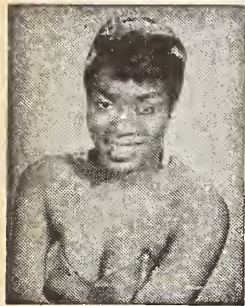




Canadian Capers
