

# Piracy: IFPI tackles the search engines

OSLO — The recording industry's battle against Internet piracy has moved onto another level, following its first action against Internet search engine operators.

On March 24, the IFPI (International Federation of the Phonographic Industry), acting on behalf of the Norwegian affiliates of Universal, Warner and EMI, asked the public prosecutor in Norway to bring criminal proceedings against Fast Search & Transfer

Headquartered in Oslo, with offices in the U.S. and U.K., FAST has licensed a search engine which is able to track down MP3 files (digitally compressed files containing music) to Lycos, one of the most popular Internet service operators. According to the IFPI, FAST "has developed a search engine software which encourages massive systematic copyright piracy by searching all MP3 files worldwide, and then storing all the direct links to continued on page 29



MILAN — He has the whole pop world in his hands, but Italian tenor Andrea Bocelli is risking it all in search of classical credibility.

Lavishly instrumented MOR/classical crossover material has made




Bocelli a force to be reckoned with in recent times. His classical debut, Aria (Philips Classics), released in March 1998, only accounts for two million of over 20 million albums sold in a career which spans barely five years.

The Italian singer is determined to boost his classical career whilst continuing with the pop-crossover side of his work. However, it appears that Bocelli's "split" career could be starting to take its toll on the artist's pop output.

Sogno (Sugar/Polydor)—his first pop album with a simultaneous, worldwide release-was delayed by six months because of Bocelli's classical engagements. Compared to Romanza (Sugar/Polydor), there is only a very narrow window to work on Sogno before Bocelli's next classical album will be rolled out in November.

So far, radio support for the European lead single, Canto Della Terra, released on March 1, has been weaker

# RTL MD resigns after 'prank' phone call

BERLIN — An on-air prank featuring a live interview with an unwitting German chancellor Gerhard Schroeder has cost 104.6 RTL/Berlin's managing director his job.

Bernt von zur Muehlen was immediately suspended by the AC station's parent company CLT-UFA following the March 12 incident. CLT-UFA subsequently announced on March 23 that Von zur Muehlen would not be returning to the station, and that his association with all of CLT-UFA's radio activities has been terminated.

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# Upfront

The turmoil at the European Commission can be a good thing for the music community.

Of course, the short-term effect of the crisis plus the forthcoming European elections is that everything is frozen in Brussels. This affects at least three key issues which are currently being discussed at Commission level-the Copyright Directive, the question of parallel imports and the e-Commerce Directive. The budget discussion on the EU's Culture 2000 plan, which included an important financial provision for music-related projects, has also been put on hold.

On these topics, not much progress will be made in the next weeks (if not months!). Music industry lobbyists will have to wait until a new Commission is appointed and a new European parliament elected to find out what the future of these issues will be. "We'll have to be patient,"

laments one lobbyist.

However, in some industry circles, the Commission's crisis is not necessarily viewed as a bad thing. Some crucial issues, particularly the parallel imports question, were progressing badly. Another Commission might have different views.

In addition, any move granting a bigger role to the European parliament in the future "is good news," according to one industry source. A possible shift of power from the Commission to the parliament is not considered as a negative step by music industry observers.

At the beginning of this year, the parliament more or less endorsed all the changes in the Copyright Directive that the music industry had called for. The music community has built up strong links with MEPs which will certainly survive the new elections.

Overall, what the crisis has proved is that Brussels is the Rome of the new millennium, with its sulphurous cocktail of power, bureaucracy and corruption. But Brussels is also at the heart of European politics (and policies), so we all have to get on with it.



# Virgin double header

LONDON — U.K. national rock station

Virgin Radio is bringing a Gallic touch to its programming department, following the appointment of Oui FM/Paris programmer Carl Watts as music scheduler.

Watts will work alongside former 103.2 Power FM/ Fareham programme editor Nik Goodman, who is appointed head of music programming, in a double-headed set-up. Both will report to Virgin Radio programme director Bobby Hain.

Says Hain: "Given that music constitutes so much of what happens on the air,

I am particularly pleased to have two people with very different backgrounds bringing their experience to bear on Virgin's output."

Watts, who was born in England but has spent most of his career in France, is a former programmer at CLT-UFA's French CHR network Fun Radio. More recently, he has programmed Virgin Media's Oui FM in Paris, which has a similar rock format to Virgin Radio in the U.K.

On the differences between the

French and British markets, Watts notes: "The music industry, from a media point of view, moves a lot quick-

er in the U.K. In France a title can stay on the playlist for more than a year."

Goodman, who des-cribes his position as "parallel" to that of Watts, sees one of his key tasks as developing and improving Virgin's relationship with record companies.

"I think a lot of [record company] people are a little woolly about our position,' he says. "They're aware that we have a male, guitar bias but aren't very clear beyond that."

Goodman says that Virgin, which blends classic

contemporary guitar-based music, wants to be seen as "clearly owning its musical position in the marketplace," and "championing quality British music, both in terms of artists and particular songs."

He adds that better communication between Virgin and the record companies can help the latter in their A&R process, through knowing the type of act likely to receive support from what is the U.K.'s only national commercial popular music station.

# Theofanellis to head up BMG in Greece

ATHENS - The vacant position of BMG Greece managing director has been filled by Panos Theofanellis, who is leaving Warner Greece where he started his career and has spent the past 12 years.

Described as "truly a music man" by Richard Griffiths, BMG U.K. and Ireland chairman and executive VP Central Europe, Theofanellis replaces George Lavendis, who recently left Athens to become VP of international for Arista Records in

New York.



Theofanellis served as director of marketing and A&R for Greek and international repertoire at Warner Music. "He knows his trade both on a local and international level," comments Griffiths, to whom

Theofanellis will report.

Says Theofanellis; "I look forward to working with Richard and the rest of the team here to give BMG Greece the focus and commitment it derserves." BMG greece artists include Yannis Kotsiras, Stefanos Korkolis and Marinella.

# 'Late' Austrian stations risk losing licences

VIENNA - Up to a dozen of Austria's new commercial radio stations could lose their licences if they don't take to the air by April 1.

Commercial radio stations were allowed to start broadcasting on April 1 1998, and licensees were given one year to get their stations up and running. But stations in six of the country's nine provinces have not yet launched, with the deadline only one week away at presstime.

Michael Kogler, a lawyer for Austria's Regional Radio Authority

(RRA), says it's impossible to predict how many stations-if any-still won't be broadcasting after the deadline has passed. "But it's very probable most will start," he says.

Revocation of unused licences will occur automatically if the stations concerned do not appear on air. "The authority doesn't even have to say that the licence is lost," Kogler notes.

In addition to the possible readvertisement of any licences not taken up by April 1, RRA member Heinz Wittman says the RRA's board has been discussing the possibility of issuing licences for a further 10 to 20 new local stations. A final decision on the matter is expected later next month.

If the Ministry of Science and Transportation agrees that extra frequencies are available, a public tender would be held in the summer.

But, warns Wittman, "there's not much sense in giving licences that serve 30,000 or 50,000 people. It's not economically sound."

The commercial stations on air so far in Austria have found it difficult to compete with the well-established services of public broadcaster ORF.

# Vibration expansion into French locals

PARIS — French broadcasting authority the CSA has given Orleans-based CHR/dance station Vibration permission to take a 50 percent share



in Bordeaux community station Radio Black Box.

It is the third community station in which Vibration has become involved—the

Orleans broadcaster already owns 50 percent of Paris rap/R&B outfit Ado FM, and 50 percent of Radio Forum in Poitiers.

"The CSA has understood that, as national networks

develop further, regional networks also need to develop their activities in order to keep the French radio market balanced," says Vibration CEO Jean-Eric Valli.

However, Valli states that his aim is not to create a new national network under the Vibration brand, but to help small radio stations with their brand identity and format. "We will not change the names and formats of these radio stations, which are all part of the [non-profit making] community radio sector."

Continues Valli: "Our aim is to help these stations benefit from economies of scale, particularly in the areas of music research and programming. Unlike the national networks, we are not here to buy licences, but to create 50/50 partnerships in order to help [community] radio in its development by investing both money and expertise. We are not actively searching for local radio stations to enter into partnership with, but we are looking at each opportunity as it arises."

In further expansion moves, Vibration is to apply for a licence to broadcast its CHR/dance format in Lille, and will also make an application to set up a Black Box station in Toulouse

However, the radio group will not be crossing any borders in its expansion plans. "We see our development as being in France only," says Valli. "We considered entering the Belgian market, but it's even more complicated than France!"

# ON THE BEAT

## PLANS FOR NEW NRK STATION

OSLO — Public broadcaster NRK is to launch a new music service to help promote digital radio in Norway. P5 will broadcast a "Classic Hits" format (gold and recurrent hits from the '50s to the '90s) aimed at 25-45 year-olds. The service will also be broadcast terrestrially on FM in the major Norwegian cities. Just five people will be hired to operate the station, with artist manager and NRK veteran Steinar Fjeld appointed as project manager. Fjeld will report to NRK Futurum managing director Anne Halvorsen, who says: "Our ultimate goal is to create something we don't already have, in order for us to help increase the sales of digital radio sets." The station is expected to start broadcasting next year.

#### LOS 40 UNPLUGS ITS TV

MADRID — SER's CHR network Los 40 Principales has extended its series of intimate unplugged-style "Conciertos Básicos" to its digital TV channel, 40TV. The first concert, shown on March 26, was a small gig by La Oreja de Van Gogh, while the second will feature the Manic Street Preachers on April 9. SER music formats director Luis Merino says: "After seven years of Conciertos Básicos on Los 40, the logical move was towards TV. It's not a question of



plugged or unplugged, but of finding out the musical reality of artists by putting them in tiny venues, far from the big crowds." From the summer, the concerts will also be shown on pay TV service Canal Plus.

# ZOMBA FOUNDER GOES DIGITAL

NEW YORK — Ralph Simon, co-founder of the Zomba Group and, more recently, president of the European arm of Rondor Music/Almo Sounds, has joined U.S. digital music software firm Global Music One (GMO) as chairman. Also on board, as deputy chairman, is Hilton Rosenthal, the South African record producer who facilitated Paul Simon's *Graceland*, among other projects. GMO, based in Santa Monica, is developing software for the delivery and promotion of music on the Internet and on private network systems. Simon was in London recently meeting with labels and others in preparation for GMO's launch of its enhanced MP4 e-mail tool.

## UPTOWN LOOKS FOR NORTHERN RANKING

COPENHAGEN — Danish broadcaster Radio Uptown launched its third station on March 18, in the town of Helsingør, North Zealand. Uptown Nord will have the same "best of the '80s and '90s" music format as Radio Uptown in Copenhagen. The new station's broadcast area stretches from the holiday resorts in the northern half of Zealand, to the Copenhagen channel in the south. Radio Uptown also operates Uptown Gold in Copenhagen, and forms part of the Danish Radio 2 group owned by U.S. media company Clear Channel Communications.

# More niche formats on the way in UK?

LONDON — The shape of the U.K.'s commercial radio sector in the next few years has been brought into sharper focus following the publication of new licensing plans by its regulator, the Radio Authority (RA).

Key amongst the new awards to be made by the RA will be four new regional licences, which will supplement the 12 regional services already in existence. These new licences will be advertised for South Wales (including Cardiff, Swansea and Newport); the West Midlands (including Birmingham, Cov-

entry and Wolverhampton); West and South Yorkshire (including Leeds, Doncaster and Sheffield) and the

East Midlands (including Nottingham, Derby and Leicester).

In the past, the RA has

awarded many of its regional licences to groups proposing specialist music formats, since the size of population being covered can make niche music for-

mats more financially viable than in smaller transmission areas. The existing regional stations include dance, jazz

and alternative formats— Chrysalis Radio's chain of Galaxy dance stations, for example, holds three of the cur-

rent regional licences.

The first of the new regional licences to be advertised by the RA will be South Wales in July this year, followed by the West Midlands in December and West/South Yorkshire in May 2000.

The RA has also announced its intention to advertise another raft of smaller, local radio licences—amongst the towns and cities which have been added to its "working list" are Barnsley, Buxton, Dumbarton, Grimsby, Rugby, Warminster, Worthing and Yeovil.

No Problemo has just launched itself as France's first Internetonly radio station with a female voice. Its web site offers a RealPlayer link, an invitation for visitors to e-mail requests, an offer to sign up for its mailing list, a nascent message board and the assurance of advertising in the



future. The station itself, a joint project of Com-FM and Capital Productions, plays an urban selection of current hits with a judicious percentage of French artists. Interestingly, there is also a remark on the page promising that efforts are underway to determine a royalties payment plan specific to webcasting.

# Resignation to hit Onda Cero sale?

MADRID — The Onda Cero Radio group has been thrown into turmoil following the shock resignation of its deputy chairman, Blas Herrero.

The move has deep implications,

because Herrero owns 60 of OCR's 84 "associated" stations (OCR wholly owns a further 102), and because OCR is currently in negotiations with



Spanish telecoms giant Telefonica, which wants to buy the whole OCR radio grouping (including all of its associated stations).

Following Herrero's resignation, OCR parent company Uniprex has asked several regional governments to transfer the ownership of 48 of Herrero's associated stations directly to OCR. A Uniprex statement released on March 19 said it had taken the action because, although the ownership of the stations

concerned was in Herrero's name, "they have never been managed by him, but by this radio network."

The statement added that the company did not know why Herrero had resigned, "but his attitude can only be interpreted as an attempt to negatively affect the current sale process [to Telefonica]."

However, Uniprex's request to the regional governments could already have backfired—the Andalucian regional government, for example, has declined to transfer ownership of the stations concerned. A government spokesman in Seville says: "If it is true that the real managers are not the real owners [of the stations], the concessions will be revoked and put out to tender again."

Herrero's decision to end his eight year association with OCR came because, he says, "I do not want to be responsible for the [financial] results to be presented next week. I cannot approve figures that I do not agree with." Herrero adds: "For a long time I have been accusing OCR of irregu-

larities within Uniprex, and I do not want to be responsible for what might happen."

The radio entrepreneur claims that OCR had promised to forward the annual accounts to him before January 18, the day on which the association of his stations with OCR was due to be renewed. He says that he came to a verbal agreement with OCR to extend this deadline until the sale of the radio group was completed.

In a further twist, it has emerged that Spain's second biggest commercial radio operator, Cadena COPE, has made approaches to both Herrero and to OCR's star presenter, Luis del Olmo (who owns 14 OCR-



associated stations), with a view to taking on Herrero and Del Olmo's combined total of 74 OCR-associated stations.

# The Voice comes to Aarhus

COPENHAGEN — The Voice, Denmark's largest commercial radio broadcaster, now has terrestrial operations in the country's three biggest cities following the launch of The Voice Aarhus.

The new station will supplement The Voice's FM signals in Copenhagen and Odense, giving the network a potential audience of half the country's population. The Voice is also available nationwide via cable and satellite.

The Voice has been able to extend its coverage to Aarhus following an agreement hammered out between its majority shareholder, the pan-European broadcasting group SBS, and the

Aarhus Stiftstidende newspaper, which owns Aarhus-based FM stations Aarhus Naerradio, Radio Colombo and Radio 1.

Under the terms of the agreement, SBS is broadcasting The Voice on the FM frequencies of those stations, which have effectively been shut down as a result. The newspaper has not actually sold the three broadcasters to SBS, but has entered into a partnership which should bring financial gains for both parties. The Voice Aarhus' local news coverage will benefit from the association with the local newspaper group enjoyed by the previous stations.

# Indie giant edel predicts further growth

HAMBURG — Leading German indie label edel is reflecting upon its most successful year since its foundation in

1986, following publication of its financial results for 1998 (M&M Hotline, March 27).

Edel, which went public on the Frankfurt stock exchange last autumn, saw turnover increase by 37.6 percent to DM284.4 million (euro 145.8m), compared to DM206.7m in 1997. Pre-tax profits grew by some 92.3 percent to DM22.5m, compared to DM11.7m the previous year. The company's expanded international division increased its turnover by 50 percent.

Though edel remains behind the five majors in Germany, with a four percent market share, the label is "already the biggest independent in

Europe," according to CEO Michael Haentjes. "Our main target is to become the biggest independent in the world," he says.

Edel's recent co-operations with companies such as Hollywood Records and EM.TV have all helped to fuel the rise of the company's shares, which have risen from DM98 in September to their current standing of around DM650. Despite the public flotation, Haentjes himself still owns most of the company—only 22.4

percent of the shares are in public

1998 was also a good year on the A&R front for edel. Blümchen won the best national female artist prize at this year's Echo awards ceremony (M&M, March 13), while Scooter, Aaron Carter and Jennifer Paige also made major impacts on the charts. "We want to develop more of our own artists—that's one reason why we now have subsidiaries in the 12 major European markets," explains Haentjes.

For 1999, the edel MD expects another increase in both turnover and profits, based on trading in the early part of this year. At the beginning of next month edel will open a new office in Buenos Aires, and Haentjes promises more co-operations and acquisitions in the coming months.

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

# Dance rooves

## RENAISSANCE

Previously known as Testament One, by Kentish Man, this all-new revamped version going out as I'm Telling You by Chubby Chunks feat. Kim Ruffin (Cleveland City/UK) is a superb makeover of a bona-fide club classic. The uplifting disco groove and distinctive hi-hat pattern are still to the fore. But now, thanks to Ruffin's gutsy vocals, the track has more crossover appeal than ever.

#### MIX IT UP

Although it relies too heavily on the chorus vocal, Calvin Stones' Soulmate (Accor/Holland) is an interesting hybrid. Featuring blues piano, a disco bass line and lots of spacey noises, the backing track has a pronounced ragtime vibe which provides a fresh spin on disco funk. A bit more lyrical variation would be welcome, but a radio edit of this melodramatic stomper might just do the business.

Surprise of the week has to be the subtle poppiness of BluPeter's latest single, BlueAir (React/UK). Not that they've turned in a track Whitney Houston will be rushing to cover, but the Short Haul mix, with its mantric vocals, sub-Moroder groove and big, heady atmosphere, will probably be appearing as music behind a TV or radio voiceover, or in a commercial slot, some time in the near furture.

## GOOD START

You Got Me Baby, Joe Martin's debut release on Undergound Sound of Amsterdam, is one of the best slowbuilders for some time. Kicking in with a hard house beat, funky guitar and tribal touches, You Got Me Baby develops, over the first four minutes, from pure groove to handsaloft shoutalong madness. After that, Martin hits the filters to create a harder version of the nu-disco sound. Kadoc's remix is big on twisted strings, bubbling bass and Italian-style cheesy piano. Both versions are superb.

## THE SOUND OF THE SPANISH **UNDERGROUND**

There might not be all that much going on in Spanish electronica, but the different local scenes based around Barcelona, Madrid and Valencia each have their own distinctive character. While Madrid is generally known for techno, hard house and breakbeats, Valencia is the epicentre of disco house. It is to Barcelona, however, that the most varied collection of artists and DJs gravitates.

Anglo/Spanish duo Easy's Easy Does It EP (Cosmosound/Spain), is as good an indication as you could hope to find of Barcelona's eclectic musical nature. The opening track, Lupita, features a racy funk bass figure over a galloping beat that hints at drum 'n' bass with the rockist phatness of bigbeat and mutant hip hop elements. Add to that urgent keyboards, trombone and cuban calland-response voices, and you have a sound that's as original as they get these days.

"It's been getting excellent reviews," comments Cosmosound MD Albert Salmaron, "and it's included on the Cosmosound 3 compilation which has also been picking up good critiques, especially in the UK." Meanwhile, Easy are preparing a second EP for release in April and an album which will, according to Salmaron, be ready after the summer.

# Datura grows on Italian radio

Italian underground dance act Datura are breaking into the mainstream with their latest single, I Love To Dance, which features former Curiosity Killed The Cat frontman Ben Volpellier Pierrot on vocals.

The song continues Datura's string of Italian underground club hits which featured vocals from illustrious guest artists-such as Billy Ray Martin on Devotion and Mystic Motion, and Steve Strange of Visage fame rounding off a slinky re-make of Visage's biggest hit Fade To Grey.

Building on their loyal fanbase, Datura have made the big league this time. The DJ Dado remix of I Love To Dance has become a staple on the playlists of all major Italian CHR networks following its February release.

Named after an hallucinogenic and potential-

ly lethal herb made famous in the books of Carlos Castanada and Tex Willer, Datura gained notoriety and a cult following in Italy with their

1993 hit Eternity—a speedy "cocaine disco" anthem, so called because of its schizophrenic, stroboscopic sound. Eternity reached number 1 in the Italian singles charts and the album of the same name sold 30,000 copies in Italy alone.

We left behind the 'cocaine disco' sound of Datura in 1996 with the release of our first house single, Would You Believe," says Stefano Mazzavillani, one half of the creative duo behind Datura. Mazzavillani's partner is Ciro Pagano, while regular contributors to Datura's tracks include DJs Ricci and Cirillo.

"There is nothing really new to do except make good songs with passion," comments Mazzavillani. "Our collaboration with Ben from Curiosity Killed The Cat stems from an old friendship. We wrote the song with him and his hit Misfit in mind, and when we asked him to sing on it he accepted."

Ben says he was keen to work in Italy. "The Italians are rich in rhythm and melody and they are funky, loyal, giving and loving people. It was also a good contrast to work on a snappy dance track. Back in the U.K. my own songwriting is more moody and rooted in blues and soul." He is looking forward to live performances with Datura, and perhaps further studio collaborations.

Datura switched from their original label, Bologna-based indie IRMA, to the Bresciabased Time label-the home of successful house act The Tamperer-in 1995. Time Records' promotions director Paolo Caputo says the label will be following up a recent radio promotion tour for Datura with further promotional work. "There is a real chemistry between Ben and Datura and it is likely that their collaboration could continue," says Caputo.

# French rap taps its African roots

French hip hop is going back to its roots with a

project which catapults African music into the Top 10. Only two weeks after its February 23

release Racines (Roots), the debut album by Bisso Na Bisso on V2 France, has rocketed into the French album charts at number 5.

The group features-among others-Melgroove's vocalist M'Passi, Neg'Marrons' Ben J, 2 Bal, Mystick, and V2-signed rap star Passi. All five share a love for music and a family background. Their ancestors can be traced back to the African state of Guinea Bisso. The translation of the

band's name, which is taken from a Congolese dialect, is "between ourselves."

"All in all we are eight artists from various tribes in Africa who are killing each other over there as we speak," says Passi, who initiated the project. "Bisso Na Bisso has a clear message, and that reads peace and unity."

At the crossroads of hip hop and traditional African music, Racines comprises 15 tracks sung in French and local African dialects.

'Bisso Na Bisso brings a new concept to rap," says Bruno Witek, head of programming at hip hop and groove dedicated station Ado FM. "Racines is a tribute to the creative source of French hip hop-Africa. Focusing once more on its roots, rap in France has moved a step forward and is bypassing U.S. influences to find its own identity.

According to V2 promotion director Michel

Vidal, the label's marketing campaign concentrates on three different target groups: the African community in France; the general press;

and last but not least the hip hop fraternity. "The debut single Bisso Na Bisso was serviced to French radio

last December," says Vidal. Major CHR/Urban network Skyrock dedicated a whole week of on-air promotions to Bisso Na Bisso between February 16-20. "All the specialist hip hop and African stations are giving us great support," adds Vidal. "And we've had good feedback from youth and dance oriented stations such as Nova and Le Mouv'." The video clip of the song, filmed on location in the Ivory Coast last January, has

been in rotation at local music TV channels M6, MCM and Fun TV since February 5.

The main man behind Bisso Na Bisso is 26year-old Passi, a member of hard core rap act Ministère Amer. He achieved platinum status in France last year for album sales of more than 300,000 units of his solo debut, Les Tentations (V2 France). "The idea for [the Bisso Na Bisso] project dates back to 1994," reveals Passi, "but it all fell into place when I

was recording Les Tentations."

Next to the hip hop "core," Bisso Na Bisso also features guests such as African artists Koffi Olomidé and Papa Wemba, as well as West Indian stars Jacob Desvarieux of Kassav, Michel Alibo and Tanya Saint-Val. The full group, including all guests, will be performing a special show for one night only on May 15 at the Zénith in Paris.



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
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
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# Dutch and Belgians nurture talent

The principal Benelux territories in terms of population, consumption and product—Belgium and the Netherlands—have always been conscious of the preeminence of English-language pop in an international market where English lyrics are the most accessible to a wide public. However, as in other European territories, both the Netherlands and Belgium are experiencing a surge in domestic demand for music performed in the home

It appears to be fuelled by steady improvement in domestic production quality, and a new interest by artists in expressing themselves in their mother tongue. Young, up-and-coming acts who can convey this to a home audience are creating fresh credibility for domestic music.

At the same time, both markets have a tradition of multilingual production. Belgium has two major languages

within its own borders to contend with, and is used to working across cultures, while the Netherlands has a cosmopolitan outlook and both imports and exports Englishlanguage material as a matter of course. With opportunities on both fronts, the Netherlands and Belgium appear to be capitalising on their ability to make music for themselves and for the international market.

As Europe plunges deeper into political and financial integration, the music industry's "regional resistance" movement is leading a revival of home-language pop for domestic consumption in the major territories. Countries are asserting their cultural individuality at home, and at the same time taking advantage of cross-border opportunities and higher standards of production to boost their music exports. As Robbert Tilli and Mark Maes report, Belgium and the Netherlands are scoring success in both areas.

# The Netherlands: hot home grown acts

iracy, downloading MP3 files from the Internet and CD burners may be the local industry's hottest issues at present, according to Paul Solleveld, managing director of Dutch IFPI body NVPI, but the hottest

acts in the Netherlands are increasingly being drawn from the domestic talent pool.

Local product currently occupies 30 percent of the Dutch charts, an unprecedented share for homeproduced music, and at the same time the Netherlands' reputation as an export nation is growing.

Although last year's total domestic turnover

of Dfl 500 million (Euros 227 million) on the Dutch market shows a 5 percent drop compared to 1997, the macro view reveals a quite stable pattern for music sales since 1991.

The strength of home sales is based on the industry's renewed confidence in product sung in the native language for home consumption, coupled with a willingness to produce

polished English-language material with an eye to both domestic and wider markets.


Language options

Dutch-language pop singer Marco Borsato (Polydor) has dominated the charts in recent years, with album releases practically every year selling on average half a million copies each (five times platinum). "The good thing is that it doesn't stop at Borsato," remarks Solleveld. "In his slipstream lots of newcomers have

successfully tapped the Dutch-language pop potential too.'

The facts support Solleveld's contention. Dutch mother-tongue pop is currently enjoying a revival to outdo even the powerful first wave of the early '80s. Old school veterans

such as De Dijk (Mercury), still



two albums charting simultaneously, are being augmented by Dutch-language newcomers such as Bløf (EMI) and De Kast (CNR), Volumia! (BMG) and Acda & De Munnik (S.M.A.R.T). All of these have platinum albums (100,000 units sold) under their belts. Meanwhile, dialect rockers Rowwen Hèze (HKM/CNR) and Skik (Polydor) are living proof of "regional resistance" to further European homogenisation. Paul Zijlstra, newly appointed head of A&R at Universal Music Holland, explains: "Our own language in all its variants is no longer seen as second-rate. With the wider acceptance of material in Dutch, the industry here is far more inclined to take a chance on it.

This does not mean that the demand for product in what is still the international language of pop-English—is being neglected. Dutch artists faring well with English-lan-

guage material include soulful pop band Total Touch (BMG) and Holland's first ever country star Ilse DeLange, who is signed directly to Warner Music Nashville. DeLange's Barry Beckett-produced debut album, World Of Hurt, is to be released in the U.S. by the end of this year.

## International ambitions

Time will tell whether recording abroad will pay off equally well for songstress Erikah Karst and her VAN Records labelmates, alternative rockers Cords-and perhaps

new albums by genuine dance/rock crossover act Urban Dance Squad, and Britpop-esque Supersub.

Meanwhile female rocker Anouk (Dino/BMG), having swept the continental European charts Scandinavia to Italy, now has her debut CD, Together Alone, released in the US by Columbia.

Classical violinist André Rieu (Mercury/Polydor) recently picked up his third consecutive Export Prize, acknowledging worldwide sales in excess of 2.7 million units in 1998.



# BENELUX SPOTLIGHT



At home this hiphopping reggae trio have scored three chart hits: Cocktail, U Wait and Renaissance featuring R&B girl trio Dignity (all on Virgin). Cocktail is released in Germany, whereas Renaissance is the preferred song in France. Debut album Documents

(TopNotch/V2), evoking memories of latter day toasters, is close to gold status (50,000 copies sold) in the Netherlands. Radio 3FM programmer Ben Houdijk is fully tuned into the positive vibes: "Whereas most reggae sounds like yesterday, with R&B and hiphop elements," he says, "Postmen have the sound of the '90s."

Dance product is also adding to Holland's growing status as an export nation. Currently, cheerful dance outfit Vengaboys (Violence/Zomba) are charted Europe-wide with various singles off their We Like To Party album.

Radio's part

NVPI's Solleveld attributes the success of domestic product, both at home and abroad, to "much higher musical and production quality than there was before. Besides, now that the re-exploitation of catalogue material, which marked the pioneering years of the CD soundcarrier, is over, record companies are working much harder on their domestic roster. Breaking new local artists has become a priority again, which has been recognised by radio stations such as public Radio 3FM, national repertoire specialist Noordzee FM and youth-oriented Radio 538, plus music television station TMF.

Erik de Zwart, who doubles as Radio 538 MD/DJ and TMF VJ notes that "on a weekly basis about ten Dutch productions are charted in the Rabo Top 40. That's 25 percent. At 538 we playlist a lot of local product, both Dutch and English-language stuff."

Vengaboys highlight the current radio power of Dutch acts at home and abroad by registering playlist additions at Radio 538 and Tros Radio 3/Mega Top 100/Hilversum with We're Going To Ibiza, and at the same time spending eight weeks, to date, on M&M's Border Breaker chart for mainland European records breaking out of their country of origin with Boom, Boom, Boom, Boom! (Violator/Jive). Robbert Tilli

# DJ Jean

With his last single, U Got My Love (Mo'Bizz), still charted in Billboard's dance chart, DJ Jean's latest outing,

Launch, seems to be surpassing all of his previous singles to date. However, the former staff DJ at Amsterdam's sexy iT club still considers himself a DJ



rather than an artist. The Launch is almost a '90s mutation of '70s instrumental synth hit Popcorn. In Jean's own words, it's "a melodic club house track with a rather gimmicky, catchy theme."
Music television channel TMF's music director, Erik Kross, has put the video in A-rotation. "Every now and then a houser is required for good measure. As they're quite scarce these days, the timing is right," he says.

Birgit's rocky debut single A Little Famous (Mercury) is the first claim

to fame for this 21year-old sister of soap star/MTV VJ Katja Schuurman. Featuring the catch phrase "I'm tired of feeling small," it the like sounds sibling's vounger declaration of intent.



Penned by Sweden's songwriting duo Larsen & Eklund and produced by Fons Merkies, Jack Pisters and Hans Ravestein, it became a radio hit across the board, followed by a series of TV appearances. The next step, according to Mercury product manager Elselinda Schouten, is to make the exposure count. "With the next, somewhat softer single, Maybe The Wine, we will try to translate the initial success into a proper sales hit," Schouten says

# Bloem de Ligny

If adventurous musicianship is a claim for attention, De Ligny deserves to be noticed. Her rather

Björkish debut CD, Zink-her word for "sea"carries considerable emotional impact. Produced by Boomtown Rat Pete Briquette, Zink's outstanding tracks include first single Fingie Crookie,

Blue Nix and Capsule, De Ligny's stunning duet with Primus' superfreak Les Claypool. The album is already released in neighbouring Belgium, and is scheduled to be out in France, Germany and Austria during the next few months, with an Italian release pending. "The rest of Europe is to release the album at a later date," reports Columbia Benelux general manager Wally van Middendorp.

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
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# Local talent gains strength in Belgian charts



sales continue to grow with a 40 percent rise in sales and units. "Dance repertoire makes up an important part of the overall Belgian industry's growth," explains IFPI Belgium Director Marcel Heymans, "and this is reflected not only in the charts but in the overall industry landscape. The fact that singles have Natural Born Deejays; 2Fabiola; continued to grow for three consecutive years is very positive, although we saw a

slight stabilisation at the end of last year which might indicate that, in 1999, we may not achieve the same 40 percent growth."

Domestic acts increase share

The share of domestic talent in overall sales figures is somewhere between 17 and 18 percent, representing growth of 11 percent in comparison to 1997. Heymans says the figures don't include Belgian talent in classical repertoire or on compilations. "Over 40 percent of last year's Top 100 Ultratop album chart was domestic talent, and these figures once more reveal the discrepancy between sales and what radio stations (claim to) play," he adds.

The Belgian 1998 singles chart was dominated by dance product with Kim'Kay, MacKenzie feat. Jessy, 2 Fabiola, Fiocco, Natural Born Deejays in the Top 10 singles chart, which also included Flemish revelation Get Ready.

Helmut Lotti continued his string of multiplatinum albums, and the Top 1998 album chart also included K's Choice, Axelle Red and Mama's Jasje, plus children-oriented Samson & Gert and Kabouter Plop.

# Radio airs home talent

Studio Brussel, the Flemish public broadcaster's alternative channel,

provides opportunities for new demo versions of Belgian bands' record-

ings. "As in the past, Studio Brussel attaches quite some importance to local artists. We invite new bands to present their debut albums and organise rock contests for upcoming talent," says Studio Brussel MD Jan Hautekiet. Bands such as Zita Swoon, Soul Wax, dEUS and Arid are current frequenters of the station's playlist, he adds.

Some 25 to 30 percent of (CHR) Radio Donna's 66-title playlist consists of domestic releases, but Jan Van Hoorickx, head of music programming, says the audience's choice is the first criterion. "Our weekly selection consists of 'happy go lucky' music. In future we might implement some positive discrimination in favour of local talent, but the music should fit our philosophy."

Van Hoorickx cites artists such as Alana Dante, Kim'Kay, Get Ready, Coco Jr and Milk Inc. as examples of the station playing a substantial role in breaking local talent.

Sam Hellemans, head of radio promotion at EMI Belgium, picks up the Milk Inc. reference to explain "how complicated things can get" in the Belgian radio landscape, "[Milk Inc.] cracked the French charts with La Vache and sold half a million records

there. That song never made it to Belgian radio, but Radio Donna was very quick to pick up In My Eyes, their new release, and took it to the top of the charts. I would say that

Radio Donna is strong breaking the 'softer' dance tracks such as Extreme's Love Song, whereas private networks such as Radio Contact and Radio are excellent for the more 'edgy' dance products.

## International ambitions

Not content with home success. record companies are actively developing acts which European have breakout potential.

For example, Play That Beat, division of Virgin Belgium since 1996, has until now only focused on the Belgian market, holding the chart Flemish number one spot for 41 weeks in 1997 and 27 weeks last year. Now, says the label's founder and MD Thèo "we're Linder, ready to export

some of the label's artists. Our first priority is Get Ready, and we're sending promo packages to all European Virgin-affiliates".

Get Ready were launched in 1996 and have, to date, achieved 10 number one hits and three platinum albums. Their new album, set for release in May, was produced by Phil Harding and Ian Curnow (East 17, Boyzone) and recorded at Strongroom Studios in London. The first single off the album, I Still Luv U, was the Belgian chart's highest new entry at number 20 in the Ultratop 50.

From the ARS Productions stable come Norwegian signing Autopulver, purveying straightforward alternative rock. "We want to establish ourselves as a fully fledged record company and not just a dance label," says A&R manager Peter Decraene, "and for us Autopulver, whose debut album F-Words [released last summer] has already sold 1,000 units in Holland through our distribution deal with Sony Music, are a great challenge. The band will play the Bevrijdingsfestival [May 5th] in Haarlem before a 100,000 crowd, and we believe this will fuel expectations for their second album due out in September.'

dEUS's new album Ideal Crash is high priority for Universal Music Belgium. The follow-up to In A Bar

Under The Sea, which sold more than 50,000 units in Belgium, is highly anticipated, and Universal has set up a strong promotion campaign to achieve



its 75,000 units sales target. This album carries the band's hopes of an international breakthrough. Headed by Tom Barman, five-piece dEUS added a string section to their already distinctive sound, which was laid down at ICP(Brussels) and mixed at Olympic studios in London. The album was set for Europewide release on March 22nd, and the band have sold out their March 26 London gig in advance.

## Indiana

Songstress partnership Indiana is another act with a prominent place in Universal Music's plans. "With Indiana we have a special story," explains MD Dirk De Clippeleir.

Usually, we build artists locally before taking them abroad. With Indiana, a handsome girl duo, it was our French colleagues who suggested that we release Sauvages et Rèbelles. The single was received very well, and Indiana were invited on an 11-date concert tour with 2B3 last year. We plan to release a new single in April."

## **Beverley Jo Scott**

With Beverley Jo Scott, Arcade takes on a high quality composer and performer. She released her well-received

debut album Honey & Hurricanes with Sony in Belgium back in 1991, followed by Mudcakes (1993) and the live recording Wailing Trail in 1995. Her new album and debut for Arcade Music, Amnesty for Eve, was preceded by the promo-only release of the single Jean Baltazaar, a remarkable duet version of



David Bowie's Jean Genie, performed by Scott and singer/performer Arno. The English language album was released in February (containing a limited four-track French language bonus CD) and sold more than 6,000 copies in a month. "Initially, Beverley Jo Scott was playlisted with stations like the VRT's Radio 1 and Studio Brussel. Now, we note than the French-language Radio Contact network has picked up the single," says Marleen Bassez, head of promotion at Arcade Music in Brussels, adding that Amnesty for Eve is now set for release in Germany, Switzerland and France.

# ENELUX SPOTLIGHT

An Arcade priority is Belgium's entrant in the Eurovision song contest, Vanessa Chinitor. "In less than one week we've passed the 15,000 units sales mark," says Marleen Bassez, head of promotion at Arcade Music Company in Brussels. "Her single Like The Wind is taking the charts by storm, and we do expect a lot from her English language debut album, set for release two weeks prior to the Eurovision festival.'

Making connections

Confidence is a feature of Belgian labels' current approach to the market. "It is our goal to maintain our leading position in releasing and breaking domestic talent," Erwin Goegebeur, MD of EMI Music Belgium. "With Flemish acts like Dana Winner and Clouseau, plus artists with great international potential like Kim'Kay, Eden and Sarah, 1999 is another promising year for us."

Goegebeur is also enthusiastic about the collaboration with dance imprint Antler/Subway (who are also currently in the spotlight with Praga Khan). "Artists such as Milk Inc., 2 Fabiola, Natural Born Deejays, Fiocco, Mack Kenzie feat. Jessie and Astroline have become household names in Belgium, and give EMI access to very wide potential. Dance/pop continues to dominate the charts here, but we try not to stick to just one trend," says

Goegebeur. "There's a lot of room for new talent, and we're prepared to go for it." While new album releases by Dana Winner and Clouseau went straight to the top, Goegebeur is confident that Sarah's well crafted, edgy pop songs on her April-released album Fracture will prove there is still an audience outside the discos.



Widening horizons

Independent labels share the general confidence and drive for international success. With Get Ready For The Sunsand, Alana Dante releases her fifth single on Rowyna Music, and MD Jeroen Mulders says he released Dante's debut album, Disco Supa Girl, "without any promotion" in December. His plan is to combine promotion efforts for both the album and new single with campaigns on Radio Donna (which selected Alana Dante as artist of the year in 1998),

Radio Contact and TMF. "In June, we take Alana Dante abroad," adds Mulders. "We're releasing a special album featuring Alana's hits. In Belgium we're continuing on course with a brand new album where Alana performs her favourite songs, resulting in covers like We Belong To The Night and an acapella version of Crying in the Chapel."

For Double T Music, the mining for platinum continues at home with albums such as Paradise in Me and Cocoon Crash from K's choice. The latter title has taken the brother and sister duo through a fully sold out seven week European tour, radio concert coverage and TV specials. Other priorities

with Double T Music include newcomers Arid, Sony Denmark signing Kashmir and Ozark Henry. "Ozark Henry is being handled in the U.K. by independent promotion crew Real Time, and they have been able Axelle Red

Virgin success story Axelle Red, having sold 750,000 units of her A Tatons Europewide and another 60,000



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



# Publishers in Italy prepare for the electronic age

behind Working scenes with a much lower profile than the record companies, music publishers are preparing for a more visible role in the age of electronic distribution. Mark Dezzani reports on the Italian experience. where publishers are actively gearing up to meet a future which, they say, will involve not only a distribution revolution, but an increased role for them in developing new artists, and a changing relationship with record labels

n Italy, the authors' rights group SIAE is among the first to issue experimental licences for the electronic downloading of music from the Internet, and music publishers see the development of global electronic distribution as a boom about to happen.

At the beginning of this year, 25 important independent record companies left AFI, Italy's independent music industry association, to join the IFPI-sponsored music industry federation FIMI. AFI president Franco Bixio, who is also president of his own family-run publishing group, says that although this was a blow to the association, his remaining members (including many publishers) are preparing to profit from the seismic changes in the music industry which the Internet is bring-

#### Internet transforms roles

"The departing companies criticised AFI on the grounds that our membership is too diverse-including music publishers and artist managers," says Bixio. "The reality is that we represent the whole spectrum of the music industry, and many of our member companies include record labels, publishing and artist management among their activities." His own Bixio Publishing Group includes seven music publishing entities and three record labels: Bubble Records specialising in pop repertoire; Music Strasse (classical); and Cinevox (soundtracks).

Bixio adds that the Internet will transform the role of publishing companies. "Technological developments will heighten the importance of music publishers, as the management of rights for music distributed via the Internet becomes a key revenue source.'

Franco Dal Dello, MD of Peer Music Italy, says that his parent company has already formed a subholding called Digital Pressure to exploit the digital distribution of music via the Internet. "We have an enormous catalogue of titles, and now more than ever it is becoming vital for music publishers to retain ownership of master recordings to keep our catalogues updated, and to enable us to exploit these new opportunities.'

# Forging ahead

Roberto Razzini, publishing director international/local at Warner Chappell Music Italy, takes a similarly pro-active view. "We should get organised to face the new technology experience, and be in a position to be part of it rather than let it take away a share of the market from the 'official' industry," Razzini asserts. "We already have different companies working on downloading as a way of using the Internet to distribute music," he adds. "We recently signed an agreement with SIAE to track usage on the Internet which can be

referenced to central repertoire. We must be able to keep downloading under control. This is the first step to being in that market. We must ensure Internet providers have no excuse for not complying with copyright and royalty regulations.

BMG Music Publishing Italy MD Tino Cennamo is pragmatic. "We have to consider all technological advances not from the point of view of whether we love them or hate them, but just as facts of life. We are using the Internet as a promotion tool.



And we're developing a way for music users—such as TV companies and advertising agencies—to look at catalogue material on the 'net, listen to samples and then call us. We have to use it, not be used by it.'

## Artist development

The role of music publishers in artist development is also likely to be enhanced, as they become more active once again in roles which had tended to be taken over by record labels. Music publishers had become focused on placing songs with artists, in movies, on compilations and for TV commercials. Now, according to Dal Dello, they are becoming more involved in developing new artists.

Peer Music's latest discovery is the female singer/songwriter Leda Battisti. "She was discovered by the songwriter and producer Mario Lavezzi, with whom we collaborate very closely." says Dal Dello. "Lavezzi, who has written many hit songs and produced many established artists including Fiorella Manoia, keeps in close contact with the various music academies to evaluate new talent. He discovered Leda Battisti at the CET academy run by Mogol, and we produced her first album in our own studio having secured a licensing deal with Sony Music Italy's Epic label." Dal Dello adds that "we are also keeping a direct interest in her development and, through our Swedish affiliate, we have now gained attention for her in Sweden, where her first record has been released. She is also at this year's San Remo Festival."

Warner Chappell's Razzini concurs. "My feeling is now that we, as publishers, can put together artistic projects in-house then take them to the record companies. We have the composers and the songs. The artist is also something we can provide."


"We see our mission as focusing on A&R, but also identifying potential market applications," Cennamo.

## New relationships

Dal Dello also predicts that the relationship between independent music publishers and record companies will change, although neither will completely assume the role of the other. "The majors," he says, "have their own publishing companies, but it's still the independent sector that is most vibrant when it comes to discovering new music and artists. We will—more and more—make autonomous alliances and licensing arrangements with the major labels, who will concentrate on promotion and marketing, even for music dis-tributed via the Internet."

Antonio Marrapodi, MD of EMI Music Publishing Italy, says that within a major music group with its own record label operations, the attention of a music publisher is focused on songs and TV promotion. "I maintain that our mission is to be a talent scout," asserts Marrapodi. "Our major role is the recruitment of new talent, but principally songwriters, and they are often also performers." He adds that "we have a special rapport with our parent company's record label operations, but we are still free to place our projects with anyone. Quite often we get involved with a new artist at a much earlier stage than a label would, but we are finding that the Italian market is too small to sustain a lot of new artist launches each year. Lately, we have principally been working with

soundtracks and TV. Whereas a record label will work much more closely with radio," Marrapodi concludes, "we get very involved in placing artists and songs on TV shows and on commercials."

Paolo Corsi, GM of BMG Ricordi's pop division, expands the idea. "We're getting involved in major projects with performers, and bringing

together writers and artists," he says. "We've had successful cooperation with Sony, WEA, and, of course, within BMG. For example," Corsi adds, "we worked with Universal to develop the band Delta V. We helped the band find a record deal with

Ricordi, and their first album sold 30,000 copies."

## Indies remain vibrant

Italy has a strong tradition of independent, familyrun music publishing compaincluding nies, Sugar Music and Bixio. One of the largest, Ricordi, was acquired by BMG in 1994. Federico Monti Arduini, formerly MD of Ricordi's publishing division, started up of Italy's one youngest music publishing com-Café panies, Concerto, two and a half years ago. "What we offer, as an independent, is much more pre-

cise management of an artist's catalogue that a major can. A multinational has too many titles, and can't manage Monti Arduini, adding that niche product and foreign catalogues such as ABC, Disney, Italy's Epic label" 20th Century-Fox and Windswept, which includes the Spice Girls catalogue.

At a local level, Café Concerto focuses on developing niche artists with mainstream crossover potential. "We think like an indie label and scout talent where the majors don't reach," says Monti Arduini. "Our latest talent is the singer/songwriter Sal Da Vinci. We worked on his songs and produced his album, which we licensed to EMI. This will happen more and more: the major record labels will reorient towards working with smaller satellite companies which produce music, and will specialise in distribution and promotion."

Legal protection

Monti Arduini is also president of Italy's largest music publishers' association, EMA, and says that, whilst the Internet will generate a new boom for music publishers and the music industry as a whole, this will

not happen until effective legislation is in place. "The experimental licensing of electronic distribution by the SIAE can be criticised for being incomplete in its coverage of rights protection, but it has at least established the right of songwriters to be compensated. The music industry as a whole will have big problems in the near future, until effective copyright protections can be ratified and applied to distribution via the Internet.

"When this does happen, however," predicts Monti Arduini, "there will be an explosion in the music market. With many of the distribution costs eliminated music will be cheaper to acquire, and the major

multinational record companies will find themselves specialising much more in promotion and marketing. The distinction between record companies and music publishers will become more blurred, as publishers take on many of the roles currently dominated by the labels."



Music publishers in Italy are also careful to point out that their work is not entirely bound up with record companies. "Printed musicwhich has its own

division within BMG—is a very important part of our business," says Corsi. Warner Chappell's Razzini echoes the assertion. "In Warner Chappell we're investing a lot of energy in holding repertoire which is not solely linked to record companies. With TV and film developingwe are at the beginning of TV expansion in Italy-publishers cannot ignore these media. In Europe there will always be a demand for local [music] product because of the variety of languages.

Razzini concludes: "Publishers have control of music beyond the record industry, so we are always developing and researching new areas of investment and exploitation which are not the same as for record companies. Publishers have choice. Music is needed everywhere."



## **CUNNIE WILLIAMS** STAR HOTEL


Peppermint Jam/Edel International release date: May 31 A former NBA basketball player, L.A.-born Williams launched his recording career in Germany in the early '90s. Now signed to Peppermint Jam, he finally finds himself working with a producer-Mousse T

of Horny '98 fame-who knows which sounds are hot and how to push Williams' sonorous voice to the max. Blessed with a voice that can, in its most inspired moments, sound as rich and velvety as Isaac Hayes', Williams is on to a winner with his first single, Saturday, a duet with U.K. singer Monie Love. Saturday is due out on April 12, and highlights Mousse T's ability to pick trendy elements such as the Spanish-sounding acoustic guitar—very Fugees, very Roots & Erykah Badu in a way-whilst maintaining his individual sound. Other prime cuts are Spinning Wheel, a Teddy Riley style two-step, the disco boogie of World Celebration and the title track Starhotel, which features one of Williams' most impressive vocal performances on the album. On Black Boy, Mousse T goes back in time and resurrects the deep soul sound of Muscle Shoals and Stax. Ignore the fact that Star Hotel was recorded in Hanover and let the music speak for itself. This is top notch R&B by dedicated professionals.

Mention bands such as Gomez, Dishwalla and Korn to the majority of Norwegian radio programmers and they would think you'd just arrived from an alien planet. Mention them to Radio Tango/Oslo music director Sverre Bjørnsen, and he'll tell you they're his station's core artists.



There's a tradition among radio stations in this country that's deeply rooted in mainstream pop music," says Bjørnsen. "Their listeners don't understand that it's possible to listen to other music on the radio. If you have a spare Nkr 100,000 (euros 11,250) these days and want to start up an independent record company, there's a big market for that just now," he adds.

Radio Tango is the most prominent alternative to mainstream CHR and AC stations in Oslo. After the only commercial national radio station, P4, launched in Norway five years ago, an increasing number of outlets tried to take on the competition head-to-head by streamlining their formats along the same lines as AC-formatted P4. This has created an opening in the market for stations such as Tango.

Despite Tango being Alternative formatted Bjørnsen feels that, even several years after the original launch, the record companies still don't comprehend his station's programming policy. "The labels are still calling us to ask why we don't play music by acts such as Britney Spears. Conse-

quently, it becomes difficult to communicate with them," he says, adding: "In the U.S., if vou're a 15-25 year-old, you can instantly identify with any one of a number of formats. But the concept of radio formats hasn't really reached Norway yet."

Working under these circumstances, Biørnsen is forced to gather his information elsewhere in the worldfrom various U.K. and U.S. magazines, radio playlists and the Internet. He compares his station to stations such as London's XFM. His

cutting-edge information savvy has led him to discover the likes of One Of The People by Adamski's Thing, which is currently without distribution in Norway. Radio Tango was also one of the first stations to play Offspring's Pretty Fly (For A White Guy) and tracks by Fastball, Everlast and Marcy Playground.

On March 1, Radio Tango became the first local station in Norway to broadcast digitally, which it will be doing 24 hours a day. Tango also operates a second station in Oslo, Radio Tango 2, which airs a Classic Rock format.

Bjørnsen is also aware of the challenge of attracting female listeners. "Attracting male listeners is no problem at all," he says, "but then women wouldn't want to listen to us. We are trying to increase our ratings among women, because now we have two male-dominated stations.

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

Texas and Germany are the most popular destinations in the European Radio Top 50 this

In Our Lifetime (Mercury) by Texas is not only the highest new entry in the European Radio Top 50 at number 24, but is also "most added" this week with an impressive 38 new additions—the highest number we've seen for six months. The new additions record holder is still U2's The Sweetest Thing (Island), which scored no less than 50 in October last year. Texas is welcomed enthusiastically in Scandinavia, the U.K. and Switzerland-and also by Jan van Hoorickx, head of music at national CHRformatted VRT Radio Donna in Flanders, the Dutch-speaking part of Belgium. Van Hoorickx comments: "Texas is sounding a lot more commercial and danceable than before. They used to be more designed for our alternative counterpart, VRT Studio Brussels, but this song is much easier for us to put into A-rotation.

Van Hoorickx describes the sound of VRT Radio Donna, which has an audience share of 29.1 percent, as "happy-go-lucky," and adds: "I'm mainly looking for tracks which have an open feel to them. We can't programme too many dark tones." Van Hoorickx reckons that the Flemish music scene at the moment is mature enough to compete with product from the rest of Europe. "Why, then, hasn't the rest of Europe heard of acts such as Kim'Kay and Get Ready!?," he asks himself. "Maybe we first have to solve an image problem."

Two of the remaining five new entries this week hail from Ger-many. At 41, Sasha scores his second hit in the European Radio Top 50, although outside the G/S/A countries only Poland is, as yet, over the moon for his ballad We Can Leave The World (WEA). The rest of Europe is still

playing his former hit, If You Believe (WEA), currently in the airplay top 20 in Holland and Scandinavia. Also from Germany is Colour The World by Sash! featuring Dr. Alban (X-It), a new entry at 45, which is in the picture mainly in Denmark, the U.K. and Belgium. At the moment, seven of the 25 records in the Border Breakers chart are produced in

Germany—that's only one short of Sweden's tally. Other new entries this week include, at number 35, Real Life by Bon Jovi (Reprise). The song, taken from a TV ad. soundtrack, gets a life in the U.K. and the G/S/A countries. And at 49, Poland and the U.K. are being sweet to Billie's Honey To The Bee (Innocent/Virgin). One place lower, Irish girl band B\*Witched Blame It On The Weatherman (Glow Worm/Epic) that only programmers in the U.K. and Ireland are playing



# Ulterior motive for CSA quota raps?

PARIS — French radio industry insiders are suspecting broadcasting authority the CSA of dual motives in its March 23 issuing of formal warnings to eight radio stations, requesting them to respect the 40 percent Frenchlanguage music quotas law.

The eight broadcasters concerned are national networks NRJ (CHR) Fun Radio (CHR), Europe 2 (AC) and five local stations—Oui FM/Paris (rock), Top Music/Strasbourg (CHR), Vibration/Orléans (CHR/dance), Vitamine/Toulon (full-service) and Contact FM/Tourcoing (dance).

Stations believe the suprise official warnings have been issued to prevent them prematurely adopting the CSA's plans for "softer" quotas, which have been proposed by the CSA to the French government. But they also suspect that the regulator is using the warnings to increase the pressure on the government to consider its proposals.

The CSA's detailed proposals for quota reform were presented last January to culture and communications minister Catherine Trautmann, and have been lying on the ministry's desk ever since. "We have had no answer from the minister and we know that it [quotas reform] has not been included in the government's new broadcasting law, which has to be presented to the

minister's council at the end of April," says a CSA source.

Says Oui FM general manager Michael Gentile: "We have always played between 37 and 40 percent [French content]. This CSA warning is their way of saying that during the construction [of the new law] the quotas are still in place and still have to be respected."

Dance outfit Vibration says in a statement that "the only possible interpretation of the CSA's move is that it was to put more pressure on the government to reform the quota law."

Meanwhile, labels' body SNEP and authors' society SACEM are keeping up their lobbying pressure to preserve the existing law. "SNEP doesn't regret this formal warning," says general manager Hervé Rony. "Today the law is the law, and it has to be respected."

Rony regrets that some five years after the parliamentary vote, the airplay requirement relating to new talent and new productions (also part of the quotas law) is still not being enforced. For example, gold-formatted radio stations such as Nostalgie and RFM, which are not playing any new talent at all, have never been censured by the CSA.

"The law is still difficult to apply because we don't have a precise definition of what constitutes a 'new production,' and thus it is impossible to measure them," says the CSA source.

Passing himself off as an aide to the president, RTL reporter Christoph Lemmer managed to get through to the chancellor's office, and was able to obtain Schroeder's mobile telephone number. Lemmer then had an impersonator call Schroeder and pretend to be German president Roman Herzog, asking the chancellor delicate questions about the recent resignation of German finance minister Oskar Lafontaine.

Schroeder told the impersonator of Lafontaine's resignation: "I don't know anything about the reasons or the background because I don't know them. I received his letter of resignation...and have not been able to talk with him because he does not want to talk with me."

Schroeder also told the RTL impersonator that he planned to name Hans Eichel, state premier of Hesse, as Lafontaine's successor—

information which at that point had not officially been made public.

According to both parties, neither Lemmer or the impersonator identified themselves, leawing Schroeder oblivious to the hoax even after the interview had ended.

A presidential spokesman publicly attacked RTL after the stunt had been revealed. "The limits of what journalists should do have been severely violated," he said, adding that legal consequences were "being looked at." Impersonating state officials can be judged a serious crime in Germany, punishable by up to two years in prison or a hefty fine.

The president's office took its complaints about the incident directly to RTL's Luxembourg-based parent company CLT-UFA. Before being suspended, Von zur Muehlen wrote apologies to both the president's office and to the chancellery.

than for Bocelli's previous pop releases. Dutch soft AC station Sky Radio supported Bocelli's *Romanza* album but isn't playing *Canto* "because it is too classical," says Sky Radio music director Frans van Dun.

If he had to pick a track to play from *Sogno*, Van Dun's preference would be for *Nel Cuore Lei*, which features Eros Ramazzotti. But although Van Dun feels that *Cuore* is the "top pop record on the album," Sky will not play the song until it becomes clear whether the track will be released as a single.

Meanwhile, at home, Bocelli's international fame is placing him at the centre of attention. His Italian lead single Sogno, released on March 15, has been featured in the TV advertising campaign for mobile phone operator TIM, and has received extensive support from national music broadcaster Radio Italia Solo Musica Italiana (RISMI). "Bocelli is an important artist for both our radio network and our TV network VISMI," says RISMI spokesman Stefano Seresini, "His mix of classical and pop music appeals to our adult target audience and his international profile fits in with our image.'

Bocelli himself believes he has found his perfect niche with Sogno. "Romanza was the search for a solution," he reveals. "Sogno is that solution." His manager Michele Torpedine observes: "Rather than call Sogno a pop album [...] I would say it is light classical. It is rhythmic, with a drum beat, but remains sufficiently classical."

Torpedine confirms that Bocelli

renegotiated his contract with Italian indie Sugar last year to place a greater emphasis on his development as an operatic tenor. Outside Italy, the artist's pop output is licensed to Universal Music's Dutch Polydor affiliate, and his classical material to Philips Classics.

"Universal knows how important his classical career is to Andrea," says Monica Marin, Universal Music International (UMI) VP marketing international repertoire. "We have to make the most out of his time. Fortunately, Bocelli is an artist who sells himself very well, so the key is to keep him on the road."


By all accounts, Bocelli is happy with the current arrangements. "There is a very dialectic rapport between [Sugar, Polydor and Philips Classics] and it is interesting that it is like that. What counts is that we have worked together since the beginning, and that I have never felt the need to change."

UMI has high hopes for Sogno, and Marin sees room to expand Bocelli's fanbase further, especially in the U.K. and in Asia. A lawyer by profession, Bocelli has no formal training as a classical tenor and started singing as a hobby. Over the past four years, he has turned his hobby into a remarkable success story. But the stunning sales figures for his pop work seemingly fail to distract Bocelli from his dream of becoming a respected opera tenor. At the end of the day, what matters is "that the artist is happy," says Marin philosophically.

those files in a database." IFPI Norway contends that FAST contravenes Norwegian copyright law by allowing access to unauthorised recordings and the unlicensed reproduction of music.

However, the process could be slowed by the nature of the complaint, which is different from the type Norwegian prosecutors usually



deal with. One source at the prosecutor's office in Oslo contends that prosecutors "seldom handle cases regarding immaterial rights," and usually deal with more traditional offences. The source says that Internet-based piracy is simply too small a crime for prosecutors to be interested.

Jason Berman, chairman of the IFPI, contends that Norwegian law offers enough elements to support the case. Saemund Fiskvik, director general of IFPI Norway, says that prosecutors have expressed to him their enthusiasm for tackling the issues the IFPI has raised because of the innovative nature of the prosecution.

According to Berman, when the IFPI and U.S. recording industry body RIAA learned about the Lycos/FAST arrangement, attempts were made to solve the question of illegal recordings through discussions with the search engine operators. "In our meeting, we wanted to figure out a way to do it legally, but it didn't turn out that way," he laments.

Berman adds that after the meeting failed, a decision was made to take legal action, and Norway was the natural place to file a complaint as FAST is incorporated in this country. Berman reveals that action against FAST might be envisaged in the U.S. too. "This is something we're looking at," he says. FAST president/CEO Espen Brodin was travelling in America and was unavailable for comment.

For Berman, FAST's search engine poses a threat to the music industry in that it marks "a qualitative difference" from the traditional Internet piracy schemes. He explains: "In the past, we did go against web sites offering unauthorised material. But this goes beyond what we've seen so far, because it gives a quick and systematic access to MP3 files. There is a qualitative danger in giving [consumers] access to unauthorised recordings."

Geneva-based software developer Audiosoft, which specialises in the electronic distribution of music, is backing the IFPI's action on the grounds that "if artists and consumers want to use the power of MP3 for their own purposes, they must be able to make the difference between files that have been legitimately licensed by copyright owners, and illegitimate files," according to Audiosoft VP copyright affairs Philippe Person.

Person says that the development of illegitimate MP3 files is a threat to the development of a legal MP3 business. "We feel close to [software] companies that can limit their reach to legitimate, licensed and secure files," he comments, implying that FAST is not in that category.

Concludes Person: "Consumers want MP3 files. You can't change the behaviour of consumers—what you need to do is make sure they can only have access to legitimate MP3 files." Additional reporting by Kai R. Lofthus

More controversial on-air antics at German radio...hard on the heels of the ousting of 104.6 RTL/Berlin managing director Bernt von zur Muehlen, following that station's "wind-up" phone call to chancellor Gerhard Schroeder (see front page), comes news that long-serving SWR 3 DJ Elmar Hoerig has been fired by his employers for making offensive remarks about gays on his show HitHop.

Hotline has learnt that French broadcasting authority the CSA will soon be inviting tenders for its airplay monitoring contract, currently held by IPSOS Music. It is understood that the CSA wants more stations to be monitored and for the number of "new productions" played by each station to be counted (see story, page 29). The data is used by the CSA to check that stations are complying with the French airplay quotas law.

Expect the IFPI to release the music industry's worldwide figures for 1998 at a press conference in London on April 29. Hotline hears that BMG International president/CEO Rudi Gassner will be in attendance.

Talking of figures, further proof of the healthy financial state of commercial radio in Europe at the moment....Spanish giant Union Radio, the holding company of SER and Antena 3 Radio, saw its profits increase by 49 percent in 1998, up to Pta4.1 billion (euros 24.5 million). Turnover was up 15 percent to Pta23.5 billion.

Michael Jackson is back in the news-he'll be headlining two charity shows organised by German concert promoter Mama Concerts this summer. The first is scheduled to take place at the Olympic stadium in Seoul, Korea on June 25, while the second is planned for June 27 at Munich's Olympic stadium. Proceeds from ticket sales will be donated to the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund, the Red Cross and UNESCO. The list of artists committed to share the bill with Jackson at either one or both venues includes Luciano Pavarotti, Stevie Wonder, Eros Ramazzotti, the Scorpions and Vanessa Mae.

The 30th anniversary edition of Woodstock will not be coming to Europe after all. The European version of Woodstock '99 was to have taken place near Vienna from July 16-18, but has now been postponed until the summer of 2000 or possibly even 2001. At presstime, the U.S. event was still scheduled to go ahead on July 23-25 in Rome, New York state. Acts which had been set to play at the European Woodstock included Metallica, Iggy Pop and Zucchero.

Popular TMF (The Music Factory) presenter Fabienne is leaving after four years at the Dutch music TV channel. The VJ will appear for the last time on the channel as the presenter of this year's TMF Awards, which will take place in Rotterdam on April 3.

Nominations for the 1999 Sony Radio Awards in the U.K. were being released as M&M was going to press; BBC Radio 1's **Zoe Ball**,

Classic FM's Sarah Lucas and Galaxy 102/Manchester's Adam Cole will do battle for the prestigious best music breakfast show award, while the accolade for best music broadcaster will be an all-BBC affair contested by Mark Lamarr (Radio 2), Bob Harris (Radio 2) and Pete Tong (Radio 1). Bob Geldof's stint at Xfm/London has earned him a nomination in the category for best drivetime music show.






