The first thing you note, as Slade take the stega to the visuel eccompeniment of wisps of smoke end a pair of

rather feeble fireworks, is how sensible the cheps look. Beck in 1973, when their boot-stomping glitter-pop dominated the cherts, Siede's stege weer bordered on the ebsurd. Deve Hill clumped ground on ridiculously lofty pletform heels with sperkle on his chaeks end e ramerkebly silly heircut while Noddy Holder fevoured ill-fitting, garish tarten suits end bettered top hets festooned with mirror discs. Tonight, however, the eccentric gerb is limited to e refined lady's hat for Noddy end a mildly rekish topper, with feether, for Deve - and both itams of haedwaer ere soon removed

The second thing you note, as Slede begin to play, is a merked ebsence of the warm-hearted, boozy-binge style of old. For, wary of ending up on the medley-of-hits ceberet circuit, the bend gloss over pest glories end opt insteed for a heavy metal approach This is a frightful misteke.

For 45 minutes, we are subjected to essorted HM stunts strobe lights, bess solos, drum solos, bludgeoning 'riffs' performed etop speeker cebinets and other rebble-rousin guiter entics. Apert from the bend's 1972 smesh, "Gudbuy T Jene" (and even this is reduced to a boogle blur), there are ebsolutely no enticing songs; the only change in pace comes when the group unlessh "My Oh My", that dreedful swey-elong anthem (reminiscent of Rod Stewert's horrid old chestnut, "Sailing") which hes just givan them their first Top Ten hit for eight yeers. (Fact: Slade have now notched up fourteen Top

Tenners: tonight they perform only four).

It is not until the obligetory encores that Slede ecknowledge their history. "Meme Weer All Crezee Now" is punctuated by much throwing of levatory paper, Noddy dons e Sente sult to bellow "Merry Xmes Everybody", averybody hes e bit of e 'knees-up' end goes home heppy. Conclusion: dull heavy metel is no substitute for "Cum On Feel The Noise" end other clomping fevourites of yesteryear. My Oh My indeed. Tom Hibbert


