



ATTENTION ALL BROS FANS!!!




She claims that her weight "changes constantly" and that she stands at 163cm, which means she's exactly the same height as Madonna.

Matt orders two large Oranginas and declares it to be his favourite drink at the moment. Luke, on the other hand, orders a rather more manly double scotch and coke because he's such a mean rockin' dude and all that. The Bros Brothers, as you will probably have noticed by now, dear viewing folk, may be identical twins but they can be like the proverbial chalk and cheese.

"Hmmmm... we are very different, which shocks quite a few people," muses Matt. Luke

agrees.

"It's weird, I think people sometimes see twins as a bit of a mystery really – they expect you to be like the same person – to think the same and agree on everything. So they're shocked if we argue."

Matt looks horrified at the suggestion that they argue but concedes, "People do say we fight like cat and dog but that we'd always be the first to stick up for each other if we were arguing with anyone else and it's true!"

Luke getting a bit embarrassed –
which is a fine thing considering

"People fascinate me," he leans over and whispers confidentially behind his hand: "That's a weird set-up going on there. I wish I could just go over and ask them what they're playing at – you know, what makes them tick."

Right. Well, Matt and Luke Goss are, as you can clearly see, not in the mood for doing a formal interview this warm and dusty eve. This is one of the rare moments in their whirlwind lifestyle where they are in relax mode - and so they should be. They're both looking incredibly tanned and healthy, their super new LP is in the so-called "can" (i.e. pop terminology meaning it's finished) and now they're looking forward to headlining one of the most amazing gigs ever - The Bros In 2 Summer concert - at Wembley Stadium. And to top it all, their current single "Too Much" is selling like hot cakes!

"Yes, it's a tough old life," smiles Matt, snatching a complimentary bowl of mixed nuts from Luke.

"Yeah, bloody dreadful," jokes Luke snatching them back again.

"Luke, if you eat all the cashew nuts I'll kill you," Matt grumbles playfully.

"Yeah, yeah, yeah, keep cool bruv, keep cool. I won't eat all your cashew nuts – Matt likes his nuts you know!"

Matt, however, has already set his sights on another plate of nibbles. It's the olives that come in for a bashing this time.

"Look," he says with a crafty glint in his eye, holding up a particularly withered one and dangling it in Luke's face just to annoy him a bit more. "Shall I be a star and complain about this olive? Hahahahaa!!"

"Oh, shove off!" parps Luke in his usual no-nonsense way. "You wouldn't even know what an olive is supposed to look like anyway. For all you know that might be a perfect specimen!"

"Well, that's told me," puffs Matt in a pretend huff. "See how horrible he is?"

THE LARKING ABOUT. . .

Luke: "One thing we do is never act our age! Especially if someone tells us to. I mean, what does it mean, 'act your age'? I hate it when people say be mature. To us, being immature is another way of saying you've got a sense of humour."

Matt: "Maturity is just an excuse for being boring. I don't think that word should exist. We wanna have a good time."

THE TERRIBLE IRONY.

Luke: "As we said before when we were talking about the video, being famous has its ironies really. When the last world tour ended this is exactly what happened: We came off stage, we all flew home and Matt went to his house, but I didn't have a house at the time so'l went to a hotel room on me Jack Jones (i.e. Cockney slang for being on your own). I said goodbye and thanks to my bodyguard Johnny and shut the door and suddenly I realised that I was totally alone. I thought, 'I can't believe this. One minute I was on tour with a load of people, the next minute I'm not.' I was really upset."

Matt: "On tour you get a sheet

Matt: "On tour you get a sheet of paper put under your door every morning telling you what the agenda is for the day and every day is filled with pressing things to do. Suddenly you're home and there's no bit of paper, and your house is so silent that it's too loud."

• THE WEIRDNESS. .

Matt: "It is weird. I'm going through a lot of changes, insecurities, fears, and I have no one to talk to about it. I can tell Luke and my manager and that, but other people say 'Yeah, yeah, we understand Matt', but I think it would be nice if someone would actually say to you, 'Well come here and I'll take you out for the night.' Why don't they? Well, people might think I'm a star and so I'm unapproachable. It could be that. But I'm not - and you can tell people that. You're sitting here next to me now and I'm approachable, aren't I?" Luke: "People just don't seem to want to believe that we're perfectly friendly people. People expect you to act like stars. Sometimes I think they're disappointed when you don't!"

THE INTERFERING WITH YOUR "PRIVATE" LIFE. . .

Matt: "In a way it's quite nice to know that people are interested in your private life but at the same time it's a very private thing. You know how they were saying I'm gay and all that? Well everyone thought that because I didn't immediately deny it I was gay. But I genuinely feel that it really is nobody's business. I shouldn't be forced to comment on my sexuality but I don't mind telling Smash Hits that I'm not gay because you've got a different attitude from the tabloids

Luke: "It's pretty obvious who I'm going out with. I find it very boring to have to keep justifying my love life when I'm doing what's natural. And I don't want to talk about it any more."

Luke: "I think there's always this doubt in people's minds that we're not talented. But I think this will prove that we can play. I was really pleased that there was that bit in The Hits about how Mike Rutherford (of Mike And The Mechanics) asked me to drum on his album. I read it and thought, 'Yeah, that's brilliant!' because people have this idea that we're totally talentless which is so bloody annoying."

SAVING THE DOLPHIN...

Luke: "One of my treats is McDonald's. I love McDonald's." Matt (looking absolutely horrified): He eats McDonald's. I wouldn't touch them. I don't eat them because when the cartons are disposed of they burn them and the chemical it gives off destroys the ozone layer. And thousands of acres of essential rain forests are being destroyed so that they can provide grazing land for all the cows that go to make McDonald's hamburgers. It's destroying our world (he's on his high horse now, viewers, and there's no stopping him!). I've given up tuna fish. Did you know that dolphins swim above tuna fish in the sea so when they catch the tuna they catch the dolphins too and they all die? I've swum with dolphins and they're beautiful creatures. I'm never eating tuna fish again. (Suddenly Matt catches sight of something through the window.)

HAVING TO GRAFT FOR A LIVING!


Luke: "Generally I work very hard while Matt tops up his tan." Matt (incredulously): Hah! I don't think so Luke!



Luke: "Sometimes people don't realise that we do actually have a job to do, and although it's better than any other job I can think of it's still hard work."

THE STRANGENESS OF IT ALL. . .

Luke: "Sometimes you feel a bit strange or lonely but as long as you can tell yourself why you're feeling strange and unsafe it helps you deal with it a lot better. At first you think, 'Why am I feeling like this?' and you don't know how to deal with it. After two years you start to understand yourself and why you're feeling ratty. Like if I get in a bad mood I start to think, 'Why am I doing this?' Or if he gets in a bad mood and, say, has a go at me for example, I used to think, 'Why is he doing that to me?' But now you get over it because you understand why the other person is doing it. Matt: "I think you start to understand yourself.'







LOVE AND KISSES...DANNII

Smash Hits has taken a close interest in Dannii Minoque for a long time now - not strange when you consider she's one of Australia's most popular performers, but remarkable when you consider that she's never had a hit single - in fact, she's never released a record of her own at all! That's why it's such great news to us and to all Dannii fans that, yes, she finally has a record - and it's a complete smash hit!!! David Nichols talks with Dannii about life, art and "dance floor credibility" as if there was such a thing. Pictures are by Tony Lyon.

xcited? No, Dannii Minogue is more than excited by the new turns her career is taking. She's just come from New York, New York and she's simply bursting with the news...her new single is on its way and it's brilliant!

"I'm really happy with all the songs I recorded," she woodles. "One of the songs I even wrote the lyrics to, that's the first bit of songwriting I've ever done, it's called 'It's a Party Jam'. The other songs I recorded were called 'Work', 'Just Can't Forget' and 'Love and Kisses'. They'll all be on the album, and the producers will fly out here to finish the album off in a month or two.

"The music's really black and funky, and the producers were just great. I know it took a long time but we put it off till we found the right people to work with - because everyone's expecting such a lot from me. I'm

glad we waited, it's been

really worth it." The trip to New York was a complete thrill for Dannii, who went accompanied by a representative from her record company - and it did her the world of good, too, because now she looks even better than ever before!

conscious image change? "Oh no - it just happened! I like to change my look a lot when I can," she explains. "When I was in New York I did extensive shopping and I picked out some great outfits for the film clip and at the time I was thinking 'OK, what's the image I'm looking for, what should I buy, what's the song

"But I loved New York, and I really can't wait to get back. It's really happening and upvibe and everyone's positive and kids tend to feel more free about expressing themselves, the way they look and speak...everyone does what they want,

There's a few obvious sorts of questions that I really just don't want to ask Dannii Minogue as she delicately hoes into her rosetta roll in a swingin' (?) Sydney cafe just near the Smash Hits offices. Like, for instance, is she just copying Kylie? Is she scared people will think she's daggy because of her longtime association with Young Talent Time? You know, those irritating questions that she gets asked all the time and hates hearing again and again. But on the other hand, we want to know the answers, so...why not!

"Well," she careens, "What I'm doing is so different to what Kylie's doing, there's no comparison - that's the way my career's going, and that's the style I was heading for. But then, if I'd wanted to go the way she was heading, I wouldn't - people would criticise

It's true that Dannii is very worried about her detractors. She's even dropped her surname! "I guess I just did it so people can see me as me and not as Kylie's little sister. It's more of an impact name, just 'Dannii!'. I mean 'Kylie Minogue' - that name just rolls off the tongue. Dannii Minogue - it's like being one of the Jacksons, they have a hard time living up to the family name after what Michael's done.

f course Dannii's as excited as hell about her new record, as we already said - but then, you might think it was a bit old hat to her now - after all, she's sung hundreds of songs on TV, she's made records with YTT before...she's done it all!

"Yeah, I did two YTT records, I think," she says nonchalantly. "They were done really quick - like, just putting down a song someone else had already done before - it's not nearly as exciting as doing something completely new! It's much better doing my

There's a certain tenseness in the air, too, though. "It's either going to go well, or people are just going to say 'Oh, that's Kylie's sister' - and not even listen to it. I'm really nervous

and I think that gets the adrenalin going.

"I think whatever you do after you leave YTT you still carry round that label with you. No matter what you do, there's always going to be people who'll say 'Oh that girl from Young Talent Time' - though hopefully they

can see it's something new.

It seems odd now, (especially to young people who dream about becoming famous) but once our Dannii was just a normal little kid with big hopes. "I've always been performing," she recalls. "I never thought it would ever happen though, it was like a dream. God! When I was little I never could have imagined myself releasing a single. Or being on television - wow!"

hich brings us to something we haven't even touched on yet - the other part of Dannii's new career moves that's every bit as exciting as her record - her role as "punky" Emma Jackson in the wondrous soapie Home and Away. Dannii's glad she's been cast as someone so completely different to herself: "I love character roles, something that gives me a challenge. It's going to be fun - and a lot of hard work, too.

It will be a lot of hard work, combining a singing and an acting career - "Yeah, people say 'How are you going to cope?' and...! really don't know! But I should be on top of the world because I've got so much work there's not that much around at the moment. So being able to go ahead with all the careers I want to do...oh, I nearly forgot the fashion label, too! Um...I'm really lucky and excited and hopefully I can keep it up...though it's going to be really draining on my energy and I'll probably have a nervous breakdown!!!"

he's just joking, of course, but remember that in addition to the strain of working like a plough horse Dannii had to move to Sydney to work on Home and Away - the first time she's lived away from home. "So it wasn't just moving interstate, it was moving out of home! I've always been a big Melbourne fan - I always

said I'd *never* live in Sydney, I just liked Melbourne better. Sydney's faster than Melbourne, but Melbourne's more homely. You talk to someone and they know someone and they know someone you know." You might remember last year Dannii told Smash Hits that she couldn't imagine living away from home. Partly it was just because she didn't have any time to do her own housework! But also because the ties that bind the Minogue family are very close

ones - and not at all like the usual "showbiz" family.
According to Dannii, "I think the thing was that our parents were really good, and ever since I can remember they let us make our own decisions. I guess Kylie and I knew from a very early age what we wanted to do and we've taken everything from there and Mum and Dad have supported us all the way!"

And Minogue fans everywhere should be glad that they have!





PRINCE - IS HE REALLY A BIT BATTY?

Apart from having his name on the credits of the Batman movie for doing "songs" (and appearing in the thing for all of a split second), Prince is really a quite enigmatic, complex, mysterious, mystifying and puzzling creature. (Phew! Did you get all that!?!!) But don't you often find yourself asking the question "Geez, I wish I knew more about this Prince fellow?" Well, it's Smash Hits to your rescue, with a mindboggling amount of fascinating facts about the man who would be king...except he's Prince instead!!!

Prince was born on June 7, 1958 in Minneapolis (which makes him a 31-year-old Gemini). His father, John L. Nelson, played in a band called The Prince Rodgers Band (hence Prince's name) and his mother Mattie was a singer with them until she married his dad.

* Without his platform boots, Prince stands at a measly 155cm (which is awfully tiny!)

Prince's first album was called "For You" on which he plays 27 different instruments. The album has been described as "earnest, uptight, over-sexed and struggling hard to sound grown-up."

* He doesn't give interviews at all.

Prince's moustache is sometimes referred to as "bum fluff". (How did this one get in? - Concerned Ed.)

* Prince likes to disguise the fact that he writes and produces material for various people. Recently he wrote two tracks on the Sheena Easton album, "The Lover In Me" and credited them to Joey Coco. He's also finished working with soul singer Mavis Staples on an album which is called "Time Waits For No One".

He won an Academy
Award for Best Original
Song Score for Purple
Rain. That album went on to sell
some 12 million copies!

* Prince's parents separated when he was seven and his mother remarried a man called Haywood Baker whom Prince hated.

His first band, when he was 12, was called Grand Central and also contained a fellow called Andre Cymone who is now producer and writer

for Jody Watley. He moved into Andre's parents house when he was 13 but eventually had to move into the basement because he couldn't put up with Andre's sloppiness!

* Prince has nine brothers and sisters of one sort or another. There's Duane, an older halfbrother from his dad's relationship before he

married Mattie, his one true sister Tyka (who released her own album in 1988 which failed miserably), a younger half-brother Omar from Mattie's second marriage as well as two step-siblings from Haywood's previous marriage and, finally, four more step or half siblings from his father's second marriage.

His second band was called Shampagne which he formed while still at high school.

* The first time he tried to get a recording contract he failed because, according to him, "I was writing things that a cat with ten albums would have out, like seven-minute laments that were, y'know, gone. I wrote like I was rich, like I had been everywhere and seen everything and been with every woman in the world."

Rumour has it that
Prince's first recording
contract was worth \$1
million, which was at the time the
most expensive contract ever
offered to an unknown artist.

* At a concert at the Los Angeles Colosseum when he opened for The Rolling Stones, Prince was booed off the stage.

His favourite colour is purple, naturellement!

* The movie Purple Rain

was shot in seven weeks for a budget of \$7 million and grossed that same amount in the first three days of release. His second movie was **Under The** Cherry Moon which featured Prince as Christopher Tracy. It was set in Paris in the 1920s and was filmed in

very stylish black and white. It was, however, a colossal flop.

Prince's third foray into cinema was a concert movie filmed on his Sign O The Times concerts of 1987. It also featured some "fantasy sequences" which were mainly acted out by Prince and his lookalike dancer/protege Cat.

* Prince on why he used to wear underwear on stage: "The decision was left up to me and when I thought about what I was most comfortable in, it's what I sleep in...I just can't stand clothes." Prince proved this point immeasureably when he posed naked, although hiding his "rude bits", on the cover of 1988's "Lovesexy" album.

Prince's recording label is called Paisley Park - after the hit single from his "Around The World In A Day" LP of 1985.

* Prince's infamous
"Black" album was never
released because:
(choose the option you
like best) it was all a
publicity stunt, it wasn't
very good, Prince wanted
to get the "Lovesexy" LP
out instead, he didn't like
the colour black! Copies of
the album now fetch up to
\$200!!!

Prince employed a new manager on January 3rd of this year, Albert Magnoli, who was also the director of Purple Rain.

* Prince is currently considering two movie scripts - Graffiti Bridge, an urban musical to be shot partly on Paisley Park's soundstage and partly at various city locations, and another called The Dawn.

At the time of the release of Prince's "Batman" album, a 10 metre projected bat signal was shone onto Prince's Paisley Park studios. The building also has a huge vault which is protected by a 20cm thick door which houses all of Prince's unreleased tapes.

* The producers of Batman claim that
"Prince's energy,
movements - his whole
persona, reminded us of
the character that was
being created on screen."
Prince wrote the nine
songs for his "Batman"
album in two weeks. On the
album, Prince takes on the
personas of The Joker,
Vicki Vale, Bruce Wayne
and Batman as well as the
character that Prince
created called Gemini.

Prince is a complete genius!

THE INS AND OUTS OF RICHARD GRIECOS

He's a hunk. He's a 21
Jump St. hunk. He's a poetry-writing 21
Jump St. hunk and his name is (you guessed it!) Richard Grieco! We know there are four hundred million Richard fans out there dying for more info on the man - so here it is, a special two page feature on the lovely guy himself!

hough he's a relative newcomer to our screens, Richard Grieco's first year on 21 Jump St. has been a remarkable one. He's won a lot of hearts and collected a huge following in his role as Officer Dennis Booker...even though his role was originally only intended to last for six weeks!

At first, Jump St.'s producers intended to "kill off" the character of Dennis Booker after a month and a half. Then, when they realised Richard's talent and popularity they decided they'd simply give him a rest for a while - "transferring" Booker to "another precinct". Then they just gave in - Booker's staying for keeps!

However, Richard Grieco's first career choice wasn't the fame and fortune acting brings. He was a sportsman. "I was a big sports person," he says. "I was an all-North football player and an all-American Lacrosse player. I played hockey - I was really into that, and I boxed at the end of High School to get my speed up."

After High School, Richard went to Southern Connecticut University on a football scholarship, but his sporting career was in trouble - because of a simple dicky knee! In fact, Richard had four (ugh) knee operations during his time at university, and he

was still playing football after the fourth one but, as he puts it, "I was always worried about getting hit again. If I got hit again, who knows if I'd be able to walk right?"

o, it was necessary to pursue some other avenue. Richard found his handsome looks made him ideal for modelling. What clothes designer could resist a guy like Grieco showing off their wares? However, modelling only lasted for six months. "It was pretty lucrative for me," he says, "I mean, I made a little bit of money, but I just saw it as a dead-end...it just didn't really stimulate me enough." What Richard really wanted was to become an actor.

With this in mind, the serious young man took to the streets. He wanted to find truth. "I was like in this creative stage, you know?" he recalls. "I thought, you know, I'm only young once and I was pretty secure with myself to know that something was going to happen. I just loved to sit on the streets watching people and talking to the bums." To Richard, homeless and starving people (he claims his best friends are bums and we think he means derros!) are the most sensitive and "real" people there are. That's probably why he enjoys his work on the hardline police show Booker so much!

nother side to Richard is his poetry. It's not just that he likes writing poetry - although he loves it - the thing is, he needs to write poetry. It's a creative outlet he couldn't function without! He's never without a notebook, and he's written over 400 poems, on topics near and dear to him...for instance, "people, emotions, how people react off of different social issues and just about people in general." Here's an example: "Youth, caught by its roots Dripping rules saturated around it Youth lost to a world Not yet an infant But controlled by adults Who live off the youth for life." However good he may be,

Richard doesn't think his

writing is ready to be published in book form.

There's been people

interested in publishing

them,but I don't want to do it yet," he reckons. "It'll be easier a year from now. I want to wait until I know they're perfect."

erfection is important to Richard - but sometimes he might be a little too perfect! In fact, his scenes with Johnny Depp in Jump St. convinced many people that the conflict between the two super hunks on the show were actually real! But Richard insists this isn't the case. "People try to make something of it," he explains, "but it's not really there just because we're conflicting as characters. As far as the show, I get along with the guy great. There's nothing there. I talk to him and we hang out together.'

The rumours were fuelled even more when Richard got his own spin-off show, Booker. But don't worry - the new series (we can't wait to see it!) is merely a reflection of Richard's talent and appeal. A talent he'd like to take further eventually, into movies.

"I want to do film," he says.

"That's my main goal. But I'm not in any hurry to pump out movies just for the sake of pumping out movies. I could've done that already. I just want to wait for some good stuff to come along and be picky."

ut even when those eager film producers do manage to snap up Richard, they better be prepared for a battle! He's not one to take orders. "I was the person always asking 'Why?" he recalls of his school days, and he's continued that rebellious tradition to the present day. "I once went to Catholic school on a motorcycle wearing a leather jacket. I was a good student though. I was sent there because they wanted me to get a little discipline!'

And discipline is just one of Richard's fine attributes. Richard Grieco - talent, skill, good looks and integrity - all wrapped up in one great guy!





"It does sort of bother us, yeah" says Danny. "Music is music, there should be just one chart. We've had some success on what they call the "urban" chart but nothing compared to our success on the black chart. We feel our songs are urban songs, so it does upset us at times, but...we're still successful."

Indeed! And that success reflects in the New Kids' increased confidence in their own songs. Most of their hits up to now have been penned by their manager Maurice Starrbut maybe that'll change with the next LP, eh Danny? "Not with our next album!" he replies.
"That's the Christmas

It's gonna have three remakes of old Christmas songs and the rest will be originals, six new songs from Maurice Starr - Donnie co-wrote one of those with Maurice. But for the album after that - we already have five or six songs written."

Before New Kids On The Block became one of the USA's hottest properties, some of the band's members hadn't even been outside Boston! So it's not surprising that the guys have a lot of affection for their hometown. "Yeah,

vou know. Boston's a great town," says Danny, "We've been to every major city in the USA and it really made us appreciate Boston a lot more. It's inbetween a lot of other cities. It's not as big as New York City, and it's not a smoggy L.A. - it's inbetween. It's nice, it's a very historical place - the Boston Tea Party and all that (ask a history teacher!) and the people are great. I know a lot of people always think of the racial violence in Boston in the late seventies and early eighties - we were all at school in black areas then but we never had any problems like that. And nothing like that ever happens now. Going to school and growing up in Boston was the best experience of my life, because I didn't grow up ignorant of different races - well, there were no races. inside that matters to all of us."

But as much of a Boston fan as he may be, Danny hasn't had much time to spend on the old home turf. "No, I haven't been there in at least a month," he reckons. "I really miss it. Yep, I still live with my mom and dad."






re the New


streets - but we stayed away from all the bad things on the streets. We were good street kids."

"Poor? Well, some of us at times were poor, but nothing outrageous. We always had food on the table. We hung out on the streets - we learnt a lot out there."

That's what the New Kids meant when they called their second LP "Hangin' Tough." Boston, you see, is a rough city to grow up in - many people remember its race riots in the sixties and seventies - and you have to battle to survive there, even if you're on the right side of the law. THE NEW SINGLE

"Tell Me Something' was written when I got a new piece of equipment (a Yamaha TX-Module, fact fans) and I started mucking around with the sounds on that. And this one sound which I use on the intro to Tell Me Something is the main keyboard riff and that's how I wrote the song with just this one sound. Then I started playing chords and worked on this bass riff and played it to David and he wrote the lyrics in 15 minutes. The whole song only took about half an hour to write - 20 minutes to do the music and 15 minutes do the lyrics.

Michael Szumowski, keyboardist extraordinaire, who has uttered these words, is at this moment ensconced in a dim, dark studio in Brisbane doing what musos in the business call "demoing" Basically this means that Mickski is tinkering about with all sorts of technical wizardry and being terribly intense about it.

David Dixon, singer supreme, is also in Brisbane. Except, he is setting up for a "gig" that the band is due to play the following evening. Basically this means that Dicko is supervising the lugging of the band's equipment and making sure that all the plugs go into the right holes and don't blow everyone up when the power is switched on! The two lads are in totally different locales but through the magic of print Smash Hits is able to bring these two Indecent boys together for your benefit. So, David, what's your version of the "Tell Me Something" story?

"Well, we wrote it about 18 months ago," he begins earnestly. "Our manager told us that we had to write eight songs in two days - as a joke and we did! It was just one of the ones that we came up with.

Indeed! And don't they make it all sound so easy! But let's rnove on, shall we! Let's change conversation topics to "something" like - what about the Indecent Obsession album?

THE ALBUM

"The album's due in November," commences Michael. "We've got five tracks down and ready to go and we're working on the other five at the moment. There's 'Say Goodbye', 'Tell Me Something', 'Spoken Words', 'Never Gonna Stop' and 'Why Don't You Come Back To Me'. Is that a smushy ballad? Yeah! It could be the third single. But there's another song which we've demoed which we really love which might be the third single. But who knows?

"There's no cover versions on the album, though. We wrote most of the material up to October of last year. But one of the songs, 'Spoken Words', was supposed to be the b-side of 'Tell Me Something' and it was literally written in 20 minutes. We just needed a song quick. We spent a fair time on recording it and it turned out to be too good for a b-side, so it's now on the album. The track on the b-side is called 'Why Do People Fall In Love'. That's one we wrote and recorded on Sunday!"

Quite makes the mind boggle, all this activity, don't it!?!! But what's the album going to be like. i.e. what can we expect from the debut Indecent Obsession long player? Quite a potent blend, actually!

"We've put a good variety of songs on the album," Michael chirps merrily. "We've gone from the rock feel of 'Say Goodbye' and 'Never

Gonna Stop', to dance tracks like 'Tell Me Something', to a rap track called 'Going Down'. (??) It's a good mixture - it shows the variety of styles that we're capable of. It proves that we're not just stuck in one vein, as far as musical styles

Perhaps we should throw over to David at this point for the tale of how the ... erm... odd-sounding rap-happy "Goin' Down" came into being.

FUNKY RAP

"That was again written about 18 months ago," utters Mr. Dixon. "It's sort of pretty funky with rap in the verses and then I sing the chorus. It was written about 18 months ago, so I suppose you can't really compare it to that same sort of thing that Bobby Brown or Neneh Cherry do. I didn't even know who Bobby Brown was until a few weeks ago!"

A slight aberration on your part, Davo old son, but don't worry! We won't reveal your terrible secret, will we readers!?!! (Hee! Hee!)

Speaking of nasty stuff; one thing you should never let David Dixon talk you into is allowing him to take you driving. A bit of a speed demon is our Dicko.

"Yeah, I can't drive at the moment," blurgs David. "'Cos I was driving back from Toowoomba earlier this year and I got caught for speeding and so they took my licence away from me. I've been without it since May, so Andrew and Michael have to do all the driving when we're on tour."

A ROCK REBEL?

Golly, looks like we've got a fully-fledged rock'n'roll rebel on our hands! David Dixon - the new James Dean! David Dixon - the next Alex Papps! Why Alex Papps? Well, David, you might remember, was offered a role in supersoap Home and Away, that's why!

"I turned it down because, well, I mean you've got Craig McLachlan with a single coming out and then there's another guy in Home and Away who's going to have one. I mean, I just thought to myself, 'I've got to concentrate on the music for now'. I'd still like to do something like that in the

future - but not right now!"






BEASTIE BOYS: Hey Ladies (EMI)

SINGLE OF THE FORTNIGHT

MAX Q: Way Of The World (CBS) "Max Q" has to be the worst name in the world for a band, so it's a strangely unfathomable paradox that Michael Hutchence's latest non-INXS project has actually produced a particularly great single. "Way Of The World" is stupendous and Mike gives it the vocals it deserves. The result is...magic! And by the way - the extended version is great value: four different songs, all excellent, where usually all you get is a dodgy instrumental of the A-side! Buy this record!!!





MICHAEL JACKSON: Liberian Girl (CBS) It's just not right that Michael should keep releasing singles off his old, old LP - and this one's nowhere near as good as some of the others. However, it does have its good points: 1. Michael sings like a dream. 2. The usual incredible video. 3. It keeps us in mind of Michael until he shocks us all again with something new!



ALICE COOPER: Poison (CBS)
Now, this is more like it! Alice is one of the greats and this song is a minor masterpiece. Actually, it's not a million miles removed from "Livin' On A Prayer", which probably has something to do with the fact that it was co-written and produced by Jovi chum Desmond Child. It's got a great chorus, a great set of subdued verses, a marvellous choir-like backing vocal, a hot guitar and a wild anthemic magnanimity that careens it right through the cave shaking down stalactites left, right and centre. What a guy!

PRINCE: Partyman (WEA)


"Batdance" was one of the greatest singles of '89, but somehow I really don't think this song - a lot less of an adventure for Prince or his fans - is going to do as well. (It also sounds like Supertramp and Bon Jovi with a bit of Johnny Diesel thrown in for good measure, ha ha ha.) No, Prince really is a great man, he's up there with Alice Cooper, but the album is a lot better value than this single.

RICHARD MARX: Right Here Waiting (EMI) Wait you must, Richard, for you are a small good looking man with a grand piano on your balcony. There you sit, in the moonlight, crooning softly to yourself at the most romantic part of the film in your top hat and tails, tears falling in big globs onto the piano keys because Cynthia's been home much too late from Animotion practise lately. No, really, "Right Here Waiting" is a beautiful ballad with an amazingly catchy tune and - like many other Richard Marx songs - it's destined to become a classic.

CYNDI LAUPER: My First Night Without You (CBS) Another classy classic with hit written all over it. People like Cyndi Lauper make the business of having spectacular hits look so darn easy - like all the best epics, this song is also blessed with a

great subdued, underhand beginning ... Cyndi's done it again!

JOHN COUGAR MELLENCAMP:
Jackie Brown (Polygram) I must say
I've never been a huge fan of J.C.M.
Mr. Soulful, "I'm not a pop star really
and don't give me large stacks of
money or platinum records as
integrity is all I care for." Fortunately
this record will not be doing anything

bland and snoresome.




NOISEWORKS: In My Youth (CBS) It's a pity that Noiseworks haven't had as much success as they should have this last year or so. "In My Youth" is extremely weird, hovering as it does between campy '50s stageiness and Cold Chisel-type earthy behaviour; it's not as catchy as some of their other singles ("Touch", for instance) but it still has the makings of a big hit, especially if it gets radio airplay.

U2: All I Want Is You (Festival) I always used to hate U2 and their great big overblown soaring ballads about Pride and Love and Fire. But there's actually something rather excellent about this single - probably something to do with the fact that it's not a great big overblown ballad. It's a sly, quiet thing based on a simple melody, a slightly military drumbeat and a very pleasing string arrangement. THE ROLLING STONES: Mixed Emotions (CBS) The Stones have done better in their time - they didn't get to megastar status on ordinary rock stomps like this one - but they've certainly done a lot worse, too. "Mixed Emotions" is a nicely put together rock song that's unmistakeably the gritty ol' Stones and undeniably hit material. Nice one grandad!

MARTIKA: Toy Soldiers (CBS) Martika is going to have a huge hit



with this little ditty - it's a glamorous, scary anti-drug operetta with lots of chilling kids' voices crying out about coming out and "playing". Not exactly my cup of tea but I'm sure it's going to mean a lot of different things to a lot of people.

PAUL NORTON: I Got You (Mushroom) If this gets to be a bigger hit than "Stuck On You", I'll eat my bicycle helmet. There's nothing particularly wrong with Paul Norton's new single - it's just not the automatic super-hit you might have expected from the obviously talented Paul. Back to the drawing board, Norty, and see if you can come up with another song with all the verve of the first one!

GLORIA ESTEFAN AND THE MIAMI SOUND MACHINE: Don't Wanna Lose You (CBS) I must say, Gloria and her Machine certainly do know how to write a stirring love ballad to have you weeping into your pillow/stuffed toy/lover's long curly tresses etc. It's what they do best, and they do it so well you just have to sit back, relax and enjoy it. A hit? Possibly...





Dexter's plagued by hay fever, and he's completely besotted by the nurse who's treating him for it, a certain Kate Lemon. So besotted is Dex, in fact, that he ends up being fired from his job. Luckily, fame and fortune present themselves in the form of the utterly tasteless musical *Elephant*, in which Dexter plays the Elephant Man himself. We see the show unfold in its various stages and discover what complete nonsense it is (although oddly enough it's a complete smash hit!). But more important to Dexter is his relationship with Kate, who leaves him on opening night. You'll just have to see the film to discover what happens! But while The Tall Guy isn't a complete success from beginning to end, it is a



thoroughly entertaining movie. Jeff Goldblum is marvellously believable; Rowan Atkinson could've been a little more horrendous, but not much; and Emma Thompson, who plays Nurse Lemon, is a star. Anyone who enjoys English comedy (or perhaps just the odd whacky love story) should go and see *The Tall Guy*.

red Savage is a cute little guy with a big talent - as lots of Australians discovered when they started watching that great show The Wonder Years a few months


