claim. It lies rather in the sentiment that music is the product of labor. In other words, people learn most about art by doing it. The Negro people in their fife and drum bands have learned to make their own entertainment instead of buying it, and getting it pre-digested and spooned. Other Negroes have paid a price for the luxury of a bought entertainment and art... The Negro people have also paid a price for having to depend upon their own resources. They have been forced into the limitations of art.

That statement, and many others throughout the book, will irritate some of the jazz sociologists who believe that jazz is a game of playing into other's hands, making exactly the statement one would like to make, and that jazz is based upon an inescapable rules of logic. Only rarely does sentiment get the better of him, as, I submit, in the second part of this statement: "It (means) that the statement of hope and struggle for freedom (from slavery). In the young mind of man, it is not hard to find the historical experiences of the American Negro soldiers in the past war. Jim Crow and treated as a second-class citizen, while we know that the war was one for democracy, 'the rights of all people to the four freedoms.' Although you may not be able to know my feelings on the American colour bar, I feel that here the author is merely taking a general view of the world, an examination, and one which—in this particular context—is logically unsupposed. (His dedication to the cause of the freedom of Israel, fighting for independence, though obviously sincere, is significant in this connection.)

Each chapter, "The place of jazz in our history," "The sound of jazz," "The blues and folk song," "Improvisation and jazz forms," "The pop song," and "The large band and the new jazz" is followed by a list of record illustrations complete with personnel names and catalogue numbers.

or "Elektra" is shown by the fact that "Metamorphosen" is the first work that Richard Strauss received a full measure of recognition for since his "Don Quixote." This Elektra, in 94 pages of this score consist of plain straightforward string writing. Effects such as, in concert halls, "Der Rosenkavalier" and "Capriccio" are completely eschewed. Even mutes are not employed, and only now and then can one see the damping or pizzicato. How different, yet one feels that had most decided to follow in Strauss's footsteps he would have robbed the work of its essential nature. If we can estimate, those works of the past beginning roughly with the first half of the century have their share of the lime-light.
