Country Ainer Jingle on TV

TULSA—KCNW has announced a new phase in the race for country music ratings here. Dick Fain, program director, said that beginning April 3 KCNW will be using a rock jingle package.

Fain contends that since three stations in the market are programmed for country that the ratings will be won or lost in the presentation of the sound.

The package is produced by PAMS in Dallas and will first be heard over television station KOTV-TV as part of a 10-second spot starting about five days be-

fore the package is integrated into the KCNW country format.

Fain says the rock package is something he has wanted to use for sometime.

"I've played the jingles with every country record we're using and they don't do anything but help the sound," Fain said.

The television spots are not being used primarily to introduce the new package, however Fain noted that it is the first time in this market that a package was first previewed on television to induce new listenership.
