Public Radio was a relatively benign, bucolic landscape, mostly gentle hills and shallow valleys—with an occasional jagged peak or deep canyons adding a little variety. Nowadays, thanks to commercial competition and new opportunities created by politics and technology, radio is addressing the real world with new young formats representing the sprawling urban jungle, and pop culture programming aimed at meeting the demands of an easily distracted audience. The latest arrival, Frankfurt's HR-XXL is now making its own mark at the cutting edge of German radio, as Christian Arndt reports.

o far, only a few stations have succeeded in capturing the attention of Germany's urban youth—HR-XXL, latest and loudest offspring of regional public broadcaster Hessischer Rundfunk, is certainly one of them.

Launched in January this year, Frankfurt's XXL has already won the annual VIVA Comet award in the category "best music format"—despite the fact that it doesn't really fit into the traditional concept of "formats" at all.

Says Markus Hertle, HR-XXL's programming manager: "The difference between us and stations like Planet Radio or Radio NRJ is both conceptual and philosophical.

"XXL wants to be credible, so we have people from within the various music scenes reporting on them, as in the weekly programmes Groovenight, Dope Beats [hip hop] and Freestylistic [drum'n'bass]. The ratio of chart music ranges between 10 and 20 percent, which is unprecedented in the German radio landscape, and the mixture of genres is also unique: new rock, new pop, drum'n'bass, big beat, hip hop, techno, alternative. About 20 percent of the music we play is chosen by the DJs alone and is not part of any [set playlist] rotation."

In the beginning

Historically, the seed of XXL was planted as one popular Saturday evening show on HR-3, the Clubnight, featuring three-hour sets by internationally known DJs such as Sven Vath, DJ Dag (Dance 2 Trance), the late Thorsten Fenslau (Culture Beat) and others. The music editor in charge of Clubnight was Markus Hertle. However, the concept of an entire Hessian regional youth radio

channel had to be shelved at the time, according to Hertle, for political reasons.

More than five years later, the concept became a practicality as part of the Europe-wide DAB (Digital Audio

Broadcasting) project, funded in part by the ARD (Association of German Public Broadcasters). Since the market for DAB has yet to evolve, HR-XXL was granted a number of terrestrial frequencies (eight so far), as well as more than a dozen local cable slots. Just like Hessischer Rundfunk's three other add-on programming strands, XXL was originally seen as a digital extension to the traditional programmes. Yet Markus Hertle and his team, including music editors Anke Gros and Manfred Kahler, have—under the auspices of HR-3 programming director Joerg Bombach—managed to create what ultimately became a new station. Although XXL is not technically independent from Hessischer Rundfunk's popular HR-3, it has had from the very beginning a highly individual and recognisable profile of its own.

Meeting a need

XXL may not yet be a major player in terms of audience coverage, but music industry feedback has been almost uniformly positive. The reasons are fairly obvious: the station targets 15-25 year-olds, the hosts are mostly under 30, and the musical range on

offer is broader than that of most competitors (apart from highly innovative non-profit local stations such as Radio X in Frankfurt).

Iris Walker, regional radio promotion manager for Universal Music, calls XXL a "crossover format," and says she

believes that things can happen there, musically, which couldn't take place anywhere else in Germany; "Certain hip hop themes, for example, which may eventually make the charts but normally don't get airplay, are often playlisted at HR-XXL."

Another important aspect of the station's approach, according to Walker, is its distinctive take on music programming, both within the genre-specific evening shows and also during the day.

Manfred Kahler who is, together with Anke Gros, responsible for all day-time music programming, explains: "The charts are not really of much help to us, because we think of our audience as trendsetters. Once a title makes the charts, it's really almost passé for our listeners. However, our choices are often confirmed by the charts."

He cites Fatboy Slim's *Rockafeller Skank*, which XXL playlisted very early, before it caught on with the mainstream. These programming choices,

according to Kahler, are based—in equal shares—on personal taste, advice from insiders, and other media including the hip press. Empirical research is used as a backup, to avoid the danger of losing touch with the audience.

More than radio

In an age of multimedia and short attention spans, radio has to reach out to meet its audience. XXL attempts to do so in several non-traditional ways, including cooperative projects and special events. The weekly late-night dance music show Groovenight is produced in cooperation with Groove, one of Germany's leading club culture magazines, also based in Frankfurt.

XXL is also actively seeking partnership projects with other clubs

such as Stammheim in Kassel, and the newly-opened U 60311 in downtown Frankfurt, which will become a new homebase for Sven Vath. XXL also broadcast Vath's marathon set during the Last Night of the Omen, the legendary Techno Club which had to close down on October 18.

Equally important is the station's own website (www.hr-xxl.de), where listen-

ers can surf in to get biographical information and pictures of the on-air personnel, breaking news (both within and outside the world of music), take part in competitions and place requests for the Sunday afternoon show Wunschtrax.

Beyond that, a continuous RealAudio stream is provided as the only way for many radio fans abroad to listen to XXL. For the future, Markus Hertle says he expects XXL to acquire its own news service. Currently, hourly news bulletins, as well as weekday evening programming, come from the mother ship HR-3. An extension of independent programming into the evening hours (19.00 to 23.00) is also being planned.

In terms of marketing, come January 1999 XXL will have the facilities to sell its advertising independently, as well as being represented by advertising sales house Young & Fun, which services several public and private radio broadcasters across Germany.

Vargas boosts his blues power

MADRID — The European radio profile of Javier Vargas looks set for a major boost in Madrid this month.

The Spanish blues guitarist will play live at a party on November 16 for hundreds of European and U.S. broadcasters who'll gather in the city between November 15-17 for the sixth National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) annual conference.


Vargas, dubbed Spain's best electric blues guitarist, stresses the genre is still his priority, but his sixth album, *Feedback*

(DRO/East West), increases his chance of crossover success by continuing to develop a potent strain of "Latin blues" or "Latin rock." It also marks the shortening of his band's name from Vargas Blues Band to plain Vargas.

"It's partly marketing, but mostly evolution," Vargas explains. "They always put the blues records at the end of the racks in the shops, but I'm also writing and producing material that incorporates much more than blues—rock, latin influences, and flamenco."

The move has been applauded by no less a personage than Carlos Santana, who invited Vargas on stage to join him for three numbers at an open-air concert in Madrid in July. "No musician should limit himself," declares Santana. "I tell my brother Javier not to accept being called 'the best Spanish blues guitarist.' He feels the same passion as I do when it comes to embracing the music of the world, not just Spanish music or blues."

DRO East West is heavily promoting Vargas,



and Feedback's first single, Back To The City, is on the playlist at Cadena 100, the third most popular rock/CHR network in Spain. Coordinator Carlos Finaly declares: "Vargas and other blues guitarists such as BB King and Raimundo Amador form our main rock element at the moment. We feel very responsible for the surge in the blues' popularity in Spain now."

Covadonga Racionero, DRO's head of international exploitation, calls Vargas one of the label's most solid performers. "He sells slowly, but

usually goes gold. The refocus implied by the dropping of the blues band tag is recognition that he now includes many more important elements. He's no longer purely and simply blues." Feedback has sold some 20,000 units in Europe since its October 1 release, including a limited (10,000) double CD edition. His last album, Gipsy Boogie, went gold in Spain (50,000 sales).

Another clear sign of Vargas' new "Latin rock" blues/soul direction sees the vocal element on Feedback divided 50/50 English/Spanish, between African American Bobby Alexander, and Cuban David Montes. Feedback is to be released in the U.S. and Latin America in January by Warner Latin. Vargas began a tour of Portugal in mid-October, which moves to Spain on November 12 and ends in Barcelona on January 23. The new album was recorded at Hook End studios in Checkendon, England, and engineered by Ian Taylor, who also co-produced it with Vargas, and who has worked with Gary Moore, Mark Knopfler and Bob Dylan.

Dance grooves

Following the close of the third annual Amsterdam Dance Event (October 22-24), Dancegrooves' Gary Smith looks at some of the acts and tracks which made major impressions.

SINGALONG TIME

One of the most talked-about tracks at this year's Amsterdam Dance Event, X-Treme's Love Song (Dance Factory/Italy), looks set for the big time. With an easygoing technopop groove, jolly keyboards and a killer melody, the track is pretty close to being the perfect tune for programmers searching for something catchy, upbeat and different. The dual lead vocal provides the necessary variation of tone, while the Party Mix is suitably daft and piano-drenched.

NATURAL BORN SWIMMERS

London-based label Deep End Productions, having made a strong impression in the U.K. in a short time, could well be one of the labels for 1999. "The ADE had everything we could have hoped for," says label founder Tom Hayes. "The quality is in the people who go there—so many of them genuinely love music, which is inspiring." The label's second single release, Cummin My Way by Articulate featuring Taka Boom (sister of Chaka Khan), is classic soul/garage with big, melodramatic keyboard sweeps and a clunky, chunky, shuffling groove. The icing on the cake is a goosebump-inducing vocal performance by Boom, whose harmonies are every bit as sharp as her sister's.

LUKE IN FOR LOVE

Laidback Luke's *Music's Always On My Mind* (M.O.M./ Netherlands), a well-managed stylistic collision between a soul vocal and a deep Detroit groove, gives good reason for an optimistic long-term view of the dance scene. The quality and freshness of the sound, with its hints of pop and a distinctly "up" vibe bound around something altogether more dangerous, indicate that this young producer has huge potential.

ARIZONA DREAMS

A Japanese TV presenter now living in Arizona and churning out weird slices of electronica is a very late '90s concept. Unsurprisingly, Mango & Sweet Rice's Cappe (M&SR) is as off-the-wall as anything to come out of Arizona—Captain Beefheart lives there too—although most of the tracks tread a thin line between fragile pop, Laurie Anderson, Can, Portishead and something gleefully, mischievously odd. Touches of Japanese tonal scales and tribal textures add to the overall impression of a wilful, offbeat talent.

HAIL TO THE CHIEF

Having established himself over the last 18 months as one of the world's most popular and open-minded DJs, Adam Freeland is now equally busy making his label Marine Parade just as essential. Latest release, Chief Rocka by



Beber, is a cool mixture of laid back breakbeats, genteel tinkling piano and lyrical guitar which fuses ragga with splashes of electro, underpinned by a pleasantly wistful tune.

Having made a virtue—and a career—from his eclectic tastes, Marine Parade promises to be a rather special label. "Music for me," says Freeland, "is all about keeping an open mind. Embracing the techniques learnt from drum'n'bass, injecting the funk of electro and the energy of house and techno to form a hybrid that conforms to no formulas, respects its roots yet has the vision to place its feet firmly on the dancefloors of the future."

Bloem blossoms in the lowlands

Justified or not, the Netherlands has a reputation for being a land where being "normal" is...well... the norm. Twenty year-old singer/songwriter Bloem de Ligny is the proverbial exception to that rule.

However, even extremely positive press bordering on hype hasn't frustrated Columbia's careful artist development plans for this unorthodox artist with a Björk-like appeal, signed by Sony Music senior VP Benelux Patrick Decam personally. "She is definitely treated as a career artist," declares Columbia Holland product manager Paul Jong. "In the printed media, such as OOR magazine, she has been followed quite strongly for two years. But we have never tried to rush an album release." Now the time

seems right; De Ligny's debut CD, Zink, was released on October 23.

"Basically, I wanted to get my act together, including a producer who could act as a catalyst," says De Ligny, often known simply as Bloem (Flower).

Ex-Boomtown Rats bassist Pete Briquette (of Tricky fame) produced at London's Townhouse Studios, and her live band played most of the basic tracks. Les Claypool, mainstay of U.S. metal act Primus, dueted with Bloem on the track Capsule. "When I wrote that song, I could hear his vocals in my head, as it were," says Bloem, who namechecks Blue Nix, the opening track, as the singer's personal favourite. It was her first ever composition. However, no single from the album will be out until January, when Fingercrookie, is slated for commercial release.

"First we want to let the album do the work, tying in with an extensive club tour this autumn to promote it," says Jong. "We've planned various in-stores and joint promotions with alternative retailers such as the Plato chain, and Amsterdam-based Concerto and Get Records." In Belgium and France (on Sony's alternative SMALL imprint) the album has been released simultaneously with the Netherlands.

"The buzz is growing each day, culminating at her recent live performance at the [pop/literature] Crossing Border festival," reports Manon Koers, the artist's personal manager at Off The Record management, based in Bloem's home town of Haarlem. "When a debuting artist is anticipated like that, even before the album launch, you hold your breath for a while. To perform in such a different environment is hard

enough in itself. In the end, everybody involved breathed a sigh of relief as we negotiated that most difficult obstacle," enthuses Koers.

As the radio industry moves towards the next millenium, the issues revolving around the Internet and the medium's development seem to increase and become more complex with each passing week.

The list of concerns already appears endless: webcasting, whether or not to supply real audio with stations' websites, the Internet as competition for listeners, how to measure on-line listening...

Unsurprisingly, the possible implications of the Internet and on-line listening occupied the discussions of many at the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) Radio Show in Seattle last month.

Fuelling those discussions, leading U.S. radio ratings company Arbitron-in conjunction with research firm, Edison Research Media-released a comprehensive, in-depth study of how 3,000 U.S. radio listeners use the 'Net during the event.

The findings of the study "Radio in the New Media World" left many NAB delegates with shocked expressions. One of the key findings of the report is that surfers spend less time listening to the radio—about three hours less a week-than non-Internet users. Also, according to the report—and this point had some delegates squirming in their chairs—three out of ten of those surveyed said they would prefer to listen to an out-of-market station.

That's something which is possible via the Internet, and a significant proportion of on-line users surveyed confirmed they listened to radio stations and visited broadcasters' websites via the 'Net. And many indicated they weren't happy with their local broadcasters' music policies. However, there was some good news: the majority of respondents said that as far as on-line listening is concerned, their first choice is still their favourite local station.

Those are just some of the findings—the tip of the iceberg in an excellent, groundbreaking piece of research which sent a chill through the bones of many NAB attendees.

You might well say to yourself: "But that's the U.S. this is Europe." Ponder on the fact that new media pundits estimate there are over 33.2 million on-line users in Europe. And that number continues to rise...

No-one is trying to needlessly scaremonger or predict the downfall of radio as we know it. After all, many broadcasters are using the Internet and their websites to bring added value to their advertisers, listeners, and record companies' artists and acts. Indeed, many in Europe are far better at it than their U.S. counterparts.

The promotional, positioning and branding opportunties, then, are boundless. However, it's clear that more must be done to change the radio industry's view of the Internet. The 'Net should not be seen as a threat; it must be taken as an opportunity.

Eyeopeners such as the Arbitron/Edison survey will hopefully push broadcasters into rethinking their strategies towards the arrival of new media, whether it be the explosion of on-line usage, satellite service and digital broadcasting.

If they don't, there is a real chance that this new dawn could swiftly become high noon for many in our business.



When an unknown girl singer meets up with an obscure soundtrack producer, what do you get? In this case, the answer is a ditty boasting some rather raunchy lyrics, driven by a jazzy beat and an absolutely irresistible trumpet part. However, the main asset of Would You...? is an absolute killer hook, which goes some way to making it one the best pop singles of the year. Among the first stations to back the song in a big way was Dutch public CHR network Radio 3/Hilversum. One of the programmers, Corné Klijn, explains why. "The real credit," he begins, "should go to my colleague Rob Stenders, who was hooked immediately; pretty soon we agreed that this was potentially a huge hit." Klijn elaborates: "The listener response was very good from day one onwards, and when feedback from retail indicated that this was proving to be a very popular song indeed, we decided to make it a Megahit (powerplay) a couple of weeks

ago. Now it's storming the Dutch singles chart (rising from 66 to 31 in its second week). In fact, if it retains its momentum it will be Top 10 soon, which is quite an achievement for what's essentially a novelty record."

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

It's something of a rarity to find as many as seven new entries on the European Radio Top 50-this is only the second time it's happened this year. What's less rare is the fact that one of them is yet another solo project from a member of the Fugees.

While Fugees chanteuse Lauryn Hill (Columbia) slides to number 24 this week with Doo-Wop (That Thing), and the remake of Queen's Another One Bites The Dust (Interscope) by Wyclef and Pras rises to 36, Pras arrives in his own right at 43 with Blue Angels (Ruffhouse/Columbia), mainly due to U.K. airplay.

Adam Lehn, music director at Danish regional CHR station Radio Victor in Esbjerg, was an early supporter of Pras' rap number, which incorporates elements of Barry Gibb's Grease theme song: "We have to be a bit picky nowadays with the number of R&B songs on our playlist," he notes. "That's why we passed on Another One Bites The Dust, but Blue Angels is one we just can't miss." He continues: "We didn't play Doo-Wop, by the way, because it lacks a catchy hook."

For Lehn, only 21 years old but a DJ since the age of 14, Grease is only a memory from TV reruns on television. Although the original would fit in fine at Radio Victor's new oldies outlet, Victor Plus. Lehn concentrates more on new tracks. He tips the Norwegian singer Christina with a new version of Prince's Wanna Be Your Lover

The highest new entry on the Top 50 this week, at 38, is If You Could Read My Mind (Tommy Boy), by Stars On 54, a collaboration of Amber, Jocelyn Enriques and Ultra Nate. A dance remake of Gordon Lightfoot's folk classic, it comes from a movie about famous New York disco Studio 54 and is doing particularly well in the G/S/A

countries (where it's already number 18, as the Major Market Airplay section shows). If We Try (Manifesto), Karen Ramirez' follow-up to her summer smash Looking For Love, is being aired mostly in the U.K. and Denmark, and the latter country plus Germany



are heavily supporting Simply Red's To Be Free (East West) at 44.

At 46, a contender for the cheesiest title of the year comes from Italian act The Tamperer featuring Maya: If You Buy This Record Your Life Will Be Better (Time/Jive). It's got supporters among programmers (and, presumably, hopeful purchasers) in the U.K., Switzerland and Italy. Featuring Shan-

non with Move Mania (X-IT), again mainly due to plays in the U.K. and Denmark.

NME gives up on Brats

LONDON — Weekly British music paper New Musical Express (NME) is scrapping its annual awards ceremony and will instead create a movie to honour artists. The paper says the move is a response to the plethora of award shows in the market.

Artists who win the critics' and readers' polls will perform and be interviewed on a film, directed by Russell Thomas and produced by commercial TV company Yorkshire Television. The movie will have its premiere at London's Virgin Haymarket on January 26, and will be shown at four other Virgin cinemas before being broadcast by Channel 4 TV as a one-hour show.

Originally called the Brat Awards, the event was created in 1994 as an antidote to the establishment-driven Brit awards. However, says NME editor Steve Sutherland, "Everyone else's awards have changed."

Sutherland admits that "artists don't want to be seen dead on stage with people like me"—last year, Richard Ashcroft, lead singer of The Verve, refused to go on stage and collect his Brat award.

PolyGram/Seagram offer

acquisition was officially launched on November 4, with the announcement that Seagram has commenced its tender for all issued PolyGram shares. The offer—of NLG 115 (\$61.46) per share—will be closed on December 4.

By then, Seagram is expected to have acquired the 25 percent of Poly-Gram shares held by the public which will add to the 75 percent shares Dutch electronic concern Philips has agreed to tender. The offer came five days after the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) declared the tender effective.

"We expect to complete the acquisition in early December," comments Seagram chief executive Edgar Bronfman Jr. "We look forward to combining the two music companies and we remain confident about our future performance."

In a statement, Seagram says: "The company is hard at work on the integration of its music business with that of PolyGram—assembling the best management team, seeking substantial cost savings, and conducting an ongoing process to realise the maximum values from PolyGram's Filmed Entertainment assets."

Presenting Seagram's financial results for the third quarter last week, Bronfman called 1998 "a watershed year for Seagram," and said the PolyGram acquisition will be

key to Universal's growth. "The combination of Universal and PolyGram will create a uniquely powerful competitor, and the acquisition will create significant shareholder value," he added.

"Upon the closing of the PolyGram transaction," concluded Bronfman,

"we will achieve our transformation's goal of operating as a leader in two global businesses: entertainment and spirits & wine."

Bronfman is expected to outline the details of the merger between Universal and PolyGram during a press conference on December 14.

U.K. label 'paying for plays'

LONDON — The concept of "pay for play" is edging onto the U.K. radio landscape, with an independent reis-

sues label purchasing airtime on two Kent stations to play its product.

Westside Records, a division of mid-price specialists VCI, has bought a two-hour slot on Friday nights until the end

of this month on restricted licence service Maidstone FM. The paid-for programme will play tracks from West-side's classic catalogue, which includes artists such as Procol Harum, the Move and the O'Jays. The show is being presented by Bob Fisher and Tony Rounce, Westside's managing director and general manager respectively.

Meanwhile, under the banner of "The Westside Archive" the record com-

pany has also bought airtime during Medway FM/Rochester's drivetime show until the end of next January. Three tracks per night (Monday-Friday) are being promoted from a fea-

tured album, and listeners to the AC/gold station are being given information on how to purchase the featured tracks.

Rounce comments: "Whether we sell one or a thousand records by

doing this, it will be worthwhile." He reveals that Westside is considering taking the idea to other broadcasters, and says: "We hope we will stir up a few of our contemporaries into following our lead."

Rounce contends that the only way to gain radio exposure for such back catalogue material is to buy airtime, because commercial radio largely "ignores" this type of music.

French scrap frequency audit

PARIS — The idea of a comprehensive national frequency audit in France has effectively been abandoned.

A test audit in the Rhone-Alps area was commissioned by broadcasting authority the CSA in 1997 and carried out earlier this year by specialist companies CMBE and CRIL. As a result of the trial, the special committee comprising CSA members and engineers from public and com-

mercial radio stations set up to investigate the matter has decided to give up on the idea of creating new frequencies by better organisation of the FM band.

According to CSA member Pierre Wiehn, "This audit has revealed that there was no anomaly in the overall use of the frequency spectrum in the test area. However, the audit did show that there are great disparities of power and coverage between the public and commercial operators." Wiehn

adds that the audit also reveals that the top end of the FM Band (106-108 MHz) is not well used, with a lot of FM frequencies allocated to public services lying idle.

Concludes Wiehn: "The results of the trial audit didn't suggest any new solutions, except a wide-ranging move of all radio station [frequencies] which would be difficult or even impossible to do because of problems with foreign territories and the cost of such an operation."

singer/songwriter. This year has already seen Lauryn Hill shifting 422,500 copies of her The Miseducation Of... set (Ruffhouse/Columbia) in its first seven days of release; the largest first-week figure for a solo female act to date, according to retail data suppliers Soundscan. However, shortly before going to press, M&M sister publication Billboard Bulletin (November 5) reported that stateside sales for Morissette's Supposed Former Infatuation Junkie Maverick/Reprise, (released in the U.S. on November 3), looked to be heading towards the half-million mark.

Europe, the album was released on November 2, alongside a string of other heavyweight releases, notably U2's long-awaited Best Of 1980-1990 (Island) and Beck's Mutations (Geffen/Universal). The follow up to Morissette's 28 million-selling 1995 Jagged Little Pill (Maverick/ Reprise), Supposed Former Infatuation Junkie now looks set for Top 20 sales chart entries across Europe over the coming week. Warner Music reports that its initial pan-European ship-out was over one million copies, instantly qualifying it for an IFPI Platinum Europe award.

Warner Music Europe vice president marketing Mark Foster describes the initial shipout as "the biggest of any album on Warner in Europe ever." He adds, "It would be nice to think that we could emulate

the sales figures of Jagged Little Pill with this one"

The first single from the album, *Thank U*, rises five places to number 9 on M&M's Eurochart Hot 100 this week, although in the fast-moving U.K. singles market, it's dropping on the sales charts after only three weeks on release. At radio in the U.K., the song rises to number 3 this week in its fifth week on M&M's Major Market Airplay listing.

Warner's Foster says he is pleased with the reception of *Thank U* at radio so far—it's currently at number 4 on the European Radio Top 50 for the second week—and adds: "We certainly won't be coming with a new single this year."

Foster claims he expects *Thank U* to "have a long life" as a single, although some European programmers have expressed some doubts about finding a suitable follow-up on the new album, which has had mixed reviews.

Per Alexanderson, head of music at Swedish CHR network P3, describes Morissette as "a core artist for our station." That made adding *Thank U* to the playlist a virtual formality—however, he's less convinced about the suitability of the rest of the new album's decidedly intense themes for some of P3's audience. "It might," he says, "be hard to target young listeners between 15-20 with the new material. But then, I'm not sure that she

needs them."

In the U.K., Essex Radio group programmer Paul Chantler describes *Thank U* as "a damn good track," but has bumped it to CHR station Essex FM's B-list after only two weeks as an A-list title. "It's dropping in the charts," he notes, adding: "Although it will be playlisted, I can't keep it on the A-list. Things are moving too quickly."

Holger Lachmann, head of music at popular CHR station 104.6 RTL Berlin is, nonetheless, largely enthusiastic. "Research results for *Thank U* are not available yet, but the track is definitely a 'Hinhörer' (ear catcher) and adds colour to our playlist." He continues: "We like to be able to spice up our largely pop dominated playlist with a good rock track if we get the chance."

Foster admits that "Supposed Former Infatuation Junkie is not Jagged Little Pill Pt 2. Morissette toured that album for two years and it was time to move on." Discussions between Warner Music, Maverick and Morissette and her management are currently being held to determine a follow up single from the album.

Meanwhile, Morissette brings her new songs to European stages at an Amnesty International charity concert in Paris on December 10 and at the Nobel Prize Concert in Oslo on December 11.

According to Annibale Pepe, head of external relations for SBS Italy, Hazan declared in December 1997 that the contract with SBS was not legitimate, as SBS was not a European-owned company, and therefore not legally eligible to own 100 percent of an Italian broadcaster.

"Hazan's withdrawal from the contract, claiming it was invalid, coincided with a period of significant growth in revenues for Radio 105, making it less imperative for him to secure investors," notes Pepe. "We applied to the Milan Tribunal for a sequestration order preventing the further sale or transfer of capital in Finelco whilst the dispute over the contract undergoes arbitration [by the Tribunal]."

In court, Hazan produced evidence that Italy's former media watchdog Garante had agreed that SBS was in effect owned by non-European interests, but the Milan Tribunal overturned this. The Italian government has since replaced the Garante with a new national media authority.

Peter Benson, managing director of SBS' radio division, says SBS legitimately owns radio and TV interests in several EU countries. "It's not true that the Garante ruled us ineligible to own Italian media—they just raised a number of questions about our status as a European company. Under Italian law, we have to prove our European ownership to the media authority as a formality after the transfer of shares, and the Milan Tribunal has upheld that."

In a statement, Finelco President Alberto Hazan declines to comment upon what he calls "contentious [legal] proceedings." Radio 105, he says, "is calm and confident of the outcome of the legal proceedings being in our favour."

The next hearing in the case is scheduled to take place in the Milan Tribunal on February 23 next year. Monaco-based AC network Radio Montecarlo Italy, which is also owned by Alberto Hazan, is not affected by the dispute.

EU to launch piracy inquiry

Single Market and are prejudicial to the development all forms of creativity and to the growth and competitiveness of European industry.

"All those involved," Monti insists, "inventors, industrialists and consumers, must have a guarantee that the Single Market is a secure environment for their activities."

According to the DG XV, the aim of the consultative process is "to determine the economic impact of counterfeiting and piracy in the Single Market, to assess the effectiveness of the relevant legislation and to propose a number of initiatives to improve the situation."

The Green Paper will consider four areas in particular: support for private-sector monitoring; legal protection of security and authentication devices, such as the IFPI's SID Code; means of enforcing intellectual proper-

ty rights; and the setting up of administrative co-operation between the relevant national authorities.

The Green Paper will focus on a wide range of sectors affected by piracy and counterfeiting, of which the music industry is just one. The International Federation of the Phonographic industry (IFPI) is planning to use the process to voice music business concern about CD piracy issues.

"We are very happy that this issue has been taken on board by the Commission in order to see what can be improved within the EU," comments Stefan Krawczyk, IFPI's Brussels-based senior advisor, international trade. "It is quite timely, because it focuses on a very important existing problem—physical piracy."

IFPI has already met on several occasions this year with Patrick Ravillard, the official responsible for the

Green Paper at DG XV, and was "very closely involved in its preparation," according to Krawczyk. IFPI has been asked to give its comments on the Green Paper by the end of the year.

Krawczyk says IFPI will continue to "provide as much input as possible," especially in answering the precise questions asked by the Commission in the Green Paper. "We will use this exercise to give the EC very structured information and a complete overview of the situation," he explains.

The Green Paper focuses purely on intra-European issues. "It is an EC initiative to clean up the EU's own backyard," says an IFPI source, and Krawczyk agrees there is still much to do within the EU to eradicate piracy.

He highlights Italy and Greece, which have "endemic piracy," as being among the current piracy black spots, and expresses concern about the Netherlands, which "hosts a number of key people involved in organised crime and different traffics, including CD piracy. The Dutch government fights against it, but it's become a transborder problem and it requires international co-operation."

IFPI will advocate a greater role for the European Commission on these issues. For the moment, on the basis of the principle of subsidiarity, individual legislation in EU member states prevails, but the IFPI would like to see the Commission take the lead in the fight against piracy.

"In most European countries, there are very good laws which set an example for other countries to follow," says Krawczyk. "However, these laws are not harmonised. We are calling for a harmonisation which will offer the highest level of protection to rights owners."



Off the record

OTR hears that the European Parliament vote on the EU Copyright Directive—expected to take place on December 16—will not take place until January 1999. Apparently, Parliament suffered a flood of legislative texts to be discussed during the last session of the year.

One week after being appointed to the radio committee of French ratings organisation Médiametrie, Jean-Eric Valli, president of Orleans regional CHR network Vibration, has been re-elected president of independent radio umbrella organisation Les Indépendants. One of the new projects Valli plans to carry out is the creation of a music research resource, available to all the group's members.

The annual controversy surrounding Italy's Sanremo Song Festival started early this week when a bogus press release arrived at Italian press agency ANSA. The release, claiming to represent independent companies in Italy's IFPI affiliate FIMI and indie labels' body AFI, stated that major labels had arranged for their artists to have priority in the selection process with Italy's public service broadcaster RAI, which covers the event live each February. Several newspapers published the ANSA dispatch which resulted, leading FIMI to categorically deny that any of their members had issued the statement.

Expect EMI Music Publishing U.K. financial director Tom Bradley to be made deputy MD. He will take over day-to-day running of the U.K. company following the appointment of MD Peter Reichardt as EMI Music Publishing president Continental Europe. Reichardt is currently looking to recruit a MD for EMI Music's Danish publishing arm.



German regional CHR station Radio PSR has a new programme director. Morning show host Klaus Vorbrodt (29) takes over from former PD Jürgen Vogel (41) who left last month.

Following last week's M&M report on the EU's EMOB launch, the French government has appointed André Nicolas, an official at the French Ministry Of Culture, to evaluate the creation of the new government body, Music Observatory.

A few months after the integration of sales house IP into CLT-UFA, IP in France has lost its MD. Renauld Vieljeux left last week "due to a disagreement on strategy," according to a source. Philippe Labro, président of IP's board, has appointed Pierre Conte, former Emap France sales director, to succeed Vieljeux.

French music retail chain FNAC is expected to open a fourth Spanish store—in Barcelona—later this month. Within a year, a fifth Spanish store is due to open in Zaragoza, and two more are planned in Portugal, adding to the existing outlet in Lisbon.




