From flower power to non-stop timeless boogie, Status Quo have kept churning out the hits for 21 years. And that, as Tom Hibbert discovers, means an awful lot of denim and fried breakfasts.

It takes Francis Rossi a good four minutes — and a great deal of straining the turn muscles — to squeeze his frama into his tight, clean blue jeans. Conce he has completed this mammoth take, he calebrates by patting his first on his line, tossing back operatically — a /a comedian Richard Pryor — 'm a MACHO MANI'' And now, suiteby be-denimed, Francis Rossi is prepared for Status Quo's appearance on ITV's Cannon And Ball TV show.

Soon, down in Studio One at London Weekend Television, Cannon and Ball are rehearsing their intro routine with the group. Onto the stage bounds little Tommy Ball with an obligatory "Rock on, Tommy!" Then, spying the group behind him, he says: "Oh. 1968 — Status Quo getting stuck into some really feb Cernaby Street clothing: (left-right) Francis Rossi (guitar), Rick Parfitt (guitar), John Coghlan (drums), Alan Lancaster (bass) and Roy Lynes (keyboards).

'ello!" "That's not the ELO!" quips his partner. "That's Status Quo!" At this point, Rick Parfit is supposed to say something but he cannot remamber what it is. "Rick's not much good at plays," commants Francis. "Tm even worse. That's why they gave him all the lines."

Status Quo's first hit single: "I wrote half of it while the wife was out shopping, and then finished it off in the bog."

A tea breek is called to give Rick time to master his script and thus I'm afforded an opportunity to quiz Francis Rosal about the state of the nation and the Status Quo.

Cannon And Ball, Francis? So you've finally arrivad! "Aya, son. This is the Big Time." Just a little joke, of course, as Status Quo have been a Big Time band almost forever and have notched up some 24 Top Twenty singles and 14 Top Ten albums in Britain in a staggaring 21 - count 'ami -years. It was back in 1962 that a group of South London schoolboys, celling themselves The Spactres, got together to play baat music for fun and profit. The years passed in a blur of youth club dates, seasons at Butlins holiday camps and assorted grisly detes, until, in 1966, they were signed to Piccadilly records who released their first single. The Spectres "I (Who Have Nothing)", a version of a Shirley Bassey hit, makes Francis cringe to his day: "Oooh, it was awfull I just can't imagine what we were thinking of."

After three further flops and two name changes — to Traffic Jam and, finally, Status Guo — the group were just about ready to knock it all on the heed and go and get some proper jobs when Francis wrote a song that was in perfect keeping with tha flower-power/psychodelic pop spirit of 1968.

"By then, everything was supposed to be a bit freaky, maan, with, like, a really deep meaning and so I wrote 'Pictures Of Metchetick Men'. There was this guitar sequence that Jimi Hendrix hed which I liked and so I thought I dr vt or e-write that. I wrote half of It while the wife was out shopping and when she came back, I finished It off in the bog. God knows what it was supposed to be about."

OF BLUES BEARING

Promoted by the group sporting best kaftens from Cernaby Strate and lecquered hair-dos with cantra partings, "Pictures Of Metchstick Men", a swirling, stirring tele of yallow eyes and othar nonsensicel imeges, beceme a huga hit and mede teen idols of Stetus Quo.

Psychadelic feshions didn't lest long, however, end the band were soon aloshing back to grim obscurity, pleying RAF bases and fieling generally stather misarable. Says Rossi.

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





The night is fraezing end moonlit, the eudience pale end clad in black. Young 'long mac' intellectuels are cesuelly gethered around the stage which is piled high with TV monitors end four large video screens. Vision is just as importent es sound et a Cebaret Voltaire event.

The set opens with e collection of videos under the general title of "Doublevision", the Cabe' own video "company" which provides an outlet for their own creations and that of other film and video mekers. The programme Includes e piece on a loony American sculptor who specializes in meking "Organic Robots", e film ebout a discontented German and the infermous American "Beat Generation" "Soe poet Williem Burroughs whose melevolent mutterings heve long fescinated and influenced Cebaret Volteire. Following that were a few of the Cebs' own video experiments which concluded the "Doublevision" presentation. The real Doublevieion was about to begin

Seeing Ceberet Voltaire is like having e confusing dream. They slink on stege, berely lit, so thet your eyes ere unavoidably ettrected to the jumble of images on the screens bahind them. Their visuals ere stunning. All this is topped by the Cabs' hypnotic, strongly rhythmic noise that weaves a rich pattern ground the gray cells and, dence-wise, could knock eny computerised disco outfit off its microchla pedestel before you could say The Human League. Layers of sound es thick as pea soup squeek end boom while frontmen Stephen Mallinder chants into e microphone. It's a weird, intoxiceting combination

Look out for the sherp end subtle dence ngla "Yesher" for e teste of Cabaret single Volteire's best. It could get them on Top Of The Pope yet. Just fescineting. Cleire Sheeff


