Talking to guitarist Tony Hicks recently I tried to discover the reason, if any, for their clean record

It is very important to have somewhere comfortable to stay on a long tour and we like the best we can afford. "The same thing applies in

other areas where most groups get aggravation - we've never infringed the Customs laws and so they take it easy with us. Quite often we sail straight through. If you treat people politely it is usually returned."






