WUBE Switches, Cincy C&W Sales Up

Major Cincinnati department stores and discount houses, along with their outlets in the Cincinnati area numbering some 50, are racking and displaying the top country singles in their record departments as the result of a promotional tie-in with radio station WUBE, in cooperation with Royal Distributing Co., local record distributor, the first in the country to rack C&W.

Royal Manager Paul Smith reports C&W sales have already increased some 25% since WUBE's switch from rock to modern country, bringing Royal's total output to over one and one half million records yearly, and still increasing. The displays, changed weekly, are set up according to the WUBE Countryopolitan Survey, copies of which are furnished in large numbers free to the outlets. The survey is also the basis for over 100 juke box operators who operate through Royal.

WUBE Program Director Bruce Nelson, along with Station Music Director Bob Tiffin, work closely with Royal and Paul Smith in keeping a close pulse on the greater Cincinnati market.

WUBE made the move to

modern country music on April 1 of this year, thus giving Cincinnati its only 24-hour-a-day country music station. The WUBE line-up is: Les Acree all night, Bruce Nelson 6-9 a.m., Bob Tiffin, 9-noon, Bill Phillips, noon-3 p.m., Wayne Shayne 3-6 p.m., Dave Bunce, 6-9 p.m., and Jay Stone 9-1 a.m.

Price on Tour

NASHVILLE — Ray Price continues to be one of the hardest working performers on the personal appearance road these days. The Columbia recording star is currently off on an extensive 33-day tour, which began on Sept. 5 in Imlay City, Mich., and will end on Oct. 7 at the Canton Auditorium in Canton, Ohio.

Immediately preceding his departure on this tour, Ray spent two days at Columbia's Studios in Nashville recording new material for future release. The sessions were produced by Don Law. Ray will participate in the Celebrity Pro-Am Golf Tournament this year, which is held the week-end prior to the start of the annual Country Music Convention in Nashville.

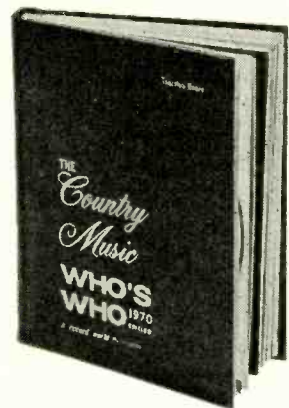
