

So Nick and Simon (sans Roger who's not really 'Inio' these filmic farks) are busy doing the obligatory arty promo vid... Time, one thinks, for the obligatory "probing" Smash Hits Q&A...

Simon is interviewed sitting on a throne borrowed from the video set at 10.30 pm. . Nick is interviewed over breakfast (freshly squeezed orange juice and curly bits of sparm with a sort of cheesy crust on top) the following day...

Ttch Tttch! This isn't how it's supposed to ba at all. Hera are HM tarrors Iron Maiden and thay're just sitting in front of ma being vary polita and really rether nice. That's right no dastruction, cheos or mayher in sight, no smashed windows, no biting the heads off live pigeons in fact just about none of the things heavy metal groups are femous for. Instaad they'ra quiatly sipping thair coffaa (pathetic, isn't it? Not even a thimbleful of rock 'n' roll mouthwash in sight) and the only real incident to speak of has been caused by drummer Nicko's two year old son who's just rather inconvaniently wat his pants. Come on, Where's all the throwing-TVs-out-of-hotalwindows-stuff?

"I think I leff tha tap on in e hotal once," apologises Dave. Well, that's not much good.

"I slammed a door," offers Adrian. Thet's useless. Surely one of

tham must have at least caused an itsy-bitsy riot on their recent tour?

"People think that because you're in a tearaway rock 'n' roll band you're going to be disraspectful all tha time," explains Nicko. "Though ws do occasionally do things when it gets on top of us."

At last Let ma guess! Driving Rolls Royces into swimming pools? Throwing members of namby-pamby pop groups ovar clifts?

"I walked into ons hotel room and it was just anothar Holiday Ann and I was sick of them all looking the same and living out of e suitcase so I turned round and picked up this trey and hurled it at the wall. There was jam and butter and tomato ketchup all over the wellpaper."

Well, that's a bit mora lika it. Raelly anjoyed it, did he?

"I felt raisly good, yeah," he agrees, "I felt 1'd got something back at the domining. But then I thought it's not hurt the hotal, it's not hurt their wall, it's just hurt ma – I'm going to have to pay for a couple of broken cups and some new walkpager. And so then I thought 'why did I do thet? It was a bit studie wan't it?"

Hmmmmph. Not guita what I expected but then it saems iron Maiden really aran't vary like their public imaga at all. "People think wa're long-haired ioonias, drugcrazed hippias making this mad music, don't they?" laughs Nicko. And it's not true. I mean, since when did nasty long-haired loonias have a bit of a sob when littla puppies are strangled by avil tramps in films like Lassia - "I can't watch things like that," says Bruce. \*I go all misty-eyed and I heve to leave the room" - or say that the things thay miss about England when they'ra away on

tour are roast beef and Yorkshire Pudding, cups of "Rosie lee" ("nectar to my chops," gushes Nicko), Heinz Baked Baans, HP sauce and "e pint of bitter with me matas"?

It gate worse. They even guile like lots of groups who wouldn't be seen diaad mumbiling enice word about then Makian. Howard Jones writes "neally good songs' how the site work and is only let down by his "lifty baarat". Whanh elso write "good songs' though understandaby they say they goils, lastrion, harcrate, good books" – and Madorma is a "drity own" which, believe It or not, is some rather hordis kind of compliment.

"A lot of paople gat the idea, says Bruce, "that heavy matal groups would like to sae avary other group that doesn't play heavy metal wiped off the face of the earth. That's just not true."

Still, they all hiss and make rather rude nosies when I esk if they'll ever gait hair hair out and look like other groups, and look positively skik at the thought of even sitting next to sometne wearing some trendy designer clothes.

"If's sily, isn't it?" asks Bruca. "To pay all that money for something which you can gat perfacily wall from Millets which will be warmer and last longar anyway." They don't mind larking out on tatioos, though. Steva, Nicko and Dave have all got drawings on their skin which will be thana forever, although Adnan edamantly rafusas: 'I don't want to look dow at my chast whan I'm 4 PARTY ANIMAL'!'

Swaz, Wa'va been chatting for over an hour and there's still no sign of eny of Iron Maidan doing anything oven the slightlast bit outrageous. Parhaps ther's because they'va always latt the scary nasty sids of Iron Maiden to Edde – tha gruasome and rather yukky monstar who's on neerly all their record sizewes and who totters out to scare the audience during live stows.

"He was organely called Edde The Ead, asys Silve, thriding back to the mid 726 whan aarly vanish of it how Middle used to play week-after-week in dryg London pubs. "One of the first argens we had, before we want pro, used to wear made and ball activity on with the maks on of a backdrop. Then we did a mould from some ugly face and had blood coming out of the mould end ligot more and more outrageous."

Recantly, Eddle has been killed (onstage in Dortmund, Garmany,) preserved as an ancient Egyptian mummy (on the "Powerslava" LP and lour) and now, on their new double live LP. "Live After Deah", he's seen bursting out of his tomb, reborn. Eddie is useful to the bard, because instead of them geting a new image and set of clothes for each alburn, they can stay in their fraying yeans and faded T-shirts and change Eddie instead.

"We could do anything we wanted to with him," says Bruce. "We could expose him to ridicule, dress him up in woman's clothing."

But sn't he a bit hornfic, a bit nasty, a bit evr? "Naah," insets Brue." II you're shocked by Eddie then you shouldn't go and see Jack And The Branstalk in case the giant corrupts you permanently. Eddie's mekoframabally evil – he's so nasty that he's not very threatening."

In fact, Bruce says Iron Maiden are completely opposed to people like Ozzy Osbourne who supposedly bites heads off bats and explodes pigeons into smithereens. "Biting the heads off bats?" he says, looking a bit queasy, "No, that's something we would not do. That whole thing finging raw meat about and stuff - is just a bit too realistic." Whereas Iron Maiden songs are ebout "transporting people into their own imaginations, trying to create fantasies with our sonos Fantasies? "Well, you can get on your high horse about changing the world, but at the end of the day il you're not entertaining people they won't listen to what you're saying anyway." They do believe in doing things like donating all the royalties from the current single to the Anti-Heroin campaign. "People often mention heavy metal bands in the same breath as drug abuse," explains Bruce, "and they assume that we condone it. We wouldn't like to be seen as encouraging it by not doing something about it. It's important thet there's no confusion at all."

"Mmmmmmm. . ." Everyone else has gone, leaving Bruce to change out of his stage clothes (he wears - gasp! - nothing under those slinky trousers, in case you wondered) and musing about "life on the road". Like all of the group except Adrian, he's married but at the moment he's reflecting on all the temptations that come his way from overeager fans. "Um. . .there's people in rock 'n' roll who are probably quite sauntly and capable of penods of tremendous abstinence." he says, "but I find it hard to even ebstain from eating chocolate buttons. After a couple of weeks of being surrounded by women it's going to be a very. very strong man who's not going to be able to give into the

This all sounds a bit more "wild rock 'n' roll band"ish but doesn't his wife get a bit peeved? Apparently not.

"My wife accepts that I'm not a monk," he says. "She knew that when she married me." Bet she didn't know about his um, strange dreams, though.

"I had this dream recently," he reveals, "where I had the ability

Io thy but only about to ur feet above the ground and as long as I did the breaststroke. It be going down the road talking to people and then 1'd say 'just going for a fly' and disappeer. I went back to visit my old school, flew over the swimming baths, past the chemistry labs and then pt my teet on the ground. Suddenly I realised I couldn't fly erymore."

How bizarre. Does he ever think he's going bonkers?

"I think I probably am already. I do tend to voice some outlandish theories occasionally, just sort of 'what it?"

What if what?

"Like the possibility of putting roof gardens on every flat surface in London to improve the general appearance. Naturally that wouldn't just include bunklings, ifd include the roots of motor vehicles as well. The whole place would be green again, ifd create loss of jobs planting them and looking after them and the whole place would look nice. Wouldn't it?"




