As testefully garbed as ever



Queen used to prance about in glitter suits (in '74) and people loved them. They used to dress up in leather and chains (in '80) and people adored them. Now they're flying around in spaceships and people simply cannot get enough of them. Tom Hibbert looks at their past and present.

In April 1974 a stunningly flashy single called "Seven Seas Of Rhye", by an unknown group celled Queen, slipped into tha Top Tan. A decade later, back with "Radio Ga", they're still international celebrities with their extravagant music and polished style. "I always knew I was a star," Marcury once confessed. "And tha rest of the world seems to agree with ma."

Queen's guiterist, Brien May, was born in July 1947 and studied infra-red astronomy (whetever thet might be) et London's Imperial College, Hare he met Rogar Meddows-Teylor (born in July 1949), e biology student who played the drums, and In 1967 the pair taamed up to form a group called Smile. Pleying a stoday brend of prograssive rock, with lots of extended guiter solos, they only meneged to impress a few hippie students in Afghen coets end eventually split up in 1970. But not before the bess pleyer had introduced May end Taylor to his flatmate, a bizarre cherecter who prenced eround in geudy, flamboyant togs end called himself Freddie Mercury. His real neme was togs end called himself Freddle Mercury, His relatere was Frederick Buisser and he had been born in 2 carbiber in September 1948. He had attended school in Bombey, had been student bands Wirch kage and Schwilla Sei, he had been on stoge end condemned them as "rubbish". What the world needed, he told May and Takyo, was a group that blands d'be heavy rock of Led Zeppelin with progressive complexity end a striking "glem" image. The group would be celled Queen — end Mercury would be its singer. Mey end Teylor thought they might as well give it a go.

In 1971, the Queen line-up was complated with bassist John Deacon (who had a First Class Honours degree in electronics) and the band began developing their style carefully behind closed doors, eventually securing a contract with EMI. By mid-1973, they had en elbum, "Queen", end a single. "Keep Yourself Alive", reedy for release. In addition, Marcury had recorded en intensely silly version of the Beach Boys' Heer Music" under the name Lerry Lurex in e misguided attampt to send up Gary Glitter and othar glem popsters of the dey. Lurex's little joke fell absolutely flat and Queen's debut releases fered little better. Mercury's mish-meah of established rock styles was beginning to seem like not quita such e good idee after eli — "a laughebly bizerre mish-mesh of every other more successful band of thair genre" as one critic wes moved to remerk et tha time

But at the next ettempt, Queen were to prove such critics wrong. "Seven Seas Of Rhye" was just tha ticket end in Merci 1974, the band meda their first Top Of The Pops eppearance elongside such imparishable groovers as Lene Zeveroni, Peper Leca end The Wombles, In April, et e date at Stirling University, the crowd rioted when Queen refused to take tha stege for e fourth encore. Thet seme month, e second album, "Queen II", reached Number 5 in the LP charts. Queen were in tha counting house and when the next single, the glossy and sophisticated "Killer Queen", became a Number 2 smash, they bagan counting the money in earnest. In 1975, the operatic "Bohemian Rhepsody" spent nine

weeks at the top of the charts, the first record in pop history that successfully used the idea of tha promotional video." A Night At The Opere", et the time reputed to be the most expansively-producad album ever, sold millions and throughout the year — and the rest of the decede — Queen seduced eudiences around the world with lavish, spectacules stege shows in which such thrilling effects as smoke bombs, thunderflashes, frenetic lights, huge hovering crowns and Ster Wers-styled invesions pleyed second fiddle to Freddie Mercury's meny costume changes. Drassed as a clown or a ther-boy, in e kimono or e saquin-encrusted jump-suit, he build strut the stega, bering his chest, toasting his fens with empegne and hogging the spotlight with unebeshed glea

Ovar the yeers, Queen were to move eway from their initial Over the yeers, Queen were to move eway from their initial sound of multi-tracked harmonias to teckle e renge of diffarin styles. On 1978's vulger "Fat Bottomed Girls", they went for a no-nonsense, footbell terrace thumping approach; the following year, on "Grazy Little Thing Celled Love", thay transformed themselves into Shekin "Stevens with a slice of '50s-styled rockebilly; in 1980, they ceme up with some gritty disco-funk on "Another One Bites The Dust" (a song later evagues as the settle nymm of Americe's Detroit Lions football teem end appellingly perceided by US funste Werd AI Arenkovic on "Another Che Rides The Buy" — tee heel, And then Queen orgoups as dreadly. In bary old dinoxars, by collaborating with uitre-trendy David Bowe on "Under Pressure". And now they's pack egain with "Redio GE Ge". Freddle Mercury hes shorn his heir, sprouted a macho-man moustable end continues to spanch his call on Unithest from the Chem. edopted as the bettle hymn of Americe's Detroit Lions footbell

end continues to spend his cash on trinkets from the Grient, Roger Teylor keeps turning up on *Pop Quize* and making a monkey out of people like Limah with his superior knowledge of amering pop facts, and May and Decon remain in the beckground tinkering eround in the studio. Ten yeers on, with 22 ht singles end 12 best-selling LPs behind them, Queensem ebout as likely to give up their throne es their nemesches — you know, the one with all the corgis.

He smiles: "Perhaps I've just had excessive training in recent weeks."

Over the intervening years, MorrisSey exed out a lite on the dole, did "sporadic bits of journalism" for pop papers and wrote two books. The first one was about "Sb film star James Dean, the other about New York glam rock group The New York Dolls. He sighs wearily when I marging it?

"I thought that one had been well and truly buried. Five years ago I would have lain on the tracks for them. Now I could never *possibly* listen to one of their records."

These ventures aside, Morrissey was "winning very quickly and preparing for the next world" by the time he met up with guitarist Johnny Narr. Legend has it that Marr came up and pressed his nose azainst Morrissev's window. "Quite literally. It left a terrible smudge. I thin he'd been eating chocolate or something. He seemed terribly sure of what he wanted to do, which I liked. He said 'let's do it and do it now'. So we did it. Then."

Hits and Myths

What they did was write songs. This was in May 1982. By December, they'd written enough and Marr went out and recruited drummer Mike Joyce and bassist Andy Rourke. They then "dound it very easy" to get on the bill at "serious venues, like the Hacienda, where we would get a certain amount of attention".

This takes us up to March '33, whereupon Rough Trade agreed to release their first single-"fland in Glove". Initially a one-single deal, it was immediately expanded to a proper contract when the record gathered unanimously rave reviews and Jogked itself in the independent charts, where if has remained ever since. Then came "This Charming Man", a bit in the "groupe chart". "And it should have been a bigger one," Morrisey reflects.

Was he surprised at the speed of their success? "No. That would imply I didn't have a great deal of confidence."

And nobody could accuse this chap of not having bags of confidence. Enough, say, to turn down a tour with The Police last year.

"We just didn't want to be associated with them, which sounds quite brutal but we'd come a long way, nobody had helped, and we didn't want anyone like The Police to feel they had a hand in helping us."

Meanwhile, they're just embarked on a seven-week tour of their own — all in Britain. They also have a second hit, a debut IP due to appear any muite and a forthcoming single they're made with '60s singer Sandle Shaw. The result of the union, a single called ''I Don't Owe You Anything'', will be out on Rough Tradu soon.

We chat a little about Morrissey's lyrics, which leads on to The Message of The Smiths. They have one:

"That people should discard any nomine or in-ness or hip-ness or coolness and simply relax and be themselves, whatever that may be. Ninety per cent of immediate daily anxieties are futile worries."

In all this, Morrissey believes in "the art of demonstration" and began making the point, and making a name for The Smiths, by doing, something considered very uncool indeed: showering, their audiences with daffs and gladioli. They're stopped now, though not out o consideration for hay fever sufferers:

"Mainly because people were beginning to associate us with flowers rather than music." People ask me if i'm worried about prake, "he adds, "which is like saying, aren't you worried that your wages are too high this week? Ludicrous. Imagine going up to your boss and saying: "there's too much in my wage packet."

"I'd rather be known for all those things that for being spotty and smelly and overweight."


